### Down Three

Atlanta has trailed New York, 4-1, in each of the last two games, yet has rallied to win both nights.

The Braves last erased deficits of at least three runs in back-to-back games in 2017, when Atlanta rallied to beat Miami on September 9 and September 10 here at Truist Park.

Atlanta has never won three straight games when trailing by at least three since moving to the city in 1966.

The Braves are 4-16 (.200) when trailing by three this season overall, tied for the sixth-most such wins in the majors.

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Braves and Mets tonight conclude a three-game series with what is the sixth of 13 games between the teams this season...The two will next meet from August 11-13, playing a four-game set at Citi Field in Queens.

Atlanta improved to 4-1 in five games with the Mets this season following last night's win.

The Braves went 10-9 against the Mets last season, taking the season set from their N.L. East rivals for the fifth consecutive season...They also went 10-9 in 2021, 7-3 in 2020, 11-8 in 2019 and 13-6 in 2018...Since the start of the 2018 season, Atlanta is 55-36 (.604) against New York overall.

The Braves have won 10 of the last 12 games with New York dating to last season, outscoring the Mets 71-41 (+30) over the stretch.

Atlanta has won six straight games here at Truist Park against New York, dating to August of last season...The Braves have not had a longer streak against the Mets at home since 1997-1998, when they won eight straight at Turner Field.

RH Spencer Strider has six career appearances and four total starts against the Mets, going 3-1 with a 5.03 ERA (11 ER/19.2 IP)...He has a higher ERA against just one team in baseball (San Francisco - 8.31)...In his only turn versus the Mets this season, May 1 at Citi Field, he allowed five hits and four runs over 5.0 innings, but earned the win in Atlanta's victory, 9-8.

RH Justin Verlander has made just three career starts against Atlanta, going 2-1 with a 2.57 ERA (6 ER/21.0 IP) and 25 strikeouts...The 6-foot-5, 225-pound native of Manakin-Sabot, VA, has completed exactly 7.0 innings in each of his three career turns...He has not faced the Braves since 2016 while with Detroit, and took the loss despite allowing just one run over 7.0 innings.

**WIN:** Atlanta erased a second consecutive three-run deficit to rally and beat New York, 7-5, last night... The Braves improved to 14-5 (.737) against N.L. East opponents with the win.

The win marked Atlanta's third straight come-from-behind win after also doing so Sunday at Arizona... The Braves improved to 14-24 (.368) when trailing at any point this season, tied for the eighth-best record in baseball.

The Braves have won each of their last three home games, tying their season-long streak here at Truist Park...Atlanta's last home winning streak longer than three games was a 10-game run, August 31 to September 20 of last season.

Atlanta scored all seven of its runs with two outs, the most two-out runs for the club since plating nine runs with two outs, August 2, 2022 vs. Philadelphia...Last night was the first time Atlanta scored at least seven runs in a game and all of them came with two outs since scoring eight on April 20, 2019 at Cleveland.

**BRIAN SNITKER WINS:** Atlanta's win last night was the 579th of Brian Snitker's managerial career, tying him with George Stallings for the third-most wins by a manager in franchise history...A win tonight will give him sole possession.

The franchise has had 48 managers since its inception into the National League in 1876, and Snitker has won more games than all but two of them.

Snitker trails just Frank Selee (1,004 wins) and Bobby Cox (2,149 wins) on the franchise leaderboard...Both Selee and Cox are enshrined in the National Baseball Hall of Fame.

Snitker became the fifth manager in franchise history to skipper 1,000 games on April 6 earlier this season, joining Cox (3,860), Selee (1,677), George Stallings (1,201) and Bill McKechnie (1,235).

Snitker has compiled a 579-475 (.549) record as manager of the Braves, winning five consecutive N.L. East titles and the World Series in 2021...Since taking over for Atlanta on May 17, 2016, Snitker's 579 wins stand as fourth most for any manager in baseball...The Dodgers' Dave Roberts (672) and Guardians' Terry Francona (602) rank first and second, respectively, while the Rays's Kevin Cash (594) sits third.

Atlanta's 23 postseason wins since Snitker took over in 2016 are third most in baseball, trailing just the Astros (53) and Dodgers (45).

**OUTFIELD DEFENSE:** Dating to May 20, Atlanta's defense has turned 67% of balls hit to the outfield into outs, the best mark in the majors...For reference, the major league average in that span is just 59%.

Ronald Acuña Jr. and Michael Harris II both made notable plays in the outfield last night, with Acuña Jr. catching a ball at the wall that had just a 70% catch probability, and Harris II nabbing a liner off the barrel with an expected batting average of .820.

Atlanta's outfielders have combined for 11 assists this season, tied with Arizona and Cincinnati for most in the National League.

**MICHAEL HARRIS II:** Went 3-for-4 with a game-winning home run in the eighth inning last night, his first three-hit game of the season and just his third home run...He raised his OPS for the season by 62 points in one game, entering with a .490 mark before a .552 OPS at game's end.

The home run was just the second of his career to give Atlanta a lead in the eighth inning or later, joining a two-run shot on August 12 of last season at Miami.

Dating to last Saturday in Arizona, six of his last nine balls in play have had exit velocities over 100.0, including his final two plate appearances last night.

#### Today's Game

- Strider is set to make his 13th start this year and second of the season against New York (NL).
- Tied with Toronto's Kevin Gausman for the most strikeouts in the majors at 113.
  - Gausman has 13 starts to Strider's 12.
- His 10 games of at least 10 strikeouts are third most in MLB history (since 1901) through a player's first 32 starts.
- Leads all qualified starters with a rate of 14.60 strikeouts per nine innings this season.
  - Dating to 1901, his 15.14 K/9 rate is the highest of any player through 10 starts to open a season.
  - The next closest were Tyler Glasnow ('20) and Jacob deGrom ('21), through their first 10 starts in a season dating to 1901.
- His swing and miss rate of 39.7% is the highest in the majors (among QS).
  - Strider's 55.7% rate of pitches in the zone is the third highest among qualifiers; trails only Seattle's George Kirby and Pittsburgh's Mitch Keller.

#### 2023 Recap

- With his strikeout of Nick Castellanos in the fourth inning on May 28, he became the fastest starting pitcher, by innings pitched (61.0), to reach 100 strikeouts in a season, since the mound was moved to its current distance in 1893...Jacob deGrom, then of New York (NL) was the previous record-holder, doing so in 61.2 innings in 2021...Strider bested his own franchise record, set last season in 64.2 innings. (Research courtesy of Elias)
- Struckout J.T. Realmuto to reach 300 on his career.
  - Strider became the 13th player in major league history to record at least 300 strikeouts in 44 career appearances or less and first since Shane Bieber in 2018.
- Of the other 12 pitchers, Strider is the only one to have more than two relief appearances in his first 44 outings.
- Snapped a streak of 12 consecutive games with at least eight strikeouts on May 17.
  - Tied Hall-of-Famers Nolan Ryan and Randy Johnson for the seventh longest such streak in the live ball era.
  - Only Hall-of-Famers Ryan, Johnson, Pedro Martínez and active pitchers Corey Kluber and Shane Bieber have longer streaks.
- Struck out 12 hitters on May 12 at Toronto, giving Strider nine games of at least 10 strikeouts; the most through a player's first 41 appearances in franchise history(1901).
  - The next closest were Brandon Beachy, Tommy Hanson, and Julio Teheran with three each in their first 41 outings.
  - Tied with Noah Syndergaard, Kerry Wood, and Al Downing for seventh most in MLB history (dating to 1901) through a player's first 41 games.
- On May 1 against New York (NL) Strider snapped his streak of nine consecutive games with at least nine strikeouts that began on September 1, 2022.
  - It is tied for third-longest such streak in the modern era (since 1900).
  - Passed Hall-of-Famer John Smoltz for the longest streak in franchise history.
- Carried a perfect game into the seventh inning in his last start against Miami until he lost his bid on a Matt Olson error.
  - Maintained a no-hitter through 7.1 innings; broken up on a single by Jean Segura.
  - Struckout a season-high 13 hitters and finished with two hits allowed over 8.0 innings pitched.

#### 2022 Recap

- Pitched his first full major league season and went 11-5 with a 2.67 ERA (39 ER/131.2 IP) and 202 strikeouts...Led rookie pitchers in the majors with 4.9 fWAR and 3.7 bWAR.
  - Is the only pitcher in baseball history to record at least 200 strikeouts and allow fewer than 100 hits in a year... Fanned 202 and allowed just 86 hits on the season.
- Became the quickest pitcher in baseball history to ever reach 200 strikeouts in a single season, doing so in his 130.0th inning...Hall-of-Famer LHP Randy Johnson held the previous record, reaching 200 strikeouts in 130.2 innings in 2001.
  - Was the third rookie in franchise history to strikeout 200 in a season, and the first in the modern era...The other rookies to reach 200 strikeouts were RHP Kid Nichols, who struck out 222 in 1890, and Bill Stemmyer, who fanned 239 in 1886.

#### Career Recap

- Drafted by the Atlanta Braves in the fourth round of the 2020 MLB June Amateur Draft.
- In three seasons with Clemson, went 5-2 with a 4.71 ERA (33 ER/63.0 IP) in 26 appearances, 10 starts.
  - Struck out 89, an average of 12.7 per 9.0 innings.

# Braves Bullpen Briefs

**Nick Anderson • RHP • 6-4 • 205 • 32 yrs • #61**

**Saves/Opp:** 1/3 **Holds:** 10 **1st Batter/Retired:** 24/22 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 5/1

- Per FanGraphs, has held opponents to a .105 batting average in high-leverage situations...Among pitchers with at least 10 high-leverage appearances, that average ranks second in the National League and fifth in MLB.
- His four wins in relief are tied for second most in MLB.
- Has induced a swing and miss on 30 curveballs this season, third most by an MLB reliever on the pitch.
- On May 24, the first batter he faced (Will Smith, LAD) hit an opposite-field single...Marked the first time Anderson had let his first batter reach this season...Had retired the first batter in each of his first 19 outings...Anderson was one of two pitchers in the majors to retire the first batter every time (min. 19 appearances)...Also Wandy Peralta (NY, 23 games)...The last Braves reliever to retire the first batter in each of his first 19 appearances was Brandon Cunniff in 2015...Cunniff retired the first batter in each of his first 24 outings.
- 2023 is his fourth major league season...Prior to this season, owned a 2.89 ERA (28 ER/87.1 IP) and 137 strikeouts in 93 career games over three major league seasons, pitching for the Marlins (2019) and Rays (2019-21).
- Did not appear in the majors in 2022 after undergoing right elbow surgery in October of 2021.

**Jesse Chavez • RHP • 6-1 • 175 • 39 yrs • #60**

**Saves/Opp:** 1/3 **Holds:** 12 **1st Batter/Retired:** 27/19 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 11/6

- Among pitchers with at least 25 appearances, his 1.73 ERA (5 ER/26.0 IP) ranks third in the N.L. and 10th in MLB.
- His 12 holds are tied for fourth in Major League Baseball.
- Is the sixth-oldest player in the major leagues, and the fourth-oldest pitcher.
- Before giving up three earned runs on April 21, Chavez was one of three Braves since 2014 with 10 scoreless appearances to start the season, joining Hunter Cervenka (15 games, 2016) and Shane Greene (10 games, 2020).
- His first 10 appearances were scoreless for the first time in his 16-season MLB career.
- Posted a 2.42 ERA in 45 relief appearances with Atlanta (52.0 IP)...Had a 6.35 ERA in three appearances (5.2 IP) with Chicago (NL) and a 7.59 ERA in 11 appearances (10.2 IP) with Los Angeles (AL).
- His 67.7% strand rate between the Braves and Cubs was the sixth highest in the NL (min. 30 inherited runners).

**Raisel Iglesias • RHP • 6-2 • 190 • 33 yrs • #26**

**Saves/Opp:** 8/9 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 14/10 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 0/0

- Has converted each of his last eight save opportunities, dating to May 17.
- Prior to May 30, hadn't walked three batters in an outing since September 2, 2018 while with Cincinnati...Marked the first time he'd walked multiple batters while with Atlanta.
- On May 10, allowed a home run for the first time since June 12, 2022 with the Angels – a homerless span of 45 games and 42.2 innings...It was the fifth-longest active homerless streak by a reliever in the majors.
- On May 5 was activated from the IL after missing Atlanta's first 32 games with a strained right shoulder...Pitched in four spring training games, compiling a 4.50 ERA (2 ER/4.0 IP) in four outings.
- In 2022, had a 2.47 ERA in 67 games with 17 saves and 15 holds between Atlanta and Los Angeles (AL)...After the trade deadline, led N.L. with a 41.7% chase rate (swings out of the zone)...Trailed only CLE's E. Clase.
- Allowed just one earned run in 28 relief appearances after becoming a member of the Braves...His 0.34 ERA during that span dating to the trade deadline is the lowest in baseball (min. 20 appearances).

**Joe Jiménez • RHP • 6-3 • 277 • 28 yrs • #77**

**Saves/Opp:** 0/0 **Holds:** 2 **1st Batter/Retired:** 20/16 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 10/4

- Pitched 62 games for DET last year, going 3-2 with a 3.49 ERA (22 ER/56.2 IP), striking out 77 and walking 13.
- Acquired from Detroit on Dec. 7, 2022 in exchange for OF Justyn-Henry Malloy and LHP Jake Higginbotham.
- Named to the A.L. All-Star team in 2018 during his first full major league campaign.
- Last season, his 12.23 strikeouts per 9.0 innings ranked fifth in the American League among pitchers with at least 50.0 innings, and his 1.4 fWAR for the season matched his career high.
- Fanned 33.3% of the batters he faced in 2022, which ranked in the top five percent of the majors.

**Collin McHugh • RHP • 6-2 • 190 • 34 yrs • #32**

**Saves/Opp:** 0/0 **Holds:** 4 **1st Batter/Retired:** 17/12 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 15/3

- His 2.23 ERA over the past three combined seasons (since 2021) is the fourth lowest in baseball (min. 100 games).
- Pitched in three games on Atlanta's opening road trip before landing on the Injured List on April 6, diagnosed with right shoulder inflammation...Pitched in two games with High-A Rome as part of his rehab assignment, tossing 4.2 scoreless innings with four strikeouts...Went 3.0 innings in his most recent rehab outing on April 21.
- 2023 is his 11th MLB season...Finished 2022 with a 2.60 ERA and a 3-2 record in his first season with Atlanta.
- In 48 outings (59.0 IP) after May 6 last season, he pitched to a 1.98 ERA.
- In 2022, Stranded 28 of 38 inherited runners for a 73.7% strand rate...The 38 inherited runners were tied for the most in the NL and his strand rate is the third highest among NL pitchers (min. 30 IR).

**A.J. Minter • LHP • 6-0 • 215 • 27 yrs • #33**

**Saves/Opp:** 8/11 **Holds:** 2 **1st Batter/Retired:** 30/23 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 9/4

- His expected ERA (3.96, Fangraphs) is more than a full point lower than his actual ERA (6.04).
- Has surrendered 10 hits on his fastball this season...Allowed 19 hits on the pitch all of last season.
