THIS DATE IN ORIOLES HISTORY
On this date in 1999, INF Cal Ripken, Jr. became the 29 th player in Major League history to hit 400 career home runs with a three-run blast off Tampa Bay's RHP Rolando Arrojo in the third inning of an 11-6 win at Camden Yards.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Orioles notched 15 hits and defeated the New York Mets 9-5 on Tuesday night at Camden Yards...The O's improved to 13-5 when recording at least 10 hits in a game and have now won five of their last six game against the Mets, dating back to August 19, 2015.

⚾ **INF Renato Núñez** connected for a three-run home run in the first inning and hit his second homer of the night to lead off the seventh inning, marking the second time this year, and fourth time in his career, with two home runs in a game...He has now hit safely in 26 of his first 34 games, including recording an extra-base hit in 15 of the 34.

⚾ **INF Pat Valaika** smacked lead-off singles in the second and fourth innings, an RBI double in the sixth, and a single in the seventh for his first career four-hit game...It marked his fourth multi-hit game of the season.

THE MORE THE MERRIER: The Orioles have four different players (**INF Hanser Alberto** - 14, **INF José Iglesias** - 11, **INF Renato Núñez** - 10, and **OF Anthony Santander** - 10) who have recorded double digit multi-hit games this season...The four players rank as the most in the AL and are tied for the most in the majors (SD and ARI)...Alberto's 14 multi-hit games rank second in the AL and are tied for the third-most in the majors.

⚾ **INF José Iglesias** has recorded a multi-hit game in a career-high six-straight games, the longest active streak in the majors and tied for the longest overall streak in the majors this season (**Charlie Blackmon**, COL and **Kyle Lewis**, SEA)

⚾ Iglesias' multi-hit game streak is the longest by an Oriole since **Danny Valencia** also recorded six-straight from August 4-September 1, 2013...The Orioles record is 10-straight multi-hit games, done twice (**Rich Dauer**, 7/18-28/78 and **Bob Nieman**, 5/4-22/58).

.400 HITTER: **INF José Iglesias** went 2-for-5 with a double and an RBI on Tuesday against the New York Mets and is now hitting .405 (32-for-79) through his first 21 games with the Orioles...Among players with at least 50 at-bats, Iglesias' .405 average leads the majors, while New York-AL's **DJ LeMahieu** ranks second with a .402 average.

I SAN-TAN-DARE YOU: **OF Anthony Santander** went 2-for-4 on Tuesday with a home run and three RBI...He has hit safely in 22 of his last 25 games...His recent hitting streak of 18 games marked a career high...Santander hit .329 (25-for-76) with eight home runs, eight doubles, a triple, and 20 RBI from August 5 [2]-23...It was the longest stretch by an Oriole since **Nick Markakis**' 18-game mark from April 21-May 11, 2014.

⚾ Santander's 11 home runs on the season lead the O's, are tied for sixth in the AL, and are tied for seventh in the majors...He is tied for first in the AL and is tied for second in the majors with 32 RBI this season...25 of his 40 hits have been for extra-bases (13 doubles, one triple, 11 home runs), leads the AL and leads the majors with 25 extra-base hits.

THAT HANSER IS SO HOT RIGHT NOW: **INF Hanser Alberto** went 1-for-4 on Monday...Since the start of the 2019 season, Alberto leads the majors with 100 hits off of left-handed pitching...In that time, he leads the majors with a .405 (100-for-247) average against lefties...This season, Alberto ranks fifth in the AL and 11th in the majors with a .321 (45-for-140) average against all pitchers...He is tied for third in the AL and is tied for fourth in the majors with 12 doubles...His 14 multi-hit games rank second in the AL and are tied for third-most in the majors.

SMALL BALL FOR ALL: The Orioles lead the majors with 12 bunt hits this season...**OF Cedric Mullins** leads the majors with seven bunt hits, while **INF Hanser Alberto** ranks second in the majors with three bunt hits and **INF/OF Andrew Velazquez** is tied for third in the majors with two bunt hits.

CATCH THIS: The O's catching corps of **Pedro Severino**, **Chance Sisco**, and **Bryan Holaday** ranks among league leaders in many offensive categories...Severino ranks seventh in the AL with a .309 (30-for-97) overall batting average...O's catchers ranks (while catching):

IF YOU AIN'T FIRST, YOU'RE LAST: The O's have been very successful swinging at the first pitch of an at-bat...They rank first in the majors in batting average (.419), rank third in OPS (1.134) and extra-base hits (24), lead the AL and are rank second in the majors in doubles (15), and lead the AL and are tied for fifth in the majors in hits (57) as a team on the first pitch.

⚾ **OF Anthony Santander** leads the Orioles with nine hits on the first pitch...He is tied for ninth-most in the majors and is tied for second in the AL...**INF Renato Núñez** is tied for ninth in the AL with seven first-pitch hits, while **INF Hanser Alberto** is tied for 19th in the AL with six hits on the first pitch of an at-bat.

⚾ Santander and Núñez are tied for fourth in the majors with five extra-base hits each on the first pitch, while **C Pedro Severino** is tied for ninth in the majors with four extra-base hits on the first pitch.

INTERLEAGUE INFO: The O's will play a total of 20 games against National League opponents this season, including contests with the Miami Marlins (0-4), Washington Nationals (4-2), Philadelphia Phillies (3-0), New York Mets (1-0), and Atlanta Braves (three games)...Since Interleague Play began in 1997, the O's are 205-232...The O's went 7-13 in Interleague Play last season...Baltimore's 14 Interleague victories in 2016 were the most in club history.

LAST START: Made his fifth start of the season on 8/28 at TOR...Did not factor in the decision after tossing 4.0 innings and allowing two runs on four hits (two home runs) with one walk and three strikeouts...He has allowed two home runs in each of his last two starts, and has given up six home runs on the season...The Orioles have lost each of the five games that Means has started in this year.

UNFAMILIAR FACES: Means will be making his first career outing against the Mets... Will be just his third career appearance against any NL East opponent, with all three coming in the 2020 season...His last start against an NL East opponent was on 8/16 vs. WSH when he allowed three runs on four hits and one walk through 0.2 innings, marking the shortest start of his career.

STARTING SLOW: Means has posted a 15.43 ERA (8 ER/4.2 IP) in the first inning in his five starts this season...Opponents are hitting .350 (7-for-20) with two walks in the first inning...For his career, Means' first inning ERA is 5.40 (19 ER/31.2 IP).

HOME VS. ROAD: Means will be making his fifth start at home this season...In 22 career games (20 starts) at home, Means is 8-7 with a 3.51 ERA (40 ER/102.2 IP), compared to 4-6 with a 5.25 ERA (41 ER/70.1 IP) in 15 games (12 starts) on the road...Has held opponents to a .215 (83-for-387) clip in games at Oriole Park, as opposed to his .276 (77-for-279) opponent average on the road...Held a five-game winning streak in games started at home from 4/24-6/28/19.

LEFT IS RIGHT: Means has held lefties to a .205 average (33-for-161) in his career, compared to a .252 clip (127-for-504) against right-handed batters...Means held left-handed hitters to a .184 (26-for-141) clip last season, which ranked eighth-lowest in the AL and 13th-lowest in the majors...Lefties had a .223 OBP and slugged just .333 against Means...Left-handers hit .153 (13-for-85) against him at Oriole Park in 2019.

AT THE TOP OF HIS CLASS: Finished the 2019 campaign leading all rookie pitchers (min. 155.0 IP) in opponent batting average (.234), and ranked in the top 10 among rookie pitchers in: opponent OPS (2nd - .702), WHIP (2nd - 1.14), K/BB (2nd - 3.18), ERA (3rd - 3.60), K/9 (3rd - 7.03), winning percentage (3rd - .522), wins (4th - 12), opponent SLG (4th - .417), HR/9 (4th .134), strikeouts (5th - 121), and Quality Starts (6th - 11)...He received votes from the media in April and May's voting for AL Rookie of the Month.

A MEAN-INGFUL FIRST HALF: In the first half of his rookie campaign last year, Means pitched to a 7-4 record with a 2.50 ERA (23 ER/82.2 IP) in 18 games (14 starts), and was named to the American League All-Star team as the Orioles lone representative...**According to STATS, LLC., Means was the fifth rookie in Orioles history (since 1954), and first since 1966, to be named to the All-Star team...**He joined RHP Chuck Estrada (1960), 1B Jim Gentile (1960), INF Ron Hansen (1960), and C Andy Etchebarren (1966) as O's rookie All-Stars...**He became the first home-grown Orioles starter to make the All-Star team since Hall of Famer Mike Mussina, who made five All-Star Game appearances with the Orioles...**Means' 2.50 pre-All-Star Game ERA was the best amongst Orioles rookies since 1954 (min. 80.0 IP).

SECOND HALF RECAP: Means made 13 starts in the second half, pitching to a 5-7 record with a 4.85 ERA (39 ER/72.1 IP) and six Quality Starts...He worked at least 6.0 innings in seven of his 13 post-All-Star break starts, going 4-2 with a 3.13 ERA (16 ER/46.0 IP) in such games...Had a career-high four-game losing streak from 7/24-8/19, followed by a two-game winning streak from 8/24-8/30, during which he allowed just three earned runs over 14.0 innings of work with 11 strikeouts and no walks.

FRIDAY'S STARTERS - RHP ALEX COBB (1-3, 4.33 ERA) AND RHP JORGE LOPEZ (0-0, 7.53 ERA)

Cobb will be making his eighth start of the season...In his last outing on 8/29 at TOR, Cobb suffered his third loss of the season and has now lost three-straight decisions after winning his first start of the season...He allowed a season-high-tying five runs (four earned) on a season-high eight hits with two walks and two strikeouts in 4.0 innings of work...He'll be making his first start of the season against New York-AL...For his career, he has gone 7-4 with a 2.92 ERA (35 ER/108.0 IP) in 18 starts against the Yankees...In 11 career home starts against the Bronx Bombers, Cobb has gone 5-2 with a 2.94 ERA (22 ER/67.1 IP)...López will be making his second start (sixth appearance) of the season...In his last outing, his first start of the season, López worked 4.2 innings, allowing three runs on three hits with three walks and three strikeouts on 8/30 at TOR; did not factor in the decision as the O's fell 6-5...This will be his third career start against New York-AL, having gone 0-1 with a 10.13 ERA (9 ER/8.0 IP) in his first two starts...His last start against the Yankees came last year, on May 25 in Kansas City, when he allowed five runs in 1.0 inning of work.
