OHIO RIVER RUMBLE TOUR: The Cardinals continue an eight-game road trip through the National League Central against two Ohio River-based opponents playing four games in Cincinnati (July 18-21; 3-1) and then four in Pittsburgh (July 22-25)...today the Cardinals open a four-game series with the Pittsburgh Pirates at PNC Park...the Cardinals lead the 2019 season series 5-4 including a two-game sweep in early April...the Cardinals have won seven of their last nine games and enter today in 3rd place in the National League Central 2.5 games behind 1st place Chicago and one-half game behind 2nd place Milwaukee.

RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals held off the Cincinnati Reds 3-1 at Great American Ballpark yesterday afternoon to win the four-game series...**Yairo Muñoz** was 3-for-4 missing the cycle by a double, hitting an RBI single in the 2nd inning, a triple in the 7th and put the finishing touches on with a solo home run off **Raisel Iglesias** in the 9th inning...**Giovanny Gallegos** earned the win by coming in with bases loaded in the 5th and striking out consecutive batters... **Carlos Martínez** picked up his eighth save of the season.

7-ELEVEN: The Cardinals will be playing the Pittsburgh Pirates seven times over 11 days, taking a three-game series in St. Louis (July 15-17) and playing the Pirates the next four games in Pittsburgh (July 22-25). The two teams will battle again for the final time in St. Louis (August 9-11) before playing their final series between the two Division rival clubs in Pittsburgh (Sept. 6-8).

PLUNDERING THE PIRATES: **Tyler O'Neill** has hit safely in his last eight career games against the Pirates dating back to 8/30/18 posting a .480 BA (12-25) with 4 HR and 11 RBI. O'Neill posted three straight games with multiple hits vs. the Pirates (7/15-17) including his first multi-home run game (7/15). The last Cardinals player with four straight multi-hit games vs. PIT was **Randal Grichuk** in 2017. The club record is 10 straight games with two or more hits by **Lou Brock** in 1964.

FROM WORST TO FIRST: The St. Louis Cardinals currently lead Major League Baseball with a .989 fielding percentage, just one season after the Cardinals finished last in MLB with a .978 fielding percentage in 2018. **Paul DeJong** leads all MLB shotstops with a .993 fielding percentage, while **Jack Flaherty** and **Miles Mikolas** also are tied for first among MLB pitchers (1.000). The Cardinals have not made an error in their last six games, tying the club high (6, June 21-28).

RUNNIN' REDBIRDS: The Cardinals recorded four stolen bases off the Reds yesterday, the 4th game this season they have recorded four or more stolen bases. **Andrew Knizner** and **Tyler O'Neill** each stole their first base of the season to give the club 16 different players with at least one theft, the most in MLB (Boston, 13, 2nd). The franchise record is held by the 1906 club with 21 players. St. Louis currently ranks 2nd in the National League with 65 stolen bases, trailing Milwaukee (68), while **Kolten Wong** ranks T6th in the N.L. with 14 stolen bases.

RUNNING OF THE BULLS: The Cardinals bullpen has post a National League leading 3.88 ERA, holding their opposition to a league best .210 batting average this season and have converted 76.9% of their save opportunities, the highest in the league. Cardinals relievers have held their opposition scoreless in 37 games this season and rank 2nd among N.L. teams with relievers posting 96 appearances of four outs or more (Milwaukee, 113).

GALLEG'OS: Relief pitcher **Giovanny Gallegos** has been a top-notch stopper out of the Cardinals bullpen this season. Since his recall on April 11, Gallegos is 2nd among National League relievers with 67 strikeouts, trailing only Milwaukee's **Josh Hader** (75) over that period. Gallegos leads Cardinals relievers in strikeouts (3rd NL), relief ERA (2.31, 10th), opponent BA (.173, 9th), opponent OBP (.220, 2nd), inherited runners scored pct. (10.3, 2nd), strikeout/walk ratio (8.38, 2nd) and has thrown four scoreless appearances with three of four outs or more since the All-Star Break. Gallegos has made 17 appearances of four outs or more, 23 appearances with multiple strikeouts and has the longest scoreless inning sterak on the club (15.1 IP).

CARRYING THE FREIGHT: Since **Yadier Molina's** last game as starting catcher on July 3, before ultimately landing on the Injured List on July 11 (right thumb tendon strain), **Matt Wieters** and **Andrew Knizner** have picked up the load batting combined .250 (12-48) with 3 HR, 5 RBI and a .322 on-base percentage while throwing out 57.1% of attempted base stealers. The club has posted a 9-5 record since July 4. Wieters leads all National League catchers with three home runs in the month of July.

PITTSBURGH CONNECTIONS

Paul DeJong was originally selected by the Pirates in the 38th round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign.

Harrison Bader previously committed to play at the University of Pittsburgh and University of Maryland before receiving a partial scholarship from the University of Florida.

Yadier Molina (June 3, 2004) and **José Martínez** (September 6, 2016) made their Major League debuts against Pittsburgh.

Miles Mikolas spent one month as a Pirate during the 2013 offseason...traded by San Diego with infielder **Jaff Decker** to Pittsburgh for outfielder **Alex Dickerson** (Nov. 25, 2013), then traded by Pittsburgh Texas in exchange for infielder **Chris McGuiness** (Dec. 30, 2013).

Pirates manager **Clint Hurdle** was selected by St. Louis from the Mets in the 1985 Rule 5 Draft... played 86 games for the Cardinals in 1986.

Pitching coach **Mike Maddux** signed with the Pirates in April 1995 and pitched in eight games before being released in May.

Bench coach **Oliver Marmol** was originally selected by the Pirates in the 31st round of the 2004 MLB draft, but did not sign.

Assistant Hitting Coach **Mark Budaska** was born in nearby Sharon, Pennsylvania.

Pirates pitching coach **Ray Searage** was selected by St. Louis in the 22nd round of the 1976 MLB Draft...later traded to the Mets for catcher **Jody Davis** in 1979...began coaching career in the Cardinals minor league system as Pitching Coach with Madison (1994), Peoria (1995-96) & Prince William (1997).

Pirates Hitting Coach **Rick Eckstein** previously served as the 2007 hitting coach for the Memphis Redbirds (AAA).

Pirates Baseball Operations Special Assistant in **David Eckstein** played three seasons at shortstop with St. Louis (2005-07), where he was a two-time NL All-Star (2005-06) and member of the 2006 World Series Champions.

Pirates Baseball Operations Senior Advisor **Nick Leyva** was drafted by St. Louis in the 24th round in 1975...played three minor league seasons in the Cardinals system (1975-77)...managed six minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization (1978-83)...served as St. Louis' First Base Coach (1984-85) and Third Base Coach (1986-88).

Cardinals Baseball Information & Media Services Administrator **Chris Tunno** graduated from nearby Canfield (Ohio) High School.

Pirates Manager of Business Communications & Social Media **Terry Rodgers** previously worked as a Public Relations Specialist in the Cardinals Communications department (2010-11).

TONIGHT’S GAME

- Rookie right-hander makes his sixth Major League start of the 2019 season and his 10 career start (20th appearance).
- Tonight marks his second start since officially being designated as a regular in the rotation.
- In five starts this season with St. Louis, is 0-0 with a 2.49 ERA (25.1 IP) and 26 strikeouts. The Cardinals are 4-1 in his games started.
- Is 0-2 with a 2.62 ERA in nine career starts (44.2 IP/13 ER), receiving just 15 runs of support (1.67 runs/game). St. Louis is 5-4 in his eight career starts.
- Two of his five prior starts this season were as fill in for Adam Wainwright (6/14 at NYM & 7/12 vs. ARI).

LAST TIME OUT

- Allowed career-high eight hits and matched career-highs four runs in St. Louis come-from-behind 6-5 win over the Pirates in last Wednesday’s homestand finale.

2019 SEASON

- Made emergency start for (7/12) Adam Wainwright (back spasms) and limited Arizona to one run on three hits in his 6.2 IP, striking out seven. Took ND in the 4-2 loss.
- Had a career-best 7.2 scoreless innings streak between his 7/4 relief appearance at Seattle and 7/12 start vs. Arizona.
- Gained his 1st career MLB win on 7/4 at Seattle with 2.2 scoreless IP and 3 strikeouts in his 2nd relief appearance of 2019.
- Fanned a career-high 9 on 6/29 at SD in 5.1 relief IP. The 9 strikeouts in relief were the most by a Cardinal since Al Hrabosky did so 9/25/74 vs. PIT. His 5.1 relief innings were also a Cardinals season high.
- Recalled on 6/25 with RHP Dominic Leone when RHP Jordan Hicks went to 10-day IL and LHP Genesis Cabrera was optioned to Memphis (AAA); was his third recall this season (also 4/23 & 6/9).
- Optioned to Memphis (AAA) on 6/20 when Adam Wainwright was activated from the 10-day IL, but did not pitch.
- Scattered two hits over 6.0 scoreless innings in a 6/19 start vs. Miami.
- Made a spot start for St. Louis on April 23 vs. Milwaukee and took a no-decision in the Cardinals 4-3 win, allowing just one run in his 5.0 IP with 7 strikeouts.
- In 11 starts for Memphis this season, is 4-4 with a 3.90 ERA (55.1 IP), striking out 47 and limiting the opposition to a .237 batting average.
