FLIGHT PATTERN: The St. Louis Cardinals continue a nine-game, 10day road trip with the second of a three-game series against the Cincinnati Reds at Great American Ballpark. The Cardinals play three three-game series in Cincinnati (May 27-29), Philadelphia (May 31-June 2) and Houston (June 3-5) with an open date in Philadelphia (May 30). St. Louis enters today in 3rd place, 5.5 games behind first place Milwaukee and one game behind 2nd place Chicago.

RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals fell to the Reds 3-1 on Memorial Day dropping their record on the Day of Remembrance to 25-24 and snapping a season-high five-game win streak. **Paul Goldschmidt** homered (#7) for the 3rd time in the last two days for the Cardinals only offense. St. Louis had one opportunity with runners in scoring position on the day, while their pitching held the Reds to only five hits and allowed just one hit after the 2nd inning.

MOTHER NATURE: Since a Mother's Day win in Milwaukee, the Cardinals sport the National League's best winning pct. (.769, 10-3) since

- Rank 2nd in the National League only to San Francisco in batting (.275), on-base pct. (.347) and slugging (.432) and T-2nd with 16 home runs.
- Have experienced a total of 8 hours & 15 minutes of rain/hail delays & thunderstorms/tornado warnings that have suspended one game and postponed another.

THE "GOLD" STANDARD: Cardinals first baseman Paul Goldschmidt homered in the 1st inning yesterday, the first time in 2024 he has homered on consecutive days. The slugger has hit a team-leading five home runs in the month of May and all since May 12. Goldschmdit hadn't homered on consecutive days since Aug. 19-20, 2022 at Arizona and has not pulled off the feat in three or more games since July 16-24, 2022 with all four games against Cincinnati 2022, with all four games against Cincinnati.

MY 3RD HOME: The home run by Paul Goldschmidt yesterday was his 20th career at Great American Ballpark. His 20 HR at GABP (13 w/STL) rank 3rd in any MLB park and most which he did not call "home" (Chase Field, AZ, 105 & Busch Stadium, STL, 77). He has 19 career home runs at Dodger Stadium (LAD) and American Family Field (MIL).

9/12 at STL 12:45 p.m. CATCHING THE CANADIANS: Also, with the RBI coming with Paul **Goldschmidt's** home run yesterday, was his 1,144th career, moving him into a 2nd place tie with former Reds' All-Star first baseman **Joey Votto**. Only **Freddie Freeman** has more among actives with 1,173 RBI, making Goldschmidt the active leader among those MLB players not holding Canadian citizenship.

STILL CHASIN' MASYN: Rookie shortstop Masyn Winn extended his hitting streak to 16 games yesterday. Winn's streak is tied for 2nd-longest active this season behind Anthony Volpe (19, NYY) and tied with J.T. Realmuto (16, PHI). The 16 game streak trails Albert Pujols (2001) and Jordan Walker (2023) for 2nd-longest by a rookie in Cardinals franchise history with Joe McEwing leading the list (25 in 1999). Winn leads all rookies with a .300 batting average and all of MLB with a 37.4 line

THE ERROR OF OUR WAYS: The Cardinals have committed an error in 12 straight games (May 13-present), longest error streak since setting the franchise record of 16 from Sept. 27, 1975-Apr. 26, 1976, also tied for their longest in-season streak at 14. The Cardinals are 14-16 in errorless games this season and 11-11 when committing at least one error (9-3 record during error streak).

MY BISCUITS ARE BURNIN': OF/1B Alec Burleson extended his hitting streak to a career-high 11 games with a 6th inning single yesterday. The North Carolina-native leads the Cardinals with 26 hits in May and is 4th in National League batting during this month with a .338 average (26-77). The .338 marks the 2nd-highest qualifying batting average in May among Cardinals over the last eight years (2017-24) only behind Paul Goldschmidt, who smashed a .404 clip (42-104) in 2022.

Sonny Gray pitched three seasons with Cincinnati (2019-21)...named a 2019 NL All-Star.

Turner Ward served as hitting coach for Cincinnati during the 2019 season.

Julio Rangel served as Bullpen Coach for the Reds in 2019. Willie McGee (May 10, 1982 at Busch II), Nick

Robertson (June 7, 2023 at GABP), and **Steven Matz** (June 28, 2015 at Citi Field) made MLB debuts vs. the Reds.

Reds pitching coach Derek Johnson played baseball and coached at Eastern Illinois Univ. (1991-94)...coached at Southern Illinois Univ. 1995-97)...was Sonny Gray's pitching coach at . Vanderbilt University.

Conner Capel appeared in nine games for St. Louis during his 2022 MLB debut season.

Riley O'Brien made his MLB debut with Cincinnati

(Sept. 28, 2021 at Guaranteed Rate Field).

Michael Siani was selected by the Reds in the 4th round of the 2018 MLB Draft...played in 12 games for Cincinnati over two seasons (2022-23).

Reds Assistant Hitting Coach Terry Bradshaw was selected by St. Louis in the 9th round of the 1990 MLB Draft...played parts of two seasons for the Cardinals (1995-96).

Hall of Famer Scott Rolen played his final four seasons with the Reds (2009-12)...won the 2010 Gold Glove and was a two-time All-Star (2010-11).

Nick Martini was selected by St. Louis in the 7th round of the 2011 MLB Draft...played seven minor league seasons in the Cards organization (2011-17).

Cardinals Principal Owner and Chief Executive Office **William DeWitt Jr.** was a prior owner of the Reds and shareholder of the Cincinnati Bengals... his father, William O. DeWitt, was a sole owner of the Reds from 1961-67.

Reds Hitting Coach Joel McKeithan, is a brother of minor league catcher Aaron McKeithan in the Cardinals organization ... Grandfather, Jerry Sr.,

spent seven years in the Cardinals organization .. Brother, Tim, is a Pirates Assistant Coach.

Drew Rom was born in Cincinnati...graduated from Highlands High School in Fort Thomas, Kentucky...resides in Fort Thomas.
