O'S ON THE INJURED LIST

LIFE ON THE ROAD: The O's defeated the A's for the second-straight day, capturing their third road series win of the season; the O's have yet to win a series at home...The O's have gone 9-4 on the road for a .692 winning percentage, the second-highest in the AL and tied for third-best in the majors.

- ⚾ The O's have posted a team ERA of 2.93 (38 ER/116.2 IP) in their 13 road games, the lowest road ERA in the majors.
- ⚾ The O's have averaged 4.1 runs per game on the road and 3.5 at home; they have a +13 run differential on the road and a -22 run differential at home.
- ⚾ The O's are looking for their second road sweep of the season (4/2-4 at BOS).
- ⚾ With a win today, the O's would reach the .500 mark for the first time since being 4-4... Last year their final time at .500 was at the 14-14 mark.
- ⚾ **OF Cedric Mullins** leads the O's with 17 road hits and is batting .340 (17-for-50) on the road; his road hits are tied for the seventh-most in the AL.

YOU GET A HIT, AND YOU GET A HIT... EVERYBODY GETS EXACTLY ONE HIT! All nine starters, along with defensive substitute **INF Pat Valaika**, each collected one hit in yesterday's game for the O's...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, it was just the second time in Orioles history (since 1954) in which all position players who appeared in the game collected exactly one hit; also happened on July 11, 1990 vs. Kansas City when nine batters recorded one hit.

- ⚾ The last time this occurred in the majors was on June 18, 2018 when Kansas City did it in a game against Texas, with nine players collecting one hit.
- ⚾ The last time the O's had 10-or-more players record at least one hit in a game was on July 25, 2019 at Los Angeles-AL.

TAKING ON THE ATHLETICS: The O's have won three-straight games against the A's, after losing their previous eight games prior (4/9/2019-4/24/2021)...The O's have won three of the first five match ups this season, with today's game being the season finale between the two clubs.

- ⚾ The Orioles are looking for their first sweep against Oakland since August 14-17, 2015 at Oriole Park, and their first sweep at the Oakland Coliseum since August 15-17, 2005.
- ⚾ The O's have out-hit the A's in all five games this season, holding A's batters to a combined .193 batting average, while batting .270 themselves.
- ⚾ **OF Cedric Mullins** is batting .381 (8-for-21) in the five games against the A's.
- ⚾ **OF Austin Hays** has hit three home runs and recorded six RBI, while batting .286 (6-for-21), in five career games against the A's, all coming this year.

DE-PEN-DABLE: The Orioles bullpen has pitched to a 2.89 ERA (34 ER/106.0 IP) this season, the fifth-lowest ERA in the AL and the majors...At home, the bullpen has posted a 3.39 ERA (22 ER/58.1 IP) compared to a 2.27 ERA (12 ER/47.2 IP) on the road.

- ⚾ In the last 14 games (since 4/16) the O's bullpen has worked to a 1.72 ERA (11 ER/57.2 IP), the second-lowest ERA in the majors during this stretch (SEA - 1.33).
- ⚾ The O's bullpen has posted a combined 2.2 wins above average, according to *Baseball-Reference*, the second-highest in the majors (TOR - 2.3).
- ⚾ **LHP Paul Fry** and **LHP Tanner Scott** have each appeared in a team-high-tying 12 games...Their 12 games are tied for the third-most by a left-handed pitcher in the AL... Fry has not allowed a run since his 2021 debut on 4/5 at NYY (11 games - 9.2 IP, 3 H, 4 BB, 15 K); the 11-straight games without allowing a run is tied for the second-longest active streak in the AL.
- ⚾ **RHP César Valdez** is tied for the AL lead in saves with six (6-for-8).
- ⚾ **RHP Adam Plutko** has worked 15.0 innings in relief, posting a 1.20 ERA (2 ER/15.0 IP)...His innings out of the bullpen are tied for the sixth-most in the AL.

STRONG DEFENSIVELY: The Orioles outfield has combined for seven defensive runs saved (LF - 1, CF - 1, RF - 5), according to *Baseball Info Solutions*, tied for the second-most in the majors...Individually, **Austin Hays** has accounted for 4 DRS in LF, the most in the majors, and **Anthony Santander** has accounted for 4 DRS in RF, tied for the second-most in the majors.

- ⚾ The O's as a team have recorded five outfield assists, tied for the fifth-most in baseball.
- ⚾ The O's have committed 12 errors, the third-fewest in the AL and have posted a .9876 fielding percentage, the third-best in the American League.
- ⚾ **C Chance Sisco** has thrown out 4-of-5 attempted base stealers, the most catcher caught stealing in the AL and the second-most in the majors (**Narváez**, MIL).

HIT TO KNOW CEDRIC: OF Cedric Mullins is tied for the Major League lead with 35 hits...He's hit safely in 21 of his 26 starts...He's batted lead off in all of his starts, batting .400 (10-for-25) in the first inning of these games; his 10 hits are tied for the second-most in the majors (**Trout**, LAA - 10 and **Buxton**, MIN - 11).

- ⚾ His 16 hits (16-for-37 - .432) against left-handed pitching are tied for the most in the majors (**Altuve**, HOU).
- ⚾ He's batting .442 (23-for-52) in the Orioles 13 wins, hitting safely in 12 of the 13, and .231 (12-for-52) in the Orioles 14 losses.
- ⚾ Mullins is swinging at 19.0% of first pitches seen, the lowest on the O's and the 13th-lowest in the AL; last season Mullins swung at 33.3% of first pitches.

LOOKING AHEAD: The O's return home next weekend and will be celebrating different events at Oriole Park...The Orioles will recognize nurses during National Nurses Appreciation week for their hard work and dedication to keep our community safe...The team has partnered with Med-Star to welcome nurses to the ballpark and MedStar will have first pitches on May 7 & 8...The Orioles will also celebrate Negro Leagues Day in Maryland on Saturday, May 8, by paying tribute to various Negro League teams throughout the game...Additionally, all fans in attendance will receive a Baltimore Elite Giants replica cap; the Elite Giants were Baltimore's Negro Leagues team from 1920-1950.

LAST START: Zimmermann suffered his third-straight loss on 4/27 vs. New York-AL at Oriole Park...Threw 3.2 innings, allowing four runs on nine hits, two home runs, and one walk with three strikeouts...His 3.2 innings marked a season-low, while his nine hits were a career-high.

VS THE AL WEST: Faced Seattle on 4/15 (G2) at Oriole Park in his only start vs. the AL West, in which he suffered the loss, throwing 5.0 innings, allowing two runs on six hits, two home runs, and three walks while striking out two batters...Will be his first start at an AL West ballpark.

FORE!: Has not allowed a hit to the cleanup hitter in his career, holding them 0-for-14, including 0-for-11 with one walk and four strikeouts in 2021...Is one of five MLB pitchers to not allow a hit to the four-spot batter in 11-or-more at-bats (min.11 AB) this year, joining Nathan Eovaldi, Michael Pineda, Zac Gallen, and Dallas Keuchel.

ON THE ROAD: Will be making his third road start of the season, and first since 4/21/20 at MIA...Is 1-1 on the road with a 5.06 ERA (6 ER/10.2 IP), compared to 0-2 with a 5.52 ERA (9 ER/14.2 IP) at home this season...Earned his only win of the season in his first start of the year at Boston, in which he threw 6.0 innings, allowing three runs on four hits and one walk, while striking out five.

OUTTA THIS PARK: Has allowed a home run in four of this five starts this season, including multiple homers in two of those starts...All six of his home runs allowed have been solo shots, accounting for six of his 15 (40%) totals runs this season...Four home runs have come on his fastball, and two on his change up...The home runs he's allowed have an average exit velocity of 108.3 MPH.

TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE: Has thrown his curveball 18.8 percent of the time this season...Of his 75 curveballs, 38 have induced swings and 18 of those have been swings and misses for a 47.4 whiff percentage.

THE FUN IS IN THE CHASE: Zimmermann's chase rate ranks in the 83rd percentile of all Major League pitchers according to *Baseball Savant*; 196 (49%) of his pitches have been out of the zone, with 63 of those inducing swings (32.1%) and 24 swings and misses.

THE ROOKIE: Entering today, Zimmermann leads all American League qualified rookie pitchers in hits allowed (32)...His games started (5), innings pitched (25.1), losses (3), and home runs (6) rank second...Zimmermann's 15 runs are the third-most, while his eight walks and 18 strikeouts both rank sixth.

2020 HIGHLIGHTS: Zimmermann made two appearances (one start) in 2020, both against AL East opponents; went 0-0 and owned a 7.71 ERA (6 ER/7.0 IP) with seven strikeouts...Held batters to a .222 AVG (6-for-27) with two walks and two home runs...Became the 28th Maryland-born player to appear in a game in Orioles history (since 1954), and the first native Marylander to debut for the Orioles since RHP Brandon Kline on 4/20/19 (G2) vs. Minnesota...Entered the season ranked as the No. 29 Orioles prospect by *MLB.com*.

Kremer will be making his fifth start of the season tomorrow in Seattle...Last pitched on 4/28 vs. New York-AL, in which he suffered the loss, throwing 4.1 innings and allowing six runs on 10 hits, two home runs, while striking out four...Kremer's 10 hits and two home runs both marked career-highs; his six runs allowed were one shy of his career-high (7 on 9/23/20 at BOS)...Will be making his second-career start against the Mariners, and first at T-Mobile Park, with his last start coming on 4/13 at Oriole Park when he allowed four runs in 3.0 innings and did not factor in the decision...Is 0-1 in two starts on the road this season with a 4.70 ERA (4 ER/7.2 IP).
