PITTSBURGH PIRATES (13-18) vs. CHICAGO CUBS (16-16)

May 8, 2021 at Wrigley Field, Chicago, IL -- GAME #32/ROAD #20

RHP WIL CROWE (0-1, 4.66 ERA) vs. RHP TREVOR WILLIAMS (2-2, 6.00 ERA)

THE PIRATES... have lost seven of their last eight games after winning a season-high three in a row and four-of-five...Have gone 12-12 in their last 24 games after losing a season-high six in a row from 4/3-8...Were 10-21 after 31 games in 2020 (10-22 after 32).

ON THE MOUND: RHP Wil Crowe is scheduled to make his third start/fourth appearance of the season this afternoon...He has gone 0-1 with a 4.00 ERA (9.0ip/4er) in his first two starting assignments, losing a 3-0 decision to the Cardinals at PNC Park last Sunday...He made his first start with the Pirates in Minnesota on 4/25 and gave up one run in 4.0ip...Crowe began the season in the big leagues and made one appearance (0.2ip/1er on 4/3 at Chicago) before being optioned to the alternate training site on 4/4...The 26-year-old righthander was acquired from the Nationals, along with pitcher Eddy Yean, in exchange for Josh Bell on 12/24...He made his Major League debut with Washington in 2020 and went 0-2 in three starts.

PITCHERS AT THE PLATE: Trevor Cahill yesterday collected his first hit of the season...Bucco pitchers have now hit safely in four of the last five games (4-for-9, .444)...Overall this season the pitchers are hitting .154 (6-for-39), ranking third among National League teams...Wil Crowe singled off St. Louis' Carlos Martinez in his first big league plate appearance last Sunday.

FEAR THE BEARD: Colin Moran has reached base safely in all seven of his games played against the Cubs this season, going 9-for-25 (.360) with six walks (.484 OBP)...In his last eight games played at Wrigley Field, Moran has homered three times while producing a 1.028 OPS...In his last three games overall, Moran has recored three straight multi-hit efforts.

4 IS THE MAGIC NUMBER: The Pirates have posted a 10-3 record this season when scoring four runs or more...They have, however, gone five straight games without plating four runs.

BULLISH PEN: Dating back to April 8, Pittsburgh's bullpen has posted the third-lowest ERA among Major League teams (2.48), trailing only Seattle (2.11) and Miami (2.34).

THE UN-FRIENDLY CONFINES: The Cubs dropped two-of-three at Wrigley Field to start the season and have gone 2-16 in their last 18 games played here, dating back to 9/26/18...They had lost 10 games in a row prior to beating the Cubs on Opening Day this season (4/1)...Pittsburgh's last winning series at Wrigley Field came in 2017, after taking two-of-three July 7-9 (the clubs split a four-game series here September 24-27, 2018).

MOUNDSMEN: In their last eight road games, the Bucco pitching staff has produced a 1.99 ERA (68.0ip/15er) while giving up two earned runs or less in seven of the eight games...In the seven games against the Cubs this season, the pitchers have posted a 3.00 ERA (60.0ip/20er)...Over the course of the last 13 games this season, the staff has posted a 3.35 ERA (113.0ip/42er).

PERFECTO: Richard Rodríguez has retired each of the last 28 batters he has faced since giving up a single to Eric Hosmer at PNC Park on 4/12...He has allowed just two baserunners overall while posting a 0.16 WHIP in his 12 appearances...His WHIP is the third-lowest by any Major League pitcher thru his first 12 games since 1900.

ON THE ROAD: The Pirates have gone 7-6 in their last 13 games played on the road while posting a 2.83 ERA (108.0ip/34er)...The starting pitchers have produced a 3.67 ERA (68.2ip/28er) while the bullpen has turned in a 1.38 ERA (39.1ip/6er).

HISTORY IN THE MAKING: Richard Rodríguez has made eight straight hitless outings (9.0ip) and has surrendered just one hit overall in his first 12 appearances (12.1ip)...Rodríguez is the first pitcher in Pirates history to allow no more than one hit over his first 12 appearances of a season.

HOT ROD: Dating back to June 1, 2019, Richard Rodríguez has produced a 2.06 ERA (78.2ip/18er) in his 82 games - that is the lowest ERA in the Majors among all relief pitchers with at least 75 appearances...Rodríguez has allowed just two baserunners (one hit and one walk) in his first nine outings this season (38 at bats) and has made 23 consecutive scoreless appearances (23.0ip) dating back to August 30 of last season.

PEN PALS: Kyle Crick has made eight straight hitless outings (7.2ip) and has allowed just one hit in his first 11 games (31 at bats) overall...Sam Howard has stranded all 10 of his inherited runners this season; he is only pitcher in MLB who has stranded all 10 or more of his inherited runners...Clay Holmes has stranded all five of his inherited runners and has been charged with one earned run in his last nine appearances (11.2ip).

SHELTY'S CREW: Manager Derek Shelton and his entire 2020 coaching staff have returned for a second season in 2021...Christian Marrero has joined the staff as Assistant Hitting Coach...Returning coaches include Tarrik Brock (First Base), Joey Cora (Third Base), Rick Eckstein (Hitting), Don Kelly (Bench), Oscar Marin (Pitching), Justin Meccage (Bullpen), Mike Rabelo (Field Coordinator) and Glenn Sherlock...Catching coaches Herbie Andrade and Jordan Comadena have returned.

TYLER ANDERSON: The 31-year-old lefthander will be making his seventh start of the season tomorrow afternoon...His last start was a 2-0 loss in San Diego Monday night (6.2ip/2h/2r/2er/3bb/5so)...Has posted a 2.35 ERA in his last four starts and has won two of his last three decisions after suffering back-to-back losses to the Cubs in his first two starts on 4/3 at Wrigley Field (5.0ip/3er) and 4/8 at PNC Park (5.1ip/3er)...Was signed as a free agent on 2/17...Spent 2020 season with San Francisco and went 4-3 with a 4.37 ERA (59.2ip/29er) in 13 games (11 starts).
vs. CHICAGO: 2-2 with a 4.45 ERA (30.1ip/15er) in five career starts...Is 0-2 in two starts this season; suffered a 4-2 loss to Jake Arrieta on 4/8 at PNC Park (5.1ip/3er)...Made his Pirates debut and suffered a 5-1 loss to Arrieta on 4/3 at Wrigley Field (5.0ip/3er)...Won an 11-2 decision over Yu Darvish on 5/2/18 while pitching with Colorado at Wrigley Field (7.0ip/2er).
