WORDS ON THE BIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals and division-rival Pittsburgh Pirates play the rubber match of a three-game series today at Busch Stadium as the club wraps up their six-game/seven-day homestand ... St. Louis took two-of-three from cross-state rival Kansas City during "Rivalry Weekend" ... After today's game, the Cardinals embark on a six-game divisional roadie through Cincinnati (May 22-24) and Milwaukee (May 25-27) ... St. Louis is 4-2 in rubber games (2-1 at home).

TARPS OFF: St. Louis enters today's businessperson's special in 2nd place in the NL Central, 1.5 games behind first place Milwaukee and pct. points ahead of third place Chicago ... Including the initial four-game sweep of Pittsburgh (April 27-30), St. Louis is 14-7 since April 27 (tied for MLB's 4th-best record) and has 28+ wins through the first 48 games of a season for the first time since the 2015 Redbirds started 32-16 and won NL Central Division Championships (100-62).

TODAY'S GAME IS SPONSORED BY THE LETTER T: St. Louis is 11-0 on days that begin with the letter T, and one of four Major League teams with no losses on Thursdays (4-0) this season ... In the other day that starts with T, St. Louis (7-0) is the only undefeated MLB team on Tuesdays.

DIVISION DASH: The Cardinals 6-2 start to the season in games against NL Central clubs (5-1 at PIT, 1-1 vs. MIL) is their best start since 2010 (also 6-2) ... A win today would give the Redbirds their best beginning in divisional play since 2005 (7-2 record).

OUCH: The Cardinals have been hit by an MLB-leading 37 pitches this season, establishing a new franchise record for most through the first 48 games of a season and 2nd-most in MLB history through 48 games since 1900 behind only the 2020 Mets (40) ... **JJ Wetherholt** (10) and **Iván Herrera** (9) are MLB's top two hit batsmen this season.

CARDIAC CARDS: The Cardinals lead the Major Leagues in extra inning victories (7), share the lead in last at-bat wins (9) and in one-run wins (10), while ranking 2nd in walk-off wins (5) and T-3rd in comeback victories (14) ... 19 of the 28 Cardinals wins have been by two runs or fewer, most in MLB. **EXTRA CREDIT:** St. Louis has won seven of its first eight extra inning games for the 2nd time in franchise history ... The **1974** Redbirds started 7-1 in extras before losing their 9th extra-inning game (finished 13-4 in extras).

EVERYDAY IVÁN: **Iván Herrera** and Pittsburgh's **Bryan Reynolds** are two of the 32 Major Leaguers to have played in every one of their team's games this season ... **Curt Flood** and **Ken Boyer** (162 games in 1964) are last Cardinals to play in every team game of a full non-shortened season ... **Paul Goldschmidt** played in all 58 games of the COVID-19-shortened 2020 sprint, while **Keith Hernandez** and **Tommy Herr** appeared in all 103 games of the strike-shortened 1981 season ... **José Oquendo** holds the franchise single-season record for games played, appearing in 163 of 164 Cardinals games in 1989.

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (May 21, 2009): The letter "I" on the BIG MAC LAND sign at Busch Stadium III is knocked out by **Albert Pujols's** first-inning blast off **Sean Marshall** in the 3-1 Cardinals victory over the division rival Chicago Cubs ... **Adam Wainwright** allowed one run over 8.2 innings in the win.

Oliver Marmol was originally selected by Pittsburgh in the 31st round of the 2004 MLB Draft, but did not sign.

Victor Scott II grew up a fan of **Andrew McCutchen** and **Starling Marte**...Scott's father was Pirates fan from Pittsburgh, although Victor II grew up a Braves fan as an Atlanta native...played college baseball at West Virginia University (2022-24).

JJ Wetherholt graduated from Mars Area (Pa.) High School and resides in Gibsonia, Pa., but was born in Baltimore, Md., and grew up a fan of the Baltimore Ravens...played college baseball at West Virginia University (2022-24).

Riley O'Brien's great uncle, **Eddie O'Brien** played for Pittsburgh as an infielder and also made five pitching appearances (1953, 1955-58)...his grandfather **Johnny O'Brien**, played part of four seasons with the Pirates (1953, 1955-57).

Yohel Pozo made his Cardinals debut on April 7, 2025 at Pittsburgh in front of approximately 15 family members based in Harrisburg, Pa.

Evan Sisk was selected by St. Louis in the 16th round of the 2018 MLB Draft and pitched in the Cardinals minor league system from 2018-21 before St. Louis traded him along with **John Gant** to Minnesota in exchange for **J.A. Happ** and cash considerations on July 30, 2021.

Brant Brown played in 130 games for the Pirates in 1999 before being traded to the Marlins for OF **Bruce Aven** (Dec. 13, 1999)...traded by the Cubs to Pittsburgh for RHP **Jon Lieber** (Dec. 14, 1998).

Nathan Church (2018) and **Paul Skenes** (2020) are graduates of El Toro High School in Lake Forest, Calif.

Justin Bruhl pitched in seven games for the Pirates in 2024.

Lars Nootbaar smacked his first career home run (Aug. 12, 2021 at PNC Park). **Alec Bursleson** tallied his first career hit (Sept. 11, 2022 at PNC Park).

Andre Pallante (April 10, 2022 at Busch), **Nolan Gorman** (May 20, 2022 at PNC), **Matthew Liberatore** (May 21, 2022 at PNC) and Special Asst. to the President of Baseball Ops. **Yadier Molina** (June 3, 2004 at PNC) made their MLB debuts vs. the Pirates.

Pirates Dir. of Hitting Development **Tim McKeithan's** grandfather, **Jerry McKeithan Sr.**, played in the St. Louis minor league system, and his brother, **Aaron McKeithan**, was selected by the Cardinals in the 16th round of the 2021 MLB Draft.

2026 Cardinals Hall of Fame Inductee **Bill Sherdel** made his MLB debut with St. Louis on April 22, 1918 vs. Pittsburgh.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Julián Javier** signed with Pittsburgh as an amateur free agent in 1956...played parts of five seasons in the Pirates minor league organization (1956-60).

Marcell Ozuna played in 278 games for St. Louis from 2018-19 after the Cardinals acquired him in a trade with the Marlins on Dec. 14, 2017 in exchange for **Sandy Alcantara**, **Zac Gallen**, **Magneuris Sierra** and **Daniel Castano**.

Pirates Color Analyst **Neil Walker** collected his first career hit vs. St. Louis on Sept. 6, 2009.

Pittsburgh Special Advisor of Pitching Development **Dewey Robinson** coached at the University of Missouri from 1984-86...received his bachelor degree in finance from SIU Carbondale and was inducted into the school's Hall of Fame in 2023.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Morris** pitched two seasons in Pittsburgh (2007-08).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Ted Simmons** was the general manager of the Pirates from 1992-93.

Cardinals Baseball Information & Media Services Manager **Chris Tunno** graduated from nearby Canfield (Ohio) High School.

Pirates Senior Director, Communications & Content **Terry Rodgers** previously worked as a PR Specialist in the Cardinals Comm. dept.(2010-11).

TODAY'S GAME:

- The 28-year-old **Dustin May** makes his 10th start as a member of the Cardinals this evening; It's his 67th career start (81st appearance).
- Making his 2nd start during this homestand, earning a no decision in a Cardinals 5-4 win in 11 innings vs. KC on Friday.
- Pitched 6.0 innings in each of his last four starts, the longest streak of his career and tied with **Michael McGreevy** for the longest by a Cardinals pitcher this season.
- The four straight quality starts (6 IP, 3 ER) is T-5th longest in MLB this season behind **Shohei Ohtani** (LAD, 7), **Chris Sale** (ATL, 6) and **Chase Burns** (CIN, 5).
- Has four caught stealing on attempted base stealers, T-2nd among National League pitchers behind **Michael King** (SD) with five.
- Issued just one walk to a right handed batter this season to Padres' **Ramon Laureano** on a full count at Petco Park (5/9); 76 total batters faced.
- Lifetime 3-5 with a 3.65 ERA (61.2 IP) in 12 career May starts; his best ERA of any month.
- Joins **Nathan Church** (2024-26), **Hunter Dobbins** (2026), **Mark McGwire** (1997-2001), **Red Schoendienst** (1945-56, '61-63), and **Rex Hudler** (1990-92) as notable red-headed Cardinals.

LAST TIME OUT (Friday, May 15 vs. Kansas City): ND, W (11), 5-4; 6.0 IP, 4 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 4 BB, 3 SO - 91 pitches.

- Pitched 6.0 innings for the 4th straight start, a new career-high, which was also a quality start.
- Walked a season-high four batters.
- Exited with the game tied a 3-3, before the Cardinals rallied for a 5-4 walk-off win in 11 innings

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

DECISIONS, DECISIONS: His 2026 season has been one of streaks starting with 2-straight loses, then 3-straight wins and now 2-losing decisions.

STEADY STARTER: Has quality starts in 6 of his 9 starts, and has allowed 3 runs or less working into the 6th inning in each of his last 7 starts for a 2.83 ERA (41.1 IP/13 ER) in that span. He has received four runs of support over his last four starts.

KICKING THE BABIP HABIT: 17 or his 54 hits allowed this season (31 pct.) came in his first two starts; he still owns the 7th-highest BABIP (.338) in MLB.

DON'T WALK TO STRANGERS: Has the 2nd-lowest walk/batters faced percentage among Cardinals starting pitchers behind Michael McGreevy (5.8%) with 7.3%.

MAY DAY: Started on May 3 while wearing uniform No. 3, against his former team, the Dodgers, suffering 4-1 loss that snapped his 3-game winning streak.

BACK-TO-BACK JACK: Gained a 5-3 win vs. CLE (4/15) as he paired back/back quality starts & wins over BOS & CLE during that homestand.

MILESTONE WIN: Bested his former team the Red Sox on 4/10 in a 3-2 win. It was his 1st win as a member of the Cardinals and his 20th career win.

TIGER STRIKE: Was hit for a season-high seven runs on seven hits (and struck in leg by line drive) over 3.1 innings in an 11-6 loss at Detroit (4/4) in his second start. First Cardinals pitcher since **Mike Parisi** (2008) to begin a season allowing 6 or more runs in his first two starts of a season; and the first Cardinal to pitch the Opening Day series since **Dizzy Dean** (1936).

OPENING ACT: Took the loss in his Cardinals debut at Busch Stadium vs. TB (3/29) allowing six runs over 4.0 inning. Tied his career-high allowing 10 hits, the first Cardinals pitcher to allow double-digit hits in his debut in 55 years since **Chris Zachary** surrendered 10 to the Phillies (5/3/1971) *Elias*. Recorded his 300th career strikeout retiring **Junior Caminero**.

MAY VS. PITTSBURGH:

- Is making his 3rd career start and appearance vs. Pittsburgh; second as a member of the Cardinals. Faced the Pirates on April 27 at PNC Park registering a no decision in a Cardinals 4-2 comeback win.
- Allowed single runs in the 1st and 2nd innings in his last start at PIT (4/27), but clamped down and held the Bucs to four singles over the next four scoreless innings before departing down 2-0.
- Will be facing the Pirates at his 3rd different stadium: Fenway Park (8/30/25), PNC Park (4/27/26) and Busch Stadium (5/21/26) in three career starts.
- Has yet to record a win against the Pirates or Brewers among N.L. Central opponents he's faced. Has not pitched against Cincinnati in his career.
