RED HOTS

Tonight is making his third career appearance and start vs the Mets.

In the 4-3 loss on 4/20 at Pit, came off the 15-day injured list to make his 2023 season and Reds debuts...in the first inning allowed all 4 runs on 3 hits, including 2-out, back-to-back home runs by Connor Joe (3-run) and Jack Suwinski (solo)...in his last 5.0 innings faced only 16 batters and retired his last 10 batters...Joe's 3-run HR snapped Weaver's career-high 29.0-inning homerless streak (24g) dating back to his only start of 2022 (6/18/22 vs Min, Gary Sánchez).

On 3/8, left his third spring training appearance with right forearm tightness...didn't pitch in another "A" game for the Reds.

On Opening Day went on the 15-day injured list with a right elbow flexor strain, snapping his 5-season streak on an active Opening Day roster (Cardinals 2018, Diamondbacks 2019-2022).

- On 4/9 and 4/14 made 2 rehabilitation apps with Louisville (0-0, 3.00, 9ip, 3h, 3er, 4bb, 9k, 1hr, 0.78whip, .107baa). On 1/13/23 was signed to a 1-year contract through the 2023 season.

In 2022, his first season pitching primarily out of the bullpen, for the Diamondbacks and Royals went 1-1, 6.56 in 1 start and 25 relief apps. On 8/1 was traded from Ari to KC for IF Emmanuel Rivera.

Was 1 of 17 players acquired in 2022 by the Royals in their 11 trades...9 of those players appeared in a game for KC last season.

Following his first appearance of the 2022 season, on 4/7 vs SD, went on the 10-day injured list with right elbow inflammation...didn't pitch again until 6/12 at Phi. Made his only start of last season in his third appearance, an 11-1 Diamondbacks loss on 6/18 vs Min (3.2ip, 10h, 9er, 1bb, 5k, Gary Sánchez 2-run HR)... finished the season with 23 consecutive relief apps (4.76era, 28.1ip). On 10/26/22 was claimed off waivers by the Mariners...on 11/18 elected free agency...2 months later signed with the Reds.

Was selected by the Blue Jays out of DeLand (FL) High School in the 19th round of the June 2011 first-year player draft and by the Cardinals out of Florida State University in the first round (27th overall) of the 2014 draft.

RED HOTS

In just his second season, tomorrow will make his 32nd Major League appearance and start...will be his second career appearance and start vs the Mets. In Fri's 5-4 loss vs WSox allowed all 5 runs on a pair of homers, including a 3-run HR by Elvis Andrus in the fifth inning and a 2-run HR by Luis Robert Jr. in the

sixth...were Greene's first home runs allowed since Opening Day, snapping his career-high homerless streak at 29.0 innings.

Through the first 7 starts of his 2022 rookie season had allowed 11 home runs.

Has been charged with 3 pitch timer violations.

Was the Reds' 2023 Opening Day starting pitcher.

- At age 23 years, 236 days became the first pitcher age 25 or under to start for the Reds on Opening Day since 1980, when at age 22 years, 232 days RHP Frank Pastore beat Phil Niekro and the Braves, 9-0...courtesy @EliasSports.
- Became the first second-year pitcher to start for the Reds on Opening Day since 26-year-old RHP Raisel Iglesias started the 6-2 win vs the Phillies in the 2016 season opener...courtesy @EliasSports.
- On 4/18 signed a \$53 million contract through the 2028 season that includes for 2029 a \$21 million club option and \$2 million buyout.
- In his age 22 season, in 2022 led the Reds' staff in starts, innings pitched and strikeouts
- In 2022 posted a strikeout rate of 30.9 percent...since 2000 and with a minimum of 100 innings pitched, no pitcher age 22 or younger has posted a higher strikeout rate in a Major League season.

Last season's average fastball velocity of 98.9 miles per hour ranked highest among all Major League pitchers with at least 100 innings pitched. Was the National League Player of the Week for 6/6-6/12, the only Reds player so honored in 2022 (2gs, 1-0, 0.75, 12ip, 3h, 1er, 2bb, 15k, .079baa). In 2022 became the only Major League rookie since 1900 to produce in a season at least 3 apps in which he threw at least 6.0 innings with at least 8 strikeouts and no more than 1 hit (5/15 at Pit, 6/6 vs Ari, 8/1 at Mia)...no pitcher in modern history, regardless of rookie status, has produced more than 3 such games... in his final start of the season, in Game 160 vs Cubs, recorded 6.0 innings and 8 strikeouts but allowed 2 hits.

Was selected by the Reds in the first round (2nd overall pick) of the June 2017 first-year player draft.

Missed the 2019 season while recovering from 4/9/19 "Tommy John" surgery.
