CHICAGO CUBS (18-12) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (11-19)

April 30, 2025 - PNC Park - Pittsburgh, PA - 6:40 EDT - Game #31/Home #15

LHP Matthew Boyd (2-2, 2.54 ERA) vs. RHP Carmen Mlodzinski (1-3, 6.95 ERA)

THE PIRATES: are in the second game of a three-game series against the Cubs...Will welcome San Diego to town for a three-game set this weekend...Will play eight of their next 11 games at PNC Park (will travel to St. Louis for three games from May 5-7)...Returned to Pittsburgh following a 3-3 road trip to Anaheim (2-1) and Los Angeles (1-2).

JOEY BARRELS: Joey Bart had two hits in Tuesday night's game against the Cubs and has hit safely in 10 of his last 13 games (since April 7 vs. St. Louis)...During that span, Bart is 15-for-44 (.341) with two doubles, a triple, a home run, six RBI and seven walks.

KEEPING UP WITH CATCH: Andrew McCutchen doubled on Tuesday night against the Cubs and has now hit safely in eight of his last nine games (since April 18 vs. Cleveland)... McCutchen is batting .324 (12-for-37) with three doubles, two home runs, five RBI, four walks and five runs scored during that stretch...With last night's double, McCutchen moved ahead of Houston's Jose Altuve for the third-most doubles (434) among all active Major League players...Only Los Angeles (NL)'s Freddie Freeman (515) and New York (AL)'s Paul Goldschmidt (454) have more...McCutchen is also just two home runs shy of tying Roberto Clemente (240) for third-most on the franchise's all-time leaderboard.

NOT TO BORR YOU: Ryan Borucki, a native of the Chicago suburb of Highland Park, has allowed only an unearned run in his last six appearances (since April 9 vs. St. Louis)... In that span, the southpaw has not allowed a hit and has issued one walk (it was intentional)...Borucki has allowed just one hit in 18 at-bats against left-handed hitters.

ON THE WAY BACK: Infielder Spencer Horwitz (right wrist surgery on February 5) and right-handed pitcher Dauri Moreta (right elbow surgery on March 19, 2024) each recently began rehab assignments with Double-A Altoona and Low-A Bradenton, respectively...Horwitz, who has not played in a Major League game since September 29, 2024 vs. Miami (with Toronto), is 1-for-4 with two walks through two games with the Curve...Moreta, who had not pitched in a game at any professional level since October 1, 2023 vs. Miami, began his assignment with the Marauders last night vs. Tampa, allowing one hit in a scoreless first inning (nine pitches).

KE'S TO THE GAME: With his eighth-inning single off Tom Cosgrove on Tuesday, Ke'Bryan Hayes extended his hitting streak to a season-high nine straight games (since April 19 vs. Cleveland)...The nine-game streak is tied for the second-longest of his career (also July 10-22, 2022)...Hayes' only longer streak was an 11-game streak from April 1-June 14, 2021...Hayes is batting .314 (11-for-35) with a double and four RBI during the streak... He's also a .310 (44-for-142) career hitter against the Cubs, having hit safely in nine of his last eleven games vs. Chicago, dating back to June 19, 2023 (batting .348 in that stretch).

PHAM-TASTIC DEFENSE: Tommy Pham threw out Michael Busch trying to stretch a single into a double in the fourth inning of Tuesday's game...It was Pham's second outfield assist of the season, tied for third-most among all Major League left fielders...Only Cleveland's Steven Kwan (five) and Toronto's Alan Roden (three) have more... Pham's eight Defensive Runs Saved (according to FanGraphs) are the most among all Major League players...Boston's Carlos Narváez and Chicago (NL)'s Pete Crow-Armstrong are tied for second in all of MLB with seven DRS each.

35 BUCS: On Tuesday night against the Cubs, Hunter Stratton made his first Major League appearance since August 24, 2024 vs. Cincinnati, when he suffered a left patella tendon rupture...Pittsburgh has now used 35 different players (18 position players, 17 pitchers) so far this season, tied for eighth-most among Major League teams...Eleven of those 35 Pirates players made their team debut this season (Canario, Cheng, Ferguson, Gorski, Harrington, Heaney, Lawrence, Mayza, Pham, Shugart, Valdez)...The Pirates used 56 different players last season, tied for 11th-most in Major League Baseball.

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

April 30, 1975: Jerry Reuss earned his first win of the season with a shutout, defeating Bob Gibson and the Cardinals by a 5-0 score at Three Rivers Stadium. Reuss allowed just five hits while striking out three batters. Manny Saguillen went 2-for-4 with a double and an RBI, while Richie Zisk and Willie Stargell each hit a solo home run. Pittsburgh turned four double plays in the win.

HOW ACQUIRED: Selected in Comp. Balance A round (No. 31) of the 2020 Draft.

STARTING OFF: Last name is pronounced “ma-JINSK-ee”...This was Mlodzinski’s first season as a member of the team’s Opening Day roster...The 26-year-old righthander is in his third season with the Pirates...Mlodzinski was drafted as the team’s Competitive Balance Round A selection (31st overall pick) in the 2020 First-Year Player Draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Mlodzinski allowed three runs on five hits and one walk (four strikeouts) over a career-high-tying 5.0 innings in his last start on April 24 in Anaheim against the Angels...He also pitched 5.0 innings on April 7 vs. St. Louis at PNC Park.

AGAINST THE CUBS: Mlodzinski has a 2.45 ERA (7.1ip/2er) in five career appearances (all in relief) against the Cubs, holding Chicago scoreless in four of those five outings...The only time he was scored on came on May 17, 2024 at Wrigley Field (1.2ip/2er).

IT WAS A WHILE: In his start on April 7 against St. Louis at PNC Park, Mlodzinski set career highs with 5.0 innings pitched and six strikeouts while earning his first Major League victory as a starter in Pittsburgh’s 8-4 win...The six strikeouts were his most in a game at any level since also striking out six for Double-A Altoona at Erie on September 10, 2022...It also marked the first time Mlodzinski pitched 5.0-plus innings in an appearance since tossing 5.0 innings for Altoona vs. Reading on September 16, 2022.

SAVE IT: Mlodzinski has one save in his MLB career, coming on September 23, 2023, at GABP in Cincinnati...The Pirates rallied from being down 9-0 after three innings, staging their largest come-from-behind win in 137 seasons of National League play.

AS A STARTER: Tonight will be Mlodzinski’s 11th career Major League start...He opened a total of four times in 2024, where he went 0-1 with a 1.42 ERA (6.1ip/1er)...His start of 3.2 innings in his 2025 debut on March 31 at Steinbrenner Field against the Rays marked the first time he pitched more than 2.0 innings in a Major League start.

- He spent his first two professional seasons as a starter from 2021-22, making 36 starts in that time between High-A Greensboro and Double-A Altoona...Mlodzinski also started 14 of 26 games in college at South Carolina (2018-20).

FINISHING 2024 STRONG: Mlodzinski posted a 1.98 ERA (13.2ip/3er) over his final 12 appearances of the 2024 season...He went 3-0 with a .167 batting average against (8-for-48) during those 12 outings, all of which came in the month of September.

2023 IN REVIEW: Mlodzinski reached the big leagues for the first time in 2023, making his Major League debut that June 16 at Milwaukee...In total, he appeared in 35 games (one start), posting a 3-3 record with 11 holds, one save, 2.25 ERA (36.0ip/9er), 34 strikeouts and 18 walks...He held opponents scoreless in 24 of his 35 outings.

AS A PROSPECT: Mlodzinski entered the 2022 season rated by Baseball America as the No. 10 prospect in Pittsburgh’s minor-league system...He began the 2021 season ranked by MLB Pipeline as Pittsburgh’s 10th-best prospect...At the end of the 2020 season, he had the “Best Changeup” in Pittsburgh’s system, according to MLB Pipeline.

BEFORE THE BUCS: Mlodzinski grew up playing shortstop before beginning to pitch as a junior in high school...Is a 2017 graduate of Hilton Head (SC) High School, where he was a Rawlings-Perfect Game Atlantic All-Region first-team selection in 2017.

- Also pitched at the University of South Carolina, where he made three starts in 2019 as the No. 1 starter before suffering a broken left foot that ended his season.
