THE TWINS: Completed their three-game roadtrip with a 1-2 series loss against the Yankees in New York, winning the finale late last nighttonight, Minnesota will begin an eight-day, seven-game homestand with the first of four against the Tigers through the weekendthey will enjoy an off-day on Monday, then host the Athletics for three games from Tuesday-Thursday.  ◆ Twins are 32-25 at home this season and have gone 12-8 in their last 20 at Target Field.
BROADWAY JOE: The Twins beat the Yankees last night in the Bronx by a score of 4-1, snapping their nine-game losing streak to New York and beating them for the first time since April 25.

their nine-game losing streak to New York and beating them for the first time since April 25, 2023 at Target Field...Joe Ryan (12-5) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on four hits in 6.2 innings pitched, with two walks and seven strikeouts...the only run allowed came on a Cody Bellinger solo home run...Kody Funderburk earned his first hold, striking out his only batters faced, and Justin Topa recorded a 2.0 innings save — his second this season... Minnesota's offense recorded eight hits and were led by Byron Buxton, who went 2-for-4 with a walk and a double...Kody Clemens hit his 10th double of the season and recorded two RRI on the night with a walk and a do two RBI on the night.

I SAW A TIGER: The Twins and Tigers are playing the 10th of 13 games this season...Twins are 4-5 against Detroit in 2025, going 1-2 at Target Field and 3-3 at Comerica Park...this series marks the final meeting between these two in 2025.

♣ Minnesota won the last series against the Tigers last week at Comerica Park, from August 4-6, taking games two and three after losing the opener.

♣ Twins lead baseball in home runs vs. Detroit since the start of 2019, hitting 146, 35 ahead of Cleveland (111).

♣ Royce Lewis is hitting .308 (16-for-52) with three doubles, two home runs, eight walks, nine RBI and an .881 OPS in 16 career games vs. the Tigers...he has reached base safely in all 16 career games vs. the Tigers.

♣ Former Tiger Kody Clemens is hitting .304 (7-for-23) with three doubles and two RBI in six career games against his former team.

♣ Brooks Lee is hitting .293 (12-for-41) with two doubles, one home run and eight RBI in 12 career games vs. the Tigers.

♣ Byron Buxton has a 1.112 OPS and a .739 slugging percentage in his last 12 games against the Tigers, hitting five doubles and five home runs in 51 plate appearances...Buck has homered four times against the Tigers this season: April 11 off Beau Brieske, April 13 off Casey Mize, June 27 off Sawyer Gipson-Long and June 28 off Casey Mize.

♣ The Twins have drawn 19 walks lifetime against Tarik Skubal, his most against any opponent...additionally, their 12 home runs are second-most (Kansas City - 13).

LONG HAIR DON'T CARE: Luke Keaschall has hit .324 (11-for-34) with three doubles, two home runs, 11 RBI, a .588 slugging percentage and a .912 OPS in eight games since returning from the Injured List...he has hit safely in 12 of 15 games to begin his career, hitting .340 (18-for-53) with six doubles, two home runs, 13 RBI, five walks, six strikeouts, five stolen bases, a .417 on-base percentage, a .566 slugging percentage and a .983 OPS...below is a list of Twins with the most RBI through the first 15 games of their career:

LEFT TURNS: Tonight marks the 24th time the Twins have faced a left-handed starter this season...Minnesota is 8-15 against lefty starters...they have lost their last two games vs. a left-handed starter, a 2-0 defeat on August 8 vs. Noah Cameron and the Royals, and Tuesday night vs. Carlos Rodón in Yankee Stadium...their last win against a lefty starter was a 5-4 victory on August 3 at Cleveland over Joey Cantillo.

♣ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .378 (14-for-37) with a .991 OPS in his last 22 games vs. lefties.

♣ Brooks Lee is hitting .338 (24-for-71) with a .801 OPS in his last 37 games vs. lefties.

♣ Byron Buxton is hitting .303 (20-for-66) with four doubles, one triple, six home runs, 11 RBI, a .667 slugging percentage and a 1.051 OPS vs. left-handed pitching this season... more info in the lower right margin.

♣ Buxton has two career home runs (16 PA) against Tarik Skubal, one of 11 players in baseball with multiple homers off the lefty.

♣ Austin Martin is 5-for-12 (.417) at the major league level vs. lefties this season, including one home run.

one home run.

BUCK SHOTS: Byron Buxton enters tonight's game with 24 home runs on the season, four short of his single-season career-high of 28, hit in 2022...he is on pace to finish with 32 home runs.

◆ He has a 14.00 at-bat-per-home run ratio, fourth-best in the AL and seventh-best in baseball, trailing Cal Raleigh (9.89), Aaron Judge (10.58), Kyle Schwarber (10.60), Shohei Ohtani (10.81), Eugenio Suárez (11.65) and Junior Caminero (13.38).

◆ Over his last 39 games, Buxton is hitting .315 (46-for-146) with nine doubles, one triple, 14 home runs, 22 RBI, 33 runs scored, 14 walks, a .380 on-base percentage, a .678 slugging percentage and a 1.058 OPS.

JEFF YEA: Despite going 0-for-7 in his last three games, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .354 (34-for-96) with seven doubles, two home runs, 11 RBI, seven walks, a .415 on-base percentage, a .490 slugging percentage and a .905 OPS.

In that same span, he is hitting .400 (24-for-60) off fastballs, fourth-best in baseball (minimum of 200 fastballs seen), trailing Luis Rengifo (.434), Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (.418) and Giancarlo Stanton (.409).

♣ Sunday: The Twins will induct Corey Koskie into the Twins Hall of Fame...24 Twins Hall of Famers are scheduled to be on hand to celebrate the former third baseman, who helped lead Minnesota to three-straight American League Central Division titles (2002-04).

GUARDING CLEVELAND: Pitched on August 2 against Cleveland in his return to the major leagues after being placed on the IL...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 4-5 defeat...allowed four runs on six hits (2 HR), with one walk and four strikeouts in 5.0 innings.

The Marked his seventh multi-homer game of the season; entered today tied for second-most in the league with Ryan Pepiot (23 starts), Seth Lugo (22 starts) and Zack Littell (22 starts)... most is eight Tyler Anderson (23 starts) and Jake Irvin (24 starts).

Is one of 10 pitchers to have allowed a home run in seven-plus consecutive games this season.

Had allowed four-plus runs in six-straight starts...had allowed four-plus runs in just five of his previous 32 starts.

TIGER KING: Ober is 4-3 in 12 career starts against Detroit...has posted a 4.05 ERA (66.2 IP, 30 ER) with 13 walks, 72 strikeouts and a .262 (68-for-260) opponent batting average.

◆ Last faced the Tigers on June 28 at Comerica Park where he was dealt his sixth loss of the season and fifth consecutive loss...allowed seven runs on a career-high-tying 11 hits with one walk and five strikeouts in 5.2 innings...allowed a career-high-tying four home runs, bringing his total home runs in June to 14, tying the most homers allowed in a month in Twins history.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Since 2021, Ober has gone 16-13 with a 4.06 ERA (288.1 IP, 130 ER), 8.99 K/9, 2.22 BB/9 and 1.69 HR/9 in 55 games (54 starts) at home compared to 13-16 with a 4.09 ERA (290.1 IP, 132 ER), 8.74 K/9, 1.74 BB/9 and 1.43 HR/9 in 54 road starts.

◆ Ober is 2-3, 4.89 ERA (49.2 IP, 27 ER) with 12 home runs, 12 walks, 42 strikeouts and a .267 (52-for-195) opponent batting average in nine home starts this season.

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** Through 19 starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .283/.31/.502 in 219 at-bats vs. Ober, while righties have slashed .284/.336/.518 in 197 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 86.8 mph and a whiff rate of 20.4 compared to righties' 92.0 mph and 26.7 percent.

JUNE GLOOM: Bailey allowed 14 home runs in the month of June; tied the most homers allowed by a pitcher in Twins history (1961-) (also 14, Bert Blyleven, May 1986)...Blyleven did so in six games and 43.2 innings, whereas Ober did so in five games and 30.0 innings...also the second most home runs allowed in a single month in American League/National League history, behind only Washington Senators pitcher Pedro Ramos, who allowed 17 in June 1957.

The Marked the first time a Twins pitcher has recorded five losses in a single month since Kevin Slowey went 0-5 in five starts in September 2011, part of an eight-game losing streak.

Recorded the highest ERA in a single month by any MLB pitcher since Aaron Sele had a 9.30 ERA (0-6) in July 2005.

**THE ARSENAL:** Ober uses a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer 38.0% of the time, the lowest of his career...primarily uses his slider, sweeper and sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring his curveball and changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:
