**THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY**  
**MAY 19**

**2002** - During a pregame ceremony, **RHP Larry Dierker** has his number 49 retired by the Astros. Dierker, who was inducted into the Astros HOF in 2019, had a legendary career with the organization as a pitcher, broadcaster and manager.

**1989** - **RHP Mike Scott** hurls a one-hit, 3-0 shutout over the Pirates in the Astrodome. Scott carried a no-hitter into the 8th inning before it was broken up by the Pirates. It marked the third one-hitter of Scott's outstanding career. Bill Doran provided the offense, driving in all 3 of Houston runs while going 2x4 with a triple.

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Astros and Twins will play the 2nd game of this 3-game set at Target Field tonight...**RHP Jason Alexander** will start for the Astros, taking on Twins RHP Zebby Matthews (1-0)...Note: **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** was scratched from tonight's start.

**ROADIES:** Tonight is the 2nd game of a 10-game, 3-city road trip for the Astros...after this 3-game set at MIN, they will visit Chicago for a 3-game series at Wrigley Field (Fri.-Sun.) vs. the Cubs and then travel back to Texas for a 4-game series vs. the Rangers at Globe Life Field.

**VS. THE TWINS:** Last night's loss snapped the Astros 4-game win streak vs. the Twins...the Astros were 5-1 vs. MIN last season, going 3-0 at home and 2-1 here at Target Field...the Astros won 2 of 3 in their last visit to Target Field, April 3-6 of 2025 and then later swept MIN in a 3-game series at Daikin Park, June 13-15...since 2021, the Astros are 9-6 at Target Field and 18-14 vs. MIN overall.

**ABOUT ALEXANDER:** **RHP Jason Alexander** gets the nod tonight, replacing scheduled starter **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.**, who has been scratched... tonight will be Alexander's first start and 3rd app. of the 2026 season...Alexander, who was recalled from Triple A Sugar Land yesterday, has made 2 relief appearances for the Astros this season, most recently on May 6 vs. LAD (4.1 IP, 5 ER)...he has spent most of the 2026 season in Triple A, where he was 1-2 with a 5.03 ERA in 7 starts...his last start was on May 12 at Tacoma, where he picked up the win (5 IP, 3 ER)...**Alexander The Great:** In 2025, Alexander had a remarkable run while in the Astros rotation...in a span of 9 of his starts, the Astros went 9-0, with Alexander posting a 2.32 ERA in that span (July 29-Sept. 15).

**LAST NIGHT'S RECAP:** The Astros were defeated by the Twins in last night's series opener, 6-3... **RHP Tatsuya Imai** (1-2) took the loss (4.2 IP, 3 ER, 0 BB, 5 SO)...Imai's night was ended prematurely when the game was interrupted by a 1 hour and 57 minute rain delay, which started with two outs in the bottom of the 5th inning...offensively, the Astros were limited to 7 singles...Christian Walker was 2x5 with an RBI.

**JP'S RETURN:** Last night, **Jeremy Peña** returned to the Astros lineup after missing 33 games while on the Injured List due to a right hamstring strain.

**RECENT STROS:** The Astros are 2-2 in their last 4 games and 3-3 in their last 6 games.

**ROADWORK:** The Astros have been the AL's top hitting team on the road in 2026...entering tonight's game, HOU leads the AL in road batting avg. (.276), OPS (.777), SLG (.428) and OBP (.349).

**ROAD WARRIOR:** In his young career, **Brice Matthews** has had success hitting on the road, as he enters tonight with a .282 (22x78) career avg. in 25 road games with 6 HR and 20 RBI with a .577 SLG and a .944 OPS...in 2026, he is hitting .296 (16x54) on the road with 2 HR and an .881 OPS.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The Astros have placed **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** on the 15-day IL (retro 5/16) due to right shoulder inflammation and optioned **IF/OF Shay Whitcomb** to Triple A Sugar Land...to take their places on the active roster, the Astros reinstated **OF Jake Meyers** and **RHP Nate Pearson** from the Injured List.

**BRYAN'S SONG:** After a slow start to his season, **RHP Bryan Abreu** has not allowed a run in his last 5 outings, covering 5.2 IP (3 H, 0 R, 3 BB, 5 SO)... in his last 7 appearances, Abreu has posted a 1.23 ERA (1ER/7.2IP) with 9 K's.

**AIR YORDAN:** **Yordan Alvarez** is batting .316 with 11 doubles, 15 HR, 31 RBI and a 1.060 OPS (.427 OBP/.633 SLG)...in the AL, he ranks first in total bases (112), first in XBH (26), 2nd in OPS, OBP, and SLG, and 3rd in batting avg...Alvarez was named AL Player of the Month for March/April...**Twinn-Killing:** In 28 career games vs. MIN, Alvarez has 9 HR and 22 RBI while posting a .570 SLG/.917 OPS...in 15 career games at Target Field, he has 5 HR and 14 RBI.

**TAPPING FOR SUCCESS:** Astros batters lead the Majors in successful ABS challenges with 31 won in 53 total challenges (58% successful)...**Jose Altuve** is tied for the MLB lead in successful challenges among hitters, having won 9 of 13 challenges (69% successful).

**ON THE OFFENSIVE:** The Astros rank first or second in the AL in many key offensive categories:

**LEADING MEN:** On Saturday night vs. TEX, **Jose Altuve** connected for his 42nd career leadoff homer, which ranks second in franchise history, trailing only **2B Craig Biggio** (53)...the Astros have a long history of leadoff homers, between Biggio, Altuve, **OF George Springer** (40), and others, with the team combining for 228 leadoff homers in franchise history, which ranks second in the Majors since their inception in 1962, trailing only the Tigers (230).

**CLIMBING THE CHARTS:** **2B Jose Altuve** connected for his 239th career homer as a 2nd baseman Sat. night vs. TEX, which tied him with **Lou Whitaker** for 7th place all-time in MLB history for the position.

**WALKER, TEXAS HAMMER:** **1B Christian Walker** is among the AL leaders in several offensive categories...he is 2nd on the club in HR (11) and T-1st in RBI...among the AL leaders, Walker ranks T-4th in RBI (31), T-9th in HR (11), 8th in total bases (90), 9th in SLG (.511).

**MASH UNIT:** With the addition of **RHP Lance McCullers Jr.** today, the Astros now have 13 players on the Injured List, eight pitchers and five position players.

**SPOT START:** Is slated to start tonight's game in place of RHP Lance McCullers Jr., who was placed on the 15-day IL today....Alexander will be making his first MLB start since Sept. 26, 2025 at LAA, when he allowed 2 runs on 4 hits through 4.2 innings with 1 walk and 4 strikeouts.

**YESTERDAY'S ROSTER MOVE:** Was recalled from Triple A Sugar Land yesterday...marks his 3rd stint with the Astros this season.

**VS. MIN:** Set to make his 2nd career start (and appearance) vs. the Twins...also faced them on July 12, 2022 at Target Field, working 4.0 innings while allowing 2 runs on 3 hits with 2 walks and 1 strikeout as a member of the Brewers...took a no-decision in a 6-3 Brewers victory, in what was just the 9th appearance of his career.

**LAST APPEARANCE (5/12 at TAC):** Made his 7th start of the season with Triple A Sugar Land last Tuesday...in that outing, he allowed 3 runs on 5 hits with 2 walks and 3 strikeouts in 5.0 innings to earn his 1st win of the season.

**LAST MLB APPEARANCE (5/6 vs. LAD):** In his relief appearance, he allowed 5 runs on 9 hits with 2 walks and 5 strikeouts in 4.1 innings.

**DOWN IN SUGAR LAND:** In 7 starts with Triple A Sugar Land this season, he's gone 1-2 with a 5.03 ERA (19ER/34IP)...has been strong when pitching at home for the Space Cowboys this year in the hitter-friendly Pacific Coast League, posting a 3.92 ERA (9ER/20.2IP), 1.21 WHIP and .253 opponent batting average in his 4 home starts.

**2025 SEASON:** Had the best season of his MLB career in 2025, spent almost entirely with the Astros...went 4-2 with a 3.66 ERA (29ER/71.1IP), 1.25 WHIP and .247 opponent batting average in 14 games (13 starts) with the Astros...was exceptional in his 7 road outings (6 starts), going 4-0 with a 1.42 ERA (6ER/38IP), a 0.95 WHIP and a .176 opponent batting average...was an anchor in the Astros rotation for the 2nd half of the season as the club went 9-0 and he recorded a 2.32 ERA in a 9-start stretch from July 29-Sept. 15...along with his time with the Astros, he also made 4 relief appearances with the Athletics.

**CHANGEUP ARTIST:** Relied heavily on his changeup in his breakout 2025 season with the Astros, tossing the pitch at a 32.7-percent rate and holding opponents to a .193 average (22x114) on the pitch...has tossed his changeup at a 34.5-percent rate in 2026, the most of any of his pitches.

**ABOUT ALEXANDER:** Has appeared in 38 MLB games (24 starts) through parts of 3 seasons, spent with MIL (2022), ATH (2025) and HOU (2025-26)...made his pro debut in 2017 after signing with the Los Angeles Angels organization as an undrafted free agent...his older brother, Scott, has pitched in 349 games through parts of 11 MLB seasons, most-recently with the Giants and Rockies in 2025.

**LAST APPEARANCE (5/16 vs. TEX):** Picked up his 2nd save of the season on Sat. night vs. TEX, tossed 1.1 scoreless innings while working around 1 hit and 1 walk...recorded a win (Wed. vs. SEA) and a save in his 2 appearances during the last homestand.

**TIDES TURNING:** Has gone 2-0-1 through 5 consecutive scoreless appearances (5.2 IP), dating back to May 3 ...prior to this streak, posted a 12.54 ERA (13ER/9.1IP) in his first 11 games of the season.

**AGAINST THE TWINS:** In 13 career appearances vs. MIN, he's recorded a 2.77 ERA (4ER/13IP) with 25 strikeouts...has logged 4 consecutive scoreless appearances vs. the Twins (since July 7, 2024), striking out 7 batters to just 1 walk over that span...his average of 17.31 SO/9IP vs. MIN ranks 1st all time (min. 10 IP)...has held **DH Josh Bell** to a 1x7 mark with 4 strikeouts in their career matchups.

**ALL-TIME ASTRO RANKINGS:** With his outing on April 24 vs. NYY, he reached 338.0 career innings, passing **RHP Octavio Dotel** for the 10th-most innings by a reliever in Astros history...ranks 7th all-time in appearances (333) among relievers in Astros history, and is closing in on **RHP Ryan Pressly** (342) for 6th on that all-time list...also among Astros relievers, he ranks 4th all-time in strikeouts (469).

**DAIKIN PARK RANKINGS:** Reached 179.2 career innings pitched at Daikin Park with his outing on Sat. night .vs TEX, surpassing **RHP Ryan Pressly** (179.1) for 4th-most by a reliever in the venue's history...is also 3 strikeouts from matching **RHP Octavio Dotel** (247) for the 2nd-most strikeouts by a reliever in Daikin Park history.

**CAREER:** In 333 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.87 ERA (110ER/344.2P) with 469 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP, a 12.25 K/9 and a 0.76 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among active AL relievers.
