TODAY'S GAME: The Giants and Rockies play the series finale of this four-game set today...today's contest marks their final matchup of the year.

- > After dropping the first three games, SF has lost its first series against the Rockies since June 7-9, 2022 (1-2).
- The last time the Giants had dropped a series here at Coors Field was in 2021, when they split a doubleheader on May 4 but lost the final game of the series the following day.
- Yesterday marked SF's first time being swept by Colorado in a doubleheader in franchise history.

BLOW OUT THE CANDLES: Hall of Famer and Giants legend Orlando Cepeda turns 86 years old today.

A WILD RACE: Entering today at 75-74 (.503), the Giants currently sit 2.5 games behind the Reds and Diamondbacks for the third and final Wild Card spot in the NL...SF is also 2.0 games back of the Marlins.

Entering play today, FanGraphs gives SF a 10.9% chance of making the postseason.

ROAD WOES: The Giants have lost each of their last nine road games...SF's nine-game losing streak on the road is its longest since dropping 12 consecutive road games from June 21-July 12, 1996.

- In fact, SF has dropped 23 of its last 27 road games since July 19, the worst road record of any team in the Majors in that span.
- The Giants have been outscored by a 151-84 margin on the road since July 19
- SF's last road series victory was a three-game sweep at Pittsburgh right after the All-Star Break, July 14-16.

SOLID AS A ROCK: The Giants have won eight of their 11 matchups against the Rockies this year and 16 of their last 20 dating back to last August.

Since the start of the 2021 season, SF is 37-13 (.740) with a +112 run differential against Colorado.

GIANT LEADER: IF Thairo Estrada's four-hit effort in Game 1 of the doubleheader yesterday put him at 123 hits for the season...Estrada currently paces the team in both hits and stolen bases (21)

- ▶ If he were to lead the team in both those categories at the end of the season, he'd become just the seventh Giants player to lead his team in hits and stolen bases in back-to-back seasons.
- The infielder owns a .382/.432/.647 slash line in 18 career games here at Coors Field.

BACK IN THE FOLD: LHP Sean Manaea returns to the rotation in a matchup that could prove advantageous for SF...Colorado batters are slashing just .238/.293/.400 against left-handed starters this season...their .693 OPS is the fourth-lowest figure in MLB, while their .238 average is fifth.

PRESSURE POINT: The Giants went 7-for-21 with a home run and five RBI in two-out situations in yesterday's twin bill...SF's offense has proven to be particularly efficient in that spot as of late, with batters posting a .284 average and .394 OBP in their last eight games.

Since September 9, SF's .284 average and .394 OBP with two outs are second-best in MLB behind the Rangers (.289/.407)

OUR HAPPY PLACE: A handful of Giants have found a lot of success here at Coors Field throughout their careers.

- IF Wilmer Flores has a .438 career OBP here at Coors Field... the mark is the second-highest among active players trailing only Starling Marte (.460)...Flores'.361 average here is tied fifth-best.
- IF Brandon Crawford has played 101 career games here at Coors, his most at any visiting ballpark...Crawford has collected 77 RBI here, his most at any other ballpark by a wide margin (Chase Field is second at 38).
- Crawford's 77 RBI at Coors are tied for second-most by any visiting player...Adrián González is first with 88.
- OF Mike Yastrzemski has a .625 SLG in 33 career games at Coors...the figure is fifth-best among active players, while his .997 OPS ranks ninth.

FIRST IMPRESSIONS: The Giants have been outscored 17-6 in the 1st inning since the start of the month...the 17 runs allowed by the pitching staff are second-most in MLB in that span behind only the Nationals (22).

- Eight of the 17 runs came via homer...the five home runs allowed by SF in that span are tied for second-most in MLB... only the Marlins (7) have more.
- SF's 7.80 ERA in the 1st inning since September 1 is tied for third-highest in the Majors.
- Offensively, the six runs scored by SF in that stretch are tied with the Cubs for second-fewest in the NL ahead of the Reds (5)...

WHAT'S LEFT?: Just 13 games remain on the Giants' regular season schedule...after today, the Giants head to Arizona to continue this 10-game road trip with two games at Chase Field followed by a four-game set against the Dodgers in Los Angeles...SF's final homestand is a six-game set against the Padres (three games) and Dodgers (three games).

WITH THE GIANTS: Manaea is in his first season with Giants...he signed a two-year, \$25 million contract with San Francisco this off-season after spending 2022 with San Diego.

LAST OUTING: Manaea received the loss vs. Cleveland on September 12 with three runs allowed (one earned) on two hits and two walks while striking out five across 5.2 innings...after allowing a run in the 1st inning, Manaea retired 15 straight batters...his 5.2 innings were his most since matching that total on July 22 at Washington.

TODAY'S GAME: Today marks Manaea's second straight start after appearing in his previous 25 games out of the bullpen.

VS. COLORADO: The southpaw has faced Colorado five times in his career, interestingly with all five games coming at Coors Field...in his one game vs. the Rockies this year, June 6, Manaea struck out five while allowing four runs on five hits and a walk in 4.2 innings of relief...**OF Charlie Blackmon** is 4-for-11 (.364) with three extrabase hits while **IF/OF Kris Bryant** is 3-for-4 with two home runs and two walks.

BACK IN THE FOLD: Manaea is making his second start since May 10 vs. Washington after coming out of the bullpen in his last 25 games...he's posted a 4.18 ERA (33er, 71.0ip) with 82 strikeouts in 27 games as a reliever this year compared to a 7.54 ERA (19er, 22.ip) and 28 strikeouts in six starts...in his career as a starter, Manaea is 59-52 with a 4.16 ERA in 897.2 innings.

KEEP IT LOW: Manaea did not allow a homer in his last start, keeping the ball on the ground (10 ground outs to one fly out)...prior to the start, he had allowed four home runs over his last four games (12.2ip)...he did, however, have a streak of 20 games and 53.1 innings from May 22-August 15 in which he did not allow a home run...in total, Manaea's 1.43 HR/9 over the past two seasons is 11th-highest in MLB (minimum 255.0ip).

FAST AND FURIOUS: Manaea has thrown his fastball 56.8% of the time, with 70 of his 115 strikeouts coming on that pitch...the Rockies have a .784 OPS against four-seam fastballs this year, which ranks 22nd in MLB...they also have a 23.8% strikeout rate on four-seam fastballs, which is 24th in MLB, and a 2.4% home-run rate on that pitch, which is 29th in the Majors.

FAVORABLE MATCHUP: Manaea held Cleveland to two hits in his last start...the Rockies are tied with Cleveland for the lowest batting average against southpaws this season (.232)...below is a chart where the Rockies rank offensively against left-handed pitchers.

BACK IN THE FOLD: In his last game, Manaea made his first start since May 10 vs. Washington, pitching 25 straight games out of the bullpen...he's posted a 4.18 ERA (33er, 71.0ip) with 82 strikeouts and a 1.17 WHIP in 27 games as a reliever this year compared to a 6.35 ERA (20er, 28.1ip), 33 strikeouts and a 1.59 WHIP in seven starts...in his career as a starter, Manaea is 59-53 with a 4.14 ERA, 821 strikeouts and a 1.24 WHIP in 903.1 innings.
