LET ME TELL YA SOMETHING, BROTHER: The St. Louis Cardinals and visiting San Diego Padres kick off a four-game series tonight at Busch Stadium as the two teams play seven times over the next 10 games ... The Miami Marlins visit St. Louis on Monday for three games leading up to the MLB trade deadline. ... St. Louis opened the post All-Star break portion of its schedule by going 1-5 through Arizona (0-3) and Colorado (1-2), being outscored a combined 28-1 over the first three innings on the trip.

BIRD WATCHING: St. Louis begins the day 4th in the National League Central, 9.5 games behind division leader Milwaukee, and 3.5 games behind San Diego for the 3rd and final NL Wild Card spot ... The Cardinals have dropped 13 of their last 18, and currently sport a negative run differential (-4) for the first time since May 5 when they were 16-19 (-2), brother.

WHATCHA GONNA DO... IN THE LOU: The Cardinals all-time .663 (172-87) home win pct. in St. Louis over the Padres (1969-present) is the 3rd-best by one home team vs. any visitor in MLB history (min. 100 games). - *Elías*

- Since Busch Stadium III opened in 2006, the Cardinals .689 home win pct. (42-19) vs. the Friars is their 2nd-best against any visitor behind only Colorado (.734, 47-17).
- The Cardinals all-time .586 (302-213) win pct. over the Padres (1969-present) is their 4th-best against any opponent (min. 50 games), while no National League team has higher all-time win pct. over San Diego than St. Louis.

EAT YOUR VITAMINS AND SAY YOUR PRAYERS: St. Louis is 11-1 in **Sonny Gray's** 12 starts at Busch Stadium this season ... Those 11 Cards team wins are the most for a singular starting pitcher at home in MLB this season ... Sonny's 15 wins at home since joining St. Louis (2024-25) are tied for 3rd-most in MLB behind **Tarik Skubal** (18) and **Zack Wheeler** (16).

DON'T MAKE ME ANGRY, BROTHER: With the Cardinals next win, **Oliver Marmol** (2022-present) will record his 300th career managerial win, ranking 13th all-time among Cardinals managers, and 12 victories back of **Gabby Street** who ranks 12th with his 312 managerial wins from 1929-33.

THIS IS THE NEW WORLD ORDER: **Nolan Arenado** leads active third basemen in career doubles (402), RBI (1,175), go-ahead RBI (287), slugging pct. (.509), extra-base hits (787), sac flies (78), and games played (1,715), while **Manny Machado** is the active third sacker leader in homers (360), hits (2,011), multi-hit games (561), walks (647), and total bases (3,514) ... The duo has combined for 15 All-Star nods, seven Silver Sluggers, 12 Gold Gloves, and seven Platinum Gloves, brother.

WELL YA KNOW SOMETHING, MEAN GENE...: **Willson Contreras** has scored in five straight games vs. the Padres, longest streak among active players and longest by a Cardinal since **Paul Goldschmidt** (7 straight games in 2022) ... The Cardinals longest streak of games scoring a run vs. the Friars is held by **Mark McGwire** with 12 from 1999-2000.

SAN DIEGO CONNECTIONS

Fernando Tatis, father of Padres outfielder, **Fernando Tatis Jr.**, played three seasons with St. Louis (1998-2000)...is famously remembered for hitting two grand slams in one inning (April 23, 1999 at Los Angeles), both off of **Chan Ho Park**.

Miles Mikolas was selected by San Diego in the 7th round of the 2009 MLB draft...pitched parts of two seasons with the Padres (2012-13), where he made his MLB debut.

Thomas Saggese was born in and resides in Carlsbad, CA...graduated from Carlsbad High School.

Phil Maton pitched parts of three seasons with the Padres (2017-19)...selected by San Diego in the 20th round of the 2015 MLB Draft...Made MLB debut on June 11, 2017 vs. KC at Petco Park...struck out first batter faced, **Lorenzo Cain** (swinging).

Mike Shildt coached and managed parts of 18 seasons in the Cardinals organization (2004-21)...served as area scout (2004-07) and coach (2005-08) before transitioning to minor league manager (2009-16)...Joined St. Louis coaching staff in 2017 and was Cardinals manager for parts of four seasons (2018-21)...led Cardinals to three postseason berths...2019 NL Manager of the Year.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played 26 games for San Diego in 2008...traded by St. Louis to San Diego for **David Freese** (Dec. 14, 2007).

FanDuel broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** played parts of four seasons in San Diego (1997-98, 2002, 2005) and appeared in the 1998 World Series... was a part of the Padres broadcasting team for 12 seasons (2012-23)...resides in San Diego.

Hall of Famer **Ozzie Smith** was selected by San Diego in the 4th round of the 1977 MLB Draft... played four seasons with San Diego (1978-81)... traded by San Diego with Al Olmsted and Steve Mura to St. Louis for Luis DeLeon, Sixto Lezcano and Garry Templeton (Dec. 10, 1981).

Padres Asst. Hitting Coach **Mike McCoy** was selected by St. Louis in the 34th round of the 2002 MLB Draft...played six minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization.

Padres Hitting Coach **Victor Rodríguez** played two minor league seasons (1986-87) for the Louisville Redbirds (AAA) in the Cardinals organization.

Padres Baseball Operations Advisor **Allen Craig** played parts of five seasons (2010-14) with St. Louis, where he was a 2013 NL All-Star and member of 2011 World Series Champion Cardinals.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Ray Lankford** played parts of two seasons for San Diego (2001-02)...traded by St. Louis with cash to the Padres for **Woody Williams** (Aug. 2, 2001).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Mark McGwire** was the Padres bench coach for three seasons (2016-18).

Jon Jay played the 2016 season with San Diego... traded by St. Louis to the Padres for **Jedd Gyorko** and cash (Dec. 8, 2015).

Padres Coach **Nick Punto** played 63 games for St. Louis in 2011 and was a member of the 2011 World Series Champions.

Padres Bench Coach **Brian Esposito** played parts of two seasons for Memphis (AAA) in 2006-07 and one game for St. Louis in 2007.

Padres broadcaster **Carlos Hernandez** played 17 games for St. Louis in 2000...traded (July 31, 2000) to St. Louis with **Nate Tebbs** from the Padres for **Heathcliff Slocumb** and current Memphis (AAA) manager **Ben Johnson**.

Athletic reporter **Katie Woo** spent the 2018 season covering the Padres as an associate reporter for MLB.com.

St. Louis Post-Dispatch reporter **Daniel Guerrero** graduated from San Diego State Univ. in 2020...interned for NBC San Diego in 2019...also served as backup MLB.com reporter on-site at Petco Park.

Cardenales broadcaster **Polo Ascencio** was born in nearby Tijuana, Mexico...considers Padres Eduardo Ortega as a broadcasting mentor.

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- The Cardinals Opening Day starter is set to make his 21st start of the season (328th career appearance/319th start).
- Is 6-1 with a 2.84 ERA (4 HR) in 12 home starts, but 3-3 with a 5.84 ERA (8 HR) in eight road starts.
- Sonny's 15 wins at home since joining St. Louis (2024-2025) are tied for 3rd-most in the majors behind **Tarik Skubal** (18) and **Zack Wheeler** (16). **The Cardinals are 11-1 in his 12 home starts this season (only loss vs. NYM on May 2), most in MLB for team home wins in starts by a singular pitcher this season.**
- Has not allowed a home run to a left-handed batter in his last 11 starts (145 batters faced). Is the only MLB pitcher since May 20 without a HR vs. a left-handed batter (100 TBF).
- Leads the Cardinals staff in percentage of Swings That Miss (27.2%) - 11th-best in the NL.
- Has 20 career double-digit strikeout games, including three since May 19. Since his career began in 2013, ranks 28th among his peers in 10+ K games.
- Issued one-or-fewer walks in 15-of-20 starts this season; Cardinals are 12-4 in those games.
- Has six scoreless starts of 6.0 innings or more, tied for 2nd-most in MLB behind Detroit's LHP Tarik Skubal (8)**
- The Cardinals are 15-5 in his 20 starts this season, with two of his defeats coming in starts against the Mets.
- Is one of 11 pitchers in Busch Stadium III history with 200+ strikeouts (219 K). **Trevor Rosenthal** ranks 10th with 244 strikeouts.
- 12 of his 109 hits allowed in 2025 have been homers and **20 of his 53 runs (37.7%) allowed this season have come via HR's.**
- His 12 HR's allowed have surpassed his season total (8) for all of the 2023 season.
- Over past two seasons since joining St. Louis (2024-25, ranks among MLB leaders in strikeouts (326, T-7th), SO/9 IP (10.57, 9th), and wins (22, T-6th).
- St. Louis is 32-16 (.667) in his 48 starts with the club since joining in 2024; His record stands at 22-13 while wearing the Birds on the Bat.

LAST TIME OUT: Yielded a career high nine runs (eight earned) in 3.1 innings in Saturday's 10-1 loss to the Diamondbacks at Chase Field. His eight earned runs and 11 hits also matched career highs.

2025:

- Authored a one-hit complete-game shutout masterpiece at CLE (6/27) striking out a season-high 11 Guardians on only 89 pitches in the 5-0 Cardinals win. His only blemish was a two-out Nolan Jones single in the bottom of the 5th inning.
- His 19 starts before the All-Star Break tied his single-season most (2014).
- Marked Gray's 5th career shutout and first since July 28, 2015 at Los Angeles Dodgers. It was the 11th time a Cardinal threw a one-hitter, one batter over the minimum since 1901, and first since **Jordan Montgomery** at Wrigley Field on Aug. 22, 2022.
- Since pitch counts were accurately kept in 1988, Gray joined **David Cone's** perfect game (July 18, 1999) as the only two pitchers to throw shutouts of one hit or fewer with 10+ strikeouts in 89 pitches or fewer.

CAREER NOTES:

- Ranks in the Top 10 among active pitchers in wins (120, 7th), games started (317, 9th), innings pitched (1,845.1, 10th), strikeouts (1,842, 9th) and ERA (3.48, 7th).

GRAY VS. SAN DIEGO:

- Making his 4th career start vs. San Diego and his 2nd as a member of the Cardinals.
- Is 3-0 in his three previous starts which came as a member of the Reds (2019), (2022), and Cardinals (2024).
- Has limited the Friars to one run in all three starts.
- In his last start vs. the Padres (Aug. 29, 2024 at Busch), his lone blemish over 6.0 innings was a a Jackson Merrill solo homer. Also fanned four and walked none in the 4-1 win.
- Struck out 10 batters at Great American Ball Park in 2019.
- Is a career 8-8, 3.30 ERA in 23 starts vs. N.L. West opponents. Wins have come vs. San Francisco (3), San Diego (3) and Los Angeles (2).
