PITTSBURGH PIRATES (9-13) vs. DETROIT TIGERS (7-14)

May 4, 2022 at Comerica Park, Detroit, MI -- GAME #23 & 24/ROAD #11 & 12 LHP DILLON PETERS & LHP JOSÉ QUINTANA vs. RHP MICHAEL PINEDA & RHP ALEX FAEDO

<u>THE PIRATES....</u> were rained out yesterday for the second time this season (also April 11 at St. Louis)...Have lost five of their last six games after winning three-of-four...Went 5-4 in their first nine games; have gone 4-9 in 13 games since...Have won two games in a row on three occasions (last from 4/21-22)...Were 11-11 after 22 games last year (12-11 after 23 and 12-12 after 24).

LET'S PLAY TWO: In addition to today's traditional doubleheader, the Pirates will play a split doubleheader Saturday at Great American Ball Park against the Reds...It's the first time that the Pirates will play two doubleheaders on a road trip since doing so on August 15-16, 1986, against the Phillies at Veterans Stadium.

DOUBLEHEADERS IN DETROIT: This is the third time in the last five seasons that the Pirates and Tigers will play a doubleheader at Comerica Park...The Bucs swept the Tigers on April 1, 2018, while splitting a doubleheader here last year on April 21.

INTERLEAGUE UNDERWAY: This two-game series against the Tigers will be Pittsburgh's first interleague action of the season (the Bucs went 10-10 against the A.L. last season)...This year the Pirates will travel to Tampa Bay (June 24-26), Baltimore (August 5-7) and New York (September 20-21)...The Pirates host Detroit (June 7-8), New York (July 5-6), Boston (August 16-18) and Toronto (September 2-4).

<u>DILLON IS DEALIN':</u> Dillon Peters, who will make his second start of the season today, retired all three San Diego batters he faced in relief in his last outing Saturday vs. San Diego...Peters has surrendered just one hit in his first 38 at bats against while tossing 13.1 scoreless frames...He allowed his first hit of the season on April 24 after not giving up a hit in his first 21 opposing at bats to start the season...Peters became the first Pittsburgh pitcher since **Francisco Cordova** in 2000 to not allow a hit in his first 21 at bats to start a season...According to the Elias Sports Bureau, it was the longest such streak at the start of a season for a Pittsburgh relief pitcher (ignoring any starts in between) since 1945.

ON Q: José Quintana will get the start in the second game of today's doubleheader...In his last outing Thursday afternoon against the Brewers at PNC Park, Quintana struck out a season-high nine batters while allowing one run in 5.0 innings in a no-decision...The nine punchouts were his most since also striking out nine batters last year on May 3 vs. Tampa Bay while pitching for the Los Angeles Angels.

<u>THIS AND THAT:</u> The Pirates have won eight of their last nine games here at Comerica Park dating back to August 10, 2017...The Pirates have outscored the Tigers 46-35 in those nine games...**Roberto Pérez** has hit safely in nine of his last 11 games here at Comerica Park, going 13-for-38 (.342) with two doubles, three homers and seven RBI.

OWNING INTERLEAGUE: Ke'Bryan Hayes went 6-for-12 in three games against Detroit last year at PNC Park from September 6-8...In 15 career games against American League teams, Hayes is hitting .400 (22-for-55) with four doubles, a triple, home run and 10 RBI while hitting safely in all but three of those games.

ON THE ROAD: This is the fourth road series for the Pirates of the 2022 campaign...The Bucs opened the year by dropping two of three games at Busch Stadium from April 7-10...During the team's last trip, the Pirates were swept in three games at Milwaukee from April 18-20 before taking three of four against the Cubs at Wrigley Field from April 21-24.

<u>HITTIN' THE ROAD:</u> Today the Pirates begin a six-game road trip to Detroit and Cincinnati...Following a day off in Cincinnati tomorrow, the Bucs will take on the Reds beginning Friday night while also playing their second doubleheader in four days on Saturday (12:35 and 6:40).

ON THE MEND: Righthander Duane Underwood Jr. started and faced a total of five batters (0.2ip/1h/1r/2bb/0so) in his second rehab appearance Tuesday with Low-A Bradenton...Underwood retired all three batters he faced in his first rehab appearance with Low-A Bradenton on April 29 against Dunedin...Underwood is currently on the 10-day injured list with a right hamstring strain.

DOWN ON THE FARM: Henry Davis homered yesterday for High-A Greensboro and now has seven RBI in his last three games...Since April 19, the 2021 No. 1 overall pick has hit safely in nine of his 11 games, going 16-for-39 (.410) with a double, three home runs and 11 RBI...Davis enters today ranked fifth in the South Atlantic League in batting (.343), tied for fifth in RBI (17), third in OBP (.453), fourth in OPS (1.024) and ninth in slugging (.571).

<u>PUTTING UP ZEROES:</u> Dillon Peters enters today with a scoreless streak of 13.1 innings, which is the second-longest active streak in Major League Baseball behind Walker Buehler of the Los Angeles Dodgers (14.0ip)...It's also tied for the longest scoreless streak by a Pirate this season along with **Wil Crowe**.

WHERE THERE'S A WIL: Wil Crowe enters today tied for the fifth-most strikeouts (17) by any right-handed reliever in Major League Baseball...The only right-handed relievers to record more punchouts this year are Michael King of the New York Yankees (22), Seattle's Matt Festa (20), Edwin Diaz of the New York Mets (19) and Minnesota's Jhoan Duran (19).

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

May 4, 2005: The Pirates used a pair of ninth inning home runs by Jason Bay and Daryle Ward to break a 3-3 tie and beat the Astros 6-4 in Houston. Mark Redman went toe-to-toe with Astros ace Roger Clemens, scattering seven hits while allowing three earned runs over 6.0 innings. Rob Mackowiak and David Ross added multi-hit games while Jose Mesa collected his 10th save of the season.
