TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS: The Reds today activated from the bereavement list **RHP Pierce Johnson**; optioned **RHP Chase Petty** to AAA-Louisville (post-game, 5/5); selected **RHP Tejay Antone** (#70) from AAA-Louisville; placed **RHP Emilio Pagán** (left hamstring strain) on the 15-day injured list; transferred **LHP Brandon Williamson** to the 60-day injured list.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is Game 3 (0-2) of a 4-game series against **Fredy Quevedo Jr.'s Cubs** and the sixth game (0-5) of a 7-game road trip that began with a 3-game series sweep at the hands of the **Pirates** at **PNC Park**.

- The Reds have lost a season-high 5 consecutive games and 7 of their last 9 since 4/25 vs **Det**.
- Following Thu's game at **Chc**, the Redlegs will return to **Cincinnati** for a 6-game homestand against the **Astros** (5/8-5/10) and **Nationals** (5/12-14).

ROOKIE RECOGNITION: **INF Sal Stewart** on Mon was named **National League Rookie of the Month** for March/April...became the ninth Red to ever earn the monthly honor, which was introduced in 2001 (last: **Spencer Steer**, May 2023).

- In 31 games between March and April, **Stewart** slashed .281/.373/.570 with 9 homers, 6 doubles, 20 runs, 29 RBI, and 18 walks.
- Stewart** entered May leading MLB in RBI (29), while also ranking among National League leaders in home runs (T4th), extra-base hits (15, T5th), slugging percentage (6th), OPS (.943, 6th), and total bases (65, T7th).
- His 29 RBI were the most by a Red before May since the stat became official in 1920, surpassing the previous mark of 26 set by Reds and **National Baseball Hall of Famer Tony Perez** in 1970.
- The 29 RBI were also second-most by any Major League rookie before May since 1920, behind only **Jose Abreu** (32, 2014 w/CWS).

A GOOD DAY TO BE JJ: Since being recalled from AAA-Louisville on 4/25, **OF JJ Bleday** has slashed .292/.414/.833 with 4 homers in 8 games...his 4 homers through his first 8 games as a Red are tied for third-most by a Cin batter in that span in club history, behind **Rece Hinds** (5, 2024) & **Tyler Naquin** (5, 2021).

- His 4 home runs since 4/26 (date of Reds debut) also rank second in the NL and fifth in the majors...among Major Leaguers with 20+ at-bats in that time, ranks fifth in slugging percentage and sixth in OPS (1.247).

ELLYTRICITY: **SS Elly De La Cruz** this season leads all Major League shortstops in homers (10), runs (27), slugging percentage (.528), and total bases (75)...is the second Red since 1900 with at least 10 homers & 8 stolen bases through the team's first 36 games of a season (also: **Eric Davis**, 1987).

- Of his 10 homers this season, 5 have come off left-handed pitching, tied with **Hou's Yordan Alvarez**, **NY Yankees Aaron Judge**, and **NY Yankees Ben Rice** for most among all Major League batters.
- Is 3 stolen bases shy of 150 for his career...is aiming to become the youngest Red (currently 24 years, 115 days old) since 1900 to reach the mark since 1900 (**Eric Davis**, 25 years, 82 days old).
- De La Cruz** is also 3 stolen bases shy of ranking among the fastest players since the live-ball era (since 1920) to reach 400 hits, 200 RBI, and 150 stolen bases for his career.

POWER SURGE: The Reds have hit 26 homers over their last 12 games (since 4/21 at **TB**), second-most in MLB during that time, behind only **NY Yankees** (28).

- The Reds' 48 home runs this season rank third among all Major League teams, behind the **Yankees** (57), **Braves** (54), and **Dodgers** (47).
- Their 48 homers this season are also tied for their 10th-most through the first 36 games of a campaign in club history, the most since the 2021 team had 52 homers through its first 36 contests.
- Have hit multiple homers in a game 14 times this season, tied with the **Astros** for the fifth-most instances in MLB.

CLOSE ENCOUNTERS: The Reds have lost 3 straight games by 2 runs or fewer after opening the year on a 12-game winning streak in such contests...the 12-game winning streak in games decided by 2 runs or fewer matched the 1987 **Brewers** for the longest run by any team to begin a season since 1900.

SERIES NOTES: The Reds and **Cubs** are meeting for the first time this season...last year, Cin went 8-5 vs **Chc** to secure its third straight season series victory.

- In their final meeting of 2025 (9/18-9/21), Cin swept the 4-game series at **Great American Ball Park**...it was its first 4-game sweep of **Chc** since 6/21-6/24, 2018 at GABP...in that set, recorded multiple 1-0 wins in a single series for the first time since 2002 at **Wrigley Field** (9/24, 9/26).
- The Reds led 5 of the 13 games of the 2025 season series by 4 or more runs (4-0 & 6-2 on 5/23, lost 13-6; 6-1 on 5/24, won 6-4; 8-3 on 5/25, lost 11-8; 6-0 5/30, won 6-2; won 5-1 on 8/5).
- The Reds are 196-192 vs **Chc** since 2003 and 93-110 since 2014...are 469-503 (.483) all-time here at **Wrigley Field**.

NATE THE GREAT: **INF Nathaniel Lowe** hit his sixth homer as a Red, all of which have come in the team's last 11 games (since 4/24 vs **Det**), on Tue at **Chc**.

- Since 4/24, **Lowe** ranks among Major League leaders in homers (6, T2nd), total bases (32, T3rd), extra-base hits (8, T3rd), RBI (11, T4th), slugging percentage (.821, 4th), and OPS (1.193, 6th).

STATE OF THE REDS: At 20-16 (.556), the Reds sit in third place in the NL Central division standings, 4.0 games behind the first-place **Cubs** (21-12)...their 20-16 record is also the eighth-best mark in MLB this season.

- The Reds entered May in first place in their division for the ninth time in the divisional era (since 1969)...last did so in 2006, when they finished April tied with the **Cardinals** for the top spot in the NL Central.
- Of the 9 Reds teams to enter May atop their division, 3 qualified for Postseason play, including each of the last 2 World Series championship squads (1976, '90).

EL CABALLO DE HIERRO: **SS Elly De La Cruz** has appeared in each of Cin's last 254 games, beginning 7/30/24...it's the fourth-longest consecutive games played streak by a Red since 1970.

BRING 'EM ON: The Reds own a 15-9 record (.625) this season against opponents entering play with a .500-or-better winning percentage.

- Their 15 wins in such games are tied with the **Cubs** for most in the majors this season...their .625 winning percentage against opponents that entered with a .500-or-better winning percentage ranks fifth in MLB, behind **StL** (.800), **Atl** (.750), **NY Yankees** (7-3, .700), and **Chc** (.652).

- LAST TIME OUT:** Suffered the 9-1 loss on Fri, 5/1 at Pit (3.1ip, 7h, 4r/4er, 2bb, 1k, 2hr, 56TP).
 • 3 of his 4 runs allowed came with 2 outs.
 • Threw first-pitch strikes to 11 of his 19 batters.
 • Both homers he allowed came when he was ahead in the count (0-2 to Bryan Reynolds in the 1st inning; 0-1 to Henry Davis in the 4th inning).
 • Pitched into the 4th inning and retired leadoff batter Konnor Griffen before allowing a home run to Henry Davis and a double to Oneil Cruz...Cruz was his last batter...turned it over to Zach Maxwell who got out of the inning without further damage.

- APRIL 25 vs DET:** Earned the 9-2 win on Sat 4/25 vs Det (5.1ip, 8h, 2r/2er, 0bb, 3k, 2hr, 94TP).
 • Allowed a season-high 8 fly balls, 8 hard-hit balls, 2 HR, and 13 swings-and-misses.
 • Gave up a leadoff home run to Kevin McGonigle on the first pitch of the game...was the second time in his career he allowed a HR on his first offering (J.P. Crawford, 8/25/23 at Sea)...allowed 2 more runners to reach in the 1st inning before escaping without further damage.
 • Scattered 5 hits and allowed 1 more run over the next 4.1 innings (HR, Spencer Torkelson in the 4th inning) before turning it over to Connor Phillips in the top of the 6th with 1 out and a runner on first...Phillips retired his 2 batters.

- APRIL 19 at MIN:** Did not factor in the decision in the 10-inning, 7-4 win at Min on Sun 4/19 (6.0ip, 5h, 3r/3er, 4bb, 2k, 0hr, 104TP).
 • Was his second straight quality start and the 66th of his career.
 • His 104 pitches and 4 walks were both season highs...last threw 104 or more pitches on 8/5/24 for KC vs Bos (107)...last walked 4 or more batters on 9/6/25 vs NYM (4bb).

- APRIL 14 vs SF:** Earned the 2-1 win on Tue 4/14 vs SF (6.0ip, 6h, 1r/1er, 0bb, 1hr, 75TP).
 • Was his first win of 2026 and his first quality start since 9/12/25 at Ath.
 • Marked his 11th start since the beginning of the 2025 season in which he pitched 6.0 or more innings and allowed fewer than 2 runs.
 • Allowed 13 ground balls, his most since 8/29/24 at Hou (14).
 • Was just the third outing of his career that he pitched as many as 6.0 innings and threw as few as 75 pitches (8/12/25 vs Phi, 6.0ip/71TP; 4/5/24 vs CWS, 6.1ip/72TP).
