HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs are on a 9-game, 11-day road trip @ Mariners (1-1), Dodgers and Astros.

- ♦ **Tyler Gilbert** had a quality start on Sept. 5 vs. Mariners (3 ER in 7.0 IP).
 - ♦ In 5 career starts, is 1-1 with a 3.48 ERA (12 ER in 31.0 IP).
- ♦ **David Peralta** has hit safely in 13 of his last 14 starts, including 11 straight to begin this stretch dating back to Aug. 19, batting .365 (19-for-52)/.977 OPS with 5 doubles, 2 home runs, 6 RBI and 2 walks.
 - ♦ In 22 road interleague games since 2019, is hitting .325 (26-for-80)/.901 OPS with 5 doubles, 4 homers, 12 RBI and 6 walks.

DOWN ON THE FARM - **DOUBLE-A AMARILLO:** The Sod Poodles made history last night at HODGETOWN as **Stone Garrett, Buddy Kennedy, Dominic Fletcher** and **Dominic Canzone** hit back-to-back-to-back-to-back home runs in the thjrd inning of a 20-12 victory vs. Tulsa.

- ♦ According to SABR and MiLB, the 4 straight homers in an inning is only the fifth documented instance in Minor League Baseball history, second since 1993.

DOWN ON THE FARM - **LOW-A VISALIA:** OF/DH **Neyfy Castillo** has 20 homers, 23 stolen bases and 70 RBI in 97 games for the Rawhide this season, the fifth California League player in the last 75 years with 20+ homers, 20+ stolen bases and 70+ RBI in a season.

- MILESTONE WATCH: Upcoming D-backs statistical marks:
- ♦ **Nick Ahmed:** His 746 games at shortstop are 1 shy of tying Stephen Drew (747) for the most in club history.
 - ♦ **David Peralta:** Hit his 98th home run on Wednesday vs. Rangers, passing Miguel Montero (97) and moving into sole possession of eighth place on the D-backs' all-time list...next up is Matt Williams (99).

- AT A GLANCE: Is in his first season with Arizona...selected by the D-backs in the Triple-A phase of the 2020 Rule 5 Minor League Draft from the Dodgers.
- Contract was selected from Triple-A Reno on Aug. 3... was 5-2 with a 3.44 ERA (20 ER in 52.1 IP) in 11 games (10 starts) with the Aces this season.
 - Selected by Phillies in the sixth round of the 2015 draft.
 - Was a non-roster invitee to 2021 Spring Training.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW: Since making his MLB debut on Aug. 14, ranks among all NL rookie pitchers [min. 3 GS] in innings (1st, 31.0), opponent average (2nd, .218), WHIP (2nd, 1.10) and ERA (3rd, 3.48).

LAST START: Did not factor in the decision on Sept. 5 vs. Mariners (3 ER in 7.0 IP)...D-backs lost, 10-4 in 11 innings.

VS. MARINERS: Will be his second career outing (SEE LAST START).

- THE NO-NO: Tossed the third 9.0-inning no-hitter in D-backs history (first @ Chase Field) in his first career start on Aug. 14 vs. Padres (also: Edwin Jackson on June 25, 2010 @ Rays and Randy Johnson on May 18, 2004 @ Braves).
- ♦ Gilbert's no-hitter was the fourth by a pitcher in their first career Major League start (second in Modern Era):
 - ❑ Bobo Holloman/STL on May 6, 1953 vs. Philadelphia A's
 - ❑ Bumpus Jones/CIN on Oct. 15, 1892 vs. Pittsburgh Pirates
 - ❑ Ted Breitenstein/STL on Oct. 4, 1891 vs. Louisville Colonels

ELECTRIC ON AND OFF THE FIELD: After not receiving an invite to the Dodgers' Alternate Training Site in 2020, he returned home to work with his father, Greg, as an electrician...he continued to work out at his high school and was eventually claimed in the Triple-A Phase of the Rule 5 Draft.

2020 REVIEW: Did not pitch due to no Minor League season.

- ON DECK - **LOS ANGELES DODGERS:** The D-backs head to Los Angeles for their final road series at Dodger Stadium (also: May 17-20, July 9-11)...will host the Dodgers from Sept. 24-26.
- ♦ 8 of 13 games have been decided by 3 runs or less, including 3 1-run games (1-2).
 - ♦ D-backs starting pitchers at Dodger Stadium have posted a .238 opponent average (29-for-122).

NEXT STARTER: RHP ZAC GALLEN (2-9, 4.32)
