Brandon Woodruff has gone 17-3 with a 2.29 ERA over his last 35 starts, which dates back to May 2022 (208ip, 142h, 56r, 53er, 47bb, 250k).

Andrew Vaughn, who was acquired from the White Sox on June 13 and ioined the team on July 7, is batting 324 (12-for-37) with 3 HR and 13 RBI in 13 games as a Brewer while posting a .409 OBP/.649 SLG/1.058 OPS.

AT HOME: The team is 33-19 at home, going 12-5-0 in series play, including this series.....are 21-10 in the last 31 home games.....had a season-high 6-game home winning streak snapped on Friday.....are looking to avoid their second season-high 3-game road losing streak (5/7-5/17).

ON THE ROAD: The team is 28-24 on the road, going 8-7-2 in series play....are 18-6 in the last 24 road games.....have had three season-high 5-game road winning streaks, coming from 5/25-6/2, 6/19-7/2 and 7/6-7/21.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy is in his second season as Brewers manager. 2024 NL Manager of the Year after going 93-69 and winning the NL Central division championship.....he is the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor.....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.

Zho in current role), bullpen coach Charlie Greene (2nd season), lead hitting coach Al LeBoeuf (1st season), hitting coach Eric Theisen (1st season), assistant coach Daniel de Mondesert (2nd season), infield coach Matt Erickson (2nd season), first base coach Julio Borbón (1st season), third base coach Jason Lane (10th season/5th in current role).

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The team has made 15 replay challenges this season, going 9-6.....their last challenge (won) came on 7/7 vs. Los Angeles-NL as an out call at third base involving Isaac Collins was overturned.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have made the postseason six times in the last seven seasons (2018-24) and won the NL Central in four of the last seven, three of four, and two in a row....Milwaukee is one of five teams to make the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons, joined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees [6].....the team was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight straight seasons (2017-24), missing by a single game in both 2017 and 2022.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons [2017-24].....this does not include 2020.....the Brewers have 727 wins since 2017 [4th in MLB/2nd in National League].

WODDRUFF AT A GLANCE: Brandon Woodruff, 32, will make his fourth start of the season and second against the Marlins.....he last started last Monday at Seattle in a 6-0 win (6ip, 2h, 0bb, 5k, 1hbp, 62 pitches).....the team is 3-0 in his starts.....he has 2 quality starts.....opponents are batting .155 (9-for-58, 3hr).....he missed the entire 2024 season as he recovered from right shoulder surgery.....he is 17-3 with a 2.29 ERA in his last 35 starts dating back to May 2022 (208ip, 142h, 56r, 53er, 47bb, 250k).....he was selected by Milwaukee in the 11th round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft out of Mississippi State University.....he is signed through the 2025 season with a mutual option for 2026.

SORRY I'M LATE: Woodruff's return to a Major League mound was delayed twice while on rehab assignment.....the team returned Woodruff from rehab assignment at Triple-A Nashville on May 12 due to right ankle tendinitis and again on June 5 due to a right elbow contusion suffered in a start on 6/3 vs. Gwinnett (struck by line drive).

SIMPLY THE BEST: Woodruff is the all-time franchise leader with a 3.06 ERA (min. 500ip).....his 811 strikeouts rank seventh in franchise history.....Corbin Burnes ranks sixth (870).....at 48-26, his .649 career winning percentage ranks second in franchise history (min. 50 decisions), trailing only Brent Suter (36-19, .655).

CAREER: Has gone 48-26 with a 3.06 ERA in 133 games/118 starts (696.2ip, 237er).....is in his ninth Major League season, all with the Brewers (2017-25).....was a 2019 and 2021 All-Star.....underwent surgery on 10/13/23 to repair the anterior capsule in his right shoulder, performed by Dr. Keith Meister....missed the entire 2024 season.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 26-9 with a 2.82 ERA in 66 games/59 starts (353.2ip, 111er).....is 0-0 with a 4.15 ERA in 1 start this season (4.1ip, 2er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 22-17 with a 3.31 ERA in 67 games/59 starts (343ip, 126er)....is 2-0 with a 0.75 ERA in 2 starts this season (12ip, 1er).
