PITTSBURGH PIRATES (34-30) vs. ATLANTA BRAVES (43-21)
June 6, 2026 - Truist Park - Atlanta, GA - 4:10 EDT - Game #65/Road #32
RHP Braxton Ashcraft (5-2, 2.77 ERA) vs. RHP Spencer Strider (3-1, 3.77 ERA)

THE PIRATES: lost 6-3 last night in the opener of this three-game weekend series against the Braves...Won two of three games at Houston (Tuesday-Thursday), including a 5-1 win on Thursday at Daikin Park, to begin this six-game, seven-day road trip...Have won eight of their last 12 games (since May 24 at Toronto)...Will return to Pittsburgh for a six-game homestand vs. Los Angeles-NL (June 9-11) and Miami (June 12-14) following this weekend's series at Truist Park (Friday-Sunday)...Have scored the fourth-most runs (328) in Major League Baseball, behind Washington (345), Atlanta (335) and Los Angeles-NL (331)...Are tied for the third-most stolen bases (62) in MLB, behind Miami (71) & Milwaukee (65).

HOW MAY I HELP YOU: Braxton Ashcraft gets the start this afternoon in game two of this weekend series against the Braves...Ashcraft recorded a 1.99 ERA (40.2ip/9er) in six starts last month...It was the seventh-lowest ERA among all National League pitchers with at least 30.0 innings of work, trailing only Philadelphia's Cristopher Sánchez (0.00), Milwaukee's Jacob Misiorowski (0.23), Cincinnati's Chase Burns (1.19), Arizona's Eduardo Rodriguez (1.60), Atlanta's Chris Sale (1.69) and Arizona's Michael Soroka (1.78).

LET'S GO REYNOLDS: Bryan Reynolds is hitting .364 (16-for-44) with four doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, 11 runs scored and a 1.082 OPS during his current 13-game on-base streak...Since the streak began on May 23, Reynolds ranks 10th in all of MLB in batting, fourth in on-base percentage (.491) and tied for fourth in walks (11).

SPENCER'S GIFTS: Spencer Horwitz has reached base safely in a season-high 13 straight games, going 15-for-49 (.306) with a double, three home runs, four RBI and a .917 OPS...Since the beginning of last month, Horwitz ranks eighth among all National League hitters in batting (.308) and fourth in on-base percentage (.403).

ON THE ROAD: The Pirates are tied for the fifth-most road wins (16) among all National League teams coming into today (the Braves lead the way with 23)...Last year Pittsburgh did not pick up its 16th win on the road until July 30 at San Francisco...The Bucs are averaging 4.61 runs per game on the road this season, which ranks 11th in all of MLB...Last year Pittsburgh ranked 29th in all of MLB with an average of 3.32 runs per game on the road.

IN THE NICK OF TIME: Nick Gonzales has hit safely in each of his last seven games, going 12-for-29 (.414) with a double, two home runs and eight RBI (he hit safely in a single-season, career-high 10 straight games earlier this year from April 19-29)...Gonzales enters today ranked ninth in all of MLB with a .312 average this season.

EXTRA! EXTRA! Pittsburgh has at least one extra-base hit in 37 straight games (since April 26 at Milwaukee)...That is the second-longest active streak in all of MLB, behind San Francisco (39 straight games, since April 24)...Since the streak began on April 26, Pittsburgh's 105 extra base hits are tied for the 10th-most in all of MLB along with Atlanta.

THE OUTFIELD: Pittsburgh's outfielders this season rank fourth in all of MLB with a .784 OPS, trailing only the Mariners (.808), Yankees (.806) and Cubs (.792)...Pittsburgh's outfielders also rank sixth in all of MLB with 28 home runs this year (Atlanta's outfielders are tied for the seventh-most home runs in MLB with 26)...Pittsburgh's outfielders ranked 27th in all of MLB last season in OPS (.661).

THAT'S SO BRAVE: Bryan Reynolds is 49-for-157 (.312) with seven doubles, two triples, five home runs and 18 RBI in 41 career games against Atlanta...He is 32-for-82 (.390) with seven doubles, four home runs, 13 RBI and a 1.085 OPS in 22 career games at Truist Park...Reynolds' .390 average here is the best among visiting players in stadium history (minimum 80 plate appearances).

SETTING UP THE SERIES: The Pirates have scored at least one run in 46 straight games against the Braves, which is their longest active streak versus a single team...It is Pittsburgh's longest streak against Atlanta since a 65-game run between 1974 and 1979...The Pirates won four of six games against the Braves last season (they won two of three games from May 9-11 at PNC Park and two of three games to end the season from September 26-28 here at Truist Park)...It was their first season series victory over the Braves since winning five of seven games in 2017...The series win in Atlanta was Pittsburgh's first at Truist Park (opened in 2017) and its first in the city of Atlanta since winning two of three contests from June 5-7, 2015 at Turner Field.

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

June 6, 2025: Nick Gonzales ended the game with his ninth-inning sacrifice fly in Pittsburgh's 5-4 win over Philadelphia, marking his third career walkoff RBI and second against the Phillies. Gonzales also added his first triple of the year and first since September 19, 2024 at St. Louis. Bryan Reynolds and Henry Davis both went deep, as part of their respective multi-hit efforts, in the Pirates' walkoff victory.

HOW ACQUIRED: Selected in the second round of the 2018 Draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Ashcraft won a 9-3 decision after striking out 11 batters (issued zero walks) while throwing just 80 pitches over 6.0 innings on May 31 vs. Minnesota...The 11 strikeouts were his second-most in any outing in his professional career, trailing only a 12-strikeout performance with Double-A Altoona on June 6, 2024 at Richmond.

PITCH EFFICIENCY: Ashcraft had a career-high 11 strikeouts (issued zero walks) while throwing just 80 pitches over 6.0 innings on May 31 vs. Minnesota...He became the 12th Pirate (13th instance) in the Modern Era (since 1901) to have at least 11 strikeouts and zero walks in an outing, the first since Mitch Keller (13k) on May 14, 2023 at Baltimore...Ashcraft also became the 11th Major Leaguer (since pitch tracking began in 1988) to have at least 11 strikeouts and zero walks in an outing of 80 or fewer pitches, the first since Tampa Bay's Ryan Pepiot (12k, 76 pitches) on Sept. 18, 2024 vs. Boston.

K COLLECTOR: Ashcraft's 81 strikeouts are tied with Cincinnati's Chase Burns and Miami's Max Meyer for the fifth-most in the National League, behind Milwaukee's Jacob Misiorowski (108), Philadelphia's Cristopher Sánchez (103), Atlanta's Chris Sale (86) & Paul Skenes (82)...The 81 strikeouts rank tied for 10th in Major League Baseball.

MR. CONSISTENT: Ashcraft has pitched at least 6.0 innings, struck out at least five batters and walked two or fewer batters in six straight starts (since May 3 vs. Cincinnati)...The only Pirates pitcher to do that in seven straight starts in the Modern Era (since 1901) was teammate Paul Skenes (he did that from June 11-July 23, 2024).

A STAR IS BORN: Ashcraft has a 2.74 ERA (144.1ip/44er) since making his Major League debut on May 26, 2025 at Arizona...His ERA during that time ranks fifth in MLB (min. 140.0 innings)...He trails Philadelphia's Cristopher Sánchez (1.92), Detroit's Tarik Skubal (2.22), Paul Skenes (2.24) and New York (AL)'s Cam Schlichtler (2.41) on that list.

ELITE ARM: Ashcraft has a 2.77 ERA (74.2ip/23er) and 81 strikeouts (has issued just 17 walks) over his first 12 starts...He is one of only three Pirates (since earned runs became an official stat in the National League in 1912) to have a sub-3.00 ERA, at least 80 strikeouts and 20 or fewer walks issued through their first 12 starts of a season... Ashcraft joined Gerrit Cole (2015, 1.73 ERA/86 K) & Paul Skenes (2024, 1.93 ERA/97 K).

RISPY BUSINESS: Ashcraft has limited opposing hitters to a .082 batting average against (4-for-49) w/runners in scoring position...He has allowed three hits in 42 at-bats w/runners in scoring pos. across his last 10 starts (since April 11 at Chicago-NL).

HISTORIC STRETCH: Ashcraft had at least eight strikeouts while issuing one/zero walks and allowing one/zero runs in back-to-back starts on April 5 vs. Baltimore and April 11 at Chicago (NL)...He joined Bob Friend (Aug. 20-24, 1959), Rick Rhoden (June 21-27, 1986), Joe Musgrove (Sept. 20-26, 2020), Mitch Keller (May 8-14, 2023) and Paul Skenes (Sept. 4-10, 2025) as the only Pirates in the Modern Era (since 1901) to have consecutive starts with at least eight strikeouts, one/zero hits and one/zero walks.

A BIT OF BOTH: Ashcraft went 1-2 with a 2.16 ERA (33.1ip/8er) in eight starts last season, while also going 3-2 with a 3.22 ERA (36.1ip/13er) in 18 relief appearances... His lone win as a member of Pittsburgh's starting rotation came on August 22 vs. Colorado, when he allowed one hit and struck out six batters over 5.0 scoreless innings.
