### Today's Headlines

Cooper Hummel (ARI) went 2for-3 on Thursday with a two-run home run and four RBI, helping lift his Salt River Rafters to a 9-6 victory over the Glendale Desert Dogs. Hummel scored two runs and reached base safely in four of his five plate appearances.

Ronny Simon (TB) posted four RBI for the Mesa Solar Sox on Thursday in a 6-3 win over the firstplace Surprise Saguaros. Simon went 1-for-4 on the night with a double; he currently holds a .281/.343/.500 batting slash in the AFL through 16 games.

Hunter Stanley (CLE) tossed four shutout innings for the Peoria Javelinas on Thursday, striking out eight hitters. He allowed one hit and zero walks, lowering his Fall League ERA to 2.63 through 13 2/3 innings. He now has the second-most AFL strikeouts (19).

Daniel Robert (TEX) pitched two perfect innings of relief for the Surprise Saguaros on Thursday, striking out four hitters. Robert has not allowed a run in his last three appearances, allowing a combined one hit and one walk in four

Zavier Warren (MIL) had a 2-for-2 showing on Thursday with the Glendale Desert Dogs, drawing three walks and reaching base safely in all five of his plate appearances. His on-base percentage of .508 currently ranks third in the AFL among qualified players.

# Arizona Fall League Alumni Spotlight

Dusty Baker (Scottsdale Scorpions, 1992) served as a manager in the inaugural season of Arizona Fall League baseball, just months before his MLB managerial debut. Baker has since managed a combined 25 MLB seasons between the Giants, Cubs, Reds, Nationals and Astros, winning National League Manager of the Year honors in 1993, 1997 and 2000. The current manager of the American League champion Houston Astros, Baker is one of 12 managers in MLB history with 2,000 career managerial wins. Before his managing career, he played 19 MLB seasons as an outfielder, earning two All-Star selections, two Silver Slugger Awards and a World Series championship (1981). Baker was a 26th-round selection in the 1967 MLB Draft.
