## Halfway

Atlanta today plays its 81 st game of the year, marking the halfway point of the 162 -game regular season.
The Braves have gone 45-35 (.563) through their first 80 games on the year, the seventhbest record in baseball and fourth best in the National League. Atlanta is on pace for 91 wins this season.

The Braves have won at least 46 of their first 81 games in a season 20 times since moving to Atlanta in 1966, and will do so again with a win this afternoon.
In those 20 seasons, Atlanta has advanced to the postseason 17 times, only failing to do so in 1983, 2011 and the strike-shortened 1994 season.

TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Pirates today continue a three-game weekend series with what is the fifth of six scheduled meetings between the clubs this season...Atlanta played three games at PNC Park in Pittsburgh, May 24-26.

A The Braves raced out to a six-run lead through two innings last night and held on to win the opener, $6-1 \ldots$ Atlanta dropped two-of-three in the series in Pittsburgh, winning the finale, 8-1, to avoid the series sweep...It marked the first time the Braves lost a series to the Pirates since July of 2021.

A The Braves went 4-3 in seven games versus the Pirates last season, including winning two-of-three here at home.

A Atlanta has won the season set with Pittsburgh every year since 2018 in which they have played, going a combined 27-11 (.711) in that span...That includes a perfect $7-0$ record against the Pirates in 2022, one of just three instances in the franchise's modern era that they swept a season series of seven or more games with an opponent.
A The Braves need a sweep this weekend to take the season set, or a series win to split the six games.

A Atlanta has never lost a series to Pittsburgh here at Truist Park, going 18-5 (.783) at home since the facility opened in 2017...The Braves and Pirates split four games in their first series in this building in 2017, and Atlanta has gone 16-3 in the 19 games since.

FRIED VS. SKENES: LH Max Fried for Atlanta and RH Paul Skenes for Pittsburgh are slated to start this afternoon, in a matchup of two of the top 13 ERAs in the National League (minimum eight starts).

A Fried is set to make the seventh start of his career against Pittsburgh, and the 6-foot-4, 190-pound left-hander is 3-1 with a 4.76 ERA (18 ER/34.0 IP) over his first six turns...Atlanta is 5-1 in these games.
A Fried last faced the Pirates with a single start last season, August 9 at PNC Park, and allowed six hits and four runs over just 4.0 innings in a nodecision.
A Skenes is set to make the first start of his career against Atlanta and just his ninth in the major leagues...The No. 1 overall pick in the 2023 FirstYear Player Draft and consensus Top 10 prospect entering the season is a perfect 4-0 with a 2.14 ERA (11 ER/46.1 IP) in his first eight career turns.

A Since Skene's debut on May 11, he (2.14 ERA) and Fried (2.09 ERA) rank seventh and fifth, respectively in the National League in ERA... Skenes ranks fourth in the NL with 61 strikeouts in that span, while Fried ranks sixth with an opponents average of just 210 .

A The Braves and Pirates are both 6-2 in the eight starts by Fried and Skenes since the latter's debut.

WIN: Atlanta used a five-run third inning last night to spur a win, 6-1, over Pittsburgh in the series opener... The win snapped a brief two-game losing streak for the Braves.

A The Braves sent nine batters to the plate in the third inning, five of which came around to score... It marked the ninth time the club has scored at least five runs within an inning this season - doing so in three of its last seven home games, dating to June 14 vs. Tampa Bay.
A Atlanta moved to 6-1 at home on Friday nights, the best such record in the National League and behind just Seattle (7-0) in the majors.
A RH Charlie Morton earned the win, the first of his career over Pittsburgh...The right-hander has now defeated all 30 teams over the course of his 17 -year career, the 22 nd pitcher in history to do so.

RILEY IN JUNE: Austin Riley opened the scoring with a solo home run in the second inning last night, his ninth of the season and sixth this month...Atlanta's third baseman is batting .297/.373/.560 over 25 games in June.
A Each of his six homers have come over his last 14 games, dating to June 14 vs. Tampa Bay...Since that date, he is hitting .388 (19-for-49) with six home runs, four doubles, 11 RBI and 13 runs.
A His 10 extra-base hits since that date match his total from his previous 45 games, dating to April 8 vs. New York (NL).
A In the month of June, he leads all qualified NL third basemen in runs (17) and OPS (.933), ranks second in on-base percentage (.373), slugging percentage (.560) and total bases (51), and is tied for second in home runs (6) and doubles (6).
A He has raised his average by 24 points (. 228 to .252) and his OPS by 101 points (. 648 to .749 ) this month.
ONE HUNDRED MPH: Paul Skenes enters today's game with 70 pitches on the season that have been clocked at over 100 miles per hour, most by a starting pitcher in baseball...Conversely, the Braves have seen just 29 pitches this season at that speed, tied for the second fewest in baseball.
A Atlanta is 2-for-5 (.400) on at-bats ending on pitches at 100 mph , the best average in baseball... However, the Braves' six total plate appearances ending with $100-\mathrm{mph}$ pitches are tied for fewest in the majors...Michael Harris II and Marcell Ozuna have each singled on such pitches this year, while Ozzie Albies drew a walk.
A Just two Braves in today's lineup have multiple hits in their careers against pitches over 100 mph , with Travis d'Arnaud and Matt Olson each totaling two...d'Arnaud doubled off of Jordan Hicks last April, and singled off of Brusdar Graterol in 2022.. Olson's two hits came in the same game, a homer and a single off of Hunter Greene in April of 2022.

A Scheduled to make his 16th start of the season and seventh of his career against Pittsburgh.
A Holding right-handed hitters to a .161 batting average, the lowest among lefthanded qualifiers this season and third lowest in baseball.
A Reached 800.0 career innnigs pitched in his last start against New York (AL).
A Among pitchers who have logged at least 800.0 innings with the organization dating to the Live Ball Era, Fried's career 3.03 ERA is the second lowest in Braves franchise history...Trails only Hall-of-Famer Greg Maddux (2.63).
Dating to his 2017 debut season, Fried's .704 winning percentage is the second highest in the majors, trailing only Clayton Kershaw (min. 700 IP).
A Opponents are being held to an average exit velocity of 85.0 MPH against Fried; tied for the second lowest with teammat Chris Saleamong qualified pitchers.
$\mathcal{A}$ Also leads the league with the lowest percentage of balls barreled against him at $11.3 \%$ (among qualifiers).
Pitching to a 7.36 ERA in the first frame and a 2.15 ERA in all other innings this season.
A Allowed a combined nine runs in the first innings between his first two games in 2024.
Sporting a 2.12 ERA since April 7 in 12 starts after allowing a combined 10 earned runs through 5.0 frames tossed between his first two starts of the season.
A Only Reynaldo López and Ranger Suárez have lower ERAs during that span.
Producing a $60.7 \%$ groundball rate this season; the third highest rate in the majors among qualified starters.
A His 150 groundballs induced are second most in MLB.
A His 67 wins over the past five seasons are most in the National League, and most by any left-hander in baseball.

A Only one pitcher, the Yankees' Gerrit Cole, has more wins than Fried since the start of 2019...Cole has 71 wins.
A Additionally, the Braves have 92 wins in games started by Fried since the beginning of 2019 , the most such wins by a pitcher in the National League... Only Cole and José, Berríos, whose teams have won 94 and 93 of their starts resepctively, have more in the majors.
Fried's 26 successful pickoffs since debuting in 2017 are the most in baseball and two more than the next closest pitcher, Washington's Patrick Corbin.
A Corbin has attempted 489 pickoffs in that time, compared to Fried's 193.
A Fried has successfully nabbed a runner on 13.5 percent of his career pickoff attempts, drastically higher than the MLB average since his debut (1.7 percent)...Since 2017, 1.6 percent of MLB's successful pick attempts have been executed by Fried.

## 2024 Recap

A Recorded a career most 13 strikeouts on June 4 against Boston.
A His previous career high was 11 punchouts, done twice.
A Earned his second win of the season while throwing a three-hit shutout against the Marlins on April 23; the fourth of his career and the third of the nine-inning variety.
A Each of his four shutouts have qualified as a "Maddux" (fewer than 100 pitches).
A Since pitch tracking began in 1988, Hall-of-Famers Greg Maddux (11) and Tom Glavine (5) are the only Braves pitchers to log more "Maddux" outings.
A It's the first 9.0-inning shutout by a Braves pitcher since RHP Bryce Elder on September 26, 2022 at Washington.
Tossed a two-run complete game against Chicago (NL) in his last start, fanning nine hitters while scattering three hits, one earned run and issuing zero walks.

A Became the first Braves pitcher to record two complete games in which he did not allow more than one earned run and three hits in the team's first 50 games of the season since Shelby Miller in 2015...Only Boston-era pitchers Irv Young, Lou Fette and Jim Tobin have more such games in that same span.

A He is one of two pitchers in baseball with two no-hit bids through the sixth inning this season...Also the first pitcher in the National League to have taken multiple no-hitters through the sixth in a season since Clayton Kershaw in 2022.
Struckout Christian Walker looking in the top of the second inning to reach 700 punchouts on his career.
A Fried became the sixth left-handed pitcher in franchise history to reach the milestone.
A Joins Hall-of-Famers Warren Spahn and Tom Glavine along with with Denny Lemaster, Lefty Tyler and Steve Avery as the only lefty Braves pitchers to do so.
A Had the shortest start of his career against Philadelphia on March 30, 2024.
A Lasted 0.2 innings while allowing three earned runs and two hits, issuing three walks on 43 pitches.
