**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Giants begin a six-game road trip tonight with the opener of a three-game series against the Cleveland Guardians...following the Cleveland series (Tuesday-Thursday), the Giants will head to Boston for a three-game set against the Red Sox (Friday-Sunday).

- ▶ Since the All-Star break, SF's 10-18 (.357) record is the third-worst in MLB over that span, ahead of only the Athletics (8-21, .276) and Guardians (9-19, .321).
- ▶ SF has played well in series openers this year, posting a 19-21 overall record, including winning five of their last seven series openers.
- ▶ The Giants are in a stretch where 15 of the 18 games they play are against Interleague opponents...SF is 14-25 (.359) against Interleague opponents this season.

**THE WHIZ KID:** LHP Carson Whisenhunt will make his first career start against Cleveland...he's coming off one of his strongest outings of the season last Tuesday against Houston, where he earned the win and threw 5.2 innings, allowing just one run.

- ▶ Whisenhunt has made 11 career starts and has earned a decision in nine of those outings (5-4 record)...the only Giants' pitchers to debut this century with as many decisions through 11 MLB starts are RHP Keaton Winn (2023-2024) and RHP Jesse Foppert (2003), each with 10 (Stats, LLC).
- ▶ Batters are hitting just .180 (9-for-50) off his changeup, which he throws 38% of the time, compared to a .467 (14-for-44) average off his four seamer (35.1%).

**AGAINST CLEVELAND:** The Giants are 3-5 over their past eight contests against the Guardians, dating back to September 2023.

- ▶ The last nine matchups between San Francisco and Cleveland have been decided by two runs or fewer, the longest active streak of matchups between any two teams...it's also the longest streak between Interleague opponents since the Twins and Brewers had a streak of 11 such games in 2018-2020 (Stats, LLC).
- ▶ The Giants are making just their fourth trip to Cleveland since 2008 (also 2022 and 2024).
- ▶ IF Rafael Devers has played very well at Progressive Field over his career, batting .350 (36-for-103) with nine homers and a 1.112 OPS over 24 games.

**DOWN ON THE FARM:** MLB Pipeline released its updated farm system rankings, with the Giants making the largest jump, climbing from No. 19 to No. 5...San Francisco's 14-spot rise is the organization's highest ranking since 2021, when they ranked No. 8 and is one spot shy of the biggest jump ever...according to MLB Pipeline; no organization has made as dramatic a move in so short a time as San Francisco improving from No. 28 in the 2025 preseason to No. 5 now.

- ▶ The Giants have five top 100 prospects per MLB.com: SS/2B Josuar Gonzalez (No. 17), SS/3B Luis Hernández (No. 27), RHP Jackson Flora (No. 31), SS/2B Jhonny Level (No. 47) and RHP Ramon Marquez (No. 100).
- ▶ SF added to its farm system talent by signing draft arms (RHP Jackson Flora, LHP Carson Bolemon and RHP Kaden Waechter) and dealing for RHP Ramon Márquez, LHP Henry Lalane and RHP Miguel Mendez at the deadline.

**300TH GAME MILESTONE:** OF Jung Hoo Lee played his 300th game this past weekend... he's recorded 313 hits in those games, which are the most base hits through 300 MLB games by any Giants player since Buster Posey had 339 from 2009-2012 and is the most by a Giants left-handed hitter since Will Clark had 317 from 1986-1988 (Stats, LLC).

- ▶ Lee is batting .328 (76-for-232) with 24 extra-base hits and a .365 OBP over 60 road games this year, compared to a .251 (51-for-203) in 54 home games...his .328 road average ranks as the third-best in MLB behind Freddie Freeman (.335) and Gabriel Moreno (.330).

**TOP OF THE CLASS:** IF Rafael Devers is one of four players leading his team in doubles, home runs, walks and RBI this season (also Yordan Alvarez, Matt Olson, Miguel Vargas)...the only Giants players to lead the team in all four categories in a season this century are Matt Chapman (2024), Buster Posey (2012) and Pablo Sandoval (2009) (Stats, LLC).

**WIZ KID:** The 25-year-old was selected in the second round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of East Carolina...he currently ranks as the Giants' No. 15 prospect per *MLB.com*.

**RUNWAY:** Is making his seventh start with the Giants this season and fifth straight after his most recent recall in late July...figures to get consistent starts down the stretch for SF with LHP Robbie Ray and RHP Tyler Mahle traded away and **RHP Trevor McDonald** now out for the season after undergoing Tommy John surgery.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Returned to the win column last Tuesday against the Astros in the Giants' 4-1 win...worked 5.2 innings and allowed a run on four hits (all singles) while walking three and striking out two in his 96-pitch effort...gave up a 2nd-inning run but stymied the Astros the rest of the way before departing after a two-out walk in the 6th inning.

**HANG WITH 'EM:** Since being recalled on July 26, Whisenhunt has allowed 15 runs (all earned) on 21 hits (four doubles, a triple and three homers) in four starts...he's walked 12 and struck out 16 in the four outings...opposing hitters have a .304 average and .927 OPS off him in this stretch.

**VS. CLEVELAND:** Faces the Guardians for a first time in his young MLB career.

**CHANGE IS...GOOD:** Whisenhunt's changeup, which has long been rated as one of the better pitches in the minor leagues, had a .286 opposing batting average in the Majors in 2025 (10x35) with six strikeouts and a 37.8% whiff rate...in his six MLB starts this year batters have gone 9-for-50 with six singles, a double and two homers...it's been a pitch that he predominantly has thrown to right-handed hitters...of his 186 changeups at the MLB level, only 12 have been thrown to a left-handed hitter....overall, 12 of his 22 strikeouts with SF this year have come with the changeup...Guardians hitters have a .501 OPS this year against changeups, lowest in the Majors.

**A NEW WRINKLE OR TWO:** Last time out, Whisenhunt still predominantly worked off his changeup and four-seamer but he also mixed in 12 sinkers, the most he's used the pitch in any of his 11 MLB starts dating to last year...Astros hitters went 0-for-2 on the pitch with nine of the 12 sinkers coming to right-handed hitters...in addition to the sinker, Whisenhunt threw what *Statcast* identified as a slurve, throwing 12 of them with Astros hitters going 1-for-5 in ABs that ended with it...five of the 12 went to righties.

**THE SPLITS:** Has held his own versus lefties with lefty batters going 3-for-21 with eight walks...the three hits are singles...righties, however, are 27-for-88 (.307) with 10 XBH off Whisenhunt with SF so far this season.

**EXPOSURE SETTINGS:** The first time through the order, batters have a .250/.370/.318 slash line (.689 OPS) with three extra-base hits off Whisenhunt in his six MLB starts...the second time through, however, they are slashing .298/.370/.638 (1.009 OPS) with seven extra-base hits (two doubles, a triple and four homers) and six walks.

**WITH THE RIVER CATS:** Whisenhunt was 6-4 with a 4.15 ERA (38er, 82.1ip), 90 strikeouts and a 1.42 WHIP in 17 games (16 starts) for Triple-A Sacramento this season...he was the PCL Pitcher of the Month for May, going 2-0 with a 2.81 ERA (10er, 32.0ip), 32 strikeouts and a 1.22 WHIP in six starts.
