TODAY'S TILT...the Mariners continue the 6-game road trip with the last of 3 games against the Toronto Blue Jays (0-2)...the M's will also visit the Boston Red Sox (3 G, 8/31-9/2) on the road trip...Seattle is coming off a successful 4-2 homestand against the Chicago Cubs (2-1) and Philadelphia Phillies (2-1)...today's game will be televised and streamed on **Mariners TV** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Ryan Rowland-Smith** on the call and **Brad Adam** serving as field reporter...the game will also be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Gary Hill Jr.** and **Angie Mentink** on the call.

ODDS & ENDS...the Mariners fell to the Blue Jays in yesterday's game by a 4-3 final score...despite the loss, the Mariners sit 3rd in the AL West and remain 4.0 games back of Houston (68-68) for 1st place and 2.0 games behind Texas (66-70).

- **In The Mix With Six** - The Mariners are 41-27 (.603) when their starting pitcher goes 6.0+ innings, and 23-45 (.333) when they do not.
- **Venti, Veinte, Twenty** - The Mariners are 1-of-3 teams in the AL with at least 3 players to record 20+ home runs this season, joining the White Sox and Twins...**Randy Arozarena**, **Julio Rodríguez** and **Dominic Canzone** are tied for the team lead with 20 HR each.
- **Hold Me Close** - The Mariners are 21-20 this season in 1-run games...only the Chicago White Sox (44 G) have played more 1-run games than the Mariners among AL clubs.
- **I Got Five (or Four) On It** - The Mariners are 40-10 (.800) when they score at least 5 runs and 47-18 (.723) when they push at least 4 runs across.
- **More Gas from Vargas** - Since returning from the Injured List on Aug. 21, RHP **Carlos Vargas** has posted a 1.35 ERA (1 ER, 6.2 IP) with 1 walk and 8 strikeouts while holding opponents to a .167 (4x24) average.
- **Mark Your Calendars** - On September 1, Major League rosters expand by 2 to a maximum of 28 players, 14 pitchers and 14 position players.

RALEIGH ON THE RISE...Cal Raleigh has reached base safely in 11 of his last 12 games (8/16-c), batting .303 (10x33) with 7 home runs, 10 RBI, 11 walks, a .477 on-base percentage and slugging .939 for an 1.416 OPS in 44 plate appearances...over his last 33 games (7/20-c), Raleigh has posted an .805 OPS with 10 homers, 24 RBI, a .333 OBP and a .472 slugging percentage...Raleigh is 1 home run away from his fifth consecutive 20+ home run season and would become the 18th catcher (min. 50% of games at catcher in a season) in MLB history to record five or more seasons with 20+ homers, and the ninth to do it before turning 30 years old.

CAL THE BIRD HUNTER...in 38 career games against Toronto, including the Postseason, **Cal Raleigh** is batting .276 (37x134) with 30 runs, 4 doubles, 17 homers, 32 RBI and 19 walks, reaching base at a .361 clip and slugging .687 for a 1.048 OPS...in 29 regular season games against the Blue Jays, Raleigh is batting .267 (27x101) with 20 runs, 2 doubles, 12 home runs, 25 RBI and 14 walks with a .350 on-base percentage, .644 slugging percentage and .994 OPS...Cal's .644 regular season slugging percentage ranks 3rd-highest all-time against the Jays (min. 100 PA), trailing only Russell Branyan (.783 SLG) and Shohei Ohtani (.699).

GOOOOD MORNING...today's starter, RHP **Logan Gilbert**, is 11-7 with a 3.36 ERA (58 ER, 155.1 IP), 162 strikeouts, 39 walks and a 1.024 WHIP in 26 starts this season...he is one of 10 pitchers in the American League to reach the 10+ win mark this season, ranking 6th in the AL overall...Logan has been especially sharp since May 22, posting a 2.74 ERA (30 ER, 98.2 IP), 27 walks and 105 strikeouts, ranking 6th in the AL in ERA during that span.

RED SKY AT NIGHT. NAYLOR'S DELIGHT...in 36 games since the All-Star Break (7/17-c), **Josh Naylor** is batting .319 (44x138) with 14 runs, 6 doubles, 2 home runs, 11 RBI, 10 walks, 7 stolen bases, a .367 OBP and slugging .406 for a .773 OPS, reaching base in 32 of those games...his .313 batting average in the 2nd half ranks 7th in the American League and T-11th in MLB among qualified hitters...he also ranks T-4th in the AL in stolen bases during that span along with José Ramírez-CLE.

RANDY RAKES...in 128 games this season, **Randy Arozarena** is batting .271 (128x473) with 85 runs, 26 doubles, 1 triple, 20 home runs, 58 RBI, 56 walks and 20 HBP, reaching base at a .370 clip and slugging .457 for an .827 OPS...Randy has 6th consecutive 20+ home runs and 20+ stolen bases for the 6th-consecutive season (2021-c), becoming the 11th player in MLB history with at least 6 such seasons and the 5th to do it in at least 6-consecutive seasons, joining Barry Bonds (9, 1990-98), Bobby Bonds (7, 1969-75), Bobby Abreu (7, 1999-2005) and Willie Mays (6, 1955-1960).

- **Lately** - Over his last 17 games since Aug. 11, Randy has an .919 OPS, getting on base at a .372 clip and slugging .547, recording 8 extra-base hits, including 6 home runs that have each been a game-tying or go-ahead home run.

HOLY CANNOLI, DOM!...Dominic Canzone has reached the 20+ homer mark in a season for the first time in his career...over his last 17 games since Aug. 9, Canzone is batting .294 (20x70) with 6 runs, 4 doubles, 2 home runs, 10 RBI, 6 walks, a .360 on-base percentage and slugging .441 for an .801 OPS in 75 plate appearances...he has reached base safely in 15 of those 17 games, hitting safely in 13... overall this season, 'Dom' is batting .256 (95x371) with 47 runs, 21 doubles, 1 triple, the 20 homers, 59 RBI, 37 walks and 2 stolen bases, reaching base at a .330 clip while slugging .480 (.810 OPS).

AS YOU MAY KNOW...Cal Raleigh has excelled in his career against the Blue Jays and at Rogers Centre in particular, batting .286 (20x70) with 19 runs, 2 doubles, 11 home runs, 20 RBI, 11 walks, a .383 OBP and slugging .786 for an 1.168 OPS, in 19 games at Rogers Centre, including the Postseason, but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...that Big Dumper's 11 home runs at Rogers Centre are the most he has hit in any ballpark outside of T-Mobile Park (including Postseason)?...Cal has hit 8 regular season home runs and 3 in the Postseason at the home of the Blue Jays, ranking ahead of his 10 HR at Angel Stadium, and...**DID YOU ALSO KNOW?**...he has homered in each series he has played in Toronto, including each Postseason series (2022 AL Wild Card and 2025 AL Championship Series)?

ON THIS DATE IN MARINERS HISTORY - AUGUST 30

- **1992** - The Mariners turn the eighth triple play in their history.
- **1993** - Alex Rodriguez signs with the Mariners following his selection as the first pick overall in the 1993 June Draft.
- **2013** - Taijuan Walker made his Major League debut at 21 years, 17 days, earning the win allowing 1 unearned run in 5.0 innings. Became the youngest Mariners starter to win his MLB debut, and the 3rd Mariners starter to not allow an earned run in MLB debut.

ABOUT LOGAN GILBERT...

- Gilbert, 29, is making his 27th start of the season and the 173rd start of his career...also marks his 2nd start against the Blue Jays this season and the 8th of his career.
- Selected by Seattle in the 1st round (14th overall) of the 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Rob Mummaw on June 16, 2018.
- Spent 3 seasons at Stetson (FL) University, 2016-18...in 2017, was ASUN Pitcher of the Year and ASUN 1st-Team All-Conference.
- Named the 2022 and the 2024 Mariners Most Valuable Pitcher by the Seattle Chapter of the BBWAA.
- Named to his 1st All-Star team in 2024.
- Was named AL Player of the Week for June 15-21, marking the 2nd time he has won the award (also: July 3-9, 2023).

LAST TIME OUT...

W#11 on Aug. 24 vs. PHI...threw 5.0 innings and allowed 2 runs (2 ER) on 5 hits (1 HR) with 2 walks and 5 strikeouts...threw 102 pitches (66 strikes), marking his 2nd consecutive start of 100+ pitches (also: 100 pitches on 8/19 at MIL)...the last time he threw 100+ pitches in back-to-back starts was on Aug. 2-8, 2023.

HEATING UP?

on 8/24 vs. PHI, threw 13 pitches over 98 mph in the 1st inning...it's the most pitches he's thrown over 98 mph in a game in his career (prev. 12 pitches on 8/19/26 at MIL)...he also threw 3 pitches of 99+ mph, most he's thrown in a game since 2024...he has increased the avg. velocity of his four-seamer throughout the season, starting at 95.4 mph in Mar/Apr to 97.3 mph in Aug. (+1.9 mph).

GIVE ME FIVE...

has thrown 5.0+ innings in each of his last 20-consecutive starts (4/28-c), tied for the 4th-longest such streak in MLB this season and T-2nd longest active streak...his 149 career starts of 5.0+ IP rank 6th-most in MLB since 2021 while his 96 career starts of 5.0+ IP with 2-or-fewer ER allowed rank 7th-most in MLB since 2021.

COMING UP...

with 10.0 more innings, he would become the 8th pitcher to throw 1000 innings since 2021, joining Dylan Cease, Zack Wheeler, Kevin Gausman, Aaron Nola, Logan Webb, Luis Castillo and Framber Valdez...would become the 1st pitcher that debuted in 2021 or later to reach 1,000 IP.

FOURTH OF JULY FIREWORKS...

in his last start against the Blue Jays earlier this season (7/4 at T-Mobile Park), he threw 7.1 scoreless innings while allowing just 1 hit with 7 strikeouts and no walks allowed...he retired 22 of 23 batters faced, including each of his first 14 batters...joined 9 other pitchers to throw 7.0+ IP with 1-or-fewer baserunners allowed in a start this season.

AGAINST THE BLUE JAYS...

owns a 4.32 ERA (20 ER, 41.2 IP) with 48 strikeouts to 6 walks allowed across 7 career starts against the Blue Jays, with the Mariners going 5-2 in those starts...has thrown 6.0+ IP in 4 of those 7 starts, including 3 quality starts...has also tossed 7.0+ IP in 3 starts and 7+ strikeouts in 5 of his 7 starts...owns a 2.79 ERA (6 ER, 19.1 IP) with 26 strikeouts to 5 walks allowed just 3 starts at Rogers Centre.

IN HIS SUNDAY BEST...

is 3-0 and owns a 2.32 ERA (8 ER, 31.0 IP), 0.74 WHIP and 38 strikeouts to 6 walks allowed across 5 Sunday starts this season...across 30 career starts on Sunday, he is 15-6 with a 3.07 ERA (60 ER, 175.2 IP), 0.92 WHIP and 200 strikeouts to 35 walks allowed.

ON THE ROAD, AGAIN...

his 2.25 ERA (18 ER, 65.0 IP) on the road this season ranks T-10th in MLB (min. 50 IP)...among AL pitchers on the road this year (min. 50 IP), he also ranks T-2nd in HR/9 (0.28), 5th in opp. SLG (.310), 7th in K/BB (3.94), T-9th in BB/9 (2.22), T-9th in BB% (6.1%), 11th in WHIP (1.05) and 11th in opp. average (.215)...through his first 6 road starts of the season (4/6-6/9), he owned a 1.36 ERA (5 ER, 33.0 IP).

WATCH HIM WHIP...

owns a 1.02 WHIP this season, which ranks 8th among qualified pitchers this season and 5th in the American League...his 0.97 WHIP since 2024 ranks T-2nd in MLB among qualified pitchers (also: Bryan Woo), trailing only Tarik Skubal-LAD/DET (0.92).

LOONEY PLATOONS...

is limiting left-handed hitters to just a .199 average (64x321) with a 10.88 SO/9 across 26 starts this season...among pitchers with min. 50 IP against LHH this season, he ranks 5th in strikeouts (106), 9th in WHIP (1.038), 9th in opp. average (.199), and 9th in SO/9 (10.88).

WINNING WITH WALTER...

the Mariners are 17-9 when he takes the mound this season, including 13-3 across his last 16 starts (5/22-c) with Logan holding a 2.74 ERA (30 ER, 98.2 IP) and 105 strikeouts in that stretch...across his career, the Mariners are 102-70 when Logan takes the mound, including 55-27 when he throws a quality start.

EXCLUSIVE COMPANY...

on Aug. 13 at NYY, he eclipsed 150 strikeouts this season becoming just the 2nd pitcher with 5-consecutive seasons of 150+ strikeouts since 2022 (also: Dylan Cease-3Tms)...his 5 such seasons rank 3rd-most in franchise history, trailing Félix Hernández (10 seasons) and Randy Johnson (8 seasons), while ranking ahead of Mark Langston (4 seasons).

HENRY'S DAD SHOVES...

was named AL Player of the Week for June 15-21 after tossing a combined 13.1 innings and allowing 2 runs (2 ER) on 5 hits (1 HR) with 3 walks and 18 strikeouts...across the 2 starts, he held opponents to a .116 average (5x43) with only 1 XBH allowed and a .401 OPS.

- Holding it Down** - Has allowed only 1 ER over his last 11 relief appearances since August 7...has tossed 11.1 innings during the span, including a perfect 2.0 innings of work on 8/14 at HOU for the 3rd such outing of his career and 1st of the season.
- On Call Often** - His 63 relief appearances this season lead the Mariners bullpen and ranks T-6th in MLB...his 25 holds also rank 5th in MLB.
- Reliable Arm** - Has only allowed an earned run in 15 of 63 appearances this season...has allowed 2+ ER only four times.
- Super Stretch** - Held a 0.77 ERA (1 ER, 11.2 IP) with 2 walks and 8 strikeouts over 12 appearances during April.
