RAY REPORT—The Rays continue their final road trip of the season against the Tigers (0-3) and Red Sox (1-0, 2 to play) with their penultimate game of 2024 today at Fenway Park...are 6-4 in their last 10 games and 8-6 in their last 14...are 25-29 since the July 30 trade deadline and 31-33 since the All-Star break...currently 1.0 GB the Red Sox, the Rays need to sweep this series to secure an eighth consecutive top-three finish in the AL East standings and seventh consecutive .500+ season...have been eliminated from playoff contention, ending a streak of five consecutive postseason appearances from 2019-23 matched only by the Astros, Braves and Dodgers...have spent the entire season no more than five games below or three games above .500.

- ★ **A Josh Lowe** RBI-double and **Christopher Morel** pinch-hit, bases-loaded walk marked the only offense the Rays needed in last night's 2-1 victory, their sixth one-run contest in the last seven games...they improved to 30-22 in one-run games, surpassing 2010 (29-27) for the most such wins in club history.
- ★ The Rays lead the majors in wins when scoring three runs or fewer (24) and two runs or fewer (15)...no team has collected more wins in the latter category since a trio of clubs in 2015 (ATL-17, CHC-17, LAD-15).
- ★ Tampa Bay has been held to three runs or fewer in 11 of its last 13 games, including six games with one or zero runs...a year after averaging a club-record 5.31 runs per game, the Rays 3.73 mark this season is the lowest in franchise history (prev. 3.78 in 2014) and second lowest in the majors, ahead of only the White Sox (3.09).
- ★ The Rays 3.17 ERA since the All-Star break ranks second in the majors behind the Tigers (3.04)...they last paced MLB in second-half ERA in 2012 (2.60).
- ★ Rays pitching has tallied 10+ SO in a season-high five straight games, their longest streak since Sept. 2-6, 2023 (5)...their last longer streak was a seven-game run from July 20-28, 2023...they have reached the mark in three straight and seven of 11 meetings with the Red Sox this season.
- ★ **RHP Shane Baz** has yielded two runs or fewer in six consecutive starts, going 3-1 with a 1.95 ERA (37.0IP, 8ER) and 0.76 WHIP, ranking among AL leaders in opp. average (2nd, .131), WHIP (2nd) and ERA (4th) in that span (since Aug. 20).
- ★ With a win today, the Rays would improve to 7-1-0 in series play vs. Boston since the start of 2023 and earn a fourth straight series win at Fenway Park, which would mark their longest streak since April 27, 2019-Aug. 13, 2020 (also 4).

CLOSE SHAVES—The Rays lead the majors with 13 one-run games in September (5-8), ahead of the Athletics (11)...six of seven and seven of their last nine games have been decided by one run...each of their last four wins have come by exactly one run, their longest streak since June 18-25, 2022 (4G)...the club record is five, accomplished six times, most recently from Aug. 20-30, 2015...on the season, Tampa Bay owns MLB's second-best record in games decided by two runs or fewer (54-34/614), trailing San Diego (40-25/615), and the fifth-best mark in one-run games (30-22/577) despite its 30 one-run victories ranking second behind Detroit (31).

★ The Rays 88 games decided by two runs or fewer pace MLB, ahead of the Brewers (84), and are third most in a season in club history (2015-94G; 2003-90G).

SERIES STUFF—Since a 10-1-2 run in series play from June 18-Aug. 4 the Rays are 5-8-3 over their last 16 sets...they are 1-5-2 in road series during that span, with the lone win coming from Sept. 6-8 at BAL...this marks the 10th time in their last 11 series the Rays have faced an opponent who entered with a winning record—the only exception in that span was a three-game sweep over Toronto (4/7) from Sept. 20-22...the Rays are 12-17-3 in series against clubs that entered with a .500+ record and 12-3-3 vs. below-.500 teams.

★ The Rays are 17-1-2 in series in which they won the opener, going undefeated (16-0-2) in their last 18.

RACE TO THE FINISH—The Rays need to sweep the Red Sox this weekend to finish with a .500+ record for a seventh consecutive season, which would surpass 2008-13 (6) for the longest streak in franchise history...they were last under the mark in 2017 (80-82)...the Rays are one of four teams to post a .500+ record each season from 2018-23, joining the Braves, Dodgers and Yankees...Tampa Bay also needs to sweep this series to avoid finishing fourth in the AL East, which would mark its lowest standing since a last-place finish in 2016 (68-94).

★ Since becoming the Rays in 2008, the club has finished with a winning record in 12 of 16 seasons, second most in MLB behind the Yankees (16) and Dodgers (15).

LET'S GET IT STARTED—Rays starters have allowed 3 ER or fewer in 20 consecutive games, their longest single-season streak since a 25-game run from May 2-31, 2019...they have posted a 1.91 ERA (99.0IP, 21ER) and .184/.246/.290 (66-for-359) opp. slash line since the current streak began on Sept. 6—all marks lead the majors...currently 11th in the majors with a 3.8315 ERA, decimal points behind the 10th-ranked Cubs (3.8284), the rotation is seeking a third consecutive season finishing with a top-10 ERA...they have accomplished the feat in six of the last seven seasons since 2017 (14th in 2021).

RUNNIN' RAYS—The Rays 178 SB lead the AL, ahead of the Guardians (148), and rank fourth in MLB behind the Nationals (220), Brewers (214) and Reds (205)...it marks the second-highest total in club history behind 2009 (194)...the Rays are looking to lead the AL in steals for the first time since 2011...however, they are just 1-for-5 on stolen base attempts over their last seven games and have gone a season-high five games without a steal, their longest streak since Sept. 23-30, 2023 (6G).

★ **José Caballero** leads the AL with 44 SB, three ahead of CLE **José Ramírez** (41SB) with two games remaining for both players...he looks to join **Carl Crawford** (2003-04, 2006-07) as the only players in franchise history to pace the AL in steals...Crawford last accomplished the feat outright in 2006 with 58 SB.

KELL YEAH—**Kevin Kelly** (23.1IP) holds the second-longest active scoreless streak in the majors behind AZ **A.J. Puk** (23.2IP)...it marks the fourth-longest single-season streak by a Ray, trailing runs by **J.P. Howell** (27.1, 2012), **Alex Cobb** (24.2, 2014) and **Taj Bradley** (24.0, 2024)...Kelly has not permitted an earned run in 25 straight outings, tied with Puk for the longest active streak in the majors and second longest in Rays history behind **Pete Fairbanks** (30, 2022-23)...Kelly's run is the longest single-season streak in club history, surpassing Howell (24) in 2012.

STUCK IN NEUTRAL—Tampa Bay is one of six teams all-time to have held a .500 record at least 33 times, joining the 2011 Blue Jays (33), 2010 Athletics (33), 1993 Cubs (33), 2009 Twins (34) and 1959 Cubs (35), per STATS LLC...the Rays would need to sweep this series in order to become the third team to reach .500 at least 34 times.

SHIPPING UP TO BOSTON—Leading the 13-game season series, 6-5, the Rays need to win one of the next two games to secure a sixth consecutive winning season against Boston dating back to 2019...their .648 (59-32) winning pct. vs. the Red Sox over that span is the highest in the AL, outpacing the Astros (20-12/.625)...Tampa Bay has an even (40-40) run differential against Boston through 11 matchups this year.

- ★ **Min. 200 PA**, **Brandon Lowe's** 629 SLG vs. Boston is fourth highest all-time behind **Babe Ruth** (.683), **Frank Robinson** (.652) and **Lou Gehrig** (.644).
- ★ **Yandy Diaz** is hitting .344 (22-for-64) in his last 15 games at Fenway Park.
- ★ **Josh Lowe** is 18-for-48 (.375) with 4 2B, 4 HR, 7 RBI and a 1.131 OPS in his last 13 games against Boston dating to Sept. 26, 2023.

- ★ Rays Third Base Coach **Brady Williams** was selected by the Red Sox in the 45th round of the 1999 First-Year Player Draft out of Pasco-Hernando Community College in New Port Richey, FL.
- ★ **Blake Butera**, Tampa Bay's Senior Director of Player Development, graduated from Boston College in 2015, playing in over 200 games for the Eagles.
- ★ Tampa Bay RHP **Zack Littell** was claimed off waivers from Boston on May 12, 2023.
- ★ Rays LHP **Jeffrey Springs** was acquired from the Red Sox on Feb. 17, 2021 along with RHP **Chris Mazza** in exchange for C **Ronald Hernández** and INF **Nick Sogard**.
- ★ Boston RHP **Kutter Crawford** was born in Okeechobee, FL, roughly 140 miles from St. Petersburg... after graduating from Okeechobee High School, he spent two seasons at Indian River State College (2015-16) before transferring to Florida Gulf Coast University in 2017.
- ★ Boston INF **Romy Gonzalez** was born in Miami, FL and attended American Senior High School in Hialeah, FL before playing collegiately at the University of Miami (2016-18).
- ★ Red Sox INF **Triston Casas** is a Miami, FL native who graduated from Plantation's American Heritage High School.
- ★ Boston INF **Vaughn Grissom** hails from Orlando, FL and attended Paul J. Hagerty High School in Oviedo, the same school as BAL **Zach Eflin**, DET **Riley Greene** and BAL **Ryan Mountcastle**.

TODAY'S START—The right-hander will take the ball for his 14th start of the campaign and eighth on the road...has recorded a 1.95 ERA (37.0IP, 8ER) in his last six starts...min. 50.0 IP, his 2.71 ERA (63.0IP, 19ER) since the All-Star break ranks seventh in the AL...missed the 2023 season after undergoing Tommy John surgery on Sept. 28, 2022...has a 3.40 ERA (113.2IP, 43ER) in 22 career MLB starts.

LAST TIME OUT—Did not factor into the decision on Sept. 22 vs. Toronto...threw 6.0 innings of one-run ball, scattering four hits and one walk while striking out six...was scoreless through 3.0 innings...allowed back-to-back singles to **Ernie Clement** and **Vladimir Guerrero Jr.** to open the 4th frame...following a **Spencer Horwitz** strikeout, Baz uncorked a wild pitch, advancing each runner up one base...followed the wild pitch with a walk to **Addison Barger**, then **Leo Jiménez** plated Clement with a sac-fly.

BOSTON STRONG—Baz made his first career start opposite Boston last week on Sept. 17 at Tropicana Field...earned the win after throwing 7.0 innings, allowing two runs on two hits and one walk with six strikeouts.

He is 3-1 with a 2.12 ERA (51.0IP, 12ER) in 10 career starts against AL East opponents, including a 1.13 ERA (24.0IP, 3ER) in five road starts.

OFF AND RUNNING—Since making his MLB debut on Sept. 20, 2021, Baz has posted a 3.40 ERA (113.2IP, 43ER) through 22 starts, nine of which have been quality starts...excluding openers, it marks the fifth-lowest ERA by a Tampa Bay hurler through 22 career starts behind **Drew Rasmussen** (2.79), **Jeremy Hellickson** (3.04), **Rolando Arrojo** (3.11) and **Chris Archer** (3.26).

THE WIZARD OF BAZ—In six starts since Aug. 20, he is 3-1 with a 1.95 ERA (37.0IP, 8ER), .131 opp. average (16-for-122) and 0.76 WHIP...min. 30.0 IP, it marks the fifth-lowest ERA in the AL during that period.

Baz completed 5.0+ IP while yielding three hits or fewer in a franchise-record five consecutive starts from Aug. 20-Sept. 17, surpassing four-start stretches from **Shane McClellan** (July 2 [G1]-26, 2022) and **Blake Snell** (Sept. 12-29, 2018)...he is one of four MLB pitchers to accomplish the feat this season, joining **TOR Bowden Francis** (Aug. 7-29), **CIN Hunter Greene** (July 6-Aug. 3) and **CWS Drew Thorpe** (June 22-July 21).

He has thrown 5.0+ IP while allowing four hits or fewer in six straight outings, tied for the second-longest run in club history behind **Shane McClellan** (8GS, June 9-July 26, 2022).

LEFT BEHIND—In his last seven starts since Aug. 13, Baz has limited left-handed hitters to a 6-for-75 (.080) clip, but three of the hits were homers...min. 60 AB, it marks the lowest opp. average vs. LHH in the majors over that span, ahead of **SD Joe Musgrove** (.137) and **NYG Gerrit Cole** (.159)...southpaws are 2-for-36 (.056) against his fastball, 0-for-12 off his changeup and 2-for-21 (.095) off his curveball during the seven-start run.

NO RISP, NO REWARD—Opponents are just 1-for-11 (.091) against Baz with runners in scoring position over his last seven starts, with the lone hit coming on Aug. 13 vs. HOU (**Yainer Diaz** RBI-single)...nine of the 12 runs against him in that span have come on home runs by **BOS Triston Casas** (2-run), **HOU Alex Bregman** (solo), **HOU Jeremy Peña** (solo), **SD Jake Cronenworth** (2-run), **BAL Gunnar Henderson** (solo) and **PHI Nick Castellanos** (2-run).

During the seven-start stretch (since Aug. 13), opposing hitters are 6-for-50 (.120) with runners on base and 17-for-99 (.172) with the bases empty...they have hit .261 (6-for-23) vs. his slider compared to a combined 17-for-126 (.135) in at-bats ending with his four-seamer (9-for-68/.132), curveball (7-for-43/.163) and changeup (1-for-15/.067).

KEEPING COUNT—Baz is holding opponents to a .147 (15-for-102) clip when ahead in the count compared to .333 (21-for-63) when behind...opponents are 16-for-138 (.117) against him in two-strike counts, fourth lowest among AL starters (min. 10GS) behind **TOR Bowden Francis** (.108), **DET Tarik Skubal** (.111) and **NYG Luis Gil** (.116).

He has limited opponents to a combined .082 (5-for-61) average against his curveball (4-for-48) and changeup (1-for-13) in two-strike counts.

LIKE FINE WINE—He has posted a .210 (22-for-105) opp. average the first time through the lineup and .218 (22-for-101) the second time...however, the third time through and beyond, opponents are 10-for-59 (.169) against him...of the 26 runs against him, 18 (69.2%) have come in the first three innings...he has a 4.15 ERA (39.0IP, 18ER) in innings 1-3 compared to a 1.83 ERA (34.1IP, 7ER) from the 4th frame on.

TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTER: RHP RYAN PEPIOT (8-7, 3.64)

LAST START—Suffered the loss on Sept. 24 at Detroit...fired 5.0 innings, allowing two runs on three hits and four walks while striking out six...has allowed three earned runs or fewer in 13 straight starts since June 21, posting a 2.71 ERA (63.0IP, 19ER) and .208 (49-for-236) opponent average during that stretch.
