TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros and Red Sox begin a 3-game weekend series here at Fenway Park tonight...RHP Mike Burrows (1-3) will start for the Astros vs. LHP Jake Bennett...tonight will be Burrows' 1st start and 2nd career app. at Fenway Park.

ROADIES: Tonight is the 4th game (1-2 thus far) of a 6-game road trip for the Astros...HOU was 1-2 in BAL on the first stop of the trip.

VS THE SAWX: The Astros swept the Red Sox in a 3-game series at Daikin Park, Mar. 30-April 1...over the past 10 seasons (since 2017), HOU is 33-22 (.600) vs. BOS overall.

FUN AT FENWAY: Despite being swept in a 3-game series in their last visit here (Aug. 1-3), the Astros have had recent success at Fenway Park...HOU has won 6 of their last 9 games at the Fens...prior to last year's series in Aug., HOU had swept the Red Sox in 2 consecutive visits to Fenway, Aug. 28-30 of 2023 and Aug. 9-11 of 2024 (both 3-game series)...additionally, the Astros are 16-9 (.640) in the regular season at Fenway Park since 2017, which is the best win pct. in the Majors at this venue in that span (min. 10 games)...Houston is also 4-3 at Fenway all-time in the postseason.

ABOUT BURROWS: RHP Mike Burrows, who is from Waterford, CT, will make his 7th start of the season tonight and his 2nd vs. BOS...one month ago today, he earned his first win in an Astros uniform in a 6-4 victory over the Red Sox on April 1 in Houston (5 IP, 2 ER, 6 SO)...Punchouts: In his last 2 starts, Burrows has seen an uptick in his strikeout totals with 8 K's in 5.0 IP in his last start on Saturday vs. NYY and 7 K's in 4.2 IP in his April 19 start vs. STL...Connecticut Connection: Burrows posted eye-opening numbers as a pitcher at Waterford High School, posting a 6-0 record in his senior year (2018) with an 0.38 ERA with 98 strikeouts in just 44.0 IP...was a Red Sox fan while growing up.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP: The Astros split a doubleheader at Camden Yards vs. the Orioles yesterday afternoon, dropping the first game, 10-3 and then rebounding to take the 2nd game, 11-5...RHP Peter Lambert (1-2) took the loss in the 1st game (4.2 IP, 2 ER)...in the second game, the Astros erupted for 5 runs in the 1st inning and never looked back...Cam Smith's 3-run HR in that 1st was the big blow...Jordan Alvarez had another strong game, going 3x4 with a HR...RHP Lance McCullers (2-2) hurled 6.0 strong innings to pick up the win, allowing just 2 hits with 9 K's...prior to yesterday, the Astros last doubleheader was July 21, 2022 vs. NYY (HOU sweep), which was the longest stretch without a DH in the Majors.

SPECIAL MOMENT: The first 2 members of the Astros Youth Academy to make it to the Major Leagues faced each other yesterday in BAL when Brice Matthews singled off O's RHP Cameron Foster in the 5th inning of Game 2 of the DH...Matthews was called up to the Majors in 2025 while Foster made his debut in April of 2026.

ROSTER MOVE: Following yesterday's doubleheader, RHP Jason Alexander was returned to Triple A Sugar Land...Alexander served as the Astros 27th man for the doubleheader.

PLAYER OF THE MONTH?: Yordan Alvarez is a strong candidate for the AL Player of the Month Award for March/April as he has had a torrid start to his season, currently leading, or tied for the lead, in the AL in all three Triple Crown categories - .356 BA, 12 HR, 27 RBI...additionally, Alvarez also leads the AL in OPS (1.199), SLG (.737), OBP (.462) and Total Bases (87) and is T-1st in WAR (2.0).

HISTORIC HOMERS: Yordan Alvarez is off to one of the most prolific starts in franchise history...his 12 HR through the club's first 32 games of the season are the tied for 2nd-most in franchise history...below is a breakdown:

ROAD WARRIOR: In 11 road games (8 starts) this season, Brice Matthews is 10x31 (.323) with a HR, 7 RBI and 5 BB, slashing (.323/.417/.516) for a .933 OPS...in his young career, Matthews is hitting .291 in 18 road games (14 starts) with 5 HR and 16 RBI with a .381 OBP and a .618 SLG (.999 OPS).

ON THE OFFENSIVE: The Astros lead the AL in most key offensive categories:

CLIMBING THE CHARTS: With 238 career HR, Jose Altuve needs one more to tie Lou Whitaker for 7th place all-time among 2nd basemen...Altuve also needs 3 RBI to become the 5th player in franchise history to reach 900.

WALKER, TEXAS HAMMER: Christian Walker is hitting .378 (14x37) in his last 9 games (since 4/20) with 3 HR and 8 RBI...Among The Leaders: For the season, Walker enters today ranked T-3rd in the AL in RBI (24), 7th in SLG (.552), 5th in TB (64), 9th in OPS (.918) and T-6th in doubles (9).

UP NEXT: Following this 3-game series in Beantown, the Astros will return home for a brief, 3-game homestand vs. the LA Dodgers, Monday-Wednesday...HOU is 8-8 at home this season.

LAST START, APRIL 25 vs. NYY: had a strong start last Saturday vs. the Yankees, tossing 5.0 innings of 2-run ball...posted a season high and tied his career high with 8 strikeouts (also reached on June 14, 2025 at CHC)...worked around 5 hits and 3 walks in the outing on Saturday, allowing his runs to come home on a pair of solo homers.

ABOUT BURROWS: the 2nd-year starter is making his 7th start of the season after opening the year as the Astros No. 2 starter...leads the Astros in innings pitched (31.2), while matching **RHP Lance McCullers** in starts (6) and in strikeouts (33).

SAVANT SAYS: has recorded a 33% chase rate this season, ranking in the 74th percentile among MLB pitchers...that percentile is tops on the Astros.

HIS REPERTOIRE: has thrown his changeup at a 25.8% rate this year, throwing the pitch 140 times this season, compared to 141 four-seam fastballs (26%)...is holding opponents to a .200 (7x35) opponent average on the changeup this season...opponents are also hitting just .143 (2x14) vs. his curveball, which he's thrown at a 14% rate.

STARTING PERFECT: retired the first 14 batters he faced to open the game on April 19 vs. STL before allowing a 2-out single to **IF Masyn Winn** in the 5th inning...had 7 strikeouts in those first 14 batters faced.

VS. BOS: is already facing the Red Sox the second time this season, having started against the Sox on April 1 in Houston (2ER/5IP)...worked around traffic in the outing, allowing 5 hits, 3 walks and a HBP...picked up the win in the Astros 6-4 victory for his first win as an Astro...has one other career appearance vs. Boston, which came in relief at Fenway Park on Aug. 30, 2025 (1ER/2IP).

SHIPPING UP TO BOSTON: as a native of Connecticut, Mike's father, Tom, routinely took him to Red Sox games at Fenway Park while growing up...some of Mike's fondest memories involve singing along to closer **Jonathan Papelbon's** entrance music, "I'm Shipping up to Boston" by the Dropkick Murphys...Mike credits finding his love for baseball by going to Red Sox games in his youth and he would go on to emulate **Josh Beckett's** pitching delivery.

CONNECTICUT CONNECTION: Burrows is in a small fraternity of Major Leaguers from Connecticut...only four other Connecticuter's have played for the Astros in their franchise history: **C Brad Ausmus** (1259g), **OF George Springer** (795g), **RHP Bill Dawley** (157g) and **RHP Josh Zeid** (48g).

THE JOURNEY: a native of Waterford, CT, Burrows was committed to the University of Connecticut out of high school...the Pirates selected him in the 11th round of the June 2018 draft and signed him to an over-slot bonus to sign and forego his commitment to UConn...spent 6 seasons (2018-23) in the Pirates minor league system before finally debuting in 2024 with a single appearance...pitched the majority of the 2025 season at the Major League level and flashed potential before the Pirates flipped him to Houston this offseason.

THE TRADE: after spending eight seasons (2018-25) in the Pirates organization, the Astros acquired Burrows this offseason in a 3-team, 6-player trade...as part of the deal, the Astros traded **OF Jacob Melton** and minor leaguer **RHP Anderson Brito** to the Rays...meanwhile, the Rays traded **IF Brandon Lowe**, **OF Jake Mangum** and **LHP Mason Montgomery** to the Pirates, and Burrows got dealt to the Astros.

2025 RECAP: pitched most of the season with the Pirates, making 23 appearances (19 starts) and going 2-4 with a 3.94 ERA (42ER/96IP)...struck out 97 hitters in 96.0 IP...had two Major League stints on the year, from April 24-25 and from May 21 thru the end of the year...recorded a strong second half with the Pirates, posting a 3.27 ERA (20ER/55IP) in 13 games (10 starts)...in that span, allowed 1-or-fewer runs in 7 of his last 8 appearances, posting a 2.22 ERA (7ER/28.1IP) in those games, which spanned from Aug. 16 thru the end of the year...did not allow a homer over a 26.1-inning span from Aug. 16-Sept. 21...finished tied for third in the NL in strikeouts by a rookie (97).

VS. BOS: In 10 career appearances against the Red Sox, he's recorded a 2.45 ERA (3ER/11IP) with 14 strikeouts, 3 walks, a 1.09 WHIP and a .220 opponent batting average.

ALL-TIME RANKINGS: With his outing on April 24 vs. NYY, he reached 338.0 career innings, passing RHP Octavio Dotel for the 10th-most innings by a reliever in Astros history...next on the all-time list is RHP Xavier Hernandez at 371.2 innings...also among Astros relievers all time, he ranks 4th in strikeouts (464) and 7th in apps. (328).

CAREER: In 328 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.92 ERA (110ER/339IP) with 464 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP, 12.32 K/9 and a 0.77 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among active AL relievers.
