D-BACKS GIVE BACK ALL-TIME 50/50 RAFFLES: The D-backs have set 2 of their top 3 all-time 50/50 raffles this season:

TOMORROW’S CHILDHOOD CANCER AWARENESS DAY TO FEATURE CUSTOM CLEATS: Tomorrow, the D-backs and Phoenix Children’s will celebrate young patients, survivors and their families during the 13th annual Childhood Cancer Awareness Day...for the first time, custom cleats designed by child patients at Phoenix Children’s will be worn by D-backs’ players and staff...these cleats are currently up for auction through September 7 at dbacks.com/auction, with proceeds benefiting childhood cancer research programs.

SNAKE BITES: Since August 1, the D-backs are 20-13 (.606), the third-best record in the Majors, behind the Brewers (23-11, .676) and Phillies (21-12, .636), ahead of the Red Sox (19-13, .594).

- The D-backs have won 7 of their last 9 games, since Aug. 27, and 11 of their last 16 games, since Aug. 19, all against teams in a postseason position (Brewers, Dodgers and Red Sox) or within 5.0 games of a Wild Card berth (Guardians, Reds and Rangers).
- Since August 20, D-backs’ starting pitchers have a MLB-best 10 quality starts and have allowed a MLB-low 4 homers (15 G - 77.1 IP).
- Another victory gives the D-backs 5 straight home series wins (previous 4: vs. Rangers, Reds, Guardians, Rockies), 6 straight series wins or splits, and 8 series wins in their last 11.
- 8 of the D-backs’ last 11 games and 19 of their last 28 have been decided by 2 or fewer runs (17-11 record / 10-4 home / 7-7 road / +34 run differential).

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 10-5 vs. Red Sox for their third straight win.

- **Eduardo Rodriguez** tossed his second straight quality start of 6.0+ innings with 1 or fewer runs for his first career win vs. Red Sox.
- **Corbin Carroll**, with his 3-run homer in the eighth inning, reached 30 home runs in a season for the first time in his career...became the third D-back all-time to record a 30+-homer season in his age 24 season or younger, joining Chris Young in 2007 (32) and Justin Upton in 2011 (31).
- **Blaze Alexander** collected his first outfield assist with his run-saving throw to the plate in the third inning...his 95.4 MPH outfield-assist throw tied for the fourth hardest by a D-back all-time in the Statcast Era [since 2015], behind Mitch Haniger (95.7 MPH on Aug. 22, 2016 vs. ATL), Corbin Carroll (95.6 MPH on May 5, 2025 vs. NYM), Socrates Brito (95.6 MPH on Sept. 23, 2016 @ BAL) and A.J. Pollock (95.4 MPH on April 27, 2015 vs. COL).
- **Geraldo Perdomo** homered in his second straight game vs. Red Sox...had his third game of 3+ hits with 1+ homers this season, his first season doing so multiple times...his 34 RBI in the seventh inning or later are tied for fifth in the Majors with Junior Caminero/TB.
- **Ketel Marte’s** 13-pitch at-bat in the second inning vs. Red Sox was the second time he has reached base on 13+ pitches (also: Aug. 22 vs. Reds, 13 pitches in 10th inning off Graham Ashcraft), tied for the most in MLB with Bo Bichette/TOR...**Geraldo Perdomo’s** 10+-pitch at-bat in the fourth inning was the fourth time he has reached base on 10+ pitches (last: Aug. 14 @ Rockies, 10 pitches in first inning off Bradley Blalock), tied for second most (also: 7 others), behind Nolan Arenado/STL (5).
- **Jordan Lawlar** collected his first career RBI in the fifth inning (sac fly) and hit safely in his second straight game...has produced a hit and/or a run in 4 of his last 6 plate appearances - 3 hits, including his first 2 career extra-base hits (2 doubles), and a RBI sac fly.

VS. RED SOX: The D-backs have won 5 consecutive games vs. Red Sox and 7 of their last 10 since 2019...are facing off with the Red Sox @ Chase Field for only the fourth time in team history (5-5 record; 1-0 in 2025, 1-2 in 2023, 2-1 in 2019 and 1-2 in 2007).

‘SOX STORIES: Last season, the D-backs earned their second-ever sweep @ Fenway Park (3-0)...it was their first sweep since their inaugural matchup with the Red Sox from June 7-9, 2002 (3-0).

- **Torey Lovullo** served as Boston’s bench coach from their 2013 World Series Championship season thru 2016.
- **Tim Bogar** was Boston’s first base coach (2009), third base coach (2010-11) and bench coach (2012).

CARROLL’S ON-BASE STREAK: **Corbin Carroll’s** 22-game on-base streak (since Aug. 13)is the longest active streak in the Majors and second longest of his career, behind a 27-gamer from Sept. 23, 2024-April 19, 2025.

CARROLL NEARING A 30-30 SEASON: **Corbin Carroll**, at 30 homers and 24 stolen bases, is looking to become the first-ever D-back to have a 30+-homer/30+-stolen base season...since his debut year in 2022, only 6 players have accomplished the feat: Bobby Witt Jr./KC (2x - 2023-24), José Ramírez/CLE (2024), Shohei Ohtani/LAD (2024), Ronald Acuña Jr./ATL (2023), Francisco Lindor/NYM (2023) and Julio Rodríguez/SEA (2023).

- In 2023, Carroll became the first D-back in franchise history to have a 25+-homer/30+-stolen base season (25 HR, 54 SB).
- In 2023, Carroll also became the fifth D-back all-time (first since 2016) to record a 20+-homer/30+-stolen base campaign.
- Is the only D-back to have multiple 20+-homer/30+-stolen base campaigns (2023-24).
- Since 2022, he is 1 of 3 players with 2+ consecutive 20+-HR/30+-SB seasons: **Corbin Carroll** (2 - 2023-24), Bobby Witt Jr./KC (4 - 2022-25) and José Ramírez/CLE (2 - 2024-25).

OPPOSING STARTERS VS. D-BACKS OFFENSE: Since August 1, opposing starters vs. D-backs’ offense have combined for a 6.17 ERA (111 ER in 162.0 IP), .267 AVG/.809 OPS with 31 doubles, 6 triples, 28 homers, 62 walks (3.44 BB/9.0 IP) and 154 strikeouts.

TRENDING OFFENSE: Since August 8, the D-backs’ 5.44 runs per game rank third in MLB, behind the Mets (6.85) and Yankees (5.96).

- The D-backs lead the Majors with 44 home runs this season in the 8th inning or later while their 163 runs are tied for the most in the same category with the Blue Jays.
- Since the All-Star break, the D-backs’ 36 first-inning runs are second in the Majors, behind the Pirates (37).
- Since August 1, the D-backs’ 76 RBI with 2 outs rank third in MLB, behind the Mets (82) and Phillies (79).

SPREADING THE SAVES: The D-backs’ **8 pitchers with 2+ saves** are tied for the most all-time/since 1969 (*when saves became an official stat*) with the 2024 Rays, 2022 Rays, 2003 Tigers, 1979 Dodgers, 1973 Braves and 1970 Indians...the D-backs’ **6 pitchers with 3+ saves** are tied for second most all-time/since 1969 with the 2022 Rays, 2021 Reds, 1992 Braves, 1991 Brewers, 1991 Pirates, 1990 Pirates, 1984 Mariners, 1983 Athletics, 1973 Braves, 1980 Angels and 1970 Indians...the record is 7 pitchers set by the 2003 Tigers [source: Elias Sports Bureau]:

- **2+ SAVES:** Shelby Miller (10), Justin Martinez (5), A.J. Puk (4), Kevin Ginkel (3), Andrew Saalfrank (3), Jake Woodford (3), Anthony DeSclafani (2), Taylor Rashi (2).
- **3+SAVES:** Shelby Miller (10), Justin Martinez (5), A.J. Puk (4), Kevin Ginkel (3), Andrew Saalfrank (3), Jake Woodford (3).

NEXT STARTER: RHP RYNE NELSON (7-3, 3.57)

- In his last 3 starts, has gone 1-0 with a 3.50 ERA (7 ER in 18.0 IP), an opponent .209 AVG (14-for-67), 3 walks and 16 strikeouts.
- Earned the win in his lone start on Aug. 23, 2024 @ Red Sox (W; 2 ER in 6.0 IP, 5 H, BB, 7 K).

SNAKEBITES

AT A GLANCE: Third season with the D-backs...debuted in 2023 and made 5 starts in the Postseason (1 Wild Card, 1 NLDS, 2 NLCS, 1 World Series).

- Named the D-backs' 2022 Minor League Pitcher of the Year after leading the organization's farmhands in wins (11), ERA (3.83) and strikeouts (218).
- D-backs' fifth-round pick in the 2020 draft (Bellarmine University).

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW: Is 3 strikeouts shy of becoming the third home-grown D-back starting pitcher to collect 400+ strikeouts within their first 80 career starts...would join Zack Godley (reached in 71st start in 2018) and Brandon Webb (reached in 75th start in 2005).

- In 2 home starts this season vs. AL East opponents, is 2-0 with a 0.75 ERA (1 ER in 12.0 IP), opponent .200 AVG (8-for-40), 0.83 WHIP, 2 walks and 8 strikeouts.
- His career-high 12 wins are tied with Matthew Boyd/CHC, Sonny Gray/STL, Jesús Luzardo/PHI, Quinn Priester/MIL, Brady Singer/CIN and Cristopher Sánchez/PHI for third in in the NL, behind Freddy Peralta/MIL (16) and Nick Pivetta/SD (13) and Logan Webb/SF (13).
- Making his 15th home start...in his last 5 home starts, is 3-0 (team is 4-1) with a 2.70 ERA (9 ER in 30.0 IP), opponent .254 AVG (30-for-118), 6 walks and 22 strikeouts.
- 10 of his 12 wins have come when the D-backs scored 6+ runs.
- In his last 6 starts, since August 4, has only allowed 2 solo homers (0.59 HR/9.0 IP)...starts were against Padres, Rockies (2x), Guardians, Brewers and Dodgers.

LAST START: Had his third straight no decision on Aug. 31 in a 5-4 loss @ Dodgers (4 ER in 4.1 IP).

- Struck out Mookie Betts for in the third inning for his 400th career strikeout.

VS. RED SOX: Making his second career start, second @ Chase Field.

- Made his last start on May 26, 2023 (L; 5 ER in 3.2 IP, 8 H, 0 BB, 4 K).

HOME COOKIN: In his last 14 home starts (7 quality), is 8-3 with a 3.66 ERA (33 R-31 ER in 76.1 IP), 17 walks and 66 strikeouts.

- Has allowed 2 earned runs or fewer in 10 of 14 starts.
- In his 14 home starts, has only allowed 3 home runs (0.35 HR/9.0 IP)...last allowed 2 home runs on June 10 vs. Seattle.
- Over 4 home starts from April 9-May 8, went 4-0 with a 1.11 ERA (3 ER in 24.1 IP), opponent .236 AVG (21-for-89) /.584 OPS, 6 walks and 20 strikeouts.
 - Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings on April 19 vs. Baltimore and 6.1 scoreless innings on May 8 vs. Dodgers.
- Posted 5 straight quality starts in his first 5 home starts from March 29-May 8, going 4-1 with a 1.78 ERA (7 R-6 ER in 30.1 IP), opponent .239 AVG, 7 walks and 25 strikeouts.

NO WALK PFAADT: Among NL starting pitchers, his 33 walks are tied with Zack Wheeler/PHI for third fewest, behind Zack Littell/CIN (7) and Sonny Gray/STL (31).

- Since the start of the 2024 season, his 16 starts with no walks are tied with Shota Imanaga/CHC and Ryne Nelson/AZ for second in the NL, behind Miles Mikolas/STL (21).
- Has walked 1 batter or fewer in 19 of his 28 starts (1.09 BB/9.0 IP).

GIVE 'EM THE HEATER: In his last 14 starts off his 4-seam fastball (44 BF, 215 P), is holding opponents to a .216 AVG (8-for-37)/.432 SLG with 13 strikeouts.

WINNING WAYS: Became the second-youngest D-back starter (26-165) and sixth overall to collect 7+ wins in their first 10 starts of a season, behind Patrick Corbin (23-261, 8 wins in 2013).
