NATIONALS NEWS

HOME, SWEET HOME

The Washington Nationals square off against the Los Angeles Angels on Sunday afternoon...With a win, Washington would secure its first sweep over Los Angeles (AL) in team history (2005-pres.).

- The Nationals walked off the Angels in the 10th inning on Saturday thanks to a fielder's choice ground ball by **Harry Ford**, plating **CJ Abrams**..**Andrew Alvarez** tossed 7.0 innings of one-hit, shutout ball with eight strikeouts and **Jack Sinclair** (1.1 IP, BB, SO) earned his first career win.
- The Nationals have won seven of their last nine home games and are 15-8 (.652) at home since July 25.

ROSTER MOVE

The Nationals reinstated infielder **Nasim Nuñez** from the Bereavement List on Sunday and optioned right-handed pitcher **Eddy Yean** to Triple-A Rochester on Saturday.

START ME UP

In 23 games since Aug. 19, **Simon Mathews'** starting pitchers/openers rank in Major League Baseball in opponents' slugging percentage (1st, .306), opponents' average (1st, .197), home runs allowed (1st, 8), opponents' OPS (2nd, .602) and ERA (3rd, 2.90).

- Starters/openers have allowed just two home runs in 73.2 innings across the last 16 games.

RUIZ IS ROLLIN'

Keibert Ruiz leads Major League catchers and ranks in Major League Baseball in batting average (2nd, .382) and on-base percentage (4th, .434), OPS (9th, .986) leads MLB catchers in slugging (.553) since Aug. 2 (min. 80 PA).

- He's 29-for-76 (.382) with four doubles, three homers, 11 RBI, seven walks, seven strikeouts and 11 runs scored during this 23-game stretch.

ALIEN ENCOUNTERS

With four more RBI, **CJ Abrams** will become the 12th player in Nationals history to record 100 RBI in a season and first since **Anthony Rendon** (126) and **Juan Soto** (110) in 2019.

- He joins **Alfonso Soriano** (40 HR/41 SB in 2006) as the only two players in Nationals history with at least 30 home runs and 25 stolen bases in a season...Only Abrams and **Pete Crow-Armstrong** have reached the 30/25 mark in MLB this season.
- Also of note, Abrams leads Major League Baseball with an 86% ABS Challenge success rate (min. 10 challenges)...He is 12-for-14 in ABS Challenges this season.

CJ, DAYLEN AND JAMES...THE 25 AND UNDER CLUB

CJ Abrams (30 HR, 96 RBI) and **Daylen Life** (20 HR, 81 RBI) have both eclipsed the 20 HR/80 RBI mark this year, while **James Wood** (30 HR, 75 RBI) is close to joining them.

- There are only nine players in MLB age 25 and younger to hit the 20/80 mark this season and Washington is the only team with more than one player in that group...With five more RBI, **James Wood** joins the club.
- If Wood reaches the 80 RBI mark, the 2026 Nationals would become the eighth team in Major League history with at least three players age 25 and younger to record a 20/80 season...The last team to do so was the 2007 Milwaukee Brewers, who hold the record with four (**Ryan Braun**, **Prince Fielder**, **J.J. Hardy**, **Corey Hart**)...The last team to have three was the 1999 Kansas City Royals (**Carlos Beltran**, **Jermaine Dye**, **Mike Sweeney**).

10 FOR 10

The Nationals boast 10 players with at least 10 home runs this season: **CJ Abrams**, **James Wood**, **Luis García Jr.**, **Daylen Life**, **Curtis Mead**, **Dylan Crews**, **Andres Chaparro**, **Brady House**, **Keibert Ruiz** and **Jacob Young**.

- Washington is tied with the New York Mets (10) and New York Yankees (10) as the teams with the most players to hit at least 10 home runs this season.
- The 2026 Nationals join the 2019 and 2017 clubs as the only teams in Nationals history (2005-pres.) with at least 10 players to hit at least 10 home runs in a season.

HOMEGROWN HEROES

When rosters expanded to 28 players on Sept. 1, Washington selected the contracts of infielder **Yohandy Morales** (2nd rd., 2023) and left-handed pitcher **Jared Simpson** (8th rd., 2023)...Including **Jack Sinclair's** selection on Friday, (16th rd., 2021), 14 of Washington's 28 players on the active roster are homegrown.

FARM REPORT

WILLITS...WOW

Harrisburg shortstop **Eli Willits** made history on Saturday night, becoming the fourth 18-year old since 2005 to record a four-hit game at the Double-A level, joining **Fernando Tatis Jr.**, **Leo DeVries** and **Jesus Made**...Willits went 4-for-6 with a double, homer, three RBI and two runs scored.

NOT YOUR AVERAGE JOE

Rochester right-handed pitcher **Joe Glassey** has not allowed an earned run in 29.0 consecutive innings, the longest active streak in Minor League Baseball and the third-longest streak the Minors this season...He's recorded 41 strikeouts against just two walks and a .122 opponents average during this streak...Glassey was acquired by the Nationals at the Trade Deadline and in 13 games in Washington's system, has 14 strikeouts and one walk in 15.1 scoreless innings between Double-A Harrisburg and Triple-A Rochester.
