I-70 STRIP SERIES: The I-70 Interleague series concludes today as the St. Louis Cardinals and cross-state rival Kansas City Royals play the finale of a three-game weekend series at Busch Stadium as part of Major League Baseball's "Rivalry Weekend" ... After tomorrow's scheduled off day, the Redbirds welcome the division rival Pittsburgh Pirates to St. Louis for a three-game series.

TARPS OFF: Winners of 13 of their last 18 since April 27, the Cardinals enter play today in 3rd place in the NL Central, 1.5 games behind first place Chicago and pct. points behind 2nd place Milwaukee (26-17).

- St. Louis has won 27 or more of its first 45 games of a season for the first time since the 2015 Redbirds started 29-16 and ended with 100 wins en route to the NL Central Division Championship.

- For only the second time since the end of the 2022 season, St. Louis is a season-best nine games above .500, matching June 29, 2025 (47-38 record).

WE'RE GOING STREAKING: With a win today, the Cardinals would secure their first series sweep of Kansas City since August 13-15, 2021 at Kauffman Stadium and their first three-game series sweep of the Royals in St. Louis since June 14-16, 2002 at Busch Stadium II.

- The last time St. Louis swept its cross-state rivals in any series at Busch Stadium III was a two-game set from Aug. 9-10, 2017, highlighted by a stray #RallyCat and **Yadier Molina's** game-winning grand slam.

- Both Cards series sweeps in 2026 have been on the road: April 17-19 at Houston (3g) and April 27-30 at Pittsburgh (4g).

SKINNED: Since Interleague play began in 1997, the Cardinals .593 regular season win pct. (81-55) against the Royals is the best of any of today's 15 MLB Rivalry Weekend Matchups.

TAKE YOUR SHIRT OFF, TWIST IT 'ROUND YO' HAND, SPIN IT LIKE A HELICOPTER: The Cardinals are tied for 3rd in MLB in comeback wins (13) behind the Diamondbacks (14) and Dodgers (14) ... St. Louis paces Major League Baseball in extra inning wins (6-1), one-run victories (10-3), and wins in games decided by two runs or fewer (19-7) ... The Redbirds also share the MLB lead in last at-bat wins (8) ... In "high leverage" situations per *FanGraphs*, the Cardinals pace MLB lead in both runs scored (68) and RBI (65).

IT'S GETTING HOT IN HERE: Since May 1, the Cardinals rotation ranks among MLB leaders in wins (7, T-1st), innings pitched (80.0, 9th), ERA (2.93, 5th), opponent OPS (.624, 6th), and quality starts (8, T-2nd).

THE NAKED TRUTH: The Cardinals and Reds are the only two MLB teams with six pitchers all making 20 or more appearances this season (**Justin Bruihl-21, Riley O'Brien-22, JoJo Romero-22, George Soriano-21, Ryne Stanek-22, Matt Svanson-20**).

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (May 17, 2025): **Miles Mikolas** (6.0), **Kyle Leahy** (2.0), and **Ryan Helsley** (1.0) combined for a four-hit 1-0 shutout win over the Royals at Kauffman Stadium ... **Jordan Walker** provides the only run in the game on a solo homer off Noah Cameron in the 6th inning.

KANSAS CITY CONNECTIONS

The Cardinals and Royals faced off in the 1985 World Series, also known as the "Show-Me Series" or "I-70 Showdown Series."

Ryne Stanek graduated from Blue Valley High School in nearby Stilwell, KS, winning the 2010 Kansas High School 6A State Championship... named the 2010 *Kansas City Star* All-Metro Baseball Player of the Year.

Jon Jay played 59 games for the Royals in 2018 before being traded to Arizona for RHP **Elvis Luciano** and LHP **Gabe Speier** (June 6, 2018).

Gordon Graceffo and **Thomas Saggese** were teammates with **Jac Caglianone** and **Vinnie Pasquantino** on Team Italy during the 2026 WBC.

Jac Caglianone made his MLB debut on June 3, 2025 against the Cardinals at Busch Stadium.

Michael Wacha, the Cardinals 1st round draft selection in 2012, pitched seven seasons (2013-19) in St. Louis and was voted MVP of the 2013 NLCS against the LA Dodgers...became the 105th player to appear in at least one game for both the Royals and Cardinals...made his MLB debut on May 30, 2013 vs. the Royals while pitching for St. Louis.

Lane Thomas played in 84 games for the Cardinals from 2019-21 after St. Louis acquired him from Toronto on July 2, 2017 in exchange for international bonus slot money.

Royals Radio Producer/Engineer **Eric Guthrie** is a St. Louis native.

Bobby Witt Jr.'s father, **Bobby Witt**, pitched in 17 games (5 starts) for the Cardinals in the second half of the 1998 season.

Nick Mears's great-grandfather **Alyn Butler** was a catcher in the Cardinals farm system.

Cardinals 2026 Hall of Fame inductee **Albert Pujols** moved to Independence, Mo., in 1996 when he was 16 years old...graduated from Fort Osage High School in Independence...played college baseball at Maple Woods Community College in Kansas City (now named Metropolitan Community College).

Michael Massey played college baseball at the University of Illinois (2017-19).

Cardinals broadcaster **Brad Thompson** (16 games) appeared on the 2010 Royals squad.

Royals VP of Scouting **Danny Ontiveros** was a Cardinals scout from 1998-2004.

Royals broadcaster **Rex Hudler** played in 251 games over three seasons in St. Louis (1990-92).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Vince Coleman** played in 179 games across parts of two seasons with Kansas City (1994-95).

Royals Major League Scout **Willie Fraser** pitched in 35 games for the Cardinals in 1991.

Royals Sr. Advisor to the GM **Mike Arbuckle** was selected by the Cardinals in the 1969 MLB Draft.

Royals MLB.com reporter **Anne Rogers** covered the Cardinals for two seasons (2019-20).

Royals Special Assistant, International Scouting **Johnny DiPuglia** worked in scouting for the Cardinals from 1990-98.

Royals Special Assistant to Baseball Operations/Player & Staff Engagement **Blaine Boyer** pitched in 15 games for the Cardinals in 2009.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Al Hrabosky** pitched in 116 games over two seasons (1978-79) with Kansas City...traded to Kansas City for **Mark Littell** and **Buck Martinez** (Dec. 8, 1977).

Royals Assistant Director of Player Development **Kevin Howard** played in 97 games for St. Louis Triple-A affiliate Memphis in 2010.

Royals Major League Scout **Tim Conroy** worked as an Area Scout and East Coast Regional Supervisor with St. Louis (1994-2000)...pitched for St. Louis for two seasons (1986-87).

St. Louis Post-Dispatch reporter **Lynn Worthy** covered the Royals for four seasons for the *Kansas City Star* (2019-22).

Royals.TV reporter **Joel Goldberg** covered the Cardinals for FOX Sports Midwest for three seasons (2005-07)...worked parts of six years for KTVI FOX 2 in St. Louis.

Royals.TV reporter **Bridget Howard's** father, **David Howard**, played in 98 games for St. Louis (1998-99).

Royals broadcaster **Steve Stewart** is a St. Louis native...called Cardinals games on KMOX in 2002.

TODAY'S GAME:

- Making his 9th start of the 2026 season as he completes the starting rotation's 9th time thru; it's his 70th career start (178th career appearance).
- Today's game continues a pattern of having alternated Home & Road starts to begin the season; won his last three road starts and dropped his last three home starts.
- His 178th career appearance ranks 70th all-time among Cardinals pitchers; He joins **Adam Wainwright** (478), **Carlos Martinez** (274), **Lance Lynn** (206), **Miles Mikolas** (204) and **Chris Carpenter** (198) since 2000 to reach 178 career games pitched for St. Louis while also making 60 or more starts.
- Pitched 5.0 or more innings in each of his first eight starts, longest streak by a Cardinal since **Sonny Gray** ran off 12 straight last season from July-September. His 8 starts of 5.0 innings or more to begin a season is longest since Gray ran off 10 to begin 2024.
- **Leads all current Cardinals pitchers in career starts (69), wins (28), innings pitched (502.1) and strikeouts (354).**
- Made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for the 5th time (2022-26), tied with **Lars Nootbaar** for most among active Cardinals.

LAST TIME OUT (Wednesday, May 12 at Athletics in Sacramento): W, 6-4; 5.0 IP, 4 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 3 BB, 4 SO, 1 HR, 85 pitches.

- Held the A's to four hits in the game, 4th start this season holding the opposition to four hits or less.
- Allowed three runs with two outs in the 3rd inning, then clamped down for three scoreless innings to depart in line for the win.

2026 NOTES:

ROAD vs. HOME: With a win in Sacramento (5/12), earned his first MLB in his home state (CA) and alternated wins in home (3 losses) and road (3 wins) over his last 6 starts.

SLIDE ON IN: Is holding opposing batters to a .161 BA (9-60) with his slider, and 20 of his 33 strikeouts this season have come via the slider.

COUNT ON ME: Has worked at least 5.0 IP in all eight starts this season, allowing 2 runs or fewer in three of those games.

IF AT FIRST: Has had issues with 1st inning, allowing a .990 OPS, 9 runs and 3 HRs in 1st inning and batters are hitting .368 (7-19) when contacting the 1st pitch of an at-bat.

BITTER BREW: Allowed four 1st inning runs, including 3-run HR, in 6-2 loss to MIL (5/6), losing his 3rd straight decision at Busch Stadium.

AHOY MATEY: Pitched a season-best 6.0 innings while allowing one run in the Cardinals 5-4 win at PNC Park (4/29) in game three of a four-game series sweep of Pittsburgh.

TRI-DENT: Fanned 8 Mariners on 4/24 in his season-high 5.1 IP, but took the 3-2 loss after Josh Naylor's solo HR in the 6th snapped a 2-2 tie.

SPACE TRAVELER: Earned his 1st road win since 5/16/25 (at KC) in a 7-5 Space City win over the Astros on 4/18 in Houston.

MARCH MADNESS: Made his 2026 season debut vs. NYM (3/31) and gained a 3-0 win as he worked 5.0 scoreless IP, allowing just 3 hits.

CAREER:

- Has made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for five consecutive seasons (2022-26) after arriving at 2022 Spring Training as a non-roster invitee, his first official invite to Major League Spring Training.
- Is 12-15 in his 34 career games started at Busch Stadium while the Cardinals have gone 16-18 in those games.
- **Since his 2022 Major League debut, boasts the highest ground ball percentage (63.0%) in Major League Baseball among pitchers with 400.0+ innings pitched.**
- As a starting pitcher (370.2 IP), Pallante's 59.7 career groundball pct. currently is the 8th-best in MLB since the stat has been tracked since 1987 (min. 350.0 IP as starter).
- Started vs. San Francisco (June 20, 2024) at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala., tossing 5.1 innings in the 6-5 Cardinals win. Was the first Cardinals starting pitcher to earn a win at a neutral site since Alan Benes vs. San Diego on April 19, 1997 at Aloha Stadium in Honolulu, Hawaii.

PALLANTE vs. KANSAS CITY

- Is 1-1 with a 5.68 ERA in four career starts (5 app.) vs. the Royals.
- Cardinals lost both his starts at Busch Stadium vs. KC (7/10/24 & 6/3/25).
- Earned his first win against Kansas City (5/16) at Kauffman Stadium in a 10-3 win. Held the Royals to two runs over 7.0 innings.
- Was hit for 7 runs and tied his career-high with 7 earned runs in his last start at Busch Stadium (6/3/25) in a 10-7 Cardinals loss.
- Hurlled 100 or more pitches three straight starts vs. KC (7/10/24-5/16/25).
- Made a relief appearance on Aug. 11, 2023 at Kauffman Stadium, closing out a 12-8 loss pitching the final two innings allowing three runs. The Cardinals trailed 9-0 after two innings, but came up short on a late rally.
- Has not walked a Royal in his last 49 batters faced against them dating back to 8/10/24 at KC when he walked Paul DeJong.
- Held the opposition to 3 ER or less in his last nine starts vs. American League opponents (4-2, 3.10 ERA, 52. 1 IP).
