THE TWINS: Have gone 2-2 through four games on their seven-game homestand, winning a series 2-1 over the White Sox earlier in the week, followed by a loss to the Royals last night... tonight, the Twins will play the second of four against Kansas City and complete the series on Sunday afternoon.
 ☞ Twins are on day 15 of a 17 games in 17 consecutive days...next day-off is Monday.

ROYAL PAIN: The Twins lost to the Royals last night at Target Field by a score of 8-6...Andrew Morris was the opener, allowing two runs on five hits in 2.0 innings pitched, with one walk and two strikeouts...Taylor Rogers (1-3) was issued the loss as Justin Lawrence allowed two of his inherited runners to score in the top of the ninth inning...the offense recorded nine hits, four being home runs, matching their single-game season-high (April 13 vs. BOS)... the homers were hit by Byron Buxton (18), Kody Clemens (7, 8) and Victor Caratini (3)...for Clemens, it marked his second career multi-homer game and for Buxton, it marked his fifth leadoff homer of the season.

GAME OF THRONES: The Twins and Royals are playing each other today for the fifth of 13 games in 2026...Twins have gone 1-3 vs. KC this season.

☞ Since the start of 2024, the Twins have gone 9-5 at home vs. the Royals, compared to 5-11 at Kauffman Stadium.

☞ Twins are 35-25 in their last 60 overall against the Royals, dating back to April 21, 2022... that includes a home record of 23-8.

☞ Josh Bell is hitting .326 (31-for-95) with six doubles, seven home runs, 22 RBI and a 1.023 OPS in 27 career games vs. Kansas City...two of his five home runs this season have been against the Royals (April 1 off Bailey Falter and April 2 off Steven Cruz).

☞ Luke Keaschall is hitting .300 (12-for-40) with two doubles, one home run, seven RBI and a .758 OPS in 10 career games vs. Kansas City.

☞ Kody Clemens has four home runs in his last three games against the Royals, dating back to September 7...he has nine career hits against the Royals, seven are home runs...he has a .225 career average vs. KC, compared to a .750 slugging percentage...1.090 OPS in 15 games...he also has seven walks and a .340 on-base percentage.

LEAD ROLE: Byron Buxton hit his fifth leadoff homer of the season last night...each of his last two homers have been leadoff homers, as have four of his last six and five of his last nine...below are Twins (since 1961) all-time leadoff homers (left) and MLB leadoff homers since 2025 (right):

ADDITIONALLY: Buck's five leadoff homers lead baseball this season, ahead of Ohtani and James Wood, both with four.

BUCK SHOTS: Byron Buxton hit his 18th home run last night, snapping his home run drought at six games (29 plate appearances between homers)...he has hit all 18 home runs over his last 40 games, since April 13...since that date, he ranks second in baseball in home runs, trailing only Kyle Schwarber (19)...below are Buck's season AL rankings in a few offensive categories:

THE BUCK STARTS HERE: Over his last 19 games, since May 8, Byron Buxton is hitting .286 (22-for-77) with five doubles, seven home runs, 11 RBI, a .360 on-base percentage, a .623 slugging percentage and a .984 OPS.

☞ In 27 home games this season, he is hitting .294 (32-for-109) with five doubles, 11 home runs, 13 RBI, a .642 slugging percentage and a 1.016 OPS...his slugging percentage ranks fourth among all AL players, while his OPS ranks fifth.

BASEBALL PLAYER: Over his last 22 games, Kody Clemens has posted a .905 OPS (.319 OBP/.586 SLG), while hitting .287 (25-for-87) with seven doubles, two triples, five home runs and 11 RBI...over that 22-game span, he has started at five different positions defensively: first base 12 times, centerfield five times, rightfield three times, leftfield once and second base once.
 ☞ Clemens has reached base safely in 17 of his last 18 home games, posting a .365 on-base percentage in that span.
 ☞ He is hitting .324 (12-for-37) with a .676 slugging percentage and 1.051 OPS over his last 10 home games.

RISPY BUSINESS: Through four games this homestand, Twins have gone 10-for-26 (.385) with runners in scoring position...on the season, they have hit .280 (150-for-536) with RISP, the best in the AL and third-highest in baseball, trailing Atlanta (.290) and Milwaukee (.285).
 ☞ Notable individuals with RISP this season in chart in right margin.
 ☞ Among all AL players with a minimum of 50 RISP plate appearances: Brooks Lee (.404) ranks third and Luke Keaschall (.345) ranks fifth.

ALL THE BELLS AND WHISTLES: Josh Bell has now hit safely in a seven of his last eight games...in those eight, he has hit .333 (9-for-27) with three doubles, three RBI and an .824 OPS.

☞ Since May 18, he is hitting .375 (15-for-40) as a left-handed batter, including three doubles, two home runs, six RBI, four walks, a .432 on-base percentage, a .600 slugging percentage and a 1.032 OPS.

☞ Two of Bell's six career hits off Michael Wacha have been home runs.

ONE BIG CALIFORNIA BIRTHDAY CAKE: Joe Ryan is celebrating his 30th birthday today and Royce Lewis is celebrating his 27th birthday.

FROM THE WINDOW TO (OVER) THE WALLNER: Last night, Matt Wallner became the third Triple-A St. Paul hitter this year (Tyler Fedko and Aaron Sabato), and seventh in franchise history, to homer three times in a game as the Saints beat Indianapolis by a score of 7-4...Wallner has recorded multiple hits in each of his last five games for the Saints, hitting .478 (11-for-23) with five home runs and a 1.674 OPS over those five.

- It will be his fourth career start against Kansas City; is 1-1 with a 5.14 ERA (14.0 IP, 8 ER) in three starts against the Royals.
- In his last outing on May 31 at Pittsburgh, Zebby took his third consecutive loss after allowing seven runs on six hits (2 HR), with two walks and seven strikeouts; the Twins fell to the Pirates 9-3.
- Tonight will be Zebby's third start at home this season, is 1-1 with a 1.38 ERA (13.0 IP, 2 ER).

LAST TIME OUT: On May 31 at Pittsburgh, Zebby made his fourth start of the season opposite right-hander Braxton Ashcraft...suffered his third consecutive loss, giving up seven runs on six hits (2 HR), with two walks and seven strikeouts in an MLB season-low 4.1 innings pitched...gave up two runs in the second inning on three hits (1 HR - Rylan O'Hearn solo), two runs in the fourth on one hit (1 HR - Nick Gonzales two-run) and three runs in the fifth on two hits...his seven runs allowed were the most he has given up since allowing nine runs on September 16, 2025 vs. New York-AL.

QUALITY START STREAK COMES TO AN END: With the seven runs allowed, Zebby's four-start quality start streak dating back to September 23, 2025 at Texas came to an end...the streak was the longest of his career; previous long was two (August 29 - September 3, 2025).

STUNG BY THE LONG BALL: With two home runs allowed on May 31, Zebby has now allowed five home runs in his last three starts...in his last 12 MLB starts dating back to August 11, 2025, Matthews has given up at least one home run in nine of them...in total he has given up 13 homers in his last 12 outings (64.1 IP); that is the third most on the Twins staff since August 11, trailing Bailey Ober - 19 (110.0 IP) and Joe Ryan - 17 (109.0 IP)...his 1.82 HR/9 during that span is the highest on the Twins staff (min. 30 IP).

TWO STARTS AGO: Zebby made his third start of the season on May 25 at Rate Field against the Chicago White Sox...suffered his second consecutive loss after going 6.0 quality innings and allowing three runs on five hits (2 HR), with one walk and six strikeouts; the Twins ultimately lost by a final score of 3-1.

OFF TO AN EFFICIENT START: Through three starts this season, Zebby has pitched a combined 19.0 innings, the most in a three-start span in the same season of his MLB career...his previous high was 16.2 innings pitched from 8/29/25-9/9/25 (8/29 - 6.0 IP vs. San Diego, 9/3 - 6.0 IP vs. Chicago-AL and 9/9 - 4.2 IP at Los Angeles-AL).

FIRST FOUR AND LAST SEVEN: Despite giving up seven runs in his last start, Zebby has pitched much better in his last seven starts than he did in his first four of the season...here are his numbers from his first four starts (all with Triple-A St. Paul), compared to his last six (three AAA and four MLB):

NUMBERS AGAINST THE ROYALS: Tonight will be Zebby's fourth start against the Royals in his career...through three starts, he is 1-1 with a 5.14 ERA (14.0 IP, 8 ER), two walks, 18 strikeouts and a 1.50 WHIP...has made two starts at Target Field against Kansas City, going 1-0 with a 4.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 4 ER), one walk, 10 strikeouts and a 1.22 WHIP.

ROYALS HITTERS: Have hit .311 (19-for-61) off Matthews in his three starts with four extra-base hits (two doubles and two home runs)...Michael Massey leads current Royals hitters with a .625 (5-for-8) lifetime batting average against Zebby with one double, one home run, two RBI and a 1.750 OPS.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS (SEASON): Matthews has been his best at home this season, going 1-1 with a 1.38 ERA (13.0 IP, 2 ER), one walk, 11 strikeouts and a .191 (9-for-47) BAA in two home starts; on the road he has made two starts, compiling an 0-2 record with a 8.71 ERA (10.1 IP, 10 ER), three walks, 13 strikeouts and a .262 (11-for-42) BAA.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS (CAREER): Matthews has gone 4-5 with a 5.98 ERA (64.2 IP, 43 ER), 15 walks, 74 strikeouts and a .302 (81-for-268) BAA in 14 career major league starts at home, compared to 3-8, 5.47 ERA (75.2 IP, 46 ER) with 24 walks, 81 strikeouts and a .273 (84-for-308) BAA in 15 career major league starts on the road.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through four starts this season, lefties are slashing .200/.286/.400 (10-for-50) with one double, three home runs, four walks and 19 strikeouts, while righties are slashing .256/.256/.462 (10-for-39) with two doubles, two home runs, zero walks and five strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Zebby has used a six-pitch mix in his four starts with the Twins this season...here are some of his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant.

TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE: In his last start on 5/31, Pirates hitters 0-for-4 with three strikeouts against Zebby's curveball...against his other five pitches, they were a combined 6-for-15 with a double, two home runs and four strikeouts...Zebby's .083 (1-for-12) BAA his curveball ranks first on the Twins staff and 14th in MLB (min. 50 pitches).

SLIDING A LITTLE TOO MUCH: Pirates hitters went 2-for-3 with two homers off Matthews' slider on May 31...in his first three starts opponents batted .174 (4-for-23) with zero extra-base hits and nine strikeouts against the pitch.

THE HEATER: Zebby's .206 (7-for-34) opponent BAA his 4-seam fastball ranks first among Twins pitchers (min. 100 pitches).

NOTHING FREE: Matthews has a 4.2 BB% through four starts this season; that ranks in the 98th percentile of all MLB pitchers.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - JOE RYAN (2026: 4-3, 3.20 ERA // CAREER: 50-39, 3.73 ERA)

Joe Ryan is slated to make his 14th start of the season tomorrow afternoon in game three of a four-game series against the Royals...in his last outing on June 1 vs. the Chicago White Sox at Target Field, Joe earned his fourth win of the season, giving up four runs on eight hits (2 HR), with zero walks and nine strikeouts in 6.0 innings...became the first pitcher in Twins/Senators history (1901-) with three consecutive starts of nine strikeouts and zero walks...has made 12 starts against Kansas City in his career, going 8-2 with a 2.58 ERA (66.1 IP, 19 ER), 15 walks, 69 strikeouts, a .201 (48-for-239) BAA and a 0.95 WHIP...his eight wins against Kansas City are his most against any MLB opponent.

CAREER NOTES

- On May 14, 2026, tied his major league career high by pitching 7.0 scoreless innings and earning the win against the Miami Marlins in his first MLB start of the season; the 7.0 scoreless innings was the longest scoreless start in his major league career.
- In 2026, tossed a professional career-high 8.0 innings for Triple-A St. Paul on May 8 at Las Vegas; earned the victory with a final line of 8.0 innings pitched with three runs allowed on 10 hits, with two walks and five strikeouts while throwing 95 pitches.
- Finished 2025 with MLB career-highs in starts (16), innings pitched (79.1), strikeouts (88), ERA (5.56) and WHIP (1.49).
- Ranked by *Baseball America* as fourth-best prospect in Twins system entering 2025...also ranked as having Best Fastball and Best Control...later ranked by same publication as 73rd-best prospect in baseball entering 2025.
- Won the Jim Rantz Award as Twins minor league Pitcher of the Year for 2024.
