BIRD WATCHING: The St. Louis Cardinals conclude a three-game series with the Los Angeles Dodgers tonight. The Cardinals took the first two games of the series 13-8 and 8-6 in 10 innings to move back to .500 for the first time since Aug. 28. Following tonight's game, the Cardinals will fly to the Mountain Time Zone for a three-game series with the Colorado Rockies. The San Francisco Giants will recall the Cardinals to the Pacific Time Zone to conclude the nine-game road trip through the National League West.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters play today in 3rd place in the National League Central, 17.0 games behind first place Milwaukee and eight games behind 2nd place Chicago. The Cardinals have closed the gap to 3.5 games beind the 3rd Wild Card position, held by Arizona, which holds a tie-breaker over St. Louis. St. Louis has 13 road games remaining and nine home games.

SWEEP-STAKES: With a win tonight, the Cardinals would sweep the Dodgers for the first time since a four-game series at Busch Stadium April 8-11, 2019 and first at Dodger Stadium since Aug. 20-22, 2018. The Cardinals have swept three series this season (at HOU 4/17-19, at PIT 4/27-30 & vs. CIN 6/5-7).

OLIVER AND DODGER(S): The Cardinals have won a 4th straight series against the Dodgers, currently the longest active series win streak against the Dodgers in MLB. St. Louis has won 9 of their last 13 against the Dodgers and have taken the season series each of the last two years. -Elias Sports Bureau

THE GOOSE IS LOOSE!: Cardinals INF **Thomas Saggese** has had a record series with one game remaining. He hit his first career multi-home run game on Tuesday including back-to-back home runs and followed it with a two-run home run last night. Saggese became the 17th instance a Cardinals player has had 3 HR over a pair of games against the Dodgers and first since **Albert Pujols** in 2011. Saggese's 3 HR vs. the Dodgers this season are T-4th most with **Nolan Arenado** and **Kyle Karros**, trailing only **Manny Machado** (10G), **Ketel Marte** (12G) and **Ceddanne Rafaela** (3G) with four each. The last Cardinals player to hit 4 HR in a season against the Dodgers was **Scott Rolen** in 2003.

DOUBLE DEUCE: Cardinals rookie OF **Joshua Báez** entered as a pinch-hitter last night in the 8th inning, doubled, then came around to score the tying run. The Boston-born Dominican would drive in two runs in the 10th inning with a second double. He became the 7th Cardinals player to have 2 doubles and 2 RBI in a reserve role and the first since **Pedro Pagés** at Boston (4/6/25-G1). **Báez** has 10 extra base hits (4 doubles, 6 home runs) of his first 12 hits, the most extra base hits by a Cardinals player in his first 18 games since **Aledmys Díaz** with 13 in 2016.

A FUN RUN: **Jordan Walker** hit his 31st double of the season and came around to score on **Leo Bernal's** first Major League home run. Walker has scored in six straight games vs. the Dodgers, the 2nd-longest active streak behind **CJ Abrams** of the Nationals with eight and longest by a Cardinals player since **Vince Coleman** with seven in 1989.

SEPTEMBER SUCCESS: Since the DeWitt family took over ownership of the St. Louis Cardinals organization prior to the 1996 season, the team has posted the 3rd-best winning percentage in September with a .558 mark (474-376), trailing only the New York Yankees (.590, 503-350) and the Los Angeles Dodgers (.564, 470-363).

ROOKIE ROCKETS: With **Leo Bernal** connecting on his home run last night, the Cardinals rookies have now hit 46 home runs this season, most in the National League and trailing only the Chicago White Sox for the most in MLB with 60.

C-NOTE GOAT: **Jordan Walker** is one RBI short of 100 and would be the first Cardinals homegrown outfielder to knock in 100 runs since **Ray Lankford** (103) in 1998. Walker currently leads the team in home runs (28), hits (153) and runs (89). He is looking to become the 18th instance a Cardinals player has 30 HR, 100 RBI, 30 doubles and 150 hits since 2000. **Albert Pujols** claims 10 of those seasons with **Jim Edmonds** (2), **Nolan Arenado** (2), **Paul Goldschmidt** (1), **Ryan Ludwick** (1) and Hall of Famer **Scott Rolen** (1) rounding out the list.

Andre Pallante was born in Mission Viejo and resides in San Clemente...graduated from San Clemente High School...played college baseball at the Univ. of California, Irvine (2017-19).

Michael McGreevy was born in and resides in San Clemente...graduated from San Clemente, High School...played college baseball at the University of California, Santa Barbara (2019-21).

Justin Bruihl pitched parts of three seasons with the Dodgers (2021-23) where he made his MLB debut...played college baseball California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo.

Tommy Edman played parts of five seasons with St. Louis (2019-24)...won a Gold Glove at second base in 2021...selected by the Cardinals in the 6th round of the 2016 MLB Draft.

Brant Brown previously served as Dodgers Assistant Hitting Coach and Minor League Hitting Coordinator for five seasons (2018-22).

Cardinals AGM/Scouting **Randy Flores** was born in Bellflower....graduated from El Rancho High School in Pico Rivera...pitched at the University of Southern California (1994-97).

Ron "Pop" Warner was born in Alhambra, Calif.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Mark McGwire** was born in Pomona and resides in San Clemente, Calif... graduated from Damien High School in La Verne, Calif...played college baseball at the University of Southern California...served as Dodgers Hitting Coach for three seasons (2013-15).

Victor Scott II made his MLB debut at Dodger Stadium (March 28, 2024)...is the only Cardinal (since 1900) to steal a base in his Major League debut on Opening Day.

Dean Kiekhefer made his MLB debut at Dodger Stadium (May 14, 2016) ...struck out career-high four of six total batters faced, including first batter, Joc Pederson (looking).

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER:

- Northern California native and former Stanford Cardinal makes his 5th career Major League start tonight, including his 4th on the road.
- Currently ranked as the No. 11 prospect in the Cardinals organization by *Baseball America*.
- Made his first career start at Busch Stadium last Friday vs. Pittsburgh and earned his first career win with a career high 5.2 innings.
- Became the first Cardinal (6th all-time) to make his first three career starts of the road (all appointed as the 27th player of doubleheaders) since **Howie Pollet** (Aug. 20-28, 1941). - *Elias Sports Bureau*
- His 33.3% "Hard Hit" percentage is 2nd-lowest on the staff behind **Luis Gastelum** (31.8).
- Has received 3 runs of support or fewer in all four of his Major League starts.
- The Cardinals 4th round draft pick out of Stanford University in 2023. Originally selected by the Rays in the 19th round in the 2022 MLB Draft.
- 2024 Cardinals and Baseball America Minor League Pitcher of the Year.
- Led the 2026 International League in strikeouts (111) and opponent BA (.170); and ranked in the Top 10 in ERA (3.13, 2nd), games started (19, 2nd), innings pitched (92.0, 5th) and WHIP (1.14, 4th) when he was first called up (Aug. 1).
- Since the beginning of 2024, ranks 2nd in all of Minor League Baseball with 437 strikeouts, trailing only the Mets **Jonah Tong** (465). Ranks 4th in qualifying ERA (3.19).
- Led all of Minor League Baseball in 2024 with 202 strikeouts, T-7th most in a single-season by any Cardinals minor league pitcher (since 1962).

LAST TIME OUT (Friday, August 28 vs. Pittsburgh): W 4-1; 5.2 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 1 BB, 7 SO, 0 HR, 102 pitches

- Made his first career start at Busch Stadium and earned his 1st career win ... Pitched a season/career-high 5.2 innings, most innings by a Cardinals rookie left hander since **Matthew Liberatore** (8.0 IP on Aug. 10, 2023 at Tampa Bay).
- Quinn's 102 pitches were a professional high (2024-26) and most is most thrown since his 156-pitch complete game in the Stanford Super Regional win against Texas on June 11, 2023 (16 SO).
- Became the first Cardinal w/ 7+ strikeouts in his first career start at Busch Stadium since **Luke Weaver** (7K vs. OAK on 8/26/16).

2026 SEASON:

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME: Became the first Cardinals pitcher (6th all-time) to make his first three starts of the road. Previous was **Howie Pollet** in 1941 (Aug. 20-28). - *Elias Sports Bureau*

OH, CANADA!: Was the first Cards starting pitcher to make his Major League debut in Canada since **Rick Ankiel** on August 23, 1999 at Montreal's Olympic Stadium vs. the Expos.

HATCHED: Is one 11 Cardinals (6 pitchers) to make their Major League debuts this season. RHP **Hancel Rincon** has yet to appear.

WALKING IN MEMPHIS: Began the season in the Memphis (AAA) rotation and held his opposition to three hits or fewer in 15-of-21 Triple-A starts.

BULL-YING DURHAM: Struck out a season-high 10 over 7.0 IP in a 7-3 Redbirds win vs. Durham (7/24) on the start before his MLB debut.

SUMMER LOVING: Over his final 12 starts with Memphis (AAA) from May 28-August 12, went 4-1 with a 1.99 ERA and 76 strikeouts over 63.1 innings pitched (10.8 K/9 IP) including a 1.01 WHIP.

SIX FOR THE FIX: Made four scoreless starts with three of them 6.0 innings or more with a season-high 7.0 IP, two-hitter at Gwinnett (Braves).

- Threw a 156-pitch complete game in the Stanford Super Regional win against Texas on June 11, 2023, striking out 16 batters.
- Has a strong interest in cryptocurrency and before baseball wanted to pursue a career as an investment banker.

- His older sister, Remy, played soccer at Rice University (2017-18).
