Solo Homers

Atlanta scored three runs on Wednesday afternoon, and all three came via solo home runs by Drake Baldwin, Marcell Ozuna and Eli White.

Each of Atlanta's last nine home runs have come with no one on base, dating to Drake Baldwin's two-run shot in the third inning last Saturday at Detroit.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Pirates tonight open a three-game weekend series with the fourth of six matchups between the teams this season...This weekend marks the final games of the 2025 season for the two clubs.

- Atlanta dropped two-of-three games in Pittsburgh earlier this season, May 9-11, with all three games decided by a single run.
- The Braves and Pirates split six games between the clubs last season, with Atlanta going 1-2 at PNC Park and 2-1 at home.
- With the split last year, Atlanta has still not lost the season set with Pittsburgh since the 2017 season, going a combined 29-14 (.674) since 2018...That includes a perfect 7-0 record against the Pirates in 2022, one of just three instances in the franchise's modern era that they swept a season series of seven or more games with an opponent.
- Atlanta has never lost a series to Pittsburgh here at Truist Park, going 19-6 (.760) against the Pirates here at home since the facility opened in 2017... Pittsburgh's six wins and .240 winning percentage are both the lowest of any NL team in this stadium.
- LH Joey Wentz is set to make the first start and third overall appearance of his career versus Pittsburgh, and owns a 6.75 ERA (3 ER/4.0 IP) without a decision against his former club... The 6-foot-5, 220-pound Kansan made 27 relief appearances for the Pirates between the 2024 and 2025 seasons, compiling a 3-1 record with a 3.32 ERA (14 ER/38.0 IP) for the club.
- RH Mitch Keller tonight makes the seventh start of his career against the Braves, and is 1-3 with a 7.94 ERA (25 ER/28.1 IP) all-time against the club...The 6-foot-3, 212-pound Iowa native earned his lone win against Atlanta in his last turn versus the Braves, allowing just one run over 6.2 innings on May 25 of last season...The righthander has lost each of his last four starts dating to August 31, going 0-4 despite a 3.32 ERA (8 ER/21.2 IP) in that span.

ONE-RUN GAMES: Atlanta's season-best winning streak of 10 games was snapped on Wednesday afternoon, following a loss, 4-3, to Washington...The defeat was the Braves' 35th loss this season by a single

- Atlanta's 35 one-run losses this season are tied for the most in baseball, and the club's 21-35 (.375) record in such games is the lowest winning percentage in the NL...Only Minnesota (15-26, .366) and Chicago (14-35, .286) have a lower such record in the majors.
- Dating to the start of 2024, Atlanta's 39-60 (.394) record in one-run games is also lowest in the NL.
- If Atlanta had played to just a .500 record in its 56 one-run games this season, the Braves' 82-77 (.516) record would be tied for the final NL Wild Card spot this season.

BRAVE OF THE YEAR: The Atlanta chapter of the Baseball Writers' Association of America today named first baseman Matt Olson as the 2025 Brave of the Year... The award has been given out annually since the Braves moved to Atlanta in 1966.

- Olson received 11 of the 13 total votes this season. while rookie Drake Baldwin earned the other two... He is the fourth first baseman to receive the honor, joining Freddie Freeman, who won the award five times, and Willie Montañez and Gerald Perry, who won once each.
- Olson has batted .272/.367/.481 on the season, and leads Atlanta in games (159), runs (95), hits (167), doubles (40), homers (28), RBI (93) and bWAR (6.0)...He was one of three Braves elected to participate in the 2025 All-Star Game.
- He leads all first baseman in baseball this season in both major WAR metrics, owning $6.0\ bWAR$ and 4.6 fWAR.

TEN HOMERS: Eli White came off the bench on Wednesday afternoon and sent the very first pitch he saw out to center field for his 10th home run of the season... Each of his last two shots have come as a pinch hitter.

- White became the 10th different Braves batter with at least 10 homers this season, joining Matt Olson (28), Marcell Ozuna (21), Ronald Acuña Jr. (20), Drake Baldwin (19), Michael Harris II (19), Ozzie Albies (16), Austin Riley (16), Sean Murphy (16) and Jurickson Profar (14).
- The Braves are one of just three teams in baseball with double-digit 10-homer players, joining the Yankees and Phillies who also have 10.
- The Braves also had 10 such players in 2023, and had a franchise-record 11 players with at least 10 homers last year...No other team in baseball has done so in each of the last three years...However, just 26 different players have hit at least a single homer with Atlanta since the start of 2023, more than just Philadelphia (25) in the majors.

DRAKE BALDWIN: Provided one of three runs for Atlanta's offense on Wednesday afternoon, hitting a solo shot in the sixth inning and going 1-for-4 on the day... Baldwin recorded his 19th homer and 79th RBI while hitting .274 on the season.

- Among all 17 National League rookies with at least 200 at-bats, Baldwin ranks first in RBI (79), second in homers (19) and total bases (183), and third in average (.274), slugging (.464), OPS (.805), extrabase hits (tied, 36) and runs scored (tied, 55).
- His 3.2 bWAR this season are also the most by any rookie in the National League, and trails just the Athletic's Nick Kurtz (5.3) among rookie batters in the majors.
- Baldwin has at least one hit in each of his last eight games dating to September 16, and is batting .387/.441/.839 with a 1.280 OPS and three homers in that span.

- In his first outing with Atlanta, Wentz held the Cardinals hitless while fanning six batters over 3.0 scoreless innings in relief.
 - A The six strikeouts were the most in a Braves debut in a relief appearance in Atlanta-franchise history (dating to 1966).

- Was traded to Detroit along with outfielder Travis Demeritte in exchange for All-Star right-handed reliever Shane Greene.
- Logged 525.1 innings pitched in the minor leagues...trails only teammate Grant Holmes for the most minor league frames tossed.
- Selected by the Braves with the 40th overall selection in the 2016 First-Year Player $Draft\ and\ split\ his\ first\ professional\ season\ between\ the\ GCL\ Braves\ and\ rookie-level$ Danville, going 1-4 with a 3.68 ERA (18 ER/44.0 IP) over 12 starts.
- A Baseball America tabbed him as the 10th-best prospect in the Appalachian League at the season's end...Entered the 2016 draft ranked as Baseball America's 26th-best prospect and the 16th-best player in the draft class according to MLB.com.

- Selected by the Atlanta Braves in the Competitive Balance Round A (40th overall) of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft...Signed by Nate Dion.
- ▲ Led Shawnee Mission East High to the 2016 Kansas Class 6A state championship and was named the Sunflower League Player of the Year after going a perfect 9-0 while not allowing an earned run in 51.1 innings pitched.
- A Struck out 104 batters over 51.1 high-school innings and allowed just seven hits with 12 walks.
