ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 12-4 on the road, going 4-0-1 in series play.....their 12-4 record ties the best road start in franchise history (also 2014).

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the San Diego Padres (42-54), replacing Bud Black in June of that season.....Murphy enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career spent primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach **Jim Henderson** (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator Walker McKinven (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff.... Rickie Weeks (associate manager). Daniel de Mondesert (assistant coach) and Charlie Greene (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made six replay challenges this season, going 5-1.....their last challenge came on 4/24 at Pittsburgh as a safe call at first base involving Edward Olivares in the ninth inning stood.

# TODAY'S STARTER: #36 - RHP TOBIAS MYERS (1gs, 0-1, 1.80)

MYERS AT A GLANCE: Tobias Myers, 25, will be making his second start of the season.....Myers made his Major League debut on Tuesday at Pittsburgh and took a 2-1 defeat (5ip, 4h, 1r, 1er, 1bb, 4k, 1hr, 1wp, 83 pitches)....his only run allowed came on a leadoff, first-pitch homer to Andrew McCutchen.....he joined the Brewers from Triple-A Nashville, where he went 1-1 with a 1.62 ERA in 4 games/3 starts (16.2ip, 11h, 3r, 3er, 7bb, 22k, 2hr).....International League opponents batted .183 (11-for-60).....Myers was originally selected from Nashville on April 17 but was optioned back the next day without pitching....he signed with Milwaukee as a free agent on 11/10/22.

LAST SEASON: In his first season in the organization, Myers went 10-5 with a 4.93 ERA in 29 games/26 starts between Double-A Biloxi (27g, 26gs) and Triple-A Nashville (2g).....he led all Brewers Minor League pitchers in wins (10), strikeouts (175) and innings pitched (140.2).....he led the Southern League in strikeouts (168) and innings pitched (137.2) and tied for second in wins (10).....also surrendered a league-leading 30 HR.

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER: Has gone 43-37 with a 4.25 ERA in 140 games/123 starts (618.1ip, 599h, 331r, 292er, 213bb, 634k, 83hr).....has pitched for six organizations: Baltimore (2016-17), Tampa Bay (2017-21), Cleveland (2022), San Francisco (2022), Chicago-AL (2022) and Milwaukee (2023-24).....did not play in the 2020 season due to the COVID-19 pandemic.....was selected by Baltimore in the sixth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Winter Haven (FL) High School.....Myers committed to the University of South Florida prior to being drafted.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Has not pitched in Milwaukee.

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 0-1 with a 1.80 ERA in 1 start (5ip, 1er).
