RAY REPORT—The Rays continue their final homestand of the season against the Red Sox (1-0, 2 to play) and Blue Jays (3 to play) tonight at Tropicana Field...have not won or lost more than three consecutive games since being swept by Baltimore from June 7-10, going 43-42 since that series...are 20-25 since the July 30 trade deadline and 26-29 since the All-Star break...including off days, this marks their 91st consecutive day occupying fourth place in the AL East...are 6.0 games behind the Twins for the AL's third and final Wild Card spot...have spent the entire season no more than five games below or three games above .500.

★ Tampa Bay hit a season-high-tying four home runs last night(4x, last: July 21 at NYY), snapping a 19-game streak without a multi-homer effort at home...it marked the Rays first game with 4+ HR against the Red Sox since April 11, 2023 (also 4HR). The Rays hit three long balls in the 5th inning, their most in a frame since April 29, 2023 at CWS (3HR, 7th inn)...it marked the fourth time in franchise history Tampa Bay hits 3+ HR in an inning against Boston (last: 3HR, Sept. 23, 2019 - 4th inn.). Tampa Bay's 7 XBH were its most against Boston since Sept. 6, 2022 (also 7).

★ **RHP Shane Baz** (W, 7.0IP, 2H, 2ER, 1BB, 6SO) made his fifth consecutive start in which he threw 5.0+ innings while allowing three hits or fewer, setting a franchise record previously shared by **Shane McClanahan** (July 2 [G1]-26, 2022) and **Blake Snell** (Sept. 12-29, 2018).

★ The Rays 3.29 ERA since the All-Star break ranks third in MLB behind the Tigers (3.08) and Astros (3.14).

REHABBING RAYS—**Richie Palacios** (right knee sprain) made his first rehab appearance with Triple-A Durham last night, going 1-for-2 with two walks while playing 7.0 innings at second base...**RHP Jacob Waguespack** (1.0IP, 1SO) has made four relief appearance (1GS) with the Bulls since Sept. 6, posting a 1.50 ERA (6.0IP, 1ER) with 8 SO and no walks.

IF THE SOX FIT—Tampa Bay is 57-31 (.648) against Boston since 2019, marking the highest winning pct. by any club against the Red Sox during that stretch (min. 10G), ahead of Houston (20-12/.625) and New York-AL (56-37/.602)...since taking over as manager in 2015, **Kevin Cash** has guided the Rays to a 90-74 (.549) mark against the Red Sox...with the current season series tied, 4-4, Tampa Bay needs to win at least three of the final five matchups to secure a sixth consecutive winning season against Boston, with the last losing season coming in 2018 (8-11).

THE GREAT BRANDINO—**Brandon Lowe** is a career .298/.416/.654 (57-for-191) with 9 2B, 13 3B, 19 HR and 45 RBI in 57 career games against the Red Sox...min. 200 PA, his .654 career slugging percentage against Boston is the second highest by any player in MLB history, trailing only **Babe Ruth** (.683)...since Lowe's MLB debut on Aug. 5, 2018, his 19 HR against the Red Sox are second most by any player behind only NYY **Aaron Judge** (23HR).

★ Lowe is 1 RBI shy of tying **Fred McGriff** (359) for seventh in Tampa Bay history, while his 124 HR are four shy of **Aubrey Huff** (128) for third.

EN FUEGO—**Yandy Diaz** has hit safely in eight straight games, going 12-for-29 (.414) with 2 2B, 1 HR and 3 RBI...in 25 games since Aug. 17, he is batting .352/.412/.549 (32-for-91) with 6 2B, 4 HR and 13 RBI, ranking among AL leaders during that stretch in AVG (1st), OBP (3rd), OPS (6th, .961) and SLG (7th, .549).

★ **Jonathan Aranda** has recorded a hit in a career-best eight straight starts, batting .345 (10-for-29) with 3 2B, 2 HR, 3 BB and 5 R...he has also reached base safely in a career-best 13 straight starts.

★ **Manuel Rodríguez** has a 1.31 ERA (20.2IP, 3ER) and 0.73 WHIP over his last 22 appearances...min. 30.0 IP, **Edwin Uceta's** 1.42 ERA ranks third in MLB behind **CLE Emmanuel Clase** (0.65) and **TEX Kirby Yates** (1.25).

EXTRA, EXTRA!—**Junior Caminero** has 12 extra-base hits (7 2B, 1 3B, 4HR) in 24 games since Aug. 23, tied for third most among MLB rookies during that stretch, trailing **MIL Jackson Chourio** (17) and **TEX Wyatt Langford** (13).

★ He has a team-leading three multi-XBH games during that stretch, outpacing **Jose Siri** (2)...the three such performances are also tied for second most among all AL hitters over that period behind **BOS Connor Wong** (4).

KELL-YEAH—**Kevin Kelly's** 20.1 scoreless inning streak is the longest active run in the majors and ties his career-long streak from May 14-July 15 (G2), 2023...he has not allowed an earned run in 22 straight outings (24.2IP) since July 23, limiting opponents to a .145/.193/.181 (12-for-83) line with a 0.65 WHIP during that time...the 22-appearance streak marks a career high, surpassing his 21-appearance run from May 14-July 15 (G2), 2023...it is the longest active streak in the majors, ahead of AZ **A.J. Puk** (20)...the last longer streak by a Rays reliever was **Pete Fairbanks'** club-record 30-appearance run (July 25, 2022-April 28, 2023).

TROP TALK—At 38-38, Tampa Bay must go 3-2 or better over the next five games to secure an eighth straight winning season at home...its last losing season came in 2016 (36-45).

★ Nine of the Rays last 15 home games have been one-run games, including four of their last six.

★ Rays starters have posted a 3.03 ERA (187.0IP, 63ER) in 37 home games since June 11, signaling the third-lowest mark by any starting rotation at their home venue during that stretch behind Seattle (2.93) and Houston (3.02)...overall, Rays pitching ranks 12th in MLB with a 3.77 home ERA, while their 3.98 road ERA ranks 10th.

CLOSE SHAVES—The Rays are 49-31 (.613) in games decided by two runs or fewer, tied with the Phillies (38-24/.613) for the best mark in the majors...their 80 such games lead the AL, trailing only the Brewers (81) in all of MLB...10 of their 16 games in September have had a margin of two runs or fewer...their 26-19 (.578) mark in one-run games ranks second in the AL behind the Guardians (24-16/.600), while the 26 victories are tied for third most in MLB behind the and Tigers (28) and Cardinals (27).

SHIPPING DOWN TO ST. PETE—Tampa Bay and Boston continue a 13-game season set tonight at Tropicana Field...tonight's game marks the second of six in a span of 13 days from Sept. 17-29...in their first meeting of the season from May 13-16, Tampa Bay took three of four at Fenway Park before suffering a three-game sweep in St. Pete the following week...the two clubs close out the 2024 season with a three-game series in Boston from Sept. 27-29.

DOWN ON THE FARM—Last night, Class-A Bowling Green fell to Hudson Valley (NYY), 6-2, in Game 2 of the South Atlantic League Championship Series...the clubs face off tonight in a winner-take-all Game 3 at 6:35 p.m. ET...**RHP Jackson Baumeister** will take the ball tonight for the Hot Rods.

★ Double-A Montgomery opened its postseason last night with a 9-2 win over Biloxi (MIL) in Game 1 of the Southern Division Championship Series...**RHP Sean Hunley** earned the win (5.0IP, 3H, 1ER, 2BB, 7SO)...seven of nine Biscuits tallied multi-hit efforts, including **1B Tre Morgan** (3-for-5, 2B, R, SB), **3B Brayden Taylor** (2-for-5, 2B, RBI, R), **SS Carson Williams** (2-for-5, R) and **CF Chandler Simpson** (2-for-6)...**RHP Yoniel Curet** is scheduled to start for Montgomery in Game 2 on Thursday at Riverwalk Stadium.

- ★ Tampa Bay Manager **Kevin Cash** and Pitching Coach **Kyle Snyder** were teammates on the Red Sox during the 2007-08 seasons, and Cash caught him for six games in 2007.
- ★ Rays Third Base Coach **Brady Williams** was selected by the Red Sox in the 45th round of the 1999 First-Year Player Draft out of Pasco-Hernando Community College in New Port Richey, FL.
- ★ **Blake Butera**, Tampa Bay's Senior Director of Player Development, graduated from Boston College in 2015, playing in over 200 games for the Eagles.
- ★ Tampa Bay RHP **Zack Littell** was claimed off waivers from Boston on May 12, 2023.
- ★ Boston RHP **Kutter Crawford** was born in Okeechobee, FL, roughly 140 miles from St. Petersburg... after graduating from Okeechobee High School, he spent two seasons at Indian River State College (2015-16) before transferring to Florida Gulf Coast University in 2017.
- ★ Rays LHP **Jeffrey Springs** was acquired from the Red Sox on Feb. 17, 2021 along with RHP **Chris Mazza** in exchange for **C. Ronaldo Hernández** and **INF Nick Sogard**.
- ★ Tampa native **Wade Boggs**, who was inducted into Tampa Bay's inaugural Hall of Fame class in 2023, hit .338 with 422 2B, 47 3B and 85 HR in 11 seasons with Boston (1982-92).
- ★ Boston **INF Romy Gonzalez** was born in Miami, FL and attended American Senior High School in Hialeah, FL before playing collegiately at the University of Miami (2016-18).
- ★ Tampa Bay selected Boston RHP **Jim Mecir** in the second round of the 1997 Expansion Draft.
- ★ Since the Rays Touch Tank opened in 2006 in right-center field, seven home runs have been hit into the water, including two by Tampa Bay batters...the first was hit by **José Lobatón**, who launched walk-off solo homer in the 9th inning of Game 3 of the 2013 ALDS vs. Boston off **Koji Uehara**...the other Tampa Bay batter to do so was **Brad Miller** on July 31, 2016 vs. NYY off **Michael Pineda**.

TONIGHT'S START—Pepiot will toe the rubber for his 24th start of the season and 14th at Tropicana Field...has allowed 3 ER or fewer in 11 straight starts, posting a 2.77 ERA (52.0IP, 1ER)...the Rays are 6-2 in his last eight starts (23-29 in all other games in span)...ranks ninth in the AL (min. 400BF) in whiff rate (29.2%)...is 1 SO shy of 200 for his career and 6.2 IP shy of 200.0...has been on the 15-day IL twice (May 6-22, lower left leg contusion; July 19-Aug. 16, right knee infection).

LAST TIME OUT—Was removed from his start on Sept. 12 at CLE after just 2.0 innings and 38 pitches (ND, 2.0IP, 4H, 2ER, 2BB, SO)...yielded three hits in the opening frame, including a two-out RBI-double by **Lane Thomas**...retired the first two batters of the 2nd frame before back-to-back walks preceded a run-scoring single by **Andrés Giménez**...averaged 93.6 mph on his four-seam fastball, 1.3 mph below his season average entering the outing (94.9)...marked the shortest non-injury-shortened start of his career.

SOX TALK—Pepiot will be making his second career start opposite the Red Sox, joining his May 22 outing earlier this season at Tropicana Field (4.0IP, 2H, 3ER, 4BB, 3SO)...in that start, an 8-5 Rays loss, he held Boston scoreless through four innings, overcoming three walks...opened the 5th with a walk and hit-by-pitch before **Cedanne Rafaela** chased him with an RBI-single after only 66 pitches...his four walks in the outing matched a season high (4x).

✦ Pepiot is 2-1 with a 3.86 ERA (21.0IP, 9ER) in four career starts vs. AL East opponents, all coming this season...this includes a 1.64 ERA (11.0IP, 2ER) across his last two (July 9 vs. NYY; Sept. 7 at BAL).

HOME COOKING—Pepiot is 2-0 with a 1.78 ERA (25.1IP, 5ER) in his last five home starts since June 26, the AL's second-lowest home ERA in that span (min. 25.0IP) behind **HOU Framber Valdez** (1.16)...under the same parameter, he also ranks highly in opp. OPS (2nd, .511), opp. SLG (2nd, .239), HR/9.0 IP (4th, 0.36) and opp. average (9th)...four of the five starts during the run have come against teams currently in postseason position (AZ, CLE, NYY, SD).

✦ In his first eight home starts prior to this stretch, Pepiot went 1-3 with a 5.36 ERA (40.1IP, 24ER), allowing opponents to slug .411 while yielding 1.56 HR/9.0 IP.

LET'S GO STREAKING—He has allowed 3 ER or fewer in a career-high 11 straight starts, the second-longest active streak among AL pitchers (excl. openers) behind **NYC Clarke Schmidt** (15GS) and seventh longest in the majors...it marks the longest streak by a Rays starter since **Drew Rasmussen** (12GS) from July 2 (G2)—Sept. 9, 2022.

✦ From June 21-Aug. 26, Pepiot held opponents to 2 ER or fewer in a career-best eight straight starts, posting an AL-best (min. 40.0IP) 2.16 ERA (41.2IP, 10ER) in that span.

KEEP THE CHANGE—Over his last eight starts, opponents are batting .143 (8-for-56) with 15 SO in at-bats ending with Pepiot's changeup...min. 50 AB, it marks the fourth-lowest opp. average on any MLB starter's changeup over that span (since July 9), trailing **MIN Bailey Ober** (.083), **KC Cole Ragans** (.138) and **KC Michael Wacha** (.135)...in his previous six starts from June 4-July 3, opponents had gone 13-for-28 (.464) against the pitch...he has recorded a 26.9 pct. usage rate on the changeup across his last eight starts compared to 15.4 pct. over his first 15.

THINK FAST—Pepiot has held opponents to a .180 (36-for-200) clip on his four-seam fastball, recording 67 of his 119 strikeouts (56.3%) on the pitch...the .180 average is the second-lowest mark on any pitcher's four-seamer in the majors (min. 150AB, starts only), trailing **PHI Aaron Nola** (.158)...min. 150 AB, it would mark the third-lowest average on any Rays pitcher's four-seamer over a full season in the pitch tracking era (since 2008) behind **Steve Geltz** (.167) in 2015 and **Colin Poche** (.172) in 2019.

✦ He has a 31.2 pct. whiff rate on the offering, the second-highest mark on any MLB starter's four-seamer (min. 250 swings, starts only) behind **CWS Garrett Crochet** (31.6%).

✦ Left-handed hitters are just 14-for-92 (.152) with 39 SO against his four-seamer...they started the season 0-for-36 with 20 SO in his first 10 starts, but have since gone 14-for-56 (.250) with 19 SO in his last 13.

LIMIT THE LONG BALL—Pepiot has yielded 5 HR in his last five starts (2.01 HR/9.0IP) on the heels of a career-best six-start homerless streak from June 21-Aug. 16 (35.2IP/145BF)...45 of the 77 runs (58.4%) he has allowed in his career have come on the 29 HR against him (25 of 53/47.2% in 2024)...in the five starts he has not allowed a home run this season, he has allowed 2 ER over a combined 25.1 innings (0.71 ERA).
