AT HOME: The Brewers are 8-7 at home, going 2-2-1 in series play....the Brewers are on a season-high, 3-game home winning streak.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 14-8 on the road, going 4-2-1 in series play....the team has lost its last two road series (1-2 at CHC/1-2 at KC) after going 4-0-1 in its first five.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the San Diego Padres (42-54), replacing Bud Black in June of that season....Murphy enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career spent primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach Jim Henderson (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator Walker McKinven (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff....Rickie Weeks (associate manager), Daniel de Mondesert (assistant coach) and Charlie Greene (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made seven replay challenges this season, going 5-2....their last challenge came on 5/6 at Kansas City as an out call at third base involving Jackson Chourio on a stolen base attempt stood.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: #54 - LHP ROBERT GASSER (Major League Debut)

GASSER AT A GLANCE: Robert Gasser, 24, will be making his Major League debut....Gasser entered the 2024 season as the sixth-best prospect in the organization according to *Baseball America*....he went 0-1 with a 5.25 ERA in 3 starts at Triple-A Nashville (12ip, 12h, 7r, 7er, 6bb, 17k, 4hr)....he was on Nashville's injured list from 3/29-4/23 with left elbow inflammation....Gasser was acquired from San Diego with three other players on 8/1/22 as part of the trade for LHP Josh Hader....he was selected by the Padres in Competitive Balance Round B of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft from the University of Houston and attended the University of New Mexico and San Joaquin Delta College.

LAST SEASON: Gasser was named International League Pitcher of the Year and Brewers Co-Pitcher of the Year (with RHP Carlos Rodríguez) as he went 9-1 with a 3.79 ERA in 26 games/25 starts at Triple-A Nashville....was an International League All-Star....led all of Triple-A Baseball and ranked second among Brewers Minor League pitchers in strikeouts (166).

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER: Is 16-14 with a 3.79 ERA in 62 games/61 starts (299.1ip, 272h, 142r, 126er, 110bb, 369k, 28hr).

LIKE FATHER, LIKE SON: Robert's father, Jim, was also a pitcher....Jim Gasser was drafted by Milwaukee (1984) and San Francisco (1986) but did not sign due to injury.

TOMORROW'S STARTER: RHP FREDDY PERALTA (7gs, 3-1, 3.49)

RHP Freddy Peralta will make his eighth start of the season and second against the Cardinals.....Peralta last started last Sunday at Chicago-NL in a 5-0 loss (5ip, 3h, 3r, 3er, 6bb, 5k, 1hbp, 1wp, 97 pitches).....his 6 walks tied a career high (5/19/18 at MIN).....following that start, he served a 5-game suspension for allegedly hitting Jose Siri intentionally with a pitch on 4/30 vs. Tampa Bay.....the team has gone 6-1 in his starts.....he has produced 3 quality starts.....opponents are batting .174 (23-for-132, 4hr).....Peralta is 3-6 with a 5.92 ERA in 16 career games/12 starts against the Cardinals (64.1ip, 62h, 39R, 38er, 26bb, 72k, 9hr), including a no-decision this season on 4/19 at Busch Stadium, coming in a 2-1, 10-inning win for the Brewers (6ip, 4h, 0r, 2bb, 7k).
