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BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore wraps up a six-game homestand with a three-game series against the Rays that begins tonight...The Orioles were swept by the Yankees in the first three games from Tuesday-Thursday....The O's embark on another three-city road trip, their second in as many trips, after this homestand at the Cardinals (8/25-27), Athletics (8/28-30), and Rockies (8/31-9/2)...The Birds are in last place in the AL East, but 2.0 games behind the Rangers and Twins for the final Wild Card spot.

- ⚾ The Orioles were swept for the fourth time this season and second time against the Yankees (4 G, 5/1-4)...The O's were also winless in three-game sets against the Rays (5/18-20) and Pirates (4/3-5).
- ⚾ Baltimore has lost four games in a row after winning three straight from August 14-16...The losing streak is tied for the second longest of the year for the O's, matching June 27-30 and June 6-9, trailing a five-gamer from April 30 (G2)-May 4.
- ⚾ **Dylan Beavers** homered last night for the second straight game, the second time in his career with a home run in back-to-back games (also 9/16-17/25)...He has three homers in his last eight games (7 w/AB) after not hitting a home run in his previous 21 games (19 w/AB).
- ⚾ After scoring 51 runs in the final eight games of the last road trip, the Birds were held to five runs in the three-game Yankees series...Four of those five runs scored via solo home runs.

ROSTER MOVES: The Orioles recalled right-handed pitcher **Anthony Nunez** from Triple-A Norfolk and designated righty **Albert Suárez** for assignment.

RAYS UP: Since the start of 2022, the O's are 21-11 (.656) against Tampa Bay at Camden Yards...From 2018-21, Baltimore went 14-23 (.378) against the Rays at home.

- ⚾ The Orioles have won four straight home games against the Rays since the final home date of 2025...The Birds have not won five consecutive games at Oriole Park since August 28, 2019-August 2, 2020.

POLAR VORTEX: **Pete Alonso** has hit safely in a career-high 12 straight games since August 8, tied for the longest active streak in the majors with AZ's Gabriel Moreno, while slashing .478/.547/.913 (22-for-46) with two doubles, six homers, 10 runs, 11 RBI, and six walks...During that time, he's leading the majors in on-base percentage, slugging percentage, OPS, hits, home runs, and total bases (42) while ranking second in batting average behind KC's Jac Caglianone (.500)...The current hitting streak is the longest by an Oriole since **Jeremiah Jackson** hit safely in 13 consecutive games from August 21-September 2, 2025.

- ⚾ Overall this season, Alonso ranks among AL leaders in RBI (T-2nd, 82), total bases (4th, 239), home runs (T-4th, 29), runs scored (T-5th, 78), slugging percentage (6th, .498), and OPS (7th, .858).
- ⚾ He is one home run shy of becoming the eighth Oriole (since 1954) to hit at least 30 home runs in his first season with the team, joining Mark Trumbo (47 in 2016), Nelson Cruz (40 in 2014), J.J. Hardy (30 in 2011), Mark Reynolds (37 in 2011), Miguel Tejada (34 in 2004), Albert Belle (37 in 1999), and Frank Robinson (49 in 1966).
- ⚾ Alonso was named the AL Player of the Week on Monday, his sixth career honor and first in the AL...The last Oriole to win the award was **Gunnar Henderson** on September 7, 2024...He is the 12th player ever to garner honors in at least five consecutive seasons, regardless of team or league.

TOUGH SLEDDING: Baltimore has the second-most difficult remaining schedule in the AL with a .503 combined opponent winning percentage, trailing Tampa Bay (.506)...Ten NL teams have the highest remaining combined opponent winning percentage, led by the Reds (.559).

- ⚾ Among teams currently in playoff position, the O's have four games against the Red Sox and three each against the Brewers, Rays, and Yankees.
- ⚾ Against AL teams within 3.0 games of the Wild Card, the Orioles lost the season series to Seattle (3-4) and Texas (2-4), beat Detroit (4-2), and split with Minnesota (3-3), with games remaining against Boston (4 G, 4-5), Cleveland (3 G, 1-3), New York (3 G, 2-8), and Toronto (6 G, 3-4).

PLAYING THE LONG GAME: The Orioles lead the majors with 21 home runs since August 9 ahead of the Padres (19) and Cubs (18)...Baltimore has homered in nine straight games, the team's longest such streak since doing so in 10 straight from July 20-29 (G1), 2025, and in 14 of 16 since August 4.

WALKING IT OUT: Baltimore has drawn at least one walk in 119 straight games since April 6, the longest active streak in the majors ahead of the Twins (43 G).

- ⚾ Baltimore has secured a walk in 100 straight games for the sixth time in franchise history (since 1954)...The O's drew 1+ walk in a franchise-record 172 games from July 2, 2024-July 12, 2025...The current 119-game stretch is the longest single-season streak in team history (since 1954), surpassing a 112-game run in 1995.
- ⚾ The Birds have been held without a free pass only once this season (4/5 at PIT).
- ⚾ Overall, the O's lead the AL with 489 walks while ranking third in MLB behind the Cubs (544 BB) and Brewers (535 BB).

NIP AND TUCK: The Orioles are 39-44 (.470) in games decided by three runs or fewer, tied for the fifth-most such games in the league this season and 19th in winning percentage in those situations this year...The club is 31-31 (.500) in games decided by two runs or fewer and 12-19 (.387) in one-run games...The team's winning percentage in one-run games is the third lowest in the majors ahead of the Giants (11-21, .344) and Tigers (12-22, .353).

HOME SICK: Baltimore has lost four consecutive home games for the second time this year, joining June 27-30...The club lost eight straight home games last year from May 3-18...The Orioles are 10-16 (.385) in the last 26 home games since June 13.

PINCH ME: The Orioles lead MLB with 31 pinch-hit RBI this season, ahead of the Nationals (27)...The O's are one of seven teams in the majors this year with at least five pinch-hit home runs, led by the Nationals (8).

- ⚾ **Tyler O'Neill** is one of five players in the majors with at least three pinch-hit homers this year, along with CHC's Michael Conforto (4) and CWS' Randal Grichuk, MIA's Heriberto Hernández, and PHI's Derek Hill (all 3)...His three pinch-hit home runs are tied for the single-season franchise record (since 1954), joining Sam Horn (1991), Jim Dwyer (1986), Pat Kelly (1979), Sam Bowens (1967), and Whitey Herzog (1962).
- ⚾ **Jeremiah Jackson** leads all Orioles batters with six pinch-hit RBI this season.
- ⚾ The team record for most pinch-hit RBI in a season is 45 in 1982...Miami led the majors with 33 pinch-hit RBI in 2025.

QUICK HITS: Rogers is scheduled to make his 24th start of the season and 125th of his career...Was reinstated from the 15-day Injured List (illness) on May 12...Voted as the winner of the 2025 Most Valuable Oriole Award by members of the local media, joining Randy Myers (1997), Mike Cuellar (1974), and Dave McNally (1968) as the only left-handed pitchers in franchise history to be named Most Valuable Oriole...He was the first pitcher to earn the honor since Rodrigo Lopez (2002).

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the win on August 16 at Tampa Bay after tossing 6.0 innings of two-run ball, scattering seven hits (1 HR) and one walk with six strikeouts...Threw 98 pitches, 73 strikes.
⚡ Has allowed two earned runs or fewer in each of his last 11 starts since June 14, the lone exception being July 29 at Detroit (4 ER).

YOU AGAIN?: Rogers is set to make his seventh career start opposite Tampa Bay, having gone 2-1 with a 5.40 ERA (18 ER/30.0 IP).
⚡ Has made one career home start against the Rays, coming on August 31, 2022 as a member of the Marlins (ND, 6.0 IP, 5 H, 1 ER, 1 BB, 5 K).

MORE HOME COOKING: Over his past 10 home starts since April 25, Rogers has received two runs of support or less in seven of the outings.
⚡ Among all 50 hurlers who have made at least 10 home starts since April 25, Rogers' 2.87 run support average is fourth lowest in the majors ahead of TOR's Dylan Cease (1.69), LAA's Reid Detmers (2.25), and TOR/CHC's Kevin Gausman (2.83).

THAT'S MORE LIKE IT: Over his last 13 starts since June 4, Rogers is 6-2 with a 2.45 ERA (21 ER/77.0 IP) and 1.05 WHIP.
⚡ Among all MLB pitchers who have thrown at least 65.0 innings since June 4, his 2.45 ERA is eighth lowest in MLB and third lowest in the AL behind TOR's Dylan Cease (1.09) and BOS's Sonny Gray (2.40).
⚡ He went 0-3 with a 10.31 ERA (21 ER/18.1 IP) and .996 opponent OPS across four May starts...Among all MLB starters who made at least four starts in May, his 10.31 ERA was second highest ahead of COL's Kyle Freeland (12.46).

SWEPT AWAY: Rogers has limited the opposition to a .181 (13-for-72) clip on his sweeper...Over his last six starts, opponents are 4-for-30 (.133) with a 32.7 percent whiff rate on the offering.
⚡ Overall, he is holding lefties to a .130 (3-for-23) mark with 10 strikeouts on the sweeper, compared to 10-for-49 (.204) with 20 punchouts against righties.

LEFT SIDE STORY: Over his past 10 starts, Rogers has limited left-handed hitters to a .143 (9-for-63) clip with three doubles and 21 strikeouts.
⚡ Over his previous seven starts from May 12-June 14, lefties went 11-for-39 (.282) with two doubles, one triple, one home run, four walks, and seven strikeouts.
⚡ Rogers opened the season limiting left-handed hitters to a .091 (2-for-22) mark with two doubles, three walks, and eight strikeouts over six starts.
⚡ His .504 opponent OPS vs. lefties is sixth lowest in MLB (min. 125 BF), including third lowest in the AL behind TOR's Louis Varland (.459) and NYY's David Bednar (.492).

SWING AND MISS STUFF: In 10 starts since June 20, Rogers owns a 25.1 percent strikeout rate and 25.5 percent whiff rate...He posted a 16.6 percent strikeout rate and 22.0 percent whiff rate over his first 13 outings.
⚡ During his most recent 10-start stretch, he owns a 28.8 percent strikeout rate on his four-seam fastball, while producing a 26.6 percent whiff rate on the offering...Over his first 13 starts, he owned a 13.8 percent strikeout rate on the heater with a 21.2 percent whiff rate.

PINPOINT: On July 24 vs. Atlanta, Rogers' 81.8 percent strike rate (72-of-88) marked the highest by any pitcher in MLB this season (min. 50 pitches thrown), ahead of MIL's Jacob Misiorowski on August 2 at Los Angeles-AL (79.5%, 66-of-83).
⚡ Under the same parameter, it was the highest strike rate by an Oriole pitcher in the pitch tracking era (since 2008), ahead of Kevin Gausman's 80.4 percent clip (86-of-107) on May 11, 2018 vs. Tampa Bay.
⚡ From July 24-August 5, Rogers recorded 6+ strikeouts while issuing zero walks in three consecutive starts, tying the longest streak by an Oriole pitcher in franchise history (since 1954) along with Scott McGregor's three-start stretch from July 13-24 (G2), 1979.
