## MILWAUKEE BREWERS (89-67) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (73-83)

SEPTEMBER 24, 2024 AT PNC PARK, PITTSBURGH, PA - 6:40 EDT - GAME #157/HOME #79

RHP TOBIAS MYERS (8-6, 3.05 ERA) vs. LHP BAILEY FALTER (8-8, 4.15 ERA)

**THE PIRATES:** had the day off yesterday...Went 2-5 on their seven-game road trip to St. Louis (1-3) and Cincinnati (1-2)...Are 2-8 in their last 10 games since winning four straight from September 8-11...Have won 15 games in their last at-bat (their most since having 16 last at-bat wins in 2021)...Have won eight games when trailing after seven innings (their most since winning nine times in 2019 when trailing after seven frames)...Have played in 50 one-run games, which are tied for the second-most in the National League behind the Brewers (52); it's also the most one-run games for the team since playing in 51 one-run contests in 2018...Have the best stolen base percentage (85.2 percent) in MLB...Have gone 24-25 against the National League Central (Pittsburgh's last winning record against the NL Central came in 2018 when the team went 43-33).

**TAKING A FINAL STAND:** Tonight the Pirates begin their final homestand of the season with this three-game series against Milwaukee...The Pirates are 38-40 at home this season, including 11-12 against the NL Central...Pittsburgh will conclude the 2024 campaign with three games this weekend at Yankee Stadium.

**SETTING UP THE SERIES:** This is the first meeting between the Pirates and Brewers since July 9-11 at American Family Field (the Pirates took of three games in that series)...A series win would give the Pirates the season series victory over the Brewers for the first time since 2018 (12-7)...After winning two-of-three in Milwaukee in July, it would also be the first time the Pirates have won two consecutive series against the Brewers since 2016/2017.

**ON THE BASES:** Nick Gonzales comes into today with a 13-game on-base streak, which is the longest of his career...Gonzales is hitting .286 (14-for-49) with a pair of doubles, triple, two RBI and four runs scored during his current 13-game on-base streak...It's tied for the fourth-longest on-base streak by a Pirate this season (Bryan Reynolds had the longest at 25 straight games).

**KEEPING UP WITH CUTCH'S MILESTONES:** Andrew McCutchen comes into today one run shy of tying Arky Vaughan (936) for 10th all time in Pirates history...McCutchen ranks second among all active players with 1239 runs scored, trailing only Freddie Freeman (1298)...McCutchen is also two extra base hits shy of 800 in his career (his 798 extra base hits are the third-most among active players)...McCutchen has also played in 1574 games as a Pirate, which is tied with Tommy Leach for ninth all time in team history.

**BUCCO BLANKINGS:** The Pirates recorded their 12th shutout of the season Sunday at Cincinnati (the 12 shutouts rank sixth in the National League)...Prior to this season, the last time the Pirates had more than 12 shutouts was in 2018 (16).

**FIRING CUBAN MISSILES:** Aroldis Chapman comes into today ninth in all of MLB among relief pitchers with 94 strikeouts (Josh Hader and Luke Weaver lead all relievers in MLB with 101 strikeouts apiece)...Chapman's 94 punchouts are tied for the most in a single season by a Pirates left-handed reliever...The only other Pirates southpaw reliever with 94 strikeouts in a season is Rod Scurry in 1982.

**SAVING THE DAY:** Aroldis Chapman comes into today with a National League-leading six saves this month....Chapman ranks 16th all time in saves in MLB history with 332 (Rollie Fingers is 15th with 341)...The only three southpaws in MLB history to record more saves than Chapman since saves became an official stat in 1969 are John Franco (424), Billy Wagner (422) and Randy Myers (347).

**PIRATING:** Oneil Cruz has been successful in each of his last 20 attempts since being caught for the only time on April 22...The last Pirate to steal at least 20 consecutive bases without being caught in a single season is Nate McLouth (21 straight) from May 2 to September 28, 2008...Pittsburgh's 85.2 percent stolen-base success rate leads MLB....Since 1951, the only seasons in which Pittsburgh led MLB in that category are 1979 and 1997.

### ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

September 24, 2015: The Bucs became the fifth club to record 10,000 or more victories with their 5-4 win against the Rockies at Coors Field. Pittsburgh extended its winning streak to six games while Joe Blanton improved to 5-0 as a Pirate after earning the win in relief of starter Jeff Locke. **HOW ACQUIRED:** From the Phillies in exchange for INF Rodolfo Castro on 8/1/23

**STARTING OFF:** The 27-year-old lefthander is in his second season with the Pirates after being acquired from the Phillies at the trade deadline last season (August 1) in exchange for infielder Rodolfo Castro...Falter is in his fourth Major League season...He made 50 appearances (24 starts) for the Phillies from 2021-23...He has also made 36 appearances (33 starts) with the Pirates from 2023-24 after being selected in the fifth round of the 2015 draft by Philadelphia.

**AGAINST MILWAUKEE:** Falter will be making the fourth appearance and third start of his career tonight against the Brewers...He struck out a career-high tying eight batters, allowed one run in 7.0-plus innings, and won a 2-1 decision in his only start against the Crew this year on April 23 at PNC Park...He made his Pirates debut on August 5 of last season at Milwaukee, where he allowed one run in 4.0 innings in a no-decision.

**BACK AT PNC:** Tonight will be Falter's 14th start of the season at PNC Park...In his last appearance here, he took a no-hitter into the seventh inning while winning a 3-1 decision against the Marlins on September 11...Jonah Bride broke up Falter's no-hit bid with a one-out single in the seventh inning...Jalen Beeks closed out the win by picking up the save.

**HITTING HIS SPOTS:** Falter comes into today with the longest active streak in MLB without hitting a batter (1059 plate appearances from August 20, 2022 to September 17, 2024)...According to the Elias Sports Bureau, the last pitcher with as long of a streak without hitting a batter was Yusmeiro Petit (1205 plate appearances) from April 21, 2017 to June 6, 2021.

**THIS MONTH:** Falter is 2-1 with a 2.50 ERA (18.0ip/5er) in three starts this month... He won each of his first two starts of this month against the Nationals on September 5 and on September 11 against the Marlins...He lost for the first time this month and for the first time since the All-Star break in his last start on September 17 at St. Louis.

**STAYING IN THE PARK:** Falter surrendered 11 home runs in 68.1 innings (1.45 per 9.0 innings) in his first 12 starts of this season through June 6...Since then he has allowed five home runs in 66.0 innings in his last 14 starts, averaging 0.68 per 9.0 innings.

**AND THE WHIFF:** Falter had a career-high tying eight strikeouts in his start on August 17 against the Mariners here at PNC Park...It was his fourth career eight-strikeout game and second of the season after also punching out eight batters on April 23 against the Brewers at PNC Park.

**FIRING BLANKS:** Falter posted a scoreless streak of 19.2 innings earlier this season from May 12-24...It's the longest scoreless streak of this season by a Pirate.
