- Making 31st start of season and 88th of career.
Last pitched on September 24 vs. Miami, tossing 5.0 innings and allowing four runs on eight hits (1 HR), two walks and seven strikeouts in his eighth loss of the season...Twins lost 4-1.
Has a 0.69 ERA (13.0 IP, 1 ER), six hits allowed, three walks and 13 strikeouts in two career starts vs. BAL.

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched on September 24 vs. Miami...took his eighth loss of the season...tossed a scoreless first inning and then allowed a four-run second inning; allowed a solo home run to Jonah Bride, a two-run double to Xavier Edwards and a Nick Fortes RBI single...tossed three scoreless innings to complete his outing...allowed four runs on eight hits (1 HR), two walks and seven strikeouts in 5.0 innings -- tied his career-high with a three-decision losing streak, previously done from May 22-June 8, 2023.

Reached 30 starts in a season for the first time in his career.

TWO STARTS AGO: Made the start on September 18 at Cleveland and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 10-inning, 5-4 loss...allowed two runs on four hits (2 HR) in 7.0 innings, with no walks and a career-high 12 strikeouts; previous high was 11 on July 28, 2024 at Detroit...both runs came on Josh Naylor solo home runs.

Induced 17 whiffs on 54 swings (31.5%).

VS. BALTIMORE: Making third career start against Baltimore...last faced the Orioles on July 7, 2023 at Target Field; did not factor into the decision of the Twins' 3-1 loss, allowing one run on four hits, with three walks and five strikeouts in 6.0 innings of work.

In two career starts vs. Baltimore, he is 1-0, 0.69 ERA (13.0 IP, 1 ER), three walks, 13 strikeouts, a 0.69 WHIP and a .140 (6-for-43) opponent batting average.

BACK AT HOME: Making his 15th home start of the season...in the previous 14, he's gone 7-4 with a 4.27 ERA (78.0 IP, 37 ER), 23 walks, 88 strikeouts, a 1.12 WHIP and a .219 (64-for-292) opponent batting average...in 16 road starts, he is 5-4, 3.67 ERA (95.2 IP, 39 ER), 20 walks, 99 strikeouts, a 0.91 WHIP and a .195 (67-for-343) opponent batting average.

Has gone 14-8 with a 3.82 ERA (226.1 IP, 96 ER) in 43 career home starts, compared to 11-12 with a 3.68 ERA (240.0 IP, 98 ER) in 44 road starts.

In his last three home starts, he is 0-2, 5.09 ERA (17.2 IP, 10 ER), seven walks, 21 strikeouts, a 1.25 WHIP and a .227 (15-for-66) opponent batting average.

The Twins are 8-6 in Ober's 14 home starts this season.

Since making his debut in 2021, Ober is second on the Twins in home wins with 14, trailing Joe Ryan (19).

REVERSE SPLITS: Through 30 games vs. Ober this season, lefties have hit .186 (55-for-295) with a .594 OPS and 27.6 percent strikeout rate, while righties have hit .224 (76-for-340) with a .702 OPS and 26.7 percent strikeout rate.

On September 24, Marlins left-handed hitters went 3-for-9 with one double and five strikeouts against Ober...right-handed hitters went 5-for-13 with one home run, two walks and two strikeouts.

Lefties have a 27.9 percent whiff rate and 86.2 mph average exit velocity vs. Ober, righties a 29.9 percent whiff rate and 88.8 mph average exit velocity.

Over his career, lefties are batting .228 (186-for-816) with 42 doubles, three triples, 27 home runs and a .666 OPS...right-handed hitters are batting .227 (210-for-925) with 37 doubles, eight triples, 45 home runs and a .700 OPS.

THE ARSENAL: Has used a five-pitch mix so far in 2024, per Baseball Savant...here's his pitch usage through 30 starts:

In Ober's last five starts, hitters have gone 5-for-45 with 21 strikeouts against his changeup.

His changeup ranks first in baseball (min. 150 PA) in opponent batting average (.147), first in wOBA (.204), first in strikeout rate (39.0%) and third in opponent slugging percentage (.270).

His slider ranks second in baseball (min. 50 PA) in opponent batting average (.099) and sixth in opponent SLG (.169).

CAREER NOTES

- Made Postseason debut in 2023 ALDS vs. Houston, allowing six runs on eight hits (4 HR) in 4.1 total innings between Games 1 and 3.
In 2023, made 26 regular season starts for the Twins, going 8-6 with a 3.43 ERA (144.1 IP, 55 ER), 29 walks, 146 strikeouts and 12 quality starts.
In 2022, made 11 starts for the Twins along with four rehab starts in the minors, going 2-3, 3.21 ERA (56.0 IP, 20 ER) with 11 walks and 51 strikeouts for Minnesota.
Set career highs in innings pitched (7.1) and strikeouts (10) in 4-0 win over Chicago-AL on September 27, 2022.
Made his MLB debut on May 18, 2021, starting for the Twins against Chicago-AL.
Finished the 2021 season with a record of 4-3, 3.99 ERA (10.1 IP, 48 ER), 24 walks and 117 strikeouts in 24 starts between St. Paul and Minnesota.
In 2020, spent spring training on minor league side of Lee County Sports Complex in Fort Myers, FL...was not part of Twins' 60-man Player Pool for season.
Added to Twins 40-man roster on November 20, 2020.
Split the 2019 season between three levels of Twins organization, combining to go 8-0, 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 100 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average in 14 games (13 starts) for GCL Twins, High-A Fort Myers and Double-A Pensacola.
Led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) with a 0.69 ERA in 2019 and ranked second in the minors with a 0.81 WHIP...also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961.
Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week twice during the 2019 season: once for Fort Myers on August 4 (6.1 IP, 0 ER, 6 H in 1 start) and again on August 25 with Pensacola (1-0, 7.0 IP, 0 ER, 3 H, 0 BB, 12 K).
In 2018, was named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week in consecutive weeks: July 7, going 1-0 with 7.0 shutout innings and 12 strikeouts vs. Wisconsin for Low-A Cedar Rapids Kernels, and again July 14, going 1-0 with two runs allowed in 7.0 innings and 10 strikeouts vs. Fort Wayne...became first ever Twin to win the award twice in a season.
Selected by Twins in 12th round of 2017 First-Year Player Draft; signed by scout Seth Moir...originally selected by Los Angeles-NL in the 23rd round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft, but elected to return to the College of Charleston.
Attended College of Charleston from 2014-17, missing the 2015 season recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow...compiled a 24-9 record with a 2.91 ERA and 254 strikeouts in 259.2 innings over the course of his collegiate career.
