12NEWS SIMULCAST: Tonight features 12News' fifth of 10 simulcast D-backs games...their first simulcast on April 25 was the club's first ever on a local network affiliate...12News reaches approximately 1.59 million television households across the market.

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 7-2 vs. Giants to split the series 2-2.

- Eugenio Suárez hit his NL second-best 27th homer in the fifth inning...his 27 homers pre-All-Star break rank second in franchise history, behind Luis Gonzalez's 35 in 2001...he is the sixth D-back all-time with 70+ RBI pre-All-Star break and first since Paul Goldschmidt's 77 in 2015.
- Lourdes Gurriel Jr. doubled in the seventh for the team's second hit
- Ketel Marte homered (19) in the ninth inning for a second consecutive night...is the third player in 2025 to hit a ninth-inning homer in consecutive games (also: Nick Kurtz/ATH on June 15-16 and Shohei Ohtani/LAD on May 8-9...is the third D-back all-time to do so (also: Damion Easley on June 3-4, 2006 and Reggie Sanders on May 26-27, 2001).

(AGAIN) ALL-STAR KETEL: Ketel Marte was voted as the 2025 NL All-Star starting second baseman...it is his second consecutive All-Star starting selection at second base and third in career (also: 2024, 2019).

- First NL second baseman to win consecutive fan-elected starting assignments since Chase Utley with 5 straight from 2006-10.
- Led all NL players in Phase 2 voting.
- First-ever D-back with 3 All-Star fan elections.
- Second D-back to make 3 All-Star starts, joining Paul Goldschmidt (3).
- Third D-back to earn consecutive All-Star starts, joining Goldschmidt (2014-15) and Randy Johnson (2000-01).
- Sixth D-back to earn 3+ All-Star appearances, joining Goldschmidt (6), Luis Gonzalez (5), Johnson (5), Zack Greinke (3) and Brandon Webb (3).
- Ninth D-back fan-elected start for a position player and 32nd position player selection overall.

4TH OF JULY ACTION: The D-backs host the Royals for the first time ever on July 4 (13-12 record), marking their 11th different opponent on the date...it is the second time ever they are hosting an AL team (Twins in 2004).

VS. ROYALS: The D-backs have won 7 of their last 10 matchups vs. Royals (since 2022), including 4 of their last 5 @ home...own a 21-16 (.568) record all-time.

COOKIN' VS. KC: Ketel Marte has homered in his last 3 starts vs. Royals (July 22-24, 2024) with a combined 7 RBI...over his last 10 starts, is batting .308 (12-for-39)/.955 OPS with 1 double, 3 homers, 10 RBI, 5 walks and 1 hit-by-pitch.

- Geraldo Perdomo has hit safely in 7 straight starts, hitting .320 (8-for-25)/.433 OBP/.913 OPS with 4 doubles, 2 RBI and 5 walks.
- Lourdes Gurriel Jr. has hit safely in his last 4 starts with 1 double, 1 strikeout and 2 stolen bases.

VS. AL CENTRAL: Since 2022 among NL teams vs. AL Centra opponents, the D-backs' 30 wins are tied for fourth wit the Cardinals, behind the Dodgers (40), Brewers (3) and Padres (33).

· Pavin Smith has reached base safely in his last 1 interleague games, batting .300 (15-for-50)/.44 OBP/.740 SLG/1.186 OPS with 4 doubles, 6 homer and 13 RBI.

Ketel Marte has reached base in 10 of his last 11 in terleague games, batting .357 (15-for-42)/.961 OP with 1 double, 2 homers, 5 RBI and 6 walks.
