ORIOLES NOTES

- The Orioles dropped their second-straight contest to the Red Sox by a score of 6-4 in 10 innings, falling to 4-4 on the season...Baltimore is now 8-7 against Boston since the beginning of last season...It was the 65th extra-inning game between Baltimore and Boston at Oriole Park, in which the O's are 26-39 all-time; the Orioles are 1-1 in extra-inning games this season, and are 5-5 in such games since the start of 2020...**1B Trey Mancini** and **RF Anthony Santander** hit back-to-back home runs in the first inning, marking the first time the O's have hit back-to-back home runs since Ramón Urías and Cedric Mullins on 9/25/20 at TOR (5th inning)...It was the first time Baltimore batters homered on consecutive first pitches of an at-bat since Manny Machado and Jonathan Schoop homered off Chris Archer on 5/12/18 vs. Tampa Bay...The O's struck out 10 times, snapping a five-game stretch in which they struck out at least 13 times, the most in Major League history.
- LHP Bruce Zimmermann** made his second career start at Oriole Park and first since 9/17/20, he did not factor into the decision after allowing three runs, including the go-ahead home run to **3B Rafael Devers** in the sixth inning, on seven hits and one walk while striking out four in 6.0 innings...Zimmermann earned his second quality start of the season and matched a career-high 6.0 innings; he is the O's only starting pitcher to throw at least 6.0 innings in both starts this year...Threw 85 pitches, 61 strikes.
- 1B Trey Mancini** hit his first home run of the season and first home run since 9/28/19 vs. Boston in the first inning on the first pitch of the at-bat; it was his first home run at Oriole Park since 9/17/20 vs. Toronto...Marked the 15th time in his career he homered on the first pitch of an at-bat and just the fourth time he's done so in the first inning...Was his first RBI since the third inning on 4/4 at Boston, snapping a streak of 19-straight at-bats without an RBI...Has 13 home runs and 42 RBI in 62 career games against Boston, his most against any team.
- RF Anthony Santander** tied the game with a 407-foot solo home run in the first inning, his second of the season...Was his 10th-career game-tying home run.
- LF DJ Stewart** appeared in his first game this season after coming off the IL...Threw out **LF Marwin Gonzalez**, the potential go-ahead run, at the plate in the fourth inning; was his seventh-career outfield assist and third at home plate...Doubled in the eighth inning for his first hit of the season, putting the tying and go-ahead runs in scoring position.
- CF Cedric Mullins** singled in the fifth inning, extending his hitting streak to 12 games dating back to last season...Is the first O's player to hit safely in the team's first eight games of the season since Dwight Smith, Jr. did so in the team's first eight games of 2019...Doubled in the seventh inning for his fourth multi-hit game of the season; did not record four multi-hit games until his 20th game in 2020.
- 3B Maikel Franco** reached on a fielder's choice in the eighth inning, scoring **DH Ryan Mountcastle** to tie the game...Was his first RBI since 4/4 at Boston, ending a streak of 20-straight at-bats without an RBI.
- SS Freddy Galvis** singled in the eighth scoring **PR-LF Ryan McKenna** to take the lead; it was his second RBI of the season and first since 4/4 at Boston...Marked his first hit since a single on 4/5 at New York-AL, snapping an 0-for-16 streak...Was his 11th career go-ahead base-hit in the eighth inning or later and first since 4/11/19 against Boston with the Blue Jays.

RED SOX NOTES

- The Red Sox defeated the Orioles by a score of 6-4 in 10 innings, securing the series win...Extended their AL-best active winning streak to five games after starting the season 0-3...Improve to 2-0 in extra-inning contests on the year...Improved to 2-0 at Oriole Park to start the season, and will try for the three-game sweep in tomorrow afternoon's series finale.
- RHP Garrett Richards** pitched to no decision after allowing two runs on three hits, two home runs, with three walks and four strikeouts over 5.0 innings of work...Allowed multiple home runs in an outing for just the 10th time in 189 career games; is 1-5 in such games, while his teams have gone 3-7...Both of his first two starts of the 2021 campaign have come against Baltimore...Threw 79 pitches, 47 strikes.
- 3B Rafael Devers** slugged his second home run of the season, a solo shot in the sixth inning that gave the Red Sox a 3-2 lead...Has homered in back-to-back games for the first time this season (last: 9/5-8/20)...The Red Sox are 53-17 in games in which Devers has at least one home run...His 11 home runs against the O's are his second-most against any single opponent (12, TOR)...His six home runs at Oriole Park at Camden Yards are his second-most at any visiting ballpark (7, Rogers Centre).
- CF Kiké Hernández** extended his hitting streak to three games with a single to lead off the contest; hitting .333 (5-for-15) during this stretch...Has reached base safely in each of his seven starts on the year...Recorded his second multi-hit game of the season (2-for-5, 2B).
- C Kevin Plawecki** extended his hitting streak to a career-long eight games dating back to 9/19 of last season; hitting .464 (12-for-26) with five extra-base hits during this stretch.
- In his 2021 season debut, **Michael Chavis** scored the winning run on a wild pitch in the 10th inning after beginning the extra frame on second base as a pinch-runner for **C Kevin Plawecki**.
