BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles continue a six-game road trip tonight through San Francisco (1-2) and San Diego (3 to play)...The Birds are in the midst of a stretch of 14 games in 14 days that began on August 21...Following the series in San Diego, Baltimore will enjoy an off day before taking on Los Angeles-NL for a three-game weekend set beginning on September 5.

🦅 Yesterday's 13-2 loss marked Baltimore's largest defeat to San Francisco in 27 all-time matchups...The day prior, the O's 11-1 victory marked their largest margin of victory over the Giants.

🦅 The loss marked the Birds seventh loss by 10+ runs this season, tied with the Rockies for the second-most such defeats in MLB ahead of the Athletics (8 G)...The seven losses are tied with the 2021 Orioles for the third most defeats by a Baltimore club in franchise history (since 1954), trailing the teams from 2019 (11 G) and 2004 (8 G).

🦅 The O's committed a season-high-tying three errors (3x), including for the second time in three days.

🦅 **Kyle Bradish** is set to make is second start of the season after tossing 6.0 innings of two-run ball on August 26 vs. Boston, permitting four hits (2 HR) with zero walks and 10 strikeouts...It marked his third career start with 10+ strikeouts and zero walks, joining September 22, 2022 vs. Houston (10 K, 0 BB) and May 10, 2022 at St. Louis (11 K, 0 BB).

BALTIMORE TIES: Of the 28 players currently on the Padres active roster, five have donned an Oriole uniform at one point in their career: **Nestor Cortes** (2018), **Jose Iglesias** (2020), **Ramón Laureano** (2025), **Manny Machado** (2012-18), and **Ryan O'Hearn** (2023-25).

🦅 Mason McCoy was selected by the Orioles in the sixth round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft and spent four years in Baltimore's minor league system...Gavin Sheets, the son of former Oriole **Larry Sheets** (1984-89), was born in Lutherville, MD.

HOLLIDAY SEASON: **Jackson Holliday** has scored 1+ run in each of his last eight road games, the longest active streak in the majors...It is tied for the second-longest streak by any player in the majors this season, trailing LAA's Luis Rengifo (9 G)...The eight-game run for Holliday is tied for a career high (also 8 G, 4/23-8/8/24)...The last Oriole to score 1+ run in nine straight road games was **Nick Markakis** (11 G, 8/3-17/08).

🦅 Holliday is the first Oriole to draw 1+ walk and score 1+ run in six straight road games since **Brian Roberts** (6 G, 8/26-9/2/04)...He is one game shy of tying the franchise record (since 1954) of seven games shared by **Ken Singleton** (6/30 [G2]-7/6/75) and **Boog Powell** (6/4-18/69)...Holliday is the first player in MLB to accomplish the feat since KC's Bobby Witt Jr.'s six-game stretch from August 14-26 (G2), 2024.

🦅 He drew 21 walks in 27 games last month, 20 of which came in his final 20 games of August...At 21 years, 271 days old, Holliday became the youngest player in franchise history (since 1954) to record 20 or more walks in a single month, per *Stats Perform*.

ACTION JACKSON: Since making his MLB debut on August 1 **Jeremiah Jackson** is slashing .323/.344/.484 (30-for-93) with five doubles, two triples, two home runs, 12 runs, and 14 RBI.

🦅 Jackson has 29 hits through his first 23 career starts, becoming the fourth Oriole in team history to accomplish the feat along with **Bob Hale** (34 H, 1955), **Billy Ripken** (30 H, 1987), and **Curtis Goodwin** (29 H, 1995).

🦅 He has hit safely in each of his last 16 starts since August 10, the longest active streak in MLB...It is the longest such run by an Oriole this season ahead of **Gunnar Henderson** (13 G, 6/5-19) and the longest overall since **Colton Cowser**'s 17-game stretch from July 19-August 4, 2024.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS: **Dylan Beavers** has reached safely in 11 of his first 14 career games since debuting on August 16, slashing .318/.434/.477 (14-for-44) with four doubles, one homer, eight runs scored, five RBI, nine walks, and one stolen base.

🦅 He has reached base safely 23 times to begin his career, tied for third most in franchise history (since 1954) through an O's first 14 games behind **Curtis Goodwin** (25 TOB, 1995) and **Cedric Mullins** (24 TOB, 2018)...Goodwin also hold the record through 15 games (26 TOB).

HENDERSON'S HIGHLIGHTS: **Gunnar Henderson** leads the Orioles outright in every major counting statistic: hits (137), doubles (30), triples (5), home runs (16), runs (76), RBI (61), walks (49), and stolen bases (20)...Only three AL players have led their team outright in each of those categories: Carlos Beltran (2002 KC), Bob Johnson (1939 PHI) and Babe Ruth (1923 NYY), per *Stats Perform*.

🦅 He can join **Brooks Robinson** (1960-62) as the only players in team history (since 1954) to lead the club in doubles, triples, and hits in consecutive seasons, *per Stats Perform*...

🦅 He needs one more double to match his career high of 31 set last year.

🦅 Henderson has reached 30+ doubles and 20+ steals for the second straight year, joining **Cedric Mullins** (2021-22), **Brian Roberts** (6x, 2004-09), and **Brady Anderson** (1995-96) as the only Orioles in team history (since 1954) to do so in consecutive seasons.

🦅 With 24 more runs this season, Henderson would become the third Oriole in team history (since 1954) to score at least 100 runs in three straight seasons, along with **Brian Roberts** (2007-09) and **Cal Ripken, Jr.** (1983-85).

🦅 Since committing two errors on June 8, Henderson has played 588.2 innings of defense at shortstop without committing an error in 273 total chances.

IT TAKES A VILLAGE: Baltimore has used an MLB-high and franchise record 66 players this season, surpassing the previous team record held by the 2021 team (62 players)...In 2024, only the Marlins (70) used more players than the O's this year.

🦅 **Samuel Basallo** hit his first major league home run on Saturday, becoming the 23rd different player to homer for the team this season, breaking the franchise record (since 1954) previously shared by the 2018 and 2012 Orioles...The current number leads the majors this season and is the most by an MLB club since the 2024 Giants (also 23).

🦅 **Dylan Beavers** became the 19th Oriole to swipe a base this year, tied for the MLB lead along with the Brewers, Mariners, Rangers, and Rays...The 19 players are the most to steal 1+ base in team history, surpassing the previous record of 17 shared by the 2018, 2001, 1990, 1988, and 1955 Orioles.

🦅 On August 18, **Samuel Basallo** became the seventh player to appear at catcher for Baltimore this year, setting the franchise record...The previous record of six was shared by the 1986, 1962, and 1960 O's...The last MLB club to use at least seven catchers in a single season was the 2023 Cleveland Guardians (also 7)...The last to use eight were the 2022 Pirates.

QUICK HITS: Set to make his second start of the season today...Made six rehab appearances between Triple-A Norfolk (4 GS), Double-A Chesapeake (1 GS), and High-A Aberdeen (1 GS), going 1-0 with a 4.91 ERA (12 ER/22.0 IP) and 25 strikeouts...Opened the 2024 campaign on the 15-day Injured List with a right UCL sprain...Was reinstated on May 2 and made eight starts before his June 15 placement on the 15-day Injured List (right ulnar collateral ligament sprain)...Underwent right elbow UCL reconstruction (Tommy John) with internal brace performed by Dr. Keith Meister in Arlington, Texas on June 19, ending his season...Was transferred to the 60-day Injured List on July 11.

LAST TIME OUT: Bradish made his first start in 438 days on August 26 vs. Boston, taking an MLB mound for the first time since June 14, 2024 vs. Philadelphia...He suffered the loss after allowing two runs on four hits (2 HR) with no walks and 10 strikeouts in 6.0 innings...Trevor Story (2nd inning) and David Hamilton (3rd inning) both hit solo homers...Threw 81 pitches, 51 strikes.

🧤 Generated 16 swings and misses, tied for the fourth most of his career and his most in a game since setting a career high with 18 on September 20, 2023 at Houston.

🧤 Fanned 10+ batters for the fifth time in his career, (last: 11 K, 5/26/24 at CWS).

🧤 Became the fifth Oriole (since 1954) to strike out at least 10 batters in his season debut, joining **Corbin Burnes** (11 K, 3/28/24 vs. LAA), **Sidney Ponson** (10 K, 4/4/01 vs. BOS), **Mike Mussina** (11 K, 3/31/98 vs. KC), and **Dave McNally** (13 K, 4/7/70 at CLE).

BEST IN THE WEST: Bradish is making his first career start against the Padres...In three career starts against the NL West, he's gone 2-1 with a 3.94 ERA (7 ER/16.0 IP) with five walks and 19 strikeouts...Last faced the division when he pitched at Arizona on September 2, 2023 (W, 6.0 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 3 BB, 1 HBP, 6 K)...Has made at least five career starts against every other division.

ACE UP THE SLEEVE: Bradish has a 2.82 ERA (67 ER/214.0 IP) in 39 starts since the beginning of 2023...Among starting pitchers during that time, he has the fifth-lowest ERA in the majors (min. 200.0 IP) behind PIT's Paul Skenes (2.01 ERA), DET's Tarik Skubal (2.38 ERA), LAD's Blake Snell (2.55 ERA), and SD's Michael King (2.75 ERA).

PITCH MIX: During his four outings with the Tides, he featured his sinker at a 34.6 percent clip and held opponents to a .250 (6-for-24) mark with five strikeouts and a 10.6 percent whiff rate...He backed the sinker up with his slider, deployed at a 31.8 percent rate, with opponents hitting .263 (5-for-19) with seven strikeouts and a 48.9 percent whiff rate.

🧤 In his first outing of the season vs. Boston, opponents went 2-for-11 (.182) with one homer and six strikeouts off his sinker and 1-for-3 (.333) with one homer and one strikeout vs. the slider.

A LOOK BACK: In 2024, Bradish did not allow a home run in each of his first seven starts, tied for the third-longest season-opening streak by an Oriole in franchise history (since 1954), trailing **Hoyt Wilhelm** (10 GS, 4/15-6/7/59) and **Storm Davis** (9 GS, 4/15-5/24/84).

🧤 In his final start on June 14, he allowed two long balls to the Phillies, including a lead-off homer to Kyle Schwarber and a solo blast by Rafael Marchán.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: In 2023, finished fourth in the AL Cy Young voting, the first Oriole to receive a Cy Young vote since **Zack Britton** in 2016...Went 12-7 with a 2.83 ERA (53 ER/168.2 IP), 168 strikeouts, and a 1.04 WHIP in 30 starts (18 QS)...Became the first qualified O's pitcher with a sub-3.00 ERA since **Mike Mussina** posted a 2.54 ERA (68 ER/241.0IP) in 1992.

🧤 In 2022, made his MLB debut on April 29 vs. Boston (6.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R, 2 ER, BB, 2 K).

🧤 Earned his first career win on May 10 at St. Louis after pitching 7.0 innings, allowing two runs on four hits (1 HR) with a career-high 11 strikeouts...Became the first Oriole to pitch 7.0 innings with zero walks and 11 strikeouts since **John Means** threw a no-hitter on May 5, 2021 at Seattle...Was only the second pitcher in MLB history to have an outing with 11+ strikeouts and no walks in one of his first three career starts, joining WSH's Stephen Strasburg on June 8, 2010 vs. Pittsburgh (14 K).

TOMORROW'S STARTER: RHP TYLER WELLS (SEASON DEBUT)

LAST TIME OUT: Wells made his last rehab start on August 27 at Gwinnett, suffering the loss after allowing two runs on six hits (1 HR) with one walk and five strikeouts in 6.1 innings...Threw 90 pitches, 59 strikes...Has not pitched in a major league game since April 12, 2024 vs. Milwaukee (L, 4.0 IP, 6 H, 4 R, 1 HR, 1 BB, 3 K)...Underwent successful right elbow revision ulnar collateral ligament surgery with UCL repair and internal brace augmentation with Dr. Keith Meister in Arlington, Texas on July 17, 2024.

vs. SAN DIEGO: Facing the Padres for the first time in his career...Has only made two career starts against the NL West, going 1-1 with an 8.59 ERA (7 ER/7.1 IP) in two starts...Made both of those starts in 2023...Suffered the loss on July 18, 2023 vs. Los Angeles-NL (2.0 IP, 6 H, 5 R, 1 HR, 2 BB, 2 K).
