



# Pittsburgh Pirates (13-14) vs. San Francisco Giants (13-14)

LHP Martín Pérez (1-1, 3.45) vs. RHP Jordan Hicks (2-0, 1.61)

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Giants will look to secure a series win in the second game of this three-game series after walking off with a victory last night over the Pirates 3-0.

- ▶ SF is 5-3 through the first eight games of its 10-game home-stand after going 2-2 vs. Arizona last weekend and taking two-of-three from the Mets Monday through Wednesday.
- ▶ The Giants will be trying for the second time on this home-stand to get back to the .500 mark (they entered Wednesday's game with a chance to do so before falling to the Mets, 8-2)...the last time they were at .500 was when they were 2-2 following the first series of the year in San Diego.

**IYKYK: C Patrick Bailey** blasted his second career walk-off homer to give SF the win last night...according to MLB's Sarah Langs, Bailey became the third player in Giants history with two walk-off homers within his first 10 career home runs joining **Matty Alou** and **Jack Bentley**.

- ▶ Last night's win was the first by SF in a scoreless game at home heading to their final at-bat since the Giants walked off the Mets 1-0 in the bottom of the 10th inning on July 19, 2019 (**IF Pablo Sandoval** reached on an error and **OF Alex Dickerson** scored the winning run)...the last time SF won such a game with a walk-off homer (like last night) was June 27, 2018 vs. the Rockies (a solo homer from **IF Brandon Crawford** in the 9th inning).

**PIRATES BOOTY:** The Giants have won 11 of their last 14 games vs. the Pirates dating to July 25, 2021, their most wins in a 14-game span over the Buccos since an 11-3 stretch from August 30, 2000-August 11, 2002.

- ▶ The last time SF took 12-of-15 in a given stretch versus the Pirates was August 28, 1999-May 2, 2001.
- ▶ Strangely, the Giants have lost three of their last four series to the Pirates here in SF dating to the 2019...the lone series win was a three-game sweep of the Pirates here in 2022.

**BINGO NUMBERS:** Giants starters have logged a 0.69 ERA (2er, 26.0ip) over their last five games...they've struck out 19, walked six and allowed one homer in those 26.0 innings.

- ▶ Over their last 20 games, Giants starters have logged a 3.28 ERA (40er, 109.2ip), sixth-best in the Majors...in the National League specifically, it's the third-best starter's ERA in that span behind the Phillies (1.87) and Pirates (3.04).
- ▶ **LHP Blake Snell**, who signed late and didn't really have the benefit of a traditional spring training, has made three starts in this 20-game span with an 11.57 ERA (15er, 11.2ip)...the other Giants starters in the other 17 games have a combined ERA of 2.30 (25er, 98.0ip).

**AIR GROUND JORDAN:** Looking to continue the trend of strong starting pitching this evening will be **RHP Jordan Hicks**, who will be making his sixth start of the campaign.

- ▶ Hicks enters today with 1.61 ERA (5er, 28.0ip), eighth-lowest in the Majors (and fifth-lowest in the NL) among qualified starters.
- ▶ The righty has logged a 55.8 groundball percentage in 2024, seventh-highest in the Majors...in fact the Giants have three of the top-7 groundball inducing pitchers in the Majors entering play today with **RHP Logan Webb** (3rd, 59.7%) and **RHP Keaton Winn** (4th, 59.5%) just ahead of Hicks.
- ▶ Hicks, who is making the transition from reliever to starter, threw a career-high 96 pitches in his last start on Sunday vs. Arizona but also walked a season-high four batters...despite that he was able to limit damage to only one run over 5.0 innings in a no-decision.

**PAT ON THE BACK: C Patrick Bailey** carries a .297/.365/.516 slash line into today's tilt with Pittsburgh...Bailey's .880 OPS is sixth-best among MLB catchers entering today (min. 70 PA).

- ▶ On the other side of the diamond, Bailey's +4 defensive runs saved in the early going are tied for second-most among MLB catchers with TOR's Alejandro Kirk...only SEA's Cal Raleigh (+6) has more.
- ▶ Bailey's 57.1 sweet spot % (a batted ball with a launch angle between 8 and 32 degrees) leads the Majors...that, according to *Sports Info Solutions*, computes to 10 extra balls hit on the sweet spot so far this year...for comparison, his sweet spot % last season was 36.2% (SIS).

**UP ALL NIGHT:** The Giants have scored 47 runs from the 7th inning on thus far in 2024 after getting all three of their runs in the 9th inning yesterday.

- ▶ Only the Braves (57 runs), Orioles (51), Mets (51) and Rays (48) have scored more runs in the seventh inning or later than the Giants this season.

**CAN I GET YOUR CONTACT INFO?: OF Jung Hoo Lee** enters today's game with a 90.9% contact rate that ranks fifth in the Majors.

- ▶ His 8.3% strikeout rate entering play today is the lowest among qualified Major Leaguers.
- ▶ Over his last 16 games dating to April 7, Lee is slashing .311/.382/.410 with 11 runs scored, three doubles, one homer, six walks and two steals.

**FIELD DAY:** Through 27 games the Giants defense has been worth +12 Outs Above Average according to *Statcast*, best in the Majors just ahead Kansas City, Milwaukee and Texas (all with nine).

- ▶ The Giants were at +14 OAA, ninth-best in MLB, in '23.
- ▶ Looking at *Fangraphs* Defensive Runs Saved metric, the Giants enter today at +7, 11th best...they finished the 2023 season at -15 DRS, tied for 22nd of 30 MLB clubs.

**WADE'S WORLD: IF/OF LaMonte Wade Jr.** has reached base in 21 of 25 games where he's had an at-bat this season, and is slashing .356/.466/.475 with 11 runs, four doubles, a home run and seven RBI on the year overall.

- ▶ His .356 batting average is tied for third-best in the Majors (min. 65 PA) while his .466 OBP is second-best.

**WELCOME TO SF:** Hicks signed with San Francisco as a free agent on January 18, 2024 on a four-year deal worth \$44 million...he was originally drafted by the Cardinals in the supplemental third round (105th overall) of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft and spent his whole career with St. Louis before being traded to Toronto in July last season for RHP Sem Robberse and RHP Adam Kloffenstein.

**PUSH TO START:** Is transitioning from a relief role into a traditional starting role...has made 13 career starts entering today, five of which have come this season...Hicks worked almost exclusively out of the rotation in the minor leagues, but the Cardinals ended up moving him to the bullpen to accelerate his path to the Majors.

**GOING THE DISTANCE:** So far this season, he's done well when pitching longer into the game with opponents going 6-for-41 (.146) with nine strikeouts and one extra-base hit once he clears 50 pitches in a game (SIS).

**LAST OUTING:** Tossed 5.0 innings and threw a career-high 96 pitches as he allowed one run on one hit and four walks in the Giants 3-5 loss to the Diamondbacks...his four walks were the second-most he's allowed in a game (most: five on May 24, 2022 vs. TOR)...Hick has allowed two runs or fewer and pitched at least 5.0 innings in each of his first five outings of this season...the last Giants starter to begin a season with five such starts was **LHP Carlos Rodón**, who did so in six straight to open the 2022 season.

**LEADING THE LEAGUE:** Hicks has posted a 1.61 ERA over his first five outings, which currently ranks as the fifth-best ERA in the National League behind ATL's Reynaldo López (0.72), CHC's Shota Imanaga (0.98), PHI's Spencer Turnbull (1.33) and PHI's Ranger Suárez (1.36)...his 0.93 WHIP also ranks as the 10th-best in the league.

**VS. THE PIRATES:** Has faced Pittsburgh 19 times in his career, tied for the second-most appearances he's made against any team (most: 24 vs. the Reds)...was 0-1 with a 7.71 ERA and a .455 (5-for-11) opponents average in four games against the Pirates last season...tonight marks his first career start against Pittsburgh.

**SMALL SAMPLE SIZE THEATER:** Right-handed hitters have gone 4-for-49 (.082) versus Hicks thus far in 2024...lefties, on the other hand, are 12-for-45 (.267).

**SPLIT IT:** According to SIS, he throws his splitter to a height an average of about 1 foot, 3 inches off the ground...relative to other pitchers, that's low... if you take the 57 pitchers who have thrown at least 25 this season, the only ones to throw it lower are Fernando Cruz, David Bednar, Matt Barnes, and Logan Gilbert.

**FEEL THE HEAT:** Since entering the Majors in 2018, Hicks has consistently been one of the hardest throwing pitchers in the league... he has thrown 4,533 pitches in his Major League career, with 1,680 (37.1%) clocked at over 100 mph...so far this year he hasn't thrown a pitch above 100 with his fastest pitch logging in at 99.5 mph on March 30 at San Diego.

**2023 SEASON:** Made 65 relief appearances between the Cardinals (40 games) and Blue Jays (25 games), posting a combined 3.29 ERA (24er, 65.2ip) with 12 saves...his 81 strikeouts, 11.1 K/9.0ip, and 28.4 strikeout percentage were all career bests...threw 470 pitches at 100+ MPH (42.2% off his total pitches) and 24 pitches at 103+ MPH, both second in MLB to Jhoan Duran.

**DIABETIC PHENOM:** Was diagnosed with Type 1 diabetes at age 17 while in high school...he calls himself the "diabetic phenom", which was the Xbox identity he chose for himself... Diabetic phenom evolved into his brand and he now sells merchandise...he wears cleats that say "Type 1" on them when he pitches.

### #75 CAMILO DOVAL ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, Cutter, Sinker

**Last Game:** 4/26 vs. PIT; W, 1.0ip, 2h, bb, k (18 pitches)

- ▶ Since allowing two runs in 0.2 innings in his first appearance of the year on March 30 at SD in a non-save situation (SF won 9-6), Doval has made eight appearances and gone 2-0-4 with five hits allowed, one run allowed, four walks, and 13 strikeouts (8.0ip) for a 1.13 ERA.
- ▶ 10 of his 13 strikeouts this year have come with his slider.
- ▶ Earned his first career All-Star selection last season after posting a 2.63 ERA and converting 26 of his 28 save chances in 41 first half games...was the winning pitcher for the NL team after working a scoreless 7th inning.
- ▶ Wrapped up the 2023 season with 39 saves, tied for the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind CLE's Emmanuel Clase (44).

### #64 SEAN HJELLE ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

**Last Game:** 4/24 vs. NYM; L, 2.2ip, 2h, 3r, 3er, bb, 2k, 2hr (37p)

- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on April 19...made season debut last Sunday, tossing 2.0 shutout innings...missed SF's first 21 games with a right elbow strain he suffered early in spring.
- ▶ Made five rehab appearances between San Jose (A) and Sacramento (AAA).
- ▶ Made 15 appearances for SF last year, posting a 6.52 ERA...had a really nice end to the '23 season with SF, working 7.0 scoreless innings with six strikeouts over the season's final 10 days.
- ▶ 6'11" right-hander is tied for the tallest pitcher in MLB history with RHP John Rauch.

### #77 LUKE JACKSON ▶ RHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Four-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball
