RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals and Chicago White Sox wrap up a three-game weekend Interleague series today at Busch Stadium ... The New York Mets visit St. Louis for three games tomorrow ... Yesterday, the Cardinals erased an early 3-0 deficit with a five-run 5th inning highlighted by **Nolan Arenado's** go-ahead three-run dinger, but the Redbirds fell to the White Sox, 6-5, in 10 innings that included a three-hour, three-minute rain delay.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis opens today in 4th place in the National League Central, 5.5 games behind first place Milwaukee (20-12) and 1.0 game back of Cincinnati (16-17) for 3rd place ... St. Louis is home for 15 games in a 22-game stretch from May 3-26.

CARLSON RETURNS: Prior to today's series finale against the White Sox, the Cardinals activated switch-hitting outfielder **Dylan Carlson** from the 10-Day Injured List and optioned catcher **Pedro Pagés** to Memphis (AAA) ... Carlson, who made his Major League debut versus the White Sox at Guaranteed Rate Field on Aug. 15, 2020 (G1), missed the first 33 games with a left shoulder AC sprain after colliding with **Jordan Walker** on a fly ball against the Cubs in a Cactus League Spring Training Game on March 25 in Mesa, Ariz.

HAPPY CINCO DE MAYO: The Cardinals have a 44-69 record all-time on May 5 with a 18-37 mark at home (5-4 at Busch III) ... They have won 8-of-their-last-11 games played on Cinco de Mayo dating back to 2013 ... Tequila!!!!

DAY TRIPPERS: The Cardinals play their 19th day game of the season today (5-13 record), tied for 2nd-most in Major League Baseball to Detroit (23) and their most through the first 34 games of a season since 1958 (19 day games) ... Prior to 1938, St. Louis played each of the first 34 games of the season under the sun.

SOUTHPAW SUCCESS: Among Major League batters with 750 plate appearances against left-handed pitchers, **Paul Goldschmidt** sports the 4th-highest OPS (1.020) against southpaws since 1974 behind **Frank Thomas** (1.083), **Manny Ramirez** (1.060), and **Jeff Bagwell** (1.023) ... **Nolan Arenado** (.950) ranks 22nd.

INTERLEAGUE ENFORCER: **Nolan Arenado** is batting .448/.529/.655 (13-29) in eight Interleague games this season ... Yesterday, Nado belted his 50th career Interleague homer, tying **Carlos Delgado**, **José Bautista**, and **Torii Hunter** for 12th all-time and most among active Major Leaguers ... Arenado also ranks among the all-time Interleague leaders in RBI (182, 6th), doubles (66, 5th), and extra-base hits (120, 7th).

WINN, WINN, WINN, WINN, WINN: Rookie shortstop **Masyn Winn**, who sports the 3rd-highest line drive percentage (37.9%) in Major League Baseball behind **Freddie Freeman** (38.5%) and **Gavin Sheets** (40.0%), shares the Major League lead among shortstops in defensive runs saved (7) with **Bobby Witt Jr.** - *Sports Info Solutions*

WORKING FOR THE WEEKEND: **Nolan Arenado** and **Willson Contreras** co-lead Major League Baseball in times on base (7) and OBP (.778) this weekend ... Arenado also ranks among MLB leaders this weekend in hits (5, T-2nd), batting average (.714, T-1st), RBI (6, 2nd), slugging (1.429, 3rd), OPS (2.206, 3rd), extra-base hits (3, T1st), and total bases (10, T-3rd).

CLOSE CALLS: Twenty-five of the Cardinals 33 games (76%) this season have been decided by three or fewer runs, 2nd-most in Major League Baseball to the Yankees (26) ... St. Louis is 13-12 in those games.

THE MERRY MERRY MONTH OF MAY: Since moving into Busch Stadium III in 2006, the Cardinals have compiled a .500 or better record in the month of May in 13 of 17 full seasons ... Their best May in that time span was a 20-7 mark (.741 win pct.) in 2013, and their worst was a 9-18 (.333) spiral in 2019 on the heels of a strong 19-10 (.655) March/April start ... The 2023 Cardinals started 0-5 in May, but finished the month going 15-8 for a final 15-13 record.

JUNIOR CIRCUIT JUGGERNAUTS: St. Louis is 246-241 all-time in Interleague play (1997-present), with a .505 win pct. that trails only Los Angeles (.540) and Atlanta (.509) among National League clubs.

CHICAGO CONNECTIONS

Cardinals broadcaster **John Rooney** spent 18 years (1998-2005) with the White Sox - one in TV followed by 17 seasons in radio...Rooney worked with the World Champion team in back-to-back seasons, following the White Sox win in 2005.

Lance Lynn pitched parts of three seasons with the White Sox (2021-23)...was an AL All-Star and finished 3rd in the Cy Young Award voting in 2021.

Paul DeJong was selected by St. Louis in the 4th round of the 2015 MLB Draft...played parts of his first seven seasons with the Cardinals (2017-23)...finished 2nd in the 2017 NL Rookie of the Year voting and was a 2019 NL All-Star.

Rafael Ortega played two minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization (2014-15).

Keynan Middleton pitched in 39 games for the White Sox in 2023.

Dominic Leone pitched parts of two seasons (2017-18) with the Cardinals.

John Brebbia pitched parts of three seasons (2017-19) for St. Louis after being selected from Arizona in the AAA phase of the 2015 Rule 5 Draft.

Dylan Carlson (Aug. 15, 2020-1 at Guaranteed Rate Field), **José Fermín** (July 7, 2023 at Guaranteed Rate Field), **Riley O'Brien** (Sept. 21, 2021 at Guaranteed Rate Field), **Kyle Leahy** (July 7, 2023 at Guaranteed Rate Field) and **Turner Ward** (Sept. 10, 1990 at Cleveland Stadium) made MLB debuts vs. the White Sox.

Willie McGee was originally selected by the White Sox in the 7th round of the 1976 MLB Draft, but did not sign.

Brandon Allen was originally drafted by the White Sox in the fifth round of the 2004 MLB Draft out of Montgomery (Texas) High School...played five minor league seasons with the White Sox (2004-09).

Tommy Pham was selected by the Cardinals in the 16th round of the 2006 MLB Draft...played parts of his first five seasons in St. Louis (2014-18).

Hall of Fame Manager **Tony La Russa** managed both the Cardinals (1996-2011) and White Sox (1979-86, 2021-22).

Dan O'Connor Assistant Video Coordinator was born in Chicago and was an usher at the stadium in Section 136/137 by the White Sox dugout during the 2006 season...Dan is the son of longtime Chicago Tribune investigative reporter **Matt O'Connor** Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** pitched in 52 games for the White Sox in 1988...originally traded by the Cardinals with outfielder Lance Johnson and cash to Chicago for pitcher Jose DeLeon.

Cardinals VP/General Manager **Michael Girsch** is a Chicago native...graduated from the University of Notre Dame and the University of Chicago.

White Sox Head Groundskeeper **Roger Bossard** designed and built new playing fields at Busch Stadium II and Busch Stadium III, as well as Roger Dean Stadium in Jupiter, Fla.

- Is a career 4-7 with a 5.72 ERA in 18 career starts and 2-2 with a 3.71 ERA in 25 career relief appearances.
- Has a 3-3 record with a 3.82 ERA in seven career starts at Busch Stadium.
- His first three starts at Busch Stadium were all 5.0 scoreless innings each (5/28/22 vs. MIL; 6/14/22 vs. PIT & 5/17/22 vs. MIL), all N.L. Central opponents.
- Was credited with win in Game 1 on Tue. at DET (4/30), working scoreless 8th in 2-1 come-from-behind win.
- Took loss at NYM (4/28) in an 11-inning 4-2 walk-off decision. Worked a season-high 3.0 IP on 38 pitches; Had his 8.1 IP ShO streak snapped.
- Leads Cardinals relievers with five appearances of 4 outs or more.
- Appeared on consecutive days three times this season.
- Has held LH batters to a .091 opp. BA (2-22) this season.
- Moved to the bullpen after four games started this Spring. Ranked 2nd behind only Miles Mikolas (21.0) in innings pitched (17.2) this Spring.
- Acquired from the Rays in a four-player trade in January 2020. Former 1st round pick in 2018 (TB).

LAST TIME OUT

- Threw a scoreless inning in relief of starting pitcher Miles Mikolas at Comerica Park in a 4-1 loss.
- Was his second appearance in less than 24 hours after earning the win in relief in Game 1 of the DH on Tuesday by pitching a scoreless 8th inning as the Cardinals rallied to win 2-1 in the 9th.

CAREER

- Made his Major League debut for the Cardinals in 2022 in Pittsburgh (5/21/22) at PNC Park tossing 4.2 innings in a no decision.
- Entered 2024 holding opposing left-handed batters to a .193 BA (16-83, HR) over his career, 2nd-lowest mark among Cardinals pitchers from 2022-23 with 95 or more batters faced (Ryan Helsley, .173).
- 2021 Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year
- In his first season of play in the Cardinals organization (2021), set career highs and led the Cardinals minor leagues in wins (9), innings pitched (124.2), and strikeouts (123).
- Is a friend and former childhood teammate of Cardinals infielder Nolan Gorman.
- Started for the National League in the 2021 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Coors Field. Worked a perfect first frame on 13 pitches, retiring a trio of then-Top 10 prospects in Bobby Witt Jr., Jarred Kelenic and Julio Rodríguez.
- Ranked as the No. 4 prospect in the Cardinals organization in 2023 by Baseball America. Previously was ranked No. 3 in 2022, and the No. 2 prospect in both 2021 and 2020.
- Rated as having the "Best Changeup" in the organization in 2022, and "Best Curveball" in the Rays (2019) and Cardinals (2020) organizations by Baseball America.
- Also obtained in the 2020 trade package that netted Liberatore from Tampa Bay was the Rays Competitive Balance Round B selection in the 2020 MLB Draft (63rd overall), which St. Louis used to select minor league pitcher and current prospect Tink Hence.

2023

- Made 22 appearances in St. Louis with 11 starts.
- Established Major League single-season highs in wins (3), appearances, starts, innings pitched (61.2) and strikeouts (46).
- Pitched arguably his finest career outing against his original drafting organization (Rays) at Tropicana Field vs. TB (8/10) firing 8.0 scoreless innings of two-hit ball with a season-high seven strikeouts in a 5-2 win.
- Was the starting pitcher in the Cardinals win over the Cubs at London Stadium on June 25, 2023 when Jack Flaherty was scratched less than 24 hours prior to the start. Pitched 2.1 innings allowing four unearned runs in a no decision as the Cardinals rallied for a 7-5 victory.
