TONIGHT'S GAME: The Giants and DBacks play the final game of this three-game series...SF is 6-6 against ARI this season, having gone 3-4 at Oracle Park and 3-2 here at Chase Field.

- ► The Giants' 11-0 win over the Diamondbacks last night was their largest margin of victory at Chase Field...the previous high was +8 (done six times, last May 25, 2021).
- SF enters tonight having won each of its last five games...it's the Giants' longest win streak since last season when they won seven-straight from July 8-18.
- San Francisco has outscored opponents 30-4 over the last five games while outhomering their opponent 13-0.
- SF enters tonight with a positive run differential (+7) for the first time since March 30 (+6).
- The Giants enter today having won seven of their last eight games to push them back to the .500 mark.
- The Giants will need to win three of their final four games to finish with a winning record (82-80) for the second time in the last eight seasons (107 wins in 2021).

BRING OUT THAT BROOM...AGAIN: The Giants can sweep the Diamondbacks with a win today after taking the first two games of this three-game series.

- The Giants haven't swept a series of three-or-more games from Arizona since September 28-30, 2021 at Oracle Park.
- San Francisco hasn't swept a series here at Chase Field of three-or-more games since June 29-July 1, 2018.
- SF is trying to sweep its fourth series of the season...the only three sweeps the Giants have completed this year have come against the Rockies (a three-game set at Oracle in May and a four-game set at Oracle in July) and Royals (last series).
- The last time SF swept back-to-back road series of threeor-more games was June 12-18, 2023 (at STL, at LAD).

ENDING STRONG: SF is 7-1 on its final road trip of the year, a nine-game trek at Baltimore (2-1), Kansas City (3-0) & Arizona (2-0)...a win tonight and the Giants would match the 1923 New York Giants for having the best winning percentage on a nine-game road trip in franchise history.

PITCHING SHUTOUTS: The Giants blanked the Diamondbacks 11-0 last night for their third shutout in their last four games and their fourth shutout in eight games on this road trip...the Giants have 12 shutouts on the season, tied for the sixth-most in the NL.

- According to Sarah Langs, the Giants' three shutout wins by nine-plus runs on this road trip are tied for the most in a calendar month in MLB history.
- ► The Giants defeated the Orioles 10-0 to start this trip then blanked the Royals 9-0 on Saturday and Diamondbacks 11-0 last night.

CONFORTO AT THE PLATE: OF Michael Conforto has homered in each of his last two games and has four homers in his last 26 at-bats...he's reached the 20-homer plateau for the first time since 2019 (33)...Conforto is 10-for-31 (.323) with six runs scored, two doubles, four homers and nine RBI in seven games on this road trip.

STARTING STRONG: Giants starting pitchers have limited opponents to three earned runs or fewer in each of their last 16 games, posting a 2.18 ERA (20er, 82.2ip) in that stretch.

In fact, in the last week (since Sept. 15), Giants starters have given up a total of just eight runs in 49.1 innings (1.46 ERA) while holding opponents to a .162 average against.

3 FOR 30: IF Matt Chapman is three HRs away from reaching the 30-HR plateau, something no Giants player has accomplished in 21 seasons since **Barry Bonds** hit 45 home runs in 2004.

- Chapman is slugging .649 with six home runs in his last 15 games...he's looking to become just the fifth Giants third baseman with a 30-homer campaign, joining Jim Ray Hart, Sid Gordon, Matt Williams and Mel Ott.
- Matt Williams is the last Giants third baseman to hit 30+ homers in a season (43 in 1994).
- Chapman has reached 27 home runs in a season for the fourth time in his career...he has ended the year with 27 home runs twice before and set a career-high in homers with 36 in 2019.

KEEP IT GOING: IF Matt Chapman is the first Giant to have a season with at least 25 home runs and 15 stolen bases since **Hunter Pence** in 2013...he's the first Giant third baseman ever to do so and the first NL third baseman to hit those marks in a single season since the Reds' Todd Frazier in 2014 (*Stats, LLC*).

HOMER PARADE: The Giants matched their season-high for homers in a game with five last night...they've hit 13 home runs in their past four games and have 17 overall through eight games on this road trip (2.1 hr/g).

HEATING UP: The Giants are 9-2 (.818) on the road this month despite playing four teams with winning records (Padres, Orioles, Royals & Diamondbacks)...only San Diego (6-1) has a better road record this month.

WITH THE GIANTS: Black is making his eighth start and his ninth appearance with the Giants at the MLB level this season...Black returned to the rotation from AAA after LHP Robbie Ray hit the IL with a left hamstring strain on August 27.

LAST TIME OUT: Picked up the first win of his Major League career last Friday in Kansas City with 5.2 shutout innings in the Giants' 2-1 victory over the Royals...the 5.2 innings were the most Black has thrown in his brief MLB career and just the second time he's reached the 5.0-inning mark in his seven prior MLB starts...it was also Black's first scoreless outing in the Majors and the first in which he did not surrender a home run.

PUTTING IT TOGETHER?: In his last two starts (vs. San Diego and at Kansas City), Black has allowed two runs in 9.2 innings (1.86 ERA) on 10 hits with six strikeouts and two walks...since returning to the big leagues on August 31, Black has a 3.72 ERA (8er, 19.1ip) in four starts with 18 strikeouts to three walks allowed.

THE MIXTAPE: Black adjusted his pitch mix during his four August outings at Triple-A and his four outings back in the Majors have resembled what was working for him down in AAA...below is a breakdown of his pitch mix in his last four starts w/SF versus his first four MLB games (three starts) in May of this year.

THE HOMERS: Has allowed at least one homer in seven of his eight MLB games thus far, surrendering seven home runs in 33.2 MLB innings total (1.87 HR/9ip)...in the minors this year, Black allowed 12 homers in 84.1 innings at AAA (1.28 HR/9ip).

SEAMHEAD: Since his return to the Majors on August 31, Black has struck out nearly a batter per inning, whiffing 18 hitters in 19.1 innings of work (8.4 K/9)...10 of the 18 punchouts in that time have come with his four-seam fastball...however, hitters are 7-for-24 (.292) off his four-seamer in his four starts (six singles, one homer)...Arizona has an .869 OPS versus four-seamers this year, best in the Majors.

SINK INTO IT: Batters have gone 4-for-20 (.200) with five strikeouts off Black's sinker since his return (two singles, two doubles)... last Friday in KC, Royals hitters went 1-for-8 (a single) off Black's sinker with a pair of strikeouts.

AUGUST IN AAA: Black had a 2.91 ERA (7er, 21.2ip) in four starts at the Triple-A level in August before returning to the big league roster on August 31...it was his best month since being optioned down to Triple-A after his first stint w/SF ended in late May...prior to August, Black had an 8.25 ERA (33er, 36.0ip) with one quality start over his previous 10 AAA outings from May 28-July 26.

THE PIPELINE: The 24-year-old right-hander enters today as the Giants eighth-best prospect overall according to *MLB.com*...he's the third-best pitching prospect in the system behind **LHP Carson Whisenhunt** (#3) and **LHP Joe Whitman** (#6)...below is a look at the pitching prospects in SF's system as of today.

FAMILY TIME: Made his debut with SF on May 6 at Philadelphia in the ballpark he grew up going to as a child...Black was born and raised in nearby Scranton, PA before attending Lehigh University in Bethlehem, PA...Black had nearly 60 family and friends on hand for his debut at Citizens Bank Park...Black was the seventh Giant, and sixth pitcher, to make his Major League debut this season.

WHAT'S IN A NAME?: Black told reporters this spring that he and his brother Dixon's names are inspired by the Mason-Dixon line, which is a line that separates Pennsylvania, Maryland, Delaware and West Virginia...per *The Athletic's Andrew Baggarly*, Mason and Dixon have matching tattoos of the geographical location (39° 43' 18" N.) to honor their namesake... Dixon is an infielder at Wofford University.
