THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
AUG. 7

1998 - A week after his acquisition at the trade deadline, **LHP Randy Johnson** makes his Astros home debut with a 5-0, 5-hit, CG shutout over the Phillies in the Dome...Johnson allows just 1 walk with 8 punchouts...**Jeff Bagwell** has a big night going 3x5 with 2 HR and 5 RBI.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The first-place Astros will begin the first game of a six-game road trip tonight at Petco Park against the San Diego Padres...**RHP Ronel Blanco** (0-1) will make his fourth start of the season for the Astros tonight opposite newly acquired **LHP Robbie Ray** (10-6) and the Padres.

THE TURNAROUND: After a slow start to the season, the Astros are 39-26 since May 22, which is the second-best record in the AL in that span...on that date, the Astros were 20-31, 11 games under, which is their low water mark for the season.

THAT'S OFFENSIVE: The Astros lead the AL in SLG (.416), and OPS (.738), while ranking second in runs scored (540), home runs (157), OBP (.322) and hits (955)...in the Majors, the Astros rank third in homers, trailing only the Nationals (168) and Yankees (164).

BLANCO'S BACK!: **RHP Ronel Blanco** is making his fourth start of the season after missing the first few months while recovering from right elbow surgery...Blanco was a mainstay in the Astros rotation prior to his injury, making 45 starts over the 2023-25 seasons, going 18-11 with a 3.36 ERA (94ER/251.2IP) and a .200 opponent average in that span...in his last start on Saturday against the Rangers, he allowed three runs on five hits and two walks with four strikeouts in 4.2 innings.

ROAD WARRIORS: The Astros begin a six-game west coast road-trip with two three-game series against the San Diego Padres and the San Francisco Giants...the Astros went 5-1 on their last road trip...Houston is also 22-13 (.629) on their last five road trips and are 28-19 (.596) on the road since going 1-9 on their first road trip of the season...Houston is 29-28 overall on the road in 2026.

THE LINEUP: The Astros have used 114 different lineups in their 116 games, repeating a lineup just twice on the season, which includes using the same lineup on Monday and Tuesday...**DH Yordan Alvarez** has the most starts at any spot in the lineup among Astros, hitting second 103 times.

VS. THE PADRES: The Astros and Padres have faced off vs. each other 615 times with the Astros leading the series 321-294...the Astros last faced the Padres in a three-game series at Daikin Park from April 18-20 (Astros went 2-1)...the last time the Astros were at Petco Park was from Sept. 16-18, 2024 at SD (Padres went 2-1).

WEDNESDAY'S GAME: The Astros were defeated by the Blue Jays, 5-4 on Wednesday at Daikin Park in 10 innings...**RHP Hunter Brown** (6 IP, 3 H, 3 ER, 2 BB, 8 K) spun his fifth quality start of the season...**2B Jose Altuve** (2x5, HR, RBI), **1B Christian Walker** (2x4, 2B, RBI) and **LF LaMonte Wade Jr.** (3x4, 2B, RBI) each recorded a multi-hit game.

ROSTER MOVES: **OF Jake Meyers** was recalled from Triple A Sugar Land today...Meyers takes the roster spot of **IF/OF Zach Dezenzo**, who was optioned to Triple A Sugar Land following Wednesday's game.

PITCHER OF THE MONTH: **RHP Bryce Mayer** was named the Texas League Pitcher of the Month on Wednesday...he went 2-0 with a 0.47 ERA (1ER/19IP) in July with Double A Corpus Christi...he also recorded 29 strikeouts, six walks, a 0.79 WHIP and a .143 opponent batting average in four appearances, including three starts during the month...according to MLB.com, he's rated as the Astros number five overall prospect and the top pitching prospect in the Astros system.

HEART & HUSTLE: OF Cam Smith has been the Houston Astros 2026 Heart and Hustle Award winner...this prestigious honor, which is awarded by the Major League Baseball Players Alumni Association (MLBPAA), is presented yearly to players who exemplify a passion for the game and who best embody the values, spirit, and traditions of the game.

NO. 500: **RHP Bryan Abreu** struck out two in 1.0 scoreless innings on Wednesday vs. Toronto...struck out **RF Nathan Lukes** to begin his scoreless 8th inning, recording his 500th career strikeout...became just the 4th reliever in franchise history to record 500 strikeouts with the club, joining **LHP Billy Wagner** (694), **RHP Brad Lidge** (557) and **RHP Dave Smith** (529).

TRADE DEADLINE: The Astros made one trade on Monday, acquiring **OF Daulton Varsho** and cash from the Blue Jays in exchange for **RHP Spencer Arrighetti**...Varsho, 30, was activated on Monday and started the first three games of this series for the Astros, batting cleanup in all three contests.

MVP-CALIBER: **Yordan Alvarez** leads the AL in all three Triple Crown categories, ranking first in batting average (.329), HR (35), and RBI (85)...additionally, he leads MLB in OPS (1.083), OBP (.442), SLG (.640), and TB (265)...in the AL, he ranks first in hits (136), extra-base hits (59), and runs (78), and second in walks (81)...AL leaders below:

HEAVY TRAFFIC: **DH Yordan Alvarez** has reached base safely in 21 straight games (since July 10), batting .413 (31x75) with 16 runs, eight doubles, six home runs, 18 RBI, 22 walks, a .551 OBP and a 1.311 OPS during the streak...Alvarez also has on-base streaks of 25 games (May 22-June 19) and 22 games (April 4-28) this season.

CLIMBING THE CHARTS: **2B Jose Altuve** went 2x5 with a solo home run on Wednesday vs. Toronto...marked his 247th career home run as a second baseman, surpassing **Joe Gordon** and **Ian Kinsler** for the 8th-most home runs by a second baseman in MLB history.

CHIPPING IN: A couple Astros are on mini hot streaks, including **OF Taylor Trammell**, who's hit three homers with seven RBI and a .950 OPS in his last 10 games...**RF Cam Smith** has hit safely in six straight games, batting .385 (10x26) with two doubles, one triple, four RBI and a .945 OPS during his streak...**1B Christian Walker** has a nine-game hitting streak, batting .324 (12x37) with four doubles, two homers, four RBI and a .985 OPS.

LAST START, AUG. 1 vs. TEX: Tossed 4.2 innings and allowed 3 runs on 5 hits with 2 walks and 4 strikeouts last Saturday vs. TEX...did not factor into the decision of the Astros' 5-4 win over the Rangers as part of their sweep last weekend.

BLANCO IS BACK: The 32-year-old Dominican righty is now in his 5th Major League season (2022-26)...tonight marks his 4th Major League start since returning from a yearlong IL stint...has struck out 16 batters through 14.2 innings while holding opponents to a .208 average (11x53) through his first 3 starts of the year.

SEASON DEBUT: Made his first Major League start in over a year on July 20 vs. MIA...tossed 4.2 innings in his return, allowing 4 runs on 2 hits and 3 walks...his 4 runs allowed came home on a pair of 2-run homers...tossed 86 pitches, including 58 strikes...struck out 8 hitters in the outing...marked his first big league start since May 17, 2025 at TEX.

UNDER THE KNIFE: Underwent right elbow surgery in June of 2025...the procedure included a repair of his ulnar collateral ligament with an internal brace as well as a repair of the flexor tendon in his forearm.

REHAB ASSIGNMENT: Made 5 appearances (4 starts) as part of his rehab assignment, which began on June 19 with the FCL Astros and ended on July 12 in a start for Triple A Sugar Land vs. Albuquerque...in his final start with Sugar Land on July 12, he tossed 68 pitches over 4.1 scoreless innings...posted a 1.06 ERA (2ER/17IP), a .203 opponent batting average, a 1.06 WHIP and struck out 13 batters to 6 walks throughout the rehab stint...topped out at 68 pitches on July 12, while reaching 4.1 innings on two occasions (July 1 and July 12).

TOUGH TO HIT: Since the 2024 season, when he became a full-time starter, he ranks 1st among AL pitchers with a .196 opponent batting average and 6.333 H/9 (min. 200 IP)...among AL pitchers since 2024, he also ranks 14th in opponent OPS (.648) and 14th in WHIP (1.12) (min. 200 IP).

VS. SD: Tonight will mark his 1st career start vs. the Padres...has faced all 4 other NL West opponents in his career and has gone 2-1 with a 3.77 ERA (13ER/31IP) in his 8 games (5 starts) vs. the division...has also posted a 2.89 ERA (6ER/18.2IP) in 4 games (3 starts) on the road vs. NL West opponents.

2025 RECAP: Following a breakout 2024 season, he made his 4th consecutive Opening Day roster and got the start in the Astros 4th game of the 2025 campaign (March 31 vs. SF)...was limited to just 9 starts prior to undergoing surgery but still managed to toss 6.0 innings in his final start of the season on May 17 at TEX...struck out 48 batters through 48.1 innings and recorded a .210 opponent batting average in his 9 starts last season.

THE BREAKOUT: Spent most of his minor league and Major League career as a reliever entering 2024, but worked that entire season out of the Astros rotation (outside of 1 relief app.) and was one of the AL's top starters...among qualifying AL starters, he ranked 1st in opponent batting average (.190), 1st in H/9 (6.13) and 2nd in ERA (2.80)...also threw the 17th no-hitter in Astros franchise history in his season debut on April 1, 2024 vs. TOR...was named the 2024 Astros Pitcher of the Year by the Houston chapter of the Baseball Writers Association of America.

ABOUT BLANCO: Was an unheralded prospect from Santiago, D.R., and was signed by the Astros at 22 years old on April 27, 2016...pitched almost exclusively in relief for the first 6 seasons of his minor league career (2016-19, 2021-22)...made 187 minor league appearances (just 21 starts) from 2016-22, which were the most among Astros minor leaguers in that span...was named a Pacific Coast League Post-Season All-Star in 2021 with Triple A Sugar Land.

LAST APPEARANCE (8/5 vs. TOR): Struck out 2 in 1.0 scoreless inning on Wednesday vs. TOR...

MILESTONE MARKERS: On Wednesday vs. TOR, he struck out **RF Nathan Lukes** to begin his scoreless 8th inning, recording his 500th career strikeout...became just the 4th reliever in franchise history to record 500 strikeouts with the club, joining **LHP Billy Wagner** (694), **RHP Brad Lidge** (557) and **RHP Dave Smith** (529)...logged his 349th career appearance on July 1 vs. MIN, surpassing **LHP Joe Sambito** for the 5th-most relief appearances in Astros history.

HEAT OF THE SUMMER: Over his last 16 appearances (since June 20), he's posted a 1.10 ERA (2ER/16.1IP) with 20 strikeouts, a .130 opponent batting average and a 0.73 WHIP...ranks 7th among AL relievers in opponent batting average in that span (min. 15 IP).

TURNING THE PAGE: Since May 3, he has gone 3-1-6 with a 2.01 ERA (7ER/31.1IP)...has also recorded 37 strikeouts, a 1.02 WHIP and a .171 opponent batting average during the stretch...within these apps., he logged 9 consecutive scoreless outings (8.2 IP) from May 3-28...his 9-game scoreless streak is T-3rd-longest by an Astro this season, behind **LHP Steven Okert's** (14-game streak and 10-game streak)...prior to May 3, Abreu had a 12.54 ERA in his first 11 apps. of the season.

VS. THE PADRES: In 4 career appearances vs. the Padres, he's recorded an 0.00 ERA (0ER/4IP) with 5 strikeouts, a 1.00 WHIP and a .143 opponent batting average.

AT DAIKIN: Has made 179 career appearances at Daikin Park tying him with **RHP Ryan Pressly** for the 3rd-most in the venue's history...his 264 strikeouts at Daikin Park trail only **RHP Brad Lidge** (287) for the most by a reliever in the venue's history...also has 192.2 IP in his career at Daikin Park, recently surpassing **Octavio Dotel** (190.1) for the 3rd-most innings pitched by a reliever in the venue's history.

LAST APPEARANCE (8/2 vs. TEX): Recorded his 1st career save, working a perfect 1.1 innings with 1 strikeout to finish out Sunday's sweep vs. TEX...also stranded both of his inherited runners and his 18.2% inherited runners scored rate this season ranks 9th in the AL (min. 50 IP).

LEAGUE LEADERBOARD: Leads MLB relievers with 69.2 IP, with **MIL LHP Aaron Ashby** (61.1 IP) the next closest...also ranks 1st in MLB with 27 multi-inning apps and ranks 6th among AL relievers with 71 strikeouts.

FOUR SEAMS: Opponents are batting .190 (24x126) vs. his 4-seam fastball this season, which he's thrown at a 50.9-percent rate this season...has averaged 95.7 mph with his 4-seam fastball, up from 94.6 mph from his 2025 rookie season.
