**AT A GLANCE:** The Yankees continue their seven-game homestand today with the final game of their rain-shortened series vs. Tampa Bay (0-1 thus far)...are 2-3 on the homestand after splitting a four-game series vs. Toronto and dropping their series opener against Tampa Bay...following this series, will embark on a six-game road trip, featuring three-game sets at Kansas City (Mon.-Wed.) and the Athletics (5/29-31).

- Their 30-22 (.577) record is the second-best in the American League and the sixth-best record in the Majors.
- Have lost each of their last three games (since 5/20)...are 4-10 in their last 14 games (since 5/8) after going 18-5 in their previous 23 games from 4/13-5/7...are still 22-15 in their last 37 games (since 4/13).
- Are in a stretch of playing 25 games in 27 days (5/1-27).
- Have won or split eight of their last 11 completed series and 11 of their 16 completed series this season.
- The Yankees'+65 run differential this season is the best in the AL and the fourth-best in the Majors.

**WHERE WE LEFT OFF:** The Yankees fell to the Rays, 4-2, in their series opener on Friday at Yankee Stadium...**RHP Gerrit Cole** (6.0IP, 2H, OR, 3BB, 2K) made his season debut and his first Major League start since 2024 World Series Game 5 vs. the Dodgers, tossing 6.0 scoreless innings in a no-decision...**C Austin Wells** (1-for-3, 1R, 1HR, 1RBI, 1BB) reached base twice and hit his fourth HR of the year with a go-ahead solo shot in fifth inning...**2B Jazz Chisholm Jr.** (2-for-4, 1 triple, 1RBI) recorded two hits, including an RBI triple in the eighth inning...**CF Trent Grisham** (3-for-5, 2 doubles) recorded a season-high-tying 3H (also 5/7 vs. Texas)...**SS José Caballero** (2-for-4) and **LF Cody Bellinger** (2-for-4, 1R, 1 double) each recorded multiple hits...**LHP Tim Hill** (0.0IP, 3H, 4R/3ER, 1BB) suffered his second loss of the season after allowing a season-high 4R/3ER.

**CLOSE CALLS:** Each of the Yankees' last six games (since 5/17) and nine of their last 13 games (since 5/9) have been decided by 2R-or-fewer...14 of the Yankees' 22 losses have been decided by 2R-or-fewer, with 11 of those losses being one-run games.

**RICE RICE BABY: C/INF Ben Rice** has hit .287/.383/.635 (48-for-167) with 36R, 10 doubles, 16HR, 33RBI, 25BB/2IBB, 2HP, 2SF and 2SB in 47 games this season...has reached base safely in 36-of-43 starts.

- Has hit 3HR in his last eight games (since 5/15), 4HR in his last 11 games (since 5/11), 6HR in his last 17 games (since 5/1), 8HR in his last 23 games (since 4/24) and 12HR in his last 30 games (since 4/16).
- Seven of his 16HR this year have given the Yankees the lead, including four of his last 5HR and five of his last 7HR.
- 26 of his 48H this season have been extra-base hits (10 doubles, 16HR).
- Has hit 8HR in his last 20 games vs. AL East opponents (since 9/21/25).

**MERRY GRISHMAS: OF Trent Grisham** recorded a season-high-tying 3H on Friday vs. Tampa Bay (also 5/7 vs. Texas)...has gone 5-for-9 (.556) with 1R, 3 doubles and 1BB over his last three games (since 5/19).

**CRUZ CONTROL: RHP Fernando Cruz** struck out both batters faced and stranded two inherited runners on Friday vs. Tampa Bay...has stranded 16 of his 20 inherited runners this season.

- **Has not allowed a run in 12 of his last 13 games (since 4/25), going 2-1 with a 0.73 ERA (12.1IP, 1ER) and 17K during that stretch.**
- Has not allowed a run in 20 of his 24 games this season, going 3-1 with a 2.18 ERA (20.2IP, 5ER) and 30K.

**HOME SWEET HOME:** The Yankees have lost a season-high three straight home games...marks their longest losing streak at home since a four-game streak from 8/13-23/25...are still **11-4 in their last 15 home games (since 4/17)**...have gone 16-9 (.640) at home this season, the fourth-best home record in the Majors, trailing only Tampa Bay (19-5, .792), Atlanta (17-9, .654) and Chicago-NL (18-10, .643).

**COLE TRAIN: RHP Gerrit Cole** made his season debut on Friday vs. Tampa Bay, tossing 6.0 scoreless innings in a no-decision...marked first Major League start since 2024 World Series Game 5 vs. the Dodgers.

- In 126 starts with the Yankees, is 59-28 with a 3.09 ERA (765.0IP, 263ER) and 917K...has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in 99-of-126 starts, the ninth-most in the AL in that span...has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 87 starts as a Yankee, tied for the sixth-most in the AL in that stretch...has recorded 25 scoreless starts as a Yankee, tied for the sixth-most scoreless starts by any AL pitcher in that span.
- Since 2023, has started after a Yankees' loss 25 times...the Yankees are 19-6 in those games with Cole going 14-4 with a 2.83 ERA (156.0IP, 49ER).

**WEATHERS REPORT: LHP Ryan Weathers** will make his 10th start of the season today vs. Tampa Bay...has gone 2-2 with a 3.58 ERA (50.1IP, 20ER) and 61K in nine starts this season...has allowed 3R-or-fewer in seven of his nine starts.

**AUSTIN POWERS: C Austin Wells** reached base twice and hit his fourth HR of the year with a go-ahead solo shot in the fifth inning on Friday vs. Tampa Bay...three of his 4HR this year have given the Yankees the lead.

**ALL THAT JAZZ: INF Jazz Chisholm Jr.** recorded two hits on Friday vs. Tampa Bay, including an RBI triple in the eighth inning...has recorded multiple hits in six of his last eight games (since 5/15).

- Is batting .441/.500/.676 (15-for-34) with 5R, 3 doubles, 1 triple, 1HR, 5RBI, 4BB and 1SB over his last nine games (since 5/13).

**ALL RISE: OF Aaron Judge** has reached base safely in each of his last 24 games vs. Tampa Bay (since 4/21/24)...his 24-game on-base streak matches his third-longest vs. a single opponent in his career, trailing only a 32-game streak vs. Baltimore from 9/3/16-9/22/18 and his 28-game streak vs. Baltimore from 5/2/24-5/12/26 (also had 24-game streaks vs. Minnesota from 9/18/17-9/8/22 and vs. Tampa Bay from 7/27/17-9/26/18).

- 24 of his 46H this season have been XBH (8 doubles, 16HR).

**SAVED BY THE BELL: INF/OF Cody Bellinger** has reached base in each of his last 18 home games (since 4/13), hitting .431/.519/.877 (28-for-65) with 15R, 10 doubles, 2 triples, 5HR, 20RBI, 13BB, 1SB and 1SF...has hit safely in 21-of-24 home games this year, batting .372/.472/.756 (32-for-86) with 19R, 11 doubles, 2 triples, 6HR, 24RBI, 18BB, 2SF and 1SB.

- According to FanGraphs and Sports Info Solutions, leads all Major League LF in DRS (nine)...is tied for ninth in the Majors in go-ahead RBI (nine, tied for fifth in AL).

**FOR STARTERS: Yankees starters** have posted a 3.15 ERA (282.2IP, 99ER) and 282K in 52 starts this season...**have allowed 3R-or-fewer in 44 of their 52 starts this season, tied with Milwaukee for the most in the Majors...also marks their second-most in franchise history through their first 52 games of a season**, trailing only their 47 starts in 2022.

- **Lead the Majors in opponents' SLG (.319), opponents' OPS (.602) and HR/9.0IP (0.73)**, rank third in opponents' BA (.212, first in AL), opponents' OBP (.284, second in AL), WHIP (1.11, second in AL) and strikeout rate (24.5%, second in AL), fourth in ERA (3.15, second in AL), sixth in strikeouts (282, third in AL) and K/9.0IP (8.98, third in AL), seventh in innings pitched (282.2, fourth in AL) and K/BB (3.00, fourth in AL), and ninth in BB/9.0IP (2.99, fifth in AL).

**HIP HIP JOSÉ: INF José Caballero** recorded multiple hits on Friday vs. Tampa Bay after being reinstated from the injured list...has reached base safely in 24 of his last 27 games with a PA (since 4/13), batting .319/.380/.505 (29-for-91) with 15R, 5 doubles, 4HR, 9RBI, 6BB, 3HP and 8SB over that span.

## TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: LHP RYAN WEATHERS (2-2, 3.58 ERA)

**LHP Ryan Weathers** will make his 10th start of the season in today's series finale vs. Tampa Bay...the 26 year-old will make the start on extended five days' rest...made his ninth start of the season on Monday vs. Toronto and did not record a decision after allowing a season-high-tying 5R/ER over 5.1IP (7H, 0BB, 7K, 2HR)...has gone 2-2 with a 3.58 ERA (50.1IP, 44H, 22R/20ER, 13BB, 61K, 8HR) in nine starts this season...has allowed 3R-or-fewer in seven of his nine starts, including 1R-or-fewer in three starts...has recorded at least 7K in six of his starts... **in his last seven starts (since 4/9), has gone 2-2 with a 3.40 ERA (42.1IP, 16ER) and 50K**...has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in five starts over that span...went 2-2 with a 3.99 ERA (38.1IP, 37H, 20R/17ER, 12BB, 37K, 7HR) in eight starts with the Miami Marlins in 2025...allowed 3ER-or-fewer in six of his eight starts and 1ER-or-fewer in four of his starts...missed the majority of the season due to two injured list stints (3/24-5/14, 6/9-9/11)...over the last three seasons (2024-26), has gone 9-10 with a 3.70 ERA (175.1IP, 159H, 81R/72ER, 49BB, 178K, 26HR) in 33 starts...during that stretch, has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in 26 of those 33 starts...since 2021, his 18 pickoffs are tied for fourth-most in the Majors...has pitched in over parts of six Major League seasons with the San Diego Padres (2021-23), Miami Marlins (2023-25) and the Yankees (2026)...has made four career Opening Day rosters (2021 and '23 with San Diego, '24 with Miami and '26 with the Yankees)...began the 2025 season on the injured list...is the son of David Weathers, who pitched in parts of 19 seasons in the Majors (1991-2009), including two seasons with the Yankees from 1996-97, where he won the World Series with the club in '96...became the fifth father/son duo in Yankees history to both play for the club, joining Clay Bellinger and Cody Bellinger, Mark Leiter and Mark Leiter Jr., Ron Davis and Ike Davis, and Yogi Berra and Dale Berra...was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the first round (seventh overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft...was acquired by Miami from San Diego in exchange for INF Garrett Cooper, RHP Sean Reynolds and cash considerations on 8/1/23...was acquired by the Yankees from Miami in exchange for OF Dillon Lewis, OF Brendan Jones, INF Dylan Jasso and INF Juan Matheus on 1/13/26.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Made his ninth start of the season on Monday vs. Toronto and did not record a decision after allowing a season-high-tying 5R/ER over 5.1IP (7H, 0BB, 7K, 2HR)...his 5R/ER matched his season high (also 5R/ER on 4/14 vs. Los Angeles-AL).

**HOME SWEET HOME:** In six starts at Yankee Stadium this season, has gone 2-2 with a 3.93 ERA (34.1IP, 33H, 17R/15ER, 8BB, 41K, 7HR)...has allowed 3R-or-fewer in four of his six starts...has recorded at least 7K in four of those starts.

- ✦ Made his first start at Yankee Stadium with the Yankees on 4/4 vs. Miami, allowing 3R/ER over 3.2IP without recording a decision (6H, 3BB, 4K, 0HR).
- ✦ Made three starts at home with the Marlins in 2025, going 1-1 with a 2.81 ERA (16.0IP, 15H, 5R/ER, 3BB, 15K, 2HR)...tossed at least 5.0 innings in all three starts...allowed 1R-or-fewer in two of his three starts.
- ✦ **Over the last two seasons (2025-26), has gone 3-3 with a 3.58 ERA (50.1IP, 48H, 22R/20ER, 11BB, 56K, 9HR) in nine home starts.**

**2026:** Is 2-2 with a 3.58 ERA (50.1IP, 44H, 22R/20ER, 13BB, 61K, 8HR) in nine starts this season...has allowed 3R-or-fewer in seven of his nine starts, including 1R-or-fewer in three starts.

- ✦ Among Major League starters this season, ranks fourth in K/9.0IP (10.91, second in AL) and fifth in strikeout rate (29.9%, third in AL)...also ranks eighth in K/BB ratio (4.69) among AL starters.
- ✦ Has recorded at least 7K in six of his starts this season, including five of his last seven starts (since 4/9)...his six starts with at least 7K is tied for fourth-most in the AL and tied for eighth-most in the Majors.
- ✦ **In his last seven starts (since 4/9), has gone 2-2 with a 3.40 ERA (42.1IP, 16ER) and 50K**...has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in five starts and 1ER-or-fewer in three starts over that span.
- ✦ Is holding opponents to a .232/.281/.389 (44-for-190) slash line this season.
- ✦ Has received 2R-or-fewer of run support in six of his nine starts this season, including 0R of support in his first four starts (3/30-4/14), recording a 3.58 run support average this year.
- ✦ Has allowed one-or-zero HR in seven of his nine starts, including five starts without allowing a HR.
- ✦ Made his Yankees debut on 3/30 at Seattle, allowing only 1R/ER over 4.1IP without recording a decision (4H, 2BB, 7K, 0HR).
- ✦ Made his third start of the season on 4/9 vs. the Athletics, suffering his first loss of the year despite allowing 1R/ER in 8.0IP (7H, 1R/ER, 0BB, 7K, 0HR, 1WP)...set a career high with 101 pitches and tied his career high with 8.0IP (also 5/14/24 at Detroit with Miami)...became the first Yankee to toss at least 8.0 innings and not allow a walk in a regular season game since Clarke Schmidt on 5/16/24 at Minnesota (8.0IP).
- ✦ Made his fourth start of the season on 4/14 vs. Los Angeles-AL, taking the loss after allowing 5R/ER in 5.0IP (5H, 2BB, 10K, 4HR, 1WP)...recorded his third career double-digit strikeout game (also a career-high 11K on 6/1/24 vs. Texas with Miami and 10K on 4/16/24 vs. San Francisco with Miami)...marked the first double-digit strikeout game by a Yankee since Max Fried recorded 13K on 9/18/25 at Baltimore.
- ✦ Earned his first win as a Yankee after tossing 7.1 scoreless innings on 4/19 vs. Kansas City (5H, 1BB, 8K)...recorded his first scoreless start of the season and first scoreless start since 9/11/25 vs. Washington with Miami (5.0IP)...also marked the second-longest scoreless start of his career, trailing only his career-high-tying 8.0 scoreless innings on 5/14/24 at Detroit with Miami.
- ✦ Allowed 2R/ER over 6.1IP and did not record a decision on 5/11 at Baltimore (1H, 3BB, 9K, 0HR)...did not allow a hit to his first 20BF before surrendering a single to Adley Rutschman to lead off the seventh inning...became the first Yankees left-hander to not allow a hit through their first 20BF in a game since Nestor Cortes did not allow a hit to his first 26BF on 5/9/22 vs. Texas.

**VS. TAMPA BAY:** Will make his second career start vs. the Rays today...made his first career start on 6/7/25 at Tampa Bay with Miami and did not record a decision after allowing 4R/3ER over 3.0IP (3H, 1BB, 1K, 1HR, 1HP).

**2025:** Went 2-2 with a 3.99 ERA (38.1IP, 37H, 20R/17ER, 12BB, 37K, 7HR) in eight starts with the Marlins...missed the majority of the season due to two injured list stints (3/24-5/14, 6/9-9/11)...allowed 3ER-or-fewer in six of his eight starts and 1ER-or-fewer in four of his starts.

- ✦ Missed the first 41 games of the season on the injured list...was placed on the 15-day I.L. on 3/27 (retroactive to 3/24) with a left flexor muscle strain...combined to make three rehab starts with Single-A Jupiter and Triple-A Jacksonville, going 1-1 with a 1.69 ERA (10.2IP, 4H, 2R/ER, 4BB, 13K, 0HR)...was reinstated from the I.L. on 5/14.
- ✦ Made his season debut on 5/14 at Chicago-NL and earned the win (5.0IP, 2H, 1R/ER, 1BB, 5K, 1HR).
- ✦ Went 1-0 with a 1.15 ERA (15.1IP, 2ER) and 15K over his first three starts (5/14-26).
- ✦ Was placed on the 60-day I.L. on 6/9 (left lat strain), missing 83 team games...made two rehab starts with Triple-A Jacksonville, posting a 2.45 ERA (7.1IP, 9H, 2R/ER, 3BB, 9K, 1HR)...was returned from rehab and reinstated on 9/11.

**WEATHERS REPORT:** Over the last three seasons (2024-26), has gone 9-10 with a 3.70 ERA (175.1IP, 159H, 81R/72ER, 49BB, 178K, 26HR) in 33 starts...during that stretch, has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in 26 of those 33 starts.

- ✦ Has limited left-handed batters to a .227/.292/.333 (30-for-132) slash line over that stretch.
- ✦ Has posted a 45.5% groundball percentage over the last three seasons.
