### **SEPTEMBER 26, 2019**

Newcomer **Jaylin Davis** hit his first career home run, hitting a walk-off solo homer off Colorado's DJ Johnson in the bottom of the 9th inning to give the Giants a 2-1 win. He became the first Giant to hit a walk-off homer for his first MLB home run since **Fran Healy** on April 15, 1971 vs. Houston, and the seventh Giant in history to do so.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Giants kick off their final series of 2025 with their first of three games vs. the Rockies tonight...SF is coming off a three-game series defeat to the Cardinals to begin this week, taking only the finale on Wednesday night.

▶ SF is 3-9 in its last 12 games (since September 13), getting outscored 72-49 in that span... SF is 2-5 in its last seven home games since September 10.

**HAPPY MEAL: RHP Trevor McDonald** is set to make his second career start and first career appearance vs. the Rockies...the Giants' No. 17 prospect per *MLB.com* is coming off his first career start on September 21 at Dodger Stadium in which he allowed just one run on six hits and a walk while striking out three in 6.0 innings.

- ▶ In three career games in the Majors (one in 2024), he has a 2.45 ERA (3er, 11.0ip), five strikeouts and a 1.09 WHIP...in the hitter friendly PCL this season, McDonald went 9-9 with a 5.31 ERA (84er, 142.1ip), 144 strikeouts and a 1.45 WHIP over 29 games (24 starts).
- ▶ McDonald's go-to pitch has been his curveball, which has a 43.9% usage rate and 25.0% putaway rate...the Rockies have a .618 OPS vs. curveballs this season (22nd in MLB).
- ▶ Although McDonald has yet to face the Rockies, he did face Colorado's Triple-A affiliate (Albuquerque) each of the last two seasons...current Rockies with history vs. McDonald include Jordan Beck (0x1, bb), Warming Bernabel (1x2), Yanquiel Fernández (0x3, k, bb), Braxton Fulford (0x3) and Kyle Karros (0x3).

**ROCK ON:** The Giants enter this series with an 8-2 record vs. the Rockies in 2025...SF's best season record vs. the Rockies was in 2021 when the Giants went 15-4 (.789) in 19 games vs. COL...their fewest losses in a season vs. COL is three (done in 1993, 1994 and 2024).

- ▶ SF has scored at least seven runs in five straight games vs. Colorado, which is tied for the team's longest streak of seven or more runs in a game vs. the Rockies all-time (also in 2022 and 2021) per *Stats*, *LLC*.
- ▶ The Giants have a chance to join the Guardians (over the White Sox) and Dodgers (over the Rockies) as the only teams to have 11 wins vs. one opponent this season.
- ▶ SF will face Rockies starter Germán Márquez for the third time this season...IF Matt Chapman has three career homers in 12 at-bats vs. Márquez while IF Willy Adames has two homers in nine at-bats...IF Wilmer Flores is also 7-for-16 with a homer and five RBI.

**HOME SWEET HOME:** The Giants enter this series with a 39-39 record at Oracle Park this season...the .500 winning percentage at home ranks 21st in MLB.

- ▶ Discounting the 2020 season, in which there were only 33 home games (19 wins) in a shortened season, SF would need to sweep this three-game series to avoid having its fewest wins at home since its Oracle Park-era (since 2000) worst 35 home wins in 2019.
- ▶ Giants fans have packed Oracle Park this season, with the team's 36,026 average home attendance ranking seventh-best in the Majors this season...that average attendance is SF's best since 2018 (38,965).

**CLOSE CALLS:** All three games in the Giants' series vs. St. Louis were decided by one run... SF's 57 games decided by one run this season are second-most in the Majors behind only the 60 such games played by Pittsburgh.

▶ The Giants' 57 one-run games are its most in a season since they had 60 such games in 1986 (*Stats, LLC*)...SF has reached 60 one-run games in a season just five times in the SF era (also 1963, 1978, 1982 and 1984).

**THE BRYCE IS RIGHT:** Top prospect **IF Bryce Eldridge** recorded his first career multi-hit game on Wednesday...his 3rd inning double had an exit velocity of 109.7 mph, which is the hardest-hit ball by a Giant, age 22 or younger, in the *Statcast* era (surpassing a 108.7 mph single hit by **Christian Arroyo** on May 16, 2017).

▶ Eldridge's 78.6% hard-hit rate is the highest in the Majors (min. eight games).

**WILLIE MAC AWARD:** The Giants will announce their annual Willie Mac Award in a pregame ceremony on the field today at 6:45 p.m.

- ▶ This season marks the 45th anniversary of the award, which was established in 1980, in honor of legend and Hall of Famer **Willie McCovey**..."Competitive Spirit, Ability and Leadership" is engraved on the plaque.
- ► The Willie Mac Award is annually awarded to the most inspirational player on the Giants, as voted upon by SF players, coaches, training staff, clubhouse staff, and the fans.
