# San Francisco Giants (67-66) at Milwaukee Brewers (75-56)

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Giants kicked off their series in Milwaukee with another one-run victory, taking down the Brewers 5-4 with three home runs.

- ▶ Despite dropping eight of their last 14 games, the Giants are still 18-11 (.621) since July 26, which is tied with the Cubs and Yankees for the fourth-best record in the Majors during that span, trailing Arizona (22-7, .759), San Diego (21-8, .724) and Kansas City (19-11, .633).
- ▶ Entering today, SF is 5.5 games back of the Braves for the final Wild Card spot in the NL, tied with the Cubs and also behind the Mets (69-63, -3.0 GB)...according to *FanGraphs*, SF's playoff chances have dropped to just 2.7%.

**SOMETHING'S BREWING:** The Giants hit a milestone with last night's win over Milwaukee, with the game being the franchise's 100th all-time victory over the Brewers since the teams started playing in 1998.

- ▶ SF has a 10-5 (.667) record against the Brewers since 2022, which is the best record against Milwaukee over that span (min. 10 games)...second is Los Angeles-NL 13-7 (.650).
- ▶ Here at American Family Field, the Giants have won nine of their last 14 games dating to 2019 and seven of their last 10.

**TORTURE:** SF is 2-2 on this road trip with all four games being decided by one run.

- ▶ Dating back to August 9 vs. Detroit, eight of SF's 16 games have been decided by one run (3-5 record)...since August 8 at Washington, 11 of SF's 17 games were one-run games at the end of the 8th inning (5-6 record).
- ▶ On the season, the Giants are an even 20-20 (.500) in one-run games, which is tied for 15th in MLB.

**STRAP IN:** The Giants will play 23 of their final 29 games against opponents who are currently .500 or better, with the only exceptions being Miami (48-84) and St. Louis (65-67).

- ▶ The Giants have gone 35-44 (.443) this year against opponents who are currently at or above .500, ranking 18th.
- ▶ SF is tied with Tampa Bay for the most difficult remaining schedule in the Majors, with its remaining opponents averaging a .540 winning percentage.

**SOUTHPAW:** LHP Kyle Harrison will make his first start since earning the win at home on August 19 vs. the White Sox... Harrison struck out five while allowing one run on five hits and two walks over 6.0 innings.

- ▶ Harrison has not been as effective on the road as at home this season...he is 4-1 with a 3.43 ERA, 62 strikeouts and a 1.21 WHIP in 11 home starts (60.1 innings), while he is 3-4 with a 4.61 ERA, 46 strikeouts and a 1.39 WHIP in 11 road starts (56.2 innings).
- ▶ He has thrown his fastball a lot this season, with the pitch holding a 58.2% usage rate while accounting for 71 of his 108 strikeouts...Milwaukee has a .787 OPS against four-seam fastballs this season, which is the sixth-best OPS in the NL.

**CENTURY MARK:** With last night's home run, **OF Mike Yastrzemski** is now at 99 homers in his MLB career.

- ▶ Paired with his grandfather **Carl Yastrzemski's** 452 career home runs, the Yastrzemskis would be the fourth duo of grandfather and grandson to each hit at least 100 home runs in their MLB careers.
- ▶ The Yastrzemskis would join former Giant **David Bell** and his grandfather Gus Bell, as well as both Aaron Boone and Bret Boone with their grandfather Ray Boone (*Elias*).
- ▶ Yastrzemski has played 667 games in his MLB career...if he were to hit the 100th home run this season, he would become 12th player in the SF-era (since 1958) to reach 100 home runs prior to their 700th game as a Giant (per *Elias*).

**MCCRAY-DAY:** Rookie **OF Grant McCray** both homered and stole a base in last night's game.

- ▶ McCray is batting .308 (12x39) with five runs, three doubles, three home runs, four RBI, three walks and two stolen bases through 11 games.
- ▶ The only other player in franchise history to log three home runs and two stolen bases through their first 11 MLB games was **Chick Fullis** (1928-29).
- ▶ Giants rookies as a whole this season have a .780 OPS in 531 plate appearances, which is third-best in MLB behind Philadelphia (.937 OPS in 66 PA) and San Diego (.788 OPS in 546 PA).

**LEADING OFF:** The Giants have a .339 on-base percentage when leading off an inning this season, second-highest in MLB and trailing only the Diamondbacks (.340).

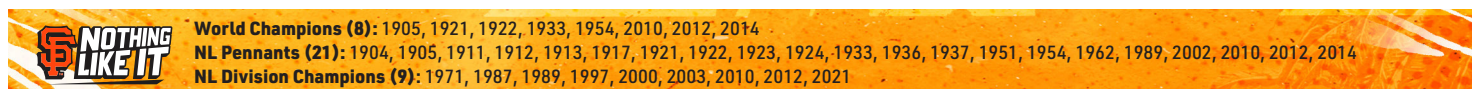
- ▶ SF is also in the top-5 in MLB when leading off an inning in doubles (62, T-2nd), batting average (.263, T-4th), slugging percentage (.441, T-4th) and OPS (.780, 3rd).

**TONIGHT'S START:** Harrison is scheduled to make his 23rd start of the season tonight...Harrison is 7-5 with a 4.00 ERA (52er, 117.0ip) in his 22 starts this season...the Giants have posted an 14-8 record in his starts this season...after a stretch of winning eight straight Harrison starts from April 15-May 24, the Giants are just 5-6 in his last 11 outings.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Earned the win as he had his best start in the month of August on August 19 against Chicago-AL...threw 6.0-innings and allowed one run on five hits and two walks with five strikeouts in the Giants 5-3 victory over the White Sox.

**INNINGSFEST:** With the Giants two recent off days, Harrison received extra rest between starts with his last start coming 10 days ago on August 19...he has worked a career-high 117.0 innings w/ SF so far in 2024...last season, Harrison tossed 102.1 innings between Triple-A Sacramento and the Giants...his previous career-high in innings pitched came in 2022 when he worked a combined 113.0 innings between High-A Eugene and Double-A Richmond.

**VS. MILWAUKEE:** Has never faced the Brewers before.

**THE FASTBALL:** Harrison has relied heavily on his four-seam fastball this season, throwing it 58.2% of the time...he has thrown 1,114 four-seam fastballs this season...he's holding opponents to a .248 average with 71 strikeouts against his fastball...however, in his last three starts, opponents are 13-for-33 (.394) with nine strikeouts off his fastball and five homers...in his two starts prior to that (both against Colorado), the Rockies combined to go just 2-for-28 with 15 strikeouts off his fastball...overall this year, his fastball has a +10 run value.

**CHANGE IT UP:** He's thrown his changeup a lot more this season throwing it 20.3% of the time, compared to 11.1% of the time last season...opponents are hitting .275 off of it, however they are just 4-for-24 (.167) over his last five starts.

**FIRST PITCH:** Opponents are hitting .319 (15-for-47) with five extra base hits off him on the first pitch of an at-bat.

**NIGHT OWL:** Harrison is 6-3 with a 3.39 ERA (32er, 85.0ip) and a .240 opponent batting average during night games this season (15 starts)...during day games (seven starts), he has a 5.63 ERA (20er, 32.0ip) and .302 opponent batting average.

**NO FREE PASSES:** Has limited his walks thus far this season, allowing 38 free passes in 117.0 innings (2.92 BB/9)...however, he's allowed 16 walks over his last eight games (3.63 BB/9).

**ABOUT KYLE:** Entered the season as the No. 1 ranked player in the SF system and the top left-handed pitching prospect for the 2024 season, according to *MLB.com* and *Baseball America*...Harrison was selected in the third round of the 2020 draft out of local De La Salle High School in Concord, CA.
