## NATIONALS NEWS

### WELCOME ROYALS

The Washington Nationals square off against the Kansas City Royals in game one of the three-game series starting tonight.

- Washington beat Seattle, 10-1, on Sunday and secured their third consecutive series win...**Miles Mikolas** threw 7.0 scoreless innings, struck out three and allowed just three hits...The offense, which saw every hitter in the lineup record at least one hit, was led by **James Wood** (3-for-4, HR, BB, 2 RBI, 2 R) and **Keibert Ruiz** (3-for-4, HR, 2 RBI, 2 R).
- Following this series, the Nationals will enjoy an off say in Tampa before starting a three-game road trip over Father's Day weekend with the American League East-leading Tampa Bay Rays.

### WINNING WAYS

- Washington enters tonight's game having won six of their last nine games and three consecutive series.
- The Nationals have won 10 of their last 11 series since May 12.
  - The Nationals have a 26-19 (.577) record since April 25 and have won 10 of 15 series over this stretch.
  - The Nationals are 11-9 (.555) at home dating back to May 3...This comes after starting the season with a 3-12 (.200) record at Nationals Park.

### VOTE FOR OUR ALL-STARS

All-Star voting is now open and **CJ Abrams** and **James Wood** have placed themselves among the best players in Major League Baseball and the National League... See charts to the right for position specific rankings.

- Wood is hitting .355/.465/.626 with five doubles, eight homers, 17 RBI, 21 walks, six stolen bases and 30 runs in his last 28 games...He is the only player in Major League Baseball with 20 home runs and 10 stolen bases.
- Abrams is 8-for-25 (.320) with a homer, five RBI, one stolen base and six runs over his last six games.



### DAYLEN'S DAYS

**Daylen Lile** is 15-for-45 (.333) with a double, two triples, one homer, nine RBI, one hit by pitch, four walks, three stolen bases and seven runs scored over his last 12 games since June 1...He has just six strikeouts in 50 plate appearances (12.0%).

- On the season, he ranks among NL outfielders in triples (T2nd, 3), doubles (T2nd, 16) and hits (T7th, 74).

### CORNER BATS

Since May 22, Washington's corner infielders **Luis Garcia Jr.** (6 HR, 21 RBI), **Curtis Mead** (6 HR, 13 RBI) and **Jorbit Vivas** (1 HR, 4 RBI) lead Major League Baseball with 13 home runs and are tied for the MLB lead with 36 RBI.

- Luis Garcia Jr.** is slugging .586 with three doubles, a triple, six home runs and 21 RBI since May 22...He is 6-for-21 (.286) with two doubles and two homers in his last six games.
- Curtis Mead** is slugging .536 with two doubles, six homers and 13 RBI since May 22.

### ACE OF BASES

**Nasim Nuñez** is second in Major League Baseball with 26 stolen bases behind **Bobby Witt Jr.** and as a club, Washington ranks second in the league with 72 stolen bases behind the Miami Marlins (81).

- The Nationals have stolen 14 consecutive bases without being caught and have been caught just twice in 26 attempts since May 22.

### FRAME JOB

**Bobby Wilson's** catchers rank tied for third in Major League Baseball with five Catcher Framing Runs (**Drew Millas** - 3, **Keibert Ruiz** - 2), according to Baseball Savant..."Catcher Framing Runs converts strikes to runs saved on a .125 run/strike basis, and includes park and pitcher adjustments. To qualify, a catcher must receive 6 called pitches per team game."

- The Nationals are one of just two teams (also Blue Jays) with two catchers in the top 13 in the league...Drew Millas is T7th and Keibert Ruiz is 8th.
- For comparison, Washington's catchers ranked 30th in MLB with -18 Catcher Framing Runs in 2025.

### SAVES ON SAVES

The Washington Nationals have had nine separate pitchers record at least one save this season, tied for the second-most in Major League Baseball with the Cincinnati Reds and behind the Minnesota Twins (11) and the second-most in Nationals history (2005-pres.) behind the 2017 Nationals (11).

- Gus Varland** (5), **Richard Lovelady** (4), **Clayton Beeter** (4), **PJ Poulin** (2), **Orlando Ribalta** (2), **Andrew Alvarez** (1), **Brad Lord** (1), **Mitchell Parker** (1) and **Paxton Schultz** (1) have all recorded saves this year.

## FARM REPORT

### CRUSHIN' CAYDEN

Harrisburg third baseman **Cayden Wallace** connected on two home runs yesterday and ended the day going 3-for-4 with two RBI and two runs scored...He now has a career-high of 14 home runs in just 56 games this season...He is hitting .400 (18-for-45) with four doubles, five home runs, nine RBI, one walk and 13 runs scored in his last 10 games... Eight of the 10 games have been multi-hit performances.

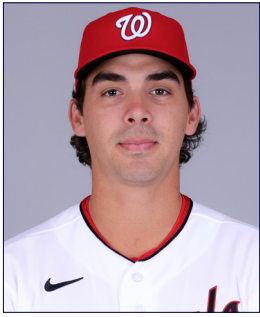

### HE PITCHES, NATIONALS WIN

The Nationals are 8-4 (.667) in Alvarez's 12 career Major League appearances since his Major League debut on Sept. 1, 2025 at Miami.

### 2025

Tall left-hander ranked second in Washington's system (4th in all of Triple-A) with 123.0 innings and third in the organization (10th in Triple-A) with 114 strikeouts at the time of his Major League debut.

- Pitched to a 1.15 ERA (2 ER/15.2 IP) in his first three career starts...Only Tanner Roark (0.95) produced a lower ERA in his first three career starts in Nationals history (2005-pres.).
- Matched the Major League record for a starting pitcher in his first five career games by not allowing a run in three of his first five games (22nd overall)...He was the first National (2005-pres.) to do so.
- Made his Major League debut on Sept. 1 vs. Miami (5.0 IP, H, 4 SO, 2 BB)...Struck out Joey Weimer in the third inning for his first Major League strikeout...Earned the win, becoming the sixth pitcher in Nationals history (2005-pres.) to do so in his Major League debut.
- Became the first pitcher in Nationals' history (2005-pres.) to throw 5.0 shutout innings in his Major League debut.
- Went 3-7 with a 4.10 ERA with 114 strikeouts and 52 walks in 25 starts this season for Triple-A Rochester before he was called up.
- In six starts prior to his callup, he went 3-0 with a 2.37 ERA (8 ER/30.1 IP) with 39 strikeouts and a .170 opponents' average.

Advanced to Triple-A Rochester for the first time...Went 8-9 with a 3.90 ERA in 26 starts between Double-A Harrisburg and Triple-A Rochester.
