AROUND THE HORN

\$111,000 RAISED IN D-BACKS BROADCAST FUNDRAISER FEATURING 25TH ANNIVERSARY WORLD SERIES COLLECTION PRINT: \$111,000 was raised in last night's annual broadcast fundraiser featuring an exclusive, limited-edition commemorative print celebrating the club's first World Series title to benefit the Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation's 25 Years of Heroes campaign, a statewide initiative launched in celebration of the 25th anniversary of the club's 2001 World Series Championship, supported by GovX...the commemorative print honors the 4 D-backs legends who helped lead Arizona to its first World Series championship - Randy Johnson, Curt Schilling, Luis Gonzalez and Jay Bell - and was available in the auction as unsigned (\$75, 500 available) or signed (\$425, 250 available).

HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs are seeking their first home series win vs. Cubs since Sept. 15-17, 2023 (3-0).

- The D-backs have won 8 of their 12 series post-All-Star break (also: split 1, lost 3).
- Vs. opposing lefty starters, the D-backs' .676 win pct. (23-11) ranks atop MLB, ahead of the Brewers (.667, 26-13).
- **Eduardo Rodriguez's** 2.61 ERA ranks fourth among NL starters, behind Jacob Misiorowski/MIL (1.68), Chris Sale/ATL (2.20) and Yoshinobu Yamamoto/LAD (2.61)...in his last 3 bids, is 3-0 with a 1.93 ERA (4 ER in 18.2 IP), opponent .203 AVG (14-for-69), 4 walks and 18 strikeouts.
- **Corbin Carroll** has reached base safely in 14 straight games, batting .347 (17-for-49)/1.153 OPS with 5 doubles, 3 triples, 2 homers, 4 RBI, 9 walks (8 K) and 4 stolen bases.
- **Tim Tawa** has reached base safely in a career-high 11 straight games, hitting .317 (13-for-41)/.890 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 homers, 6 RBI and 4 walks.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 5-4 vs. Cubs in walk-off fashion courtesy of **Ryan Waldschmidt's** 2-out, 2-run pinch-hit homer in the bottom of the ninth.

- The D-backs scored 5 unanswered runs from the eighth inning on (3 in eighth, 2 in ninth).
- **Ryan Waldschmidt** (1-for-1, HR, 2 RBI) hit his second career walk-off (both homers).
- **Gabriel Moreno** (1-for-3, 2B, RBI, BB) ended the scoreless streak in the eighth with a 2-out double down the first base line.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** (2-for-3, 2 RBI, BB) singled behind Moreno to plate the third run.
- **Justin Martinez** (W, 0 ER in 1.0 IP, K) earned the win...his 103.3 MPH fastball (pitch 5) to Michael Conforto was the fastest in his career and fastest by a D-back pitcher in the Statcast era (since 2015).
- **Dennis Santana** (0 ER in 1.1 IP, K) tossed his third hitless and scoreless outing in 4 games.
- **Brandon Pfaadt** (ND, 4 ER in 6.2 IP, 6 H, 2 BB, 3 K) allowed a 3-run homer in the fourth and 1 run on 2 hits in the sixth.

WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs are fourth in the NL Wild Card race, 1.0 game behind the Padres (WC3, season tied 5-5), 3.0 games behind the Phillies (WC2, lead season 2-1) and 6.0 games behind the Cubs (WC1).

FIRST ROOKIE: **Ryan Waldschmidt** became the first D-back rookie all-time to hit a pinch-hit walk-off home run.

- Per @OptaSTATS, **Ryan Waldschmidt** also became the first rookie in MLB history to hit 2 walk-off homers while trailing in the same calendar month (Aug. 7 vs. Dodgers and Aug. 25 vs. Cubs).

2 WALK-OFF HOMERS IN FIRST 3 CAREER HOMERS: **Ryan Waldschmidt** is the fifth player in MLB history to hit 2 walk-off homers within their first 3 career home runs, joining Will Smith/LAD (2019), **James McCann/DET** (2015), Kevin Romine/BOS (1988-90) and Kirby Higbe/Brooklyn-PIT (1943-48) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].

WALDY'S WALK-OFF: **Ryan Waldschmidt** is the seventh D-back all-time to hit a pinch-hit walk-off homer (last: Corbin Carroll on July 29, 2024 vs. Nationals).

- First MLB rookie to hit a pinch-hit walk-off homer since Tyler Stephenson/CIN on Sept. 14, 2020 vs. Pirates.
- First MLB rookie with multiple walk-off homers in a season since Nick Kurtz/ATH (2) in 2025.
- Fifth MLB rookie with multiple walk-off plate appearances this season with Tristan Peters/CWS (3), Dylan Beavers/BAL (2), Justin Crawford/PHI (2) and Carson Benge/NYM (2).
- Second D-back rookie all-time with multiple walk-off homers in a season with Chris Young in 2007 (2).
- Fifth D-back rookie all-time with multiple walk-off plate appearances in a season with Chris Young (2 in 2007), Brandon Drury (3 in 2016), Tim Locastro (3 in 2019) and Corbin Carroll (2 in 2023).

70 WINS: The D-backs have reached 70+ wins within their first 135 games in a season for the 12th time all-time (last: 76 in 2024)...fifth time since 2017 (also: 77 in 2017, 74 in 2018 and 70 in 2023).

MOST COMEBACKS IN MLB: The D-backs' 40 comeback wins are tied for the most in the Majors with the Cubs (40)...they are 1 of 3 MLB teams with multiple 4+-run comeback wins in the eighth inning or later with the Orioles (2) and Padres (2).

- It is the D-backs' ninth season in franchise history with 40+ comeback wins, joining 1999 (45), 2002 (41), 2003 (41), 2011 (franchise-high 48), 2013 (42), 2017 (44), 2019 (41) and 2023 (43).

BEST GLOVES FACE OFF: The D-backs' .990 fielding pct. (49 errors) ranks best in MLB with the Cubs (49 errors).

- The D-backs' 117 double plays rank third in the Majors, behind the Cardinals (133) and Giants (121)...the Cubs' 100 rank tied for 13th.

HITTING LEFTIES: The D-backs offense vs. lefties ranks among all teams in August in AVG (1st, .304), XBH (T-1st, 30), hits (2nd, 77), OBP (2nd, .377), SLG (2nd, .486), OPS (2nd, .863), times on base (3rd, 109) and P/PA (4th, 4.14).

- **Corbin Carroll**, in his last 10 games vs. lefties, is hitting .429 (9-for-21)/1.460 OPS with 3 doubles, 2 triples, 1 homer, 1 RBI and 5 walks (4 K).

OVER THE LONG HAUL: The D-backs' 25 wins (25-16) since July 9 are tied for second in the Majors with the Padres, behind the Red Sox (31).

VS. CUBS: The D-backs are 5-5 in their last 10 home games vs. Cubs (since 2023).
