SEVENTH HEAVEN: The O's beat the Marlins last night, 6-5, to clinch the series and earn their seventh win in a row...**Gunnar Henderson** hit a game-tying solo home run and **Anthony Santander** knocked a go-ahead RBI single in the seventh inning...The bullpen trio of **Mike Baumann**, **Yennier Cano**, and **Félix Bautista** combined to toss 3.2 scoreless frames.

- ⚾ Baltimore has hit 10 homers in the last three games after tallying eight in the previous 13 games from June 25 to July 8.
- ⚾ Baumann improved to 6-0, the most wins without a loss in MLB this season.
- ⚾ **Ryan Mountcastle's** second-inning double registered an exit velocity of 113.1 mph, the second-hardest-hit ball of his career (114.6 mph, 2B, 6/5/21 vs. CLE).
- ⚾ Bautista notched his 25th save of the year, tied for second in the AL and tied for fourth in MLB; marked his 40th career save in his 106th appearance, the second-fastest Oriole to reach that mark behind Gregg Olson (94 G).

COMEBACK KIDS: The Orioles earned their 33rd comeback win of the season last night, tied with the Reds for the most in MLB, and their 69th come-from-behind victory since the start of 2022, tied with the Dodgers for the most in MLB...Trailing 4-0 in the second inning, marking their fourth win when trailing by 4+ runs this year, tied for second-most in MLB, and their eighth such victory since the start of last season, tied for third-most in MLB.

SWEEP DREAMS: The Birds are searching for their sixth sweep of the season, second in a row, and first ever against Miami...The O's are the only team in MLB to not be swept this year...The last time the Orioles swept back-to-back series was July 4-6 vs. Texas (3 G) and July 7-10 vs. Los Angeles-AL (4 G).

WHAT'S TRENDING: Baltimore has won seven games in a row, the longest active streak in the majors, since July 5 after losing six of seven from June 27 to July 4...The team has not won eight games in a row since a 10-gamer from July 3-13, 2022...At 56-35 (.615), the Orioles have the second-best record in the AL and third-best in MLB (see box at right)...The Birds are 118-84 (.584) since the beginning of June 2022, the second-best record in the AL and fourth-best in MLB during that time.

- ⚾ The current stretch marks the second seven-game winning streak for the Orioles this year, joining April 16-24; Atlanta (4x) and Tampa Bay (2x) are the only other teams with multiple win streaks of at least seven games this season.
- ⚾ Marks the third winning streak of at least seven games for the O's since last season; the Birds had four such streaks in the previous 16 seasons from 2006-21.
- ⚾ On Friday, the O's moved to 20 games over .500 for the first time since the end of the 2014 season (96-66) and for the first time before August since 1997.

HOME COOKING: The O's are 28-18 (.609) at Oriole Park this season and have the sixth-best home record in MLB...The Birds have won three straight at Camden Yards after dropping four in a row from June 27 to July 1...The Orioles play the Marlins (53-41) and Dodgers (53-38) on this homestand before traveling to Tampa Bay (60-35) and have the seventh-toughest remaining schedule in MLB with opponents having a combined .509 winning percentage, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

AGAINST THE MARLINS: The Orioles and Marlins are meeting for the only time in the regular season this weekend...Have won a series against Miami for the second time in team history, joining July 16-18, 2000 at Oriole when they took two of three...The Birds have taken three games in a row from the Fish dating back to 2021 after dropping 10 of the previous 12...The O's have never won four straight against the Marlins...Baltimore is just 12-28 (.300) against Miami since the franchise joined MLB in 1993 with the teams first meeting in 1997...The winning percentage is the lowest by the Orioles against one club.

PITCH PERFECT: O's starting pitchers have a 2.70 ERA (20 ER/66.2 IP) with 51 hits (6 HR), 21 total runs, 20 walks, three hit batters, and 59 strikeouts in 11 games this month, including eight quality starts...Last night snapped an eight-game stretch of Orioles starters throwing at least 6.0 innings, the team's longest since 2015, and marked the first time a starter surrendered more than four runs since June 30...Overall, Baltimore's 2.76 ERA (30 ER/98.0 IP) in July is the second-best in the AL and third-best in MLB this month (see box at right).

ON THE OFFENSIVE: Baltimore is batting .311/.381/.549 (80-for-257) with 16 doubles, three triples, 13 home runs, 55 runs scored, and 28 walks as a team in the last seven games since July 5...During that time, the Orioles lead MLB in runs scored, batting average, on-base percentage, hits, total bases (141), and extra-base hits (32) while ranking second in home runs and OPS (.930)...In the previous five games from June 30 to July 4, the O's slashed .198/.261/.290 (32-for-162) and scored an MLB-low 10 runs...The Birds have recorded at least 11 hits in three straight games for the second time this year, joining April 24-26...The team has not done so in four straight games since July 18-21, 2017.

HAYS OF OUR LIVES: **Austin Hays** is batting .338/.384/.500 (27-for-80) with seven doubles, two homers, 15 runs scored, eight RBI, five walks, and one hit-by-pitch in the last 21 games (20 GS) since June 13...His .311 batting average this season ranks fourth in the AL and seventh in MLB.

- ⚾ Hays was named to his first All-Star Game this season, earning a spot based on the MLB player vote; he went 1-for-2, starting in center field and batting seventh following injuries to Aaron Judge and Mike Trout.
- ⚾ His 28 multi-hit games lead the team and rank tied for eighth in the AL.

CEDRIC THE ENTERTAINER: **Cedric Mullins** is slashing .409/.440/.727 (9-for-22) with four doubles, one home run, five runs scored, six RBI, two walks, and one stolen base in his last six games since July 5...He batted .143/.244/.143 (5-for-35) with no extra-base hits, two runs, two RBI, and five walks in his previous 10 games (9 GS) after being reinstated from the IL on June 24.

- ⚾ Mullins has driven in a run in five straight games since July 6, tying his career high set from September 23-27, 2022.

AY, TONE: **Anthony Santander** has hit safely in six straight games while slashing .370/.469/.704 (10-for-27) with three doubles, two homers, five runs scored, five RBI, three walks, and two hit-by-pitches since July 5...His current streak is his second-longest of the season behind a nine-gamer from May 2-10...He's also been on base in 12 straight games, longest active stretch by an Oriole, while reaching at a .442 clip since June 30.

- ⚾ Last night was his 14th multi-RBI game, tied with **Adam Frazier** for the team lead.
- ⚾ He homered twice last Sunday at Minnesota for the second time this year, joining May 5 at Atlanta; his 12 career multi-homer games are tied for ninth-most in O's history (since 1954).
- ⚾ Santander is batting .299/.367/.548 (72-for-241) with 16 doubles, one triple, 14 home runs, 38 runs scored, 41 RBI, 22 walks, four hit-by-pitches, and three stolen bases since the beginning of May; during that time, he ranks among AL leaders in homers (5th), slugging (5th), extra-base hits (5th, 31), total bases (5th, 132), OPS (5th), hits (T-7th), on-base percentage (9th), and RBI (T-9th).
- ⚾ Leads MLB switch hitters with 49 home runs since the start of last season.

BRO'HEARN: **Ryan O'Hearn** is slashing .393/.438/.607 (11-for-28) with three doubles, one homer, four runs scored, seven RBI, three walks, and one stolen base in nine games (8 GS) since July 3...He's batting .331/.375/.585 (39-for-118) with nine doubles, seven home runs, 20 runs scored, 22 RBI, seven walks, two hit-by-pitches, and one stolen base in 37 games (33 GS) since May 16; he ranks among AL leaders during that time (min. 125 PA) in batting average (4th), slugging (4th), and OPS (5th, .960).

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his 17th start of the season, eighth at home, and first career start against the Marlins today...Made 23 starts in his rookie season with the Orioles in 2022...Went 4-7 with a 4.90 ERA (64 ER/117.2 IP) with 111 strikeouts to 46 walks...Was one of 13 O's players (7 pitchers) to make their debut in 2022...Started on the bump for **Adley Rutschman's** debut on May 21 vs. Tampa Bay...Tossed 16.0 consecutive scoreless innings across four starts from August 26 to September 6...Acquired by the Orioles along with **RHP Kyle Brnovich**, **RHP Zach Peek**, and RHP Isaac Mattson from Los Angeles-AL in exchange for RHP Dylan Bundy on December 4, 2019...Originally drafted by the Angels in the fourth round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of New Mexico State...Teammates at NMSU with **INF Joey Ortiz**.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his fifth win of the season on July 6 at New York-working 6.0 scoreless innings on three hits with two walks and five strikeouts...Marked his eighth quality start of the season and first career win against the Yankees...Has allowed four hits-or-fewer in four of his last five starts since June 14...Threw 92 pitches, 55 strikes.

CAREER AGAINST THE MARLINS AND NL EAST: Making his first career start against the Marlins and third career start against the NL East today...Owns a 1-0 record against the division with a 2.45 ERA (3 ER/11.0 IP) in two career appearances.

INTERLEAGUE HERO: Will be his ninth career Interleague start; has pitched to a 2-1 record with a 3.16 ERA (15 ER/42.2 IP) and three quality starts in eight career outings against the National League...Held opposing hitters to a .239 (39-for-163) batting average in those games...Did not factor in the decision in his last start against the NL on June 8 at Milwaukee...Earned his first career win and tallied a career-high 11 strikeouts on May 10, 2022 at St. Louis...Threw a career-high 105 pitches on June 7, 2022 vs. Chicago-NL...Has allowed three earned runs-or-fewer in each of his eight career Interleague outings.

SHIFTING SPEEDS: Bradish is holding opposing hitters to a .182/.216/.282 (20-for-110) slash line against his slider this season...His 42 punchouts via his primary pitch are tied for the 13th-most among MLB starting pitchers entering play today...In 2022, opposing batters slashed .212/.278/.343 (29-for-137) against the off-speed pitch.

HITTING HIS STRIDE: Has pitched to a 4-3 record with a 2.73 ERA (21 ER/69.1 IP) and seven quality starts in his last 12 outings since May 6...Has allowed three earned runs-or-fewer in 11 of those games...Tossed a season-high 10 strikeouts on June 8 at Milwaukee...Did not allow a home run in a career-high-tying three straight starts from May 28 to June 8 (also: 10/2/22-4/19/23)...Completed 7.0 innings in two of those outings (6/14 vs. TOR & 6/25 vs. SEA)...Won consecutive starts for the first time this season from June 20-25.

LIMITING THE DAMAGE: He surrendered one or no home runs in each of his last 31 starts since June 13, 2022; the O's own an 19-12 edge in those games...Marks the third-longest active streak among MLB starting pitchers and longest by an O's starter since Ubaldo Jiménez accomplished the feat in 36 straight starts from July 23, 2015 to September 10, 2016.

SWING AND A MISS: Bradish registered 16 swings and misses on May 12 vs. Pittsburgh, his second-most in a game in his career behind the 17 he recorded on August 26, 2022 at Houston.

2022 HIGHLIGHTS: Started the season with Triple-A Norfolk, going 2-0 with a 1.20 ERA (2 ER/15.0 IP) in three starts with the team...Named the International League Pitcher of the Week for the week of April 11-17 after going 1-0 with a 1.00 ERA (1 ER/9.0 IP) in two starts...Recalled from Norfolk on April 29 and made his MLB debut later that day against the Boston Red Sox...Placed on the 15-day Injured List (right shoulder inflammation) on June 24...Went 3-3 with a 3.28 ERA (26 ER/71.1 IP) in his final 13 starts after being reinstated from the 15-day Injured List on July 29...Notched his first win at Oriole Park on September 22 vs. Houston after surrendering two hits and recording ten punchouts in 8.2 scoreless innings...Allowed three earned runs-or-fewer in 16 of his 23 starts.
