TODAY'S ACTION:

- Will include the completion of last night's suspended game (2:30et), followed by the originally-scheduled series finale (7:10et)...FanDuel Sports Network Ohio will televise the conclusion of the suspended game in addition to tonight's regularly-scheduled contest.
- Are Games 2 & 3 (0-1) of a 3-game series vs JP Nolan's Red Sox and Games 2 & 3 (0-1) of Cin's final road trip before the All-Star break, a 7-day/6-game excursion that includes an upcoming weekend series against the **Phillies** at **Citizens Bank Park**.
- The Reds are coming off a 4-2 homestand in which they won 2 of 3 against both the **Yankees** (6/23-6/25) and **Padres** (6/27-6/29).

LET'S PLAY TWO: Tue's game at **Bos** was suspended prior to the top of the 4th inning, with the Reds trailing, 2-1.

- Marks the Reds' second suspended game this season (also: 6/6 vs AZ)...that game was suspended prior to the top of the 7th inning, with the score even at 3-3...when play resumed the next day, 1b Christian Encarnacion-Strand delivered a walkoff, RBI double in the 10th inning...marked the first run Cin scored in extras this season.
- The Reds have had 12 games impacted by weather this season, including 9 delays (5/1 vs StL, 5/2-5/4 vs Wsh, 5/13 vs CWS, 6/8 vs AZ, 6/13 at Det, 6/18 vs Min, 6/27 vs SD), two suspensions (6/6 vs AZ, completed on 6/7; Tue at Bos), one rain-shortened game (6/18 vs Min), and one postponement (4/29 vs StL; made up as part of DH on 4/30).

SERIES NOTES: The Reds and **Red Sox** are meeting for the only time this season...**Bos** won 2 of 3 games vs Cin at **Great American Ball Park** in 2024.

- The Reds won 2 of 3 games here at Fenway Park in 2023...it was the first time the Reds won a series vs the Red Sox since the 1975 World Series, and the first regular season series win against a team from Boston since a 2-1 series victory vs the Braves in September 1952 (was the opening series of the Braves' final homestand in Boston).
- The Reds' 2-1 win on 5/31/22 was their first victory at **Fenway Park** since Game 7 of the 1975 World Series.

NATIONAL LEAGUE PLAYER OF THE WEEK: INF/OF Spencer Steer on Mon was named National League Player of the Week for 6/23-6/29, marking his second career weekly honor (also: 4/1-4/7, 2024) and the second by a Red in 2025 (also: **Will Benson**, 5/12-5/18).

- During the week, slashed .444/.448/.815 (12-for-27) with 3 homers, 8 RBI, and 5 runs in 7 games...in that time, led qualified Major Leaguers in AVG (.522), SLG (.957), OPS (1.477), hits (12), and total bases (22).
- In Fri's 8-1 win vs SD, he produced his first career 3-homer game, the first by a Red since OF Jesse Winker did it on 6/6/21 at StL...the second of his 3 HR on the night marked his 150th career XBH.
- Has hit safely in 8 of his last 9 games and in 10 of his last 12g.

DON'T CALL IT A COMEBACK: Cin on Sun vs **SD** plated 2 runs in the 9th inning to secure its third walkoff victory of 2025 (also: 6/6 vs **AZ**, 6/24 vs **NYY**).

- Was also its first win this season in which they trailed after 8 innings... prior to Sun, hadn't won a game in which it trailed entering the 9th inning since 6/5/24 at **Col** (trailed 7-6, won 12-7).
- OF Will Benson delivered the win with an RBI single off Robert Suarez... marked his second career walkoff hit (also: solo HR, 6/7/23 vs LAD).
- Of **Cin's** 15 wins in June, 10 were in comeback fashion...those 10-such victories ranked second to only the **Dodgers** (14) for in MLB.

WREAKING HAVOC IN THE FIRST: The Reds have scored at least 1 run in the 1st inning 27 times this season, including Sat vs **SD** (1r, 3h, 1bb).

Cin is tied with LAD for the Major League lead with 63 runs in the 1st inning...this includes the 10 runs plated in the 1st inning on 5/10 at Hou.
 Cin has outscored opponents 63-36 in the first inning and are slashing .269/.349/.420 with 10 home runs.

HISTORIC

Fri's 8-1 win vs SD marked the first time in the expansion era (since 1961) that any MLB team had a pitcher throw 8.0+ no-hit innings (Martinez) in the same game in which a teammate (Steer) hit 3 or more homers (*Elias*).

FRANCONA CLOSING IN ON 2000 WINS: Terry Francona enters today's action 6 wins away from reaching 2,000 as a Major League manager.

- He'd become the 13th manager to reach the 2,000-win milestone.
 Would be the second active manager in the majors with 2,000 wins
- (Tex' Bruce Bochy 2,213).
 Each big league skipper with 2,000 career wins, except for Bochy and Dusty Baker, are in the Hall of Fame.
- Baker (2,183) and Sparky Anderson (2,194 wins) are the only 2,000win skippers to manage the Reds.
- Leo Durocher is the only 2,000-win manager to play for Cin (1930-33).
- Would be the fourth manager to earn his 2,000th win for a team he once played for (1987), joining Bochy (SF), Bucky Harris (Det), and John McGraw (NYG).

ELLECTRICITY: Over his last 37 games dating back to 5/19, SS Elly De La Cruz is slashing .324/.405/.633 (45-for-139, 10hr, 21xbh, 37r, 19bb, 26rbi).

- Has scored at least 1 run in 49 of Cin's 85 games this season.
- Is batting .297/.382/.548 this season <u>vs RHP</u> (65-for-219, 13hr, 42rbi).
- Against LHP in June, slashed .338/.442/.646 (3hr).
- Beginning 6/9, <u>vs. relief pitchers</u> is batting .469/.541/.938 (15-for-32, 4hr, 10rbi, 11r, 20 times on base, 30tb).
- Beginning 6/13, <u>with 2 strikes</u>, is batting .313/.353/.531 (10-for-32, 16g).
 Is 2 HR shy of joining **Eric Davis** (23hr/33sb, 1987) as the only players
- in Reds history with at least 20 HR and 20 SB before the All-Star break.
 Swiped his 20th base of 2025 in the 4th inning of the 1-0 win on 6/10 at Cle, making him the first player in Reds history with 20 or more steals in each of his first 3 seasons in the majors (*courtesy Elias*).

NO ROOM FOR THE BROOM: The Reds have not been swept in any of their first 27 series this season.

- Marks their longest streak of consecutive series without being swept to open a season since 1989, when they went 30 straight series before getting broomed in a 3-game set from 7/17-7/19 vs Phi.
- <u>Cin is the only Major League team that has yet to be swept this season.</u>

THE FUTURE IS HERE: C Alfredo Duno and INF Sal Stewart on Mon were selected to represent the Reds organization in the 26th edition of the All-Star Futures Game, which will take place on 7/12 at Truist Park in Atlanta, GA.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the 8-1 win on Fri (6/27) vs SD... carried a no-hitter into the 9th inning before allowing a double to the inning's second batter, **Elías Díaz** (8.0+ip, 1h, 1r/1er, 2bb, 6k, 112TP).

- The 8-inning no-hit bid marked the longest of his career.
- Was the longest no-hit bid by a Reds pitcher since LHP Wade Miley's no-hitter on 5/7/21 at Cle and the longest by a Reds pitcher at Great American Ball Park since RHP Homer Bailey's no-hitter on 7/2/13 vs SF.
- Pitched into the 9th inning for the first time in his career, as a starter.
- \bullet Matched his career-high with 8.0 inning pitched (also: 9/27/24 at Chc).
- Was the sixth time he allowed exactly 1 hit in a start (last: 8/10/24 at Mil).
- Matched his career-high with 112 pitches (also: 5/28/15 for Tex vs Bos).
- After walking Jackson Merrill in the 1st inning, retired the next 22 consecutive batters until he walked Trenton Brooks in the 9th inning.
- Marked the first time in the expansion era (since 1961) that any Major League team had a pitcher throw 8 or more no-hit innings in the same game in which a teammate (Spencer Steer) hit 3 or more home runs (*Elias*).

JUNE 23 (RELIEF): In Mon's 6-1 win vs NYY made his second consecutive relief app (1.0ip, 1k, 12TP)...was his 139th career app out of the bullpen.

• Replaced reliever Scott Barlow in the top of the 7th...retired DJ LeMahieu (flyout), Jasson Domínguez (groundout), and Paul Goldschmidt (strikeout swinging) in order.

JUNE 21 (RELIEF): In Sat's 11-inning 6-5 loss at StL made his first relief app of the season, his first since 8/2/24 vs SF.

• Relieved starter Brent Suter in the 3rd inning and retired all 6 batters he faced (18TP).

JUNE 19: Suffered the 12-5 loss on 6/19 vs Min (2.2ip, 7h, 7r/7er, 1bb, 4k, 3hr, 1hb, 52TP).

- Allowed a season-high 3 home runs for the second straight outing...marked the first time in his career that he gave up 3 homers in back-to-back appearances...became the first Reds pitcher to give up 3 or more homers in consecutive outings since Tanner Roark did it in 2019.
- Was his shortest start since 6/9/14 for Tex vs Cle (2ip).
- The 7 runs allowed were his most in an appearance since 8/1/17 for Tex vs Sea (7r).

JUNE 13: Suffered the 11-5 loss on 6/13 at Det (5.0ip, 8h, 4r/4er, 2bb, 5k, 3hr, 89TP).

- Allowed a season-high 3 home runs for the first time since 8/21/24 at Tor.
- Entered the 6th inning with the Reds trailing 3-2...walked the first batter in the inning and the last batter he faced (Javier Báez)...that runner would go on to score on a sac fly off reliever Scott Barlow...the 3 previous runs he allowed in the game came via 3 solo homers.

1-2-3 BATTERS : Is holding batters at the top of the order (1, 2, 3) to a .215/.269/.415 slash line with just 8 walks (145 BF)...his 1-2-3 batters have reached safely just 39 times

QUALIFIED: On November 19, 2024, Martinez accepted the club's qualifying offer to return for the 2025 season after opting out of his original 2-year contract he signed in 2023.
